2012-13 Record: 7-1; 0-0 MW

Back-to-Back Mountain West Regular-Season Champions

- – The Aztecs have won at least 20 games in a school-record seven straight seasons and 25 or more in four consecutive seasons.
- – San Diego State has advanced to postseason play each of the last seven seasons (2006 NCAA, 2007-09 NIT, 2010-12 NCAA).


Trends:




