The San Diego State men's golf team travels to the Pacific Northwest this week to compete in the NCAA Pullman Regional, May 16-18, at Washington State University's Palouse Ridge Golf Club in Pullman, Wash. The Aztecs, who are making their 15th consecutive and 18th regional appearance overall will be among the field vying for a spot in the NCAA national championship series, scheduled for May 28-June 2 in Alpharetta, Ga.

SDSU earned the No. 9 seed out of 14 teams in the Pullman Regional, snagging one of 53 at-large bids to the NCAA tournament after tying for the runner-up spot at the Mountain West Championship on May 5. A total of 81 NCAA Division I schools received invitations to play in one of six regional events that will be held concurrently this week in Tempe, Ariz. (Arizona State), Baton Rouge, La. (LSU), Columbus, Ohio (Ohio State), Fayetteville, Ark. (Arkansas) and Tallahassee, Fla. (Florida State).

Joining the Aztecs in the Palouse this week will be 13 other teams, including seven foes ranked in the top 40, along with 10 individual competitors (75 golfers overall). The top five squads and the low individual not on an advancing team will move on to nationals from each of the six regionals.

Teams will play 18 holes (54 total) of stroke play each of the three days with a practice round on Wednesday, May 15. SDSU will be paired with North Texas and Baylor for Thursday's first round, which is set to get underway from the first tee at 8:55 a.m. PT, while Friday's second round starts as early as 8 a.m. The competition then wraps up on Saturday, with final-round action slated to begin at 7:30 a.m.

Live hole-by-hole stats will be available on golfstat.com, as well as goaztecs.com for all three rounds.

Aztec Lineup For This Week

For the sixth time this season and second tournament in a row, San Diego State head coach Ryan Donovan will employ the starting lineup of senior Tom Berry (New Haw, Surrey, England), sophomore Xander Schauffele (San Diego, Calif.), freshman Riccardo Michelini (Carpi, Italy) and juniors James Holley (Chatsworth, Calif.) and Austin Kaiser (Atascadero, Calif.). The combination was also utilized at the MW Championships and comprised five-sixths of the SDSU delegation at the Western Intercollegiate last month.

Berry is lone Aztec with regional experience among the group, tying for 18th out of 75 golfers at last year's tournament, while the four remaining SDSU players, Schauffele, Michelini, Holley and Kaiser are set to make their regional debuts.

Aztec Regional History

Since the NCAA regional tournaments began in 1989, SDSU has received a bid 18 times, including a current streak of 15 straight from 1999 to 2013.

The Aztecs have placed in the top 10 on seven occasions, with their best finish coming in 2011 when they captured the team title at OMNI Tucson National Golf Club. The lowest score in regional competition for SDSU also occurred that season when it posted a combined 19-under 833 en route to the seven-stroke victory.

Two-time All-American J.J. Spaun set three Aztec regional records last year at Stanford, including lowest score (12-under 198), lowest round (7-under 63) and best individual finish (2nd). The record for best single round by an SDSU golfer at a regional was previously held by Magnus Carlsson, who shot a 6-under 66 in 1999.

The Aztecs have advanced to the national championships 26 times in school history, including four times (1999, 2003,

2005, 2008, 2011) since the regional format made its debut. Overall, this is the 15th time SDSU has played an NCAA regional in the Pacific time zone, including 11 in a row.

A Look At The Course

The Aztecs will be making their first-ever appearance Palouse Ridge Golf Club, the home course of Washington State University. Located on 315 acres amongst the rolling terrain of southeastern Washington, the par-72, 7,308-yard track opened in August of 2008 at a cost of \$12.3 million. Palouse Ridge is an eco-friendly course that has already attained the status of Certified Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary. It was designed by the late John Harbottle III, who was one of the top golf course architects on the West Coast. From the back tees, Palouse Ridge maintains a course rating of 75.9 with slope of 140. In addition to this week's regional, the course played host to the Pac-12 Conference women's championship in 2012 and will welcome the Pac-12 men's tournament next season.

Just A Chip Shot Away

The top five schools and two individuals (not on those qualifying teams) will advance out of the Pullman Regional to the NCAA championships, May 28-June 2, at the Crabapple Course at Capital City Club in Alpharetta, Ga. The Aztecs have made the national championships 22 times in school history, including six times (1999, 2003, 2005, 2008, 2011, 2012) since the regional format made its debut.

A total of 30 teams and six individuals will play 54 holes of stroke play over a three-day period to determine the individual national champion. The final three days will feature match play between the top eight squads for the team national title.

Last Time Out: Aztecs Tie for Second at MW Tourney

The San Diego State men's golf team came up short in its quest for a third straight conference title, tying for second place at the Mountain West Championships, May 3-5 in Tucson, Ariz. The Aztecs carded a 289 during the final round to finish at even-par 852 for the tournament on the par-71, 7,144 Catalina Course at the OMNI Tucson National Golf Club.

SDSU had three golfers finish among the top 10 individually, led by Riccardo Michelini, who placed fourth at 3-under 210. The Aztec freshman began the day in a three-way tie for first, but slipped three spots after carding a 71 over the final 18 holes. Despite the stumble, Michelini's performance gave SDSU a top-four finisher at the MW Championships for the eighth straight season.

Tom Berry ended the tournament two strokes in back of Michelini, tying for sixth at 1-under 212 after posting a final-round 72, which featured four birdies. The Aztec senior was just one shot off the pace in fourth place entering the day; however, five bogeys thwarted his advance up the leaderboard. Still, Berry came away with his third top-10 finish at the MW Championships in four appearances.

Xander Schauffele, who began the day in fourth along with Berry, was unable to generate any momentum either, dropping into a tie for the 10th spot at 1-over 214 after shooting a 74 on Sunday. Despite draining a team-high six birdies, the SDSU

sophomore had his progress derailed by six bogeys and a pair of double bogeys.

Meanwhile, James Holley finished three strokes behind Schauffele at 3-over 216 following a final-round 72. The Aztec junior managed to offset three bogeys and a double-bogey with four birdies to wind up in a tie for the 13th position.

Rounding out the SDSU contingent was junior Austin Kaiser, who tied for 19th at 8-over 221 after posting his second straight 74 on Sunday. New Mexico (-8) ended the Aztecs' two-year reign atop the conference, winning by eight strokes over SDSU and UNLV, which tied for the runner-up spot, while Air Force (+23) and Colorado State (+24) finished a distant fourth and fifth respectively

fourth and fifth, respectively.

UNLV's Kevin Penner (-7) held off a late charge from James Erkenbeck of New Mexico (-6) to claim medalist honors. Erkenbeck carded a tournament-low 65 during the final round only to fall one stroke short of forcing a playoff, while Lobo teammate Gavin Green (-4), the Aztecs' Michelini (-3) and Taeksoo Kim of Boise State (-2) comprised the rest of the top five.

Aztecs Garner Postseason MW Honors

San Diego State's Riccardo Michelini was named the Mountain West Conference Men's Golf Freshman of the Year, as the league announced its postseason team and individual awards on May 9. In addition, the Aztecs landed two players on the all-MW team for the third straight year after Tom Berry and Xander Schauffele were selected in a vote of the conference's nine head coaches.

With his accolade, Michelini becomes the second SDSU men's golfer to garner top freshman honors from the MW after Matt Hoffenberg earned such distinction in 2008, while Berry and Schauffele received their first career all-league selections.

Michelini has maintained a 72.80 stroke average through 12 events this year, which ranks third on the squad and 14th in the conference. The Carpi, Italy native recorded four top-20 finishes during the regular season, highlighted by a fourth-place effort at the MW Championships, where he posted season-low score of 3-under 210 to help SDSU tie for second in the team standings.

In addition, Berry tied for sixth at the conference tournament for his team-leading sixth top-10 finish of the year. The Aztec senior owns the squad's best stroke average of 71.83, which ranks third in the MW. Berry also captured MW Golfer of the Month honors last September after posting his first collegiate victory at the PING/Golfweek Preview to go with a fifth-place showing at the Kikkor Golf Husky Invitational.

Schauffele, meanwhile, has found success as well in his first season on The Mesa after transferring from Long Beach State. The SDSU sophomore leads the team with 12 rounds below par, including eight in the 60s, while his 72.11 stroke average ranks right behind Berry at No. 4 in the conference. An alumnus of Scripps Ranch High, Schauffele has five top-10 finishes to his credit, including a fourth-place effort at the highly competitive Western Intercollegiate last month to garner MW Golfer of the Week recognition.

Backspin: SDSU At 2012 Stanford Regional

For the second consecutive season and the third time in the last five years, San Diego State men's golf team earned a trip to the national championships after finishing second at the NCAA Stanford Regional in Stanford, Calif. The Aztecs climbed from eighth after the first 18 holes into second place on day two, which is where they remained in the final standings after posting a 274 for a three-day total of 19-under 821.

The Aztecs had three golfers place in the top 18, including senior J.J. Spaun, who was the individual runner-up at 12-under 198. Spaun followed his career-low 63 on Friday with a 5-under 65, including seven birdies, nine pars and just two bogeys. The 2012 MW Golfer of the Year was denied his fourth medalist honor of the season by Pepperdine's Josh Anderson, who was competing as an individual and ended

with a 14-under 196.

Still, Spaun finished out the weekend with three Aztec NCAA regional records for low round (63), low 54-hole score (198) and best finish (2nd). He beat the previous marks held by current teammate Alex Kang, who finished fourth last year n Tucson at 5-under 208, and former standout Magnus Carlsson, who carded a 6-under 66 in 1999. Spaun's 198 also is just the third time an SDSU golfer has broken the 200-barrier at a 54-hole event (tied for second all-time).

Kang, meanwhile, logged his second consecutive top-10 performance at an NCAA regional, improving from 14th into 10th with 4-under 206, including a final-round 69. Kang fired an eagle on the par-5 first hole to start the day and tallied three more birdies to get to 5-under before double bogeying the eighth and 10th holes. He then finished the tournament with eight straight pars to match his season-low for 54 holes and place in the top 10 for the seventh time in 13 outings in 2011-12.

Junior Tom Berry was the third Aztec in the top 20 with his second-consecutive sub-70 round to tie for 18th at 2-under 208. Senior Matt Hoffenberg, who played in his first NCAA regional since 2008, was the fourth SDSU golfer to improve on the individual leaderboard on the final day, moving from 51st into 44th at 5-over 215. Classmate Colin Featherstone capped the Aztec contingent in 55th place with a 218, following back-to-back 74s.

2012-13 Season Capsule

SDSU recorded three top-10 individual finishes, featuring Xander Schauffele's third-place effort, followed by Austin Kaiser (sixth) and Tom Berry (seventh).

 Tom Berry was named MW Golfer of the Month for September after winning the prestigious PING/Golfweek Preview to go with a sixth-place finish at the season-opening Kikkor Golf Husky Invitational.
- The Aztecs placed fifth in five other events, including their last outing of the regular season at the 67th annual Western Intercollegiate in Santa Cruz on April 13-14. As a team, SDSU led the field with six eagles for the tournament. Individually, Xander Schauffele tied for fourth-place en route to capturing MW Golfer of the Week honors.
- Schauffele owns two of the Aztecs' lowest rounds of the season in relation to par, carding a 6-under 65 during the second round of the Alister Mackenzie Invitational in October, followed by a 6-under 66 during the first round of the Don Puckette N.I.T. in March. In addition, Berry registered an opening-round 5-under 66 at the ASU Thunderbird Invitational last month.

Head Coach Ryan Donovan

Ryan Donovan is in his 10th season at the helm of the SDSU golf program after serving as an assistant in 2003. Since taking the reins, he has directed the Aztecs to 24 tournament titles and five NCAA national championship appearances. In both 2011 and 2012, he received Mountain West Coach of the Year honors and was named a finalist for the Dave Williams Award, which is handed out annually to the national coach of the year in Division I men's golf. Donovan was also was tabbed the Eaton Golf Pride West Region Division I Men's Coach of the Year by the GCAA following the 2010-11 campaign. A native of Yorba Linda, Calif., Donovan was a four-year member of the Aztec golf squad before graduating in 2001.
