MW BY THE NUMBERS

2

Two Mountain West teams are nationally ranked heading into the NCAA tournament. Boise State is No. 23 in the AP poll, while Colorado State is No. 24 in this week's AP poll.

4

Four Mountain West teams earned bids to the 2022 NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament, marking the most bids since the Conference had five in 2013.

7

This is the **seventh** time since 2000 that the Mountain West has had six or more teams playing in the postseason. The last time the MW had at least six teams playing in March was in 2013.

13

Three Mountain West teams are among the top **13** nationally in scoring defense: San Diego State (2nd; 57.7), Fresno State (3rd; 58.5) and Boise State (13th; 60.8).

16

The Mountain West has six NCAA Sweet **16** appearances in league history. Nevada was the last MW team to reach the Sweet 16 in 2018.

19

The Mountain West's four bids in the 2022 NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament marks the **19th** time in league history to have two or more teams earn a bid.

32

With Utah State's bid to the 2022 NIT, the Mountain West has made **32** NIT appearances in Conference history.

.500

All 11 MW men's basketball teams posted a nonconference record of **.500** or better.

55

With four teams in the NCAA tournament, the Mountain West has **55** NCAA appearances in league history.

.669

The MW owns a 103-51 (**.669**) nonconference record this season, which is the best nonconference record for the league since 2012-13.

100

The Mountain West has seven programs in the top **100** of the NET rankings as of March 13, including San Diego State (25), Colorado State (28), Boise State (29), Wyoming (50), Utah State (60), Fresno State (73) and UNLV (94).

MOUNTAIN WEST NOTEBOOK

- A total of six Mountain West squads are playing in the 2022 postseason. Four teams (Boise State, Colorado State, San Diego State and Wyoming) earned bids to the NCAA tournament. Utah State received a bid to play in the National Invitation Tournament, while Fresno State accepted an invitation to play in The Basketball Classic.
- The 2022 NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament bracket features four Mountain West teams, the most NCAA tournament bids since 2013 when the MW had five. This is the fourth time that the MW has had four or more bids to the NCAA tournament.
- This marks the fourth-straight tournament that the MW has had multiple bids and 19th time in Conference history to have two or more teams in the NCAA tournament.
- Boise State, the Mountain West's automatic qualifier, earned a No. 8 seed, its highest seed in program history.
- The Broncos earned the MW's AQ after going 3-0 at the Mountain West championship in Las Vegas. Boise State defeated San Diego State, 53-52, in the championship game to earn its first MW tournament title.
- Boise State returns to the NCAA postseason for the first time since 2015. This is Boise State's eighth NCAA tournament appearance and third since joining the Mountain West in 2011.
- Colorado State received an at-large bid and a No. 6 seed, its highest seeding in school history.
- The Rams are dancing for the 11th time in program history and fourth since the inception of the MW. This is CSU's first trip to the NCAA tournament since 2013.
- San Diego State also earned an at-large bid and a No. 8 seed in its second-straight NCAA tournament appearance.
- San Diego State has made a MW-leading 11 NCAA tournament appearances since the inception of the league in 1999. The Aztecs also have two NCAA Sweet 16 appearances in 2011 and 2014.
- With this season's appearance in the postseason, the Aztecs are competing in the NCAA tournament for the 14th time in program history.
- Wyoming is the fourth MW team to receive a bid and will be a No. 12 seed.
- The Cowboys are dancing for the first time since 2015. This marks the 16th NCAA appearance in program history and third bid since the inception of the Mountain West.
- Utah State is making 10th overall appearance in the National Invitation Tournament and first since joining the MW. This will be the Aggies' 34th overall postseason appearance.
- USU has qualified for the postseason in each of the last four years as it played in both the 2021 and 2019 NCAA Tournaments and was the Mountain West's automatic qualifier for the 2020 NCAA Tournament prior to it being cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- After accepting an invitation to play in The Basketball Classic, founded by College Insiders, Fresno State is making its 25th overall postseason appearance and first since 2017.
