14-Time MW Champions, 13 Postseason Berths in Last 15 Years

- SDSU has won at least 19 games in 17 straight seasons.
- SDSU has advanced to the postseason in 14 of the last 16 seasons in which a champion was crowned (2006 NCAA, 2007-09 NIT, 2010-15 NCAA, 2016 NIT, 2018, 2021 & 2022 NCAA).
- SDSU has won 36 of last 38 games when leading at the half.
- SDSU has won its last 74-of-78 when having a higher FG pct.
- SDSU is 9th nationally in winning percentage (.756) since the

- beginning of the 2010-11 season.
- Since its founding in 1999, no men's basketball program has won more Mountain West championships (regular-season and tournament) than San Diego State's 14.
- Since 2006, SDSU's 13 appearances in its conference championship game are tied for second most in Division I.
- SDSU's 17 MW wins in 2019-20 are the most in MW history.

career. In 27 minutes, he was 4-of-6 shooting from the field and 6-of-8 from the line. His game-high 10 boards marked the 16th time he has reached double digit rebounds. The 2021-22 Mountain West Defensive Player of the Year added three blocks and four steals to his stat line.

- **Brian Dutcher** is now in his sixth season as San Diego State's head coach and his 24th season on the Aztec sidelines. In his five-plus seasons as head coach, he has led the Aztecs to four conference titles, five Mountain West championship game appearances, a 121-40 overall record, and has been named the national coach of the year and twice the Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year.

TRAMMELL EARNS MOUNTAIN WEST PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Darrion Trammell, a senior guard, is the Mountain West men's basketball Player of the Week, for the week ending Sunday, Nov. 13. The announcement was made Monday morning at the league office in Colorado Springs, Colo.

- The Marin City, Calif., native, shot 60.0 percent from the floor (12-of-20), 70.0 percent from distance (7-of-10), and sank 80.0 percent of his free throws (8-of-10) in wins over Cal State Fullerton and Brigham Young, a pair of 2022 NCAA tournament teams.
- Trammell opened the 2022-23 season, his first as an Aztec, with 18 points against Cal State Fullerton. Trammell was 6-of-7 from the field, including 4-of-5 five from beyond the arc, and knocked down both his free throw attempts. He added three steals, two rebounds, and an assist in 24 minutes of action.
- Trammell hit his first two shots against CSF, a 3-pointer, 13 seconds in to stake the Aztecs to a 3-0 lead, and just before the first media timeout, a jumper to extend the advantage to five points, 9-4. His next shot was off the mark, but for the rest of the contest he did not miss in SDSU's 80-57 win over the Titans.
- Against Brigham Young, Trammell totaled 21 points, hitting 6-of-13 shot attempts from the floor (46.2 percent), 3-of-5 from the bonus distance (60.0 percent), and 6-of-8 from the line (75.0 percent), with four assists, three rebounds and a steal in a team-high 35 minutes on the floor.
- Trailing 60-58 with 8:23 to play, Trammell hit a jumper in the paint and was fouled. He sank the free throw to give SDSU its first lead, 61-60, since a 20-18 advantage with 11:55 to play in the first half.

ELITE LEADERS

Through his first five seasons, head coach Brian Dutcher has led the Aztecs to 121 wins, the most by any SDSU coach in the 101 seasons of basketball on The Mesa.

Since the start of the 2017-18 season only two first time head coaches who were hired that year, have amassed at least 100 victories:

1. Brian Dutcher, San Diego State (121)
2. Bob Richey, Furman (113)

- The Cougars jumped back in front 67-61, but Trammell hit a three and followed that with a free throw to bring SDSU back to within a bucket. He dished out assists on the team's next two possessions and with 3:48 left, helped put the Aztecs up 71-68.
- With 2:03 to go in the contest and the score 73-70 in San Diego State's favor, Trammell nailed a baseline three as the shot clock expired to extend the Aztecs' cushion to six points. Down the stretch he sank each of his four free throw attempts to secure the 82-75 victory over the program's longtime rival.
- This is the first Mountain West men's basketball Player of the Week award in Trammell's career and the first for an Aztec this season.

AZTECS TO NO. 17 IN THE ASSOCIATED PRESS POLL; NO. 19 IN THE COACHES POLL

Opening the 2022-23 season with wins over Cal State Fullerton and Brigham Young, San Diego State's men's basketball team moved up two spots, to No. 17, in the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and one spot in the USA Today Coaches Poll to No. 19. The Aztecs earned 524 points in the AP poll and garnered 222 points in the Coaches Poll and is the only Mountain West school ranked in either poll.

- It also marks the 90th week San Diego State has been ranked in the AP Top 25 since the start of the 2010-11 season, the most of any program in the state of California in that time frame.
- San Diego State is ranked No. 17 for the fourth time in school history. SDSU has appeared in every position in the poll between No. 4 and No. 25, except for No. 12.
- Today's poll ranking, released on Nov. 14, marks the fourth time SDSU has appeared in the AP Top 25 on this date and is the second highest ranking for the program on this date.

CALIFORNIA DREAMIN' FOR SDSU...CALIFORNIA NIGHTMARE FOR IN-STATE OPPONENTS

- Since the start of the Coach Dutcher/Fisher era (1999-2000), the Aztecs are 127-34 (.789) against 24 of the other 25 current Division I schools in California (SDSU has not played Cal Baptist), and have a winning record against all but four of those 24 opponents.
- In the last 95 home games against those same 24 opponents, and also starting in 1999-2000, San Diego State is 84-11 (.884).
- In program history against the 24 schools, the Aztecs are 461-324 (.587) overall.
- San Diego State opened the 2022-23 season hosting an in-state foe in Cal State Fullerton and improved to 23-10 against the Titans in the all-time series. The Aztecs have games remaining on the schedule against in-state opponents, including its game at Stanford on Tuesday night.

ROAD (AND NEUTRAL) WARRIORS

With San Diego State playing its first of 14 regular season road/neutral contest here are some road and neutral site facts about SDSU:

- Since the start of the 2009-10 season, San Diego State's 93-57 (.620) record in road games is the ninth best in the nation.
- Since the start of the 2009-10 season, San Diego State's 148-85 (.635) record in road/neutral games is the eighth best in the nation.
- Since the start of the 2009-10 season, San Diego State's 72-43 (.626) in road games against the Mountain West, which leads the conference.

TOP-25 FACTS

- San Diego State opened the 2022-23 season ranked No. 19 in the Associated Press Top 25 Poll. It is the fourth time that SDSU has been included in the AP top-25 preseason poll; all coming during the Dutcher/Fisher era, and is the second highest ranking for the program in the poll.
- The previous three occasions when San Diego State was ranked in the preseason poll by the AP voters was prior to the 2010-11 season when the Aztecs were initially No. 25; prior to the 2012-13 campaign, when SDSU was No. 20; and the most recent appearance before this year, was 2014-15 when the Scarlet and Black was No. 16, the program's highest ranking in the preseason poll.
- How important is the preseason ranking or what does it portend? The three previous Aztec teams which were ranked in the preseason AP poll, finished a combined 84-23, including a 44-3 mark in Viejas Arena. Each squad made at least the round of 32 in the NCAA tournament with the 2010-11 team reaching the Sweet 16 and finishing the season with a 34-3 record.
- San Diego State's longest consecutive streak of weeks ranked in the AP Top-25 is 22 straight (Dec. 2, 2013 to Dec. 15, 2014).
- Entering this season, the Aztecs had appeared in the AP Poll for 88 weeks, and all have come since the start of the 2010-11 campaign.
- San Diego State's 90 appearances in the AP poll, since the start of the 2010-11 campaign, are the most of any school in California. (See box in the left column)
- Prior to this season's ranking, the last time the Aztecs appeared in the AP poll was March 15, 2021, the final poll of the 2020-21 season, and the Aztecs were ranked No. 16.
- Since the start of the 2019-20 season San Diego State has appeared in the USA Today Coaches Poll 21 times, including this year's preseason ranking of No. 20.

SDSU INKS TWO IN EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

San Diego State's men's basketball program bolstered its roster on Thursday signing guard B.J. Davis and forward Miles Heide to National Letters of Intent. The pair will compete for the Scarlet and Black beginning in the 2023-24 school year.

Davis, a 6-1, 170-pound point guard, will graduate in May from Modesto (Calif.) Christian High School. He is a three-star prospect who is ranked as the No. 137 recruit in the country, including a No. 22 national ranking at his position, and a No. 20 ranking overall within the state of California according to 247Sports.com.

Davis is a lanky ball handler whose athletic ability and crafty playing style make him explosive on both ends of the court. He possesses an impressive offensive skill set; able to create shots for both him and his teammates, as well as knocking down spot-up opportunities at an efficient rate. Defensively, Davis has proven to have great hands, finding ways to get into passing lanes and poke balls free consistently. He is an exciting and explosive addition for the Aztecs, who already have a strong backcourt coming back next year.

Davis, a team captain, led Modesto Christian as the primary ball handler in the 2021-22 campaign, averaging 17.0 points, 6.5 rebounds, 4.5 assists, and 2.6 steals per game, according to Maxpreps. He was very efficient offensively, completing the season shooting 52.4 percent from the field, 41.7 percent from the bonus distance, 88.6 percent from the line, and a 2.18:1 assist-to-turnover ratio.

He led Modesto Christian to a second-place finish at the 2022 CIF State Finals Open Division and an overall record of 30-6. Highlighting the playoff run was a 28-point performance in routing touted San Jose's Archbishop Mitty, 77-55, to reach the tournament's semifinals and was named to the All-Northern California basketball team in his junior year as well as the first-team All-Tri City Athletic League.

Davis chose the Aztecs over offers from 15 other schools including Washington and Ole Miss as well as Mountain West programs Wyoming, Boise State, and Fresno State.

Heide is a 6-9, 225-pound forward who is set to graduate year from Mount Si High School in Snoqualmie, Washington, at the conclusion of the school year. He is a three-star recruit who ranks No. 274 player in the nation according to PrepHoops, the No. 30 rated center in the country, and the No. 3 recruit out of the state of Washington, according to 247 Sports.

Heide is a lean big man who is a skilled interior player. His athleticism allows him to swallow up rebounds on both ends of the court, and his efficient offensive close to the basket is elite. Heide's defensive presence shows up in his block statistics, 2.3 per outing. He is a skilled big who can run the floor and contribute to the Aztecs fast-paced offense.

Heide's most productive year is his most recent, finishing his junior campaign averaging 14.5 points, 10.1 rebounds, and 2.3 blocks per game according to Maxpreps. He led Mount Si to an impressive 25-1 record on the year, including a 16-0 mark in 4A KingCo District play. Perhaps most impressive from Heide, apart from his double-double average, is his efficiency scoring the ball, shooting 71.0 percent from the field. Even more, the big man improved from his offensive totals as a sophomore significantly, more than doubling his point production which suggests he will continue to grow as a scorer within the Aztecs offense.

Heide chose the Aztecs over 13 other programs, including BYU, Iowa, and Loyola Chicago, as well as Mountain West programs Fresno State and New Mexico.

AZTECS ANNOUNCE FINAL TELEVISION PACKAGE

San Diego State has announced that Cox Communications' YurView network will televise six men's basketball home games, which were not included in its national television package. The games will be carried by YurView on Cox (channel 4/1004) and Spectrum (channel 4) in San Diego.

The games will also be streamed on the Mountain West Network, through a link at www.goaztecs.com.

Among the six games, Cal State Fullerton (Nov. 7), UC Irvine (Nov. 29), Occidental (Dec. 2), Troy (Dec. 2) and Kennesaw State (Dec. 12) are scheduled for a 7 p.m. PT tipoff with Brigham Young (Nov. 11) set for a 7:30 p.m. PT start.

With this announcement, all 16 San Diego State men's basketball regular-season home games will be televised.

OPENERS

- With its 80-57 victory over Cal State Fullerton on Monday evening, San Diego State improved its record to 69-33 (.676) in season opening games, regardless of location.
- In its now 53rd season of Division I basketball, San Diego State is 34-19 (.642) in DI season-opening games.
- San Diego State has won its last 18 home openers, regardless of whether the game was the season opener.
- The Aztecs have won 10 consecutive season openers, regardless of location.

AZTECS PREDICTED TO FINISH FIRST IN MOUNTAIN WEST PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

- San Diego State has won an unprecedented 14 Mountain West titles in men's basketball (eight regular season & six tournament), six more than any other Mountain West program, and despite not winning either the regular season and tournament crowns in 2021-22, but returning four starters, has been predicted to finish in first by a poll of the media that regularly cover the conference.
- SDSU has been predicted to finish either first or second in the Mountain West media's preseason poll in each of the last nine years.
- It is also the 14th time in the last 18 years that San Diego State has been picked first or second in the Mountain West's preseason poll.
- San Diego State received 16 of a possible 20 first place votes.
- The Aztecs have garnered at least one first-place vote in the preseason poll in eight of the last nine years.
- Complete Mountain West media preseason predicted order of finish is located in the column on page 4.

BRADLEY AND TRAMMELL EARN PRESEASON MOUNTAIN WEST HONORS

In addition to SDSU being predicted to win its Mountain West-record 15th league title in 2022-23, a pair of Aztec players, Matt Bradley and Darrin Trammell, were included on the conference's list of preseason honors. Bradley was included on the All-MW Team and Trammell was named the Newcomer of the Year by the media who regularly cover the Mountain West.

- Last season, Bradley was second-team NABC All-District 17, Mountain West Newcomer of the Year (coaches & media), first-team All-MW (coaches), second-team All-MW (media), MW All-Tournament Team, Two-Time MW Player of the Week & ESPN National Player of the Week (March 7), *NCAA March Madness* Player of the Week (March 7).
- Bradley's 542 points in 2021-22, are the 14th most in a single season in the program's Division I era (since the start of the 1970-71 campaign) and he led the team in points, was second in assists (85), and rebounds (174) and third in steals (33).
- Bradley is the second Aztec to be named to the preseason All-Mountain West in the last three seasons, joining Matt Mitchell who was named to the team prior to the 2020-21 campaign. Mitchell went on to be named the Mountain West Player of the Year and a first-team performer following that season.
- In 2021-22, Bradley was one of nine players in the nation and the second Aztec since the start of the 1996-97 season, to shoot at least 43.8 percent from the field (minimum 425 shots attempts) & 40.1 percent from the bonus distance (minimum 142 shot attempts).
- Trammell is one of four players in Division I who totaled at least 539 points, dished out at least 157 assists and had a 1.73:1 assist-to-turn-over ratio last season, and if you add his 5-10 height to the mix, he is the only player to accomplish those statistics in 2021-22.
- Trammell ranked as the 5th most productive pick and roll scorer in the nation (6.9 ppg) according to Synergy Sports.
- Joining Malachi Flynn (2019-20) and Matt Bradley (2021-22), Trammell becomes the third Aztec in the last four seasons to be recognized by the media as the preseason Newcomer of the Year. Both Flynn and Bradley proved the prognosticators correct by earning the award when the season was complete.

BRADLEY INCLUDED ON JERRY WEST AWARD WATCH LIST

- For the second time in as many years, Matt Bradley has been included on the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame's initial watch list for the Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award, the most prestigious individual honor a collegiate shooting guard can earn.
- Bradley, one of 20 men's basketball players who have been included on the watch list, transferred to The Mesa from the University of California prior to the 2021-22 season and last year led the Aztecs in points per game (16.9), 3-pointers (57), free throws (113) and minutes (1,007). In addition, he ranked second on the squad in rebounds (174), assists (85), and was third in steals (33). His 542 points are the 15th most in a season in program history.
- The native of San Bernardino, Calif., returns in 2022-23 as the No. 4 scorer and the No. 5 rebounder in the Mountain West. He reached double-figure scoring 26 times last year and in those games the team was 20-6. He enjoyed 19 games of 15 or more points, 12 games of 20 or more, and a career-high 30-point game in a 73-66 victory at Wyoming, the only home loss the Cowboys suffered last season. At the conclusion of the year, he was named a second-team NABC All-District 17 performer, the Mountain West Newcomer of the Year, first-team

- A 6-4, 220-pound shooting guard, he has scored 1,831 points in 117 career games and is one of five players in the nation, who still have eligibility and will compete this year, to score at least that many points in the last four seasons.

AZTECS OPEN 2022-23 NO. 19 IN THE AP TOP 25 POLL

The San Diego State men's basketball team is ranked No. 19 in the Associated Press' preseason Top 25 poll, garnering 394 points. It marks the fourth time in program history SDSU has earned inclusion on the initial AP poll and all have come since the start of the 2010-11 campaign. The Aztecs are the only program in the Mountain West to appear in the AP's initial 2022-23 poll.

In its three previous appearances in the AP preseason poll, San Diego State was ranked No. 25 and received 158 points to start the 2010-11 season, was No. 20 with 463 points before the 2012-13 season, and No. 16, garnering 560 points, to open the 2014-15 campaign.

The appearance marks the first time since the 2020-21 season the Aztecs have found themselves among the AP Top 25. On that occasion the team was ranked No. 16 in the poll, which was published on March 15, 2021, the final poll of that season.

Overall, the Aztecs have been ranked in the AP Poll 89 weeks, which is the most by any team in the state of California since the start of the 2010-11 season: ahead of UCLA's 68, Saint Mary's 44, Southern California's 35, and California's 11.

Among Mountain West program's total of weeks in the AP Poll since 2010-11, San Diego State's 89 are more than three times more than Nevada and its 28 weeks. Others in the league who have appeared in the poll in that time frame are UNLV (27 weeks), New Mexico (25 weeks), Colorado State (10 weeks) and Boise State (two weeks).

Possible opponents on SDSU's schedule who appeared in the first AP poll are Creighton (No. 9), Arkansas (No. 10), Arizona (No. 17) and Texas Tech (No. 25).

COACHES POLL RANKS SAN DIEGO STATE NO. 20 IN THE PRESEASON

- For the third time in program history and first since the 2014-15 campaign, San Diego State is ranked in the preseason USA Today Coaches Poll, slotting in at the No. 20 spot.
- The ranking matches the ranking the team garnered prior to the 2012-13 season. Ahead of playing in the 2014-15 season, SDSU was a program-best No. 17 in that year's preseason poll.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

San Diego State has advanced to the NCAA tournament 10 of the last 12 seasons in which a national championship has been crowned, and has an NIT national semifinalist appearance during that span as well. One reason for the success is that Viejas Arena is a very tough place for opponents. Since the start of the 2009-10 campaign, and after two games this season, San Diego State has the seventh-highest winning percentage in the country, amassing a 186-24 home record, winning 88.6 percent of its home games during that span.

With the 2022-23 season underway, here are a few of the categories to keep an eye on.

- In its last 214 home games, San Diego State has compiled a 189-25 mark, including an 88-10 record against non-conference competition at Viejas Arena.
- Since the start of the 2012-13 campaign, the Aztecs are 141-20 at home, including a 63-9 record in non-conference home contests during that stretch (48-7 against non-top 25 non-conference foes).
- The Aztecs are 59-10 in their last 69 non-conference home games.

MORE HOME COOKING

- In the last 40 home games, San Diego State is 37-4, with an average scoring margin of +16.2 points in those victories. Of the 41 home games, 27 were decided in the Aztecs' favor by at least nine points.
- The Aztecs 11-game non-conference home court win streak, snapped on Dec. 18, 2020, by Brigham Young, is the seventh-longest in school history and longest since a 13-game win streak from Dec. 16, 2000 to Nov. 23, 2002.
- San Diego State is 36-4 in its last 40 home games dating back to Jan. 1, 2019.
- The Aztecs are 31-3 in their 34 Mountain West Conference home games since Jan. 24, 2018.
- San Diego State has never had an undefeated home season as a Division I program. The last time the Aztecs made it through the home portion of the schedule unscathed was 1966-67. That season, San Diego State went 16-0 at home enroute to a 24-5 record. In the Division I era, SDSU has ended the home portion of its schedule with a single loss on seven occasions (1977-78, 2009-10, 2010-11, 2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2019-20).

SERIES HISTORY VS. STANFORD

- Tonight's game against Stanford marks just the fifth meeting between these programs, with the Cardinal taking each of the previous four matchups, two at Stanford and two in San Diego.
- The series began on Jan. 6, 1941, a 52-29 win on the Cardinal's home floor and nearly 37 years later, traveled to America's Finest City and edged the Aztecs 85-84 in the Cabrillo Classic played at the San Diego Sports Arena. The last two matchups occurred in 1997. The first, a 97-50 win at Stanford on Feb. 24 and the second, a 63-42 decision in Viejas Arena (known then as Cox Arena) on Dec. 16. The Cardinal were ranked No. 25 and No. 9 in the 1997 games respectively.
- Brian Dutcher is facing Stanford, as a member of the Aztec coaching staff, for the first time in his 24 seasons on The Mesa.
- All-time series meetings against Stanford can be found in the column on page 4.

SAN DIEGO STATE VS. THE PAC-12 CONFERENCE

- San Diego State is 64-149 vs. current members of the Pac-12 Conference and fell in its last match-up against an opponent from the conference (vs. Southern California, 58-43, on Nov. 26, 2021, in the championship game of the 2021 Paycom Wooden Legacy at the Anaheim Convention Center). Prior to the Southern California loss San Diego State had run off four straight wins against the league, including the season 2020-21 season opener against No. 22 UCLA, 73-58) and just over two weeks later at No. 23 Arizona State, 80-68.
- On its home floor, the Aztecs have won 11 of 23 games against Pac-2 opposition since the start of the 1997-98 season and have an average margin of victory of 7.6 points per game in those wins and in its last seven home matchups against the Pac-12 have a 5-2 record.
- As the road team, since the 1998-99 season, SDSU is 4-13, winning by an average of 10.5 points, but the losses have come by an average of 15.8 points.
