### Aztecs Look to Advance to WCWS for the First Time; Meets No. 15 Utah on Sunday

The San Diego State softball team looks to punch its ticket to the Women's College World Series when it takes on No. 15 overall seed Utah at noon MT (11 1.m. PT) Sunday at Dumke Family Softball Stadium in Salt Lake City. The game will be broadcast on ESPN.

The Aztecs (39-16) beat the Utes (41-14), 4-3, on Friday but fell, 10-1, in five innings on Saturday.

SDSU needs a victory to advance to the Women's College World Series (WCWS), which will be held June 1-9 at the ASA Hall of Fame Stadium in Oklahoma City. The WCWS is an eight-team, double-elimination tournament with the championship final being a best-of-three series.

San Diego State went 3-0 at the first Mountain West tournament held since 2006 for its second straight MW title and league-record ninth overall. The Aztecs then went 3-0 in the NCAA's toughest regional (RPI average of 32.00) last weekend at Easton Stadium in Los Angeles before splitting with the Pac-12 Tournament champion Utah in front of record-setting crowds on back-to-back days.

SDSU is playing in its 13th NCAA tournament and second straight under second-year head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz. San Diego State, which also made the tournament in 2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2022, is 22-24 all-time in the NCAA championship.

Four players are hitting over .300 for the Aztecs, including Bella Espinoza (.396, 57 R, 30 SB), Cali Decker (.376, 6 HR, 40 RBI, 29 R), Mac Barbara (.365, 13 HR, 45 RBI, 34 R) and Jillian Celis (.345, 6 HR, 48 RBI, 42 R). SDSU slugged five home runs at the NCAA Los Angeles Regional and have eight in eight postseason games after having 27 in its 47 regular-season contests.

The MW Pitcher of the Year Allie Light leads the San Diego State pitching staff with a 15-6 record, school-record seven saves and a 1.85 ERA in 128.1 innings, while Sarah Lehman (11-5, 3 SV, 2.62 ERA, 91.0 IP) and Dee Dee Hernandez (8-3, 6 SV, 3.12 ERA, 80.2 IP) were also a part of a streak of four consecutive shutouts this postseason. The four straight shutouts were the most in a row for the Aztecs since 2010.

**STACEY NUVEMAN DENIZ**  
 HEAD COACH | 2ND SEASON (15TH OVERALL) | UCLA, 2002

- Was named San Diego State's fifth head coach in program history on June 8, 2021, taking over for SDSU's all-time winningest head coach Kathy Van Wyk.
- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 14 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- In her first season as SDSU's head coach in 2022, San Diego State went 39-16 (.712) for the second-best winning percentage in school history, winning the Mountain West regular-season title for the first time since 2014.
- Was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in 2022 in her first season as head coach.
- Is 78-32 (.709) as head coach at San Diego State, leading the Aztecs to a Mountain West Tournament title in 2023.
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs.

**SDSU Notes from NCAA Super Regional Second Game**

- \* San Diego State lost its first NCAA Super Regional in program history, falling to 1-1.
- \* The Aztecs had their seven-game winning streak snapped (all in the postseason). SDSU is now 7-1 in the postseason.
- \* San Diego State had its four-game winning streak snapped in the NCAA tournament.
- \* The Aztecs fell to 23-7 (.767) over their last 30 games.
- \* SDSU to 22-25 all-time in the NCAA tournament.

**SDSU / NCAA Tournament Notes**

- \* San Diego State is playing in its first NCAA Super Regional.
- \* The Aztecs are playing in their 13th NCAA tournament overall and second straight, but just the second since 2015.
- \* SDSU is in its second NCAA tournament under second-year head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz.
- \* All 13 NCAA tournament appearances have come this century, including 2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2022 and now 2023.
- \* San Diego State is 22-25 all-time at the NCAAs.
- \* The Aztecs are 21-14 in the NCAA tournament when playing as a neutral team (1-11 as the road squad).
- \* SDSU has now advanced to seven NCAA regional finals (2001, 2006, 2011, 2012, 2015, 2022 and 2023) out of its 13 appearances.
- \* With a 6-3 win over Liberty last Sunday, San Diego State is now 1-7 all-time in NCAA Regional final games.
- \* SDSU won at least one game at the NCAA tournament in 12 of its 13 appearances.
- \* San Diego State is playing an NCAA tournament game outside the state of California or Arizona for the first time in program history. Of the 45 games the Aztecs have played in an NCAA tournament prior to this weekend, 29 have come in California (23 in Los Angeles, three in Fresno and three in Fullerton) and 16 have happened in Tempe, Arizona.

**A Look Back at the NCAA Los Angeles Regional**

San Diego State went 3-0 at the toughest regional last weekend in Los Angeles to advance to its first-ever NCAA Super Regionals. The third-seeded Aztecs downed second-seeded Liberty, 7-0, in the opener on Friday night, then beat fourth-seeded Grand Canyon, 6-0, in the winner's bracket game on Saturday, and then finished off Liberty, 6-3, in the regional final on Sunday. Top-seeded and the No. 2 overall seed UCLA lost its first two games and were eliminated by Saturday.

SDSU became the first team to advance to NCAA Super Regionals without facing a top-seeded team in a regional since 2009, when it happened twice. At Florida State in 2009, California beat Mississippi State and then Oklahoma State twice to advance. Also in 2009 Baylor hosted a regional but Northwestern was the top seed. Baylor went on to beat Louisiana, Texas State and Louisiana again to advance.

For the fifth time in SDSU's last six NCAA regional appearances, San Diego State played in the toughest region. Last weekend's NCAA Los Angeles Regional featured UCLA (No. 2 in the final regular season RPI), Liberty (No. 28), the Aztecs (No. 34) and Grand Canyon (No. 64), which comes out to an average RPI of 32.00. The next-toughest regional based on average RPI was ironically the Salt Lake City Regional, which had Utah (No. 18), Baylor (No. 19), Ole Miss (No. 35) and Southern Illinois (No. 84), and an average RPI of 39.00.

SDSU dominated in all three phases over the three games, outscoring the opposition, 19-3, with a much better average (.322-to-.181) and more home runs (5-to-1), while owning a better ERA (1.00-to-5.95) and highest fielding percentage (.988-to-.933).

Bella Espinoza (6-for-11 (.545), 4 R, BB, 2 SB), Makena Brocki (5-for-10 (.500), HR, 2 RBI, 3 R, 3B) and Cali Decker (4-for-10 (.400), 2 HR, 8 RBI, 2 R) led the offense, while Sarah Lehman (1-0, 0.00 ERA, 7 K, 2 BB, .125 avg.), Dee Dee Hernandez (0-0, 1 SV, 0.00 ERA, 4 K, 0 BB, .188 avg.) and Allie Light (2-0, 1.85 ERA, 11 K, 0 BB, .200 avg.) combined to post a 1.00 ERA with two shutouts and 22 strikeouts to just two walks.

San Diego State was the only No. 3 seed from a regional to make a NCAA Super Regional, one of three unseeded overall teams (also Oregon and Louisiana) remaining and one of only two from a Group of 5 program (Louisiana).

**Peaking at the Right Time**

San Diego State seems to be playing its best softball at the right time heading into NCAA Super Regionals this weekend.

The Aztecs have won seven of their last eight games, going 3-0 at both the Mountain West Tournament from May 11-13 and the NCAA Los Angeles Regional from May 19-21, and 1-1 at Utah in the NCAA Salt Lake City Regional. SDSU has outscored the opposition, 44-29, in the postseason with four straight shutouts at one point for the first time since the 2010 season.

**Scouting Utah**

Utah is hosting in its first NCAA Super Regional. SDSU's former Mountain West foe is 41-14 on the season after finishing third in the Pac-12 regular season with a 15-9 mark. The Utes, who are ranked 17th in the latest USA Today/NFCA Top 25 poll (May 16) and 14th by ESPN.com/USA Softball (May 16), won the inaugural Pac-12 Tournament with victories over California, 6-2, No. 5 Washington, 8-4, and No. 2 UCLA, 7-4.

Utah is hitting .330 as a team, while it's .330 average coming into the Super Regional ranked fourth in the country, with 47 home runs and 98 stolen bases. Aliya Belarde is hitting .401 with three home runs, 30 RBIs, 53 runs and 16 stolen bases, while Haley Denning (.384, 48 R, 32 SB), Sophie Jacquez (.380, 4 HR, 32 RBI, 27 R), Abby Dayton (.373, 15 RBI, 22 R) and Julia Jimenez (.355, 10 HR, 51 RBI, 29 R) are also hitting over .350.

The Ute pitching staff has combined for a 2.74 ERA and 11 shutouts. Maria Lopez (22-6, 2.17 ERA, 186.2 IP) and Sydney Sandez (13-5, 3.04 ERA, 106.0 IP) have done the bulk of the pitching for Utah.

The Aztecs and Utes are meeting for the first time since 2017, when SDSU came out on top, 3-2, at the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic on Feb. 26 in Cathedral City, Calif. The two teams also met in 2012 in Utah's first year in the Pac-12, where San Diego State won, 14-2.

With last night's win, Utah snapped a three-game losing streak in the series.

Overall, the Aztecs are 34-50 against Utah.

**Three Aztecs Earn NFCA All-West Region Honors**

Three San Diego State softball players earned National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) All-West Region honors, the NFCA announced May 18. Sophomore Mac Barbara (Long Beach, Calif.) made the first team for a second straight year, while junior Allie Light (Lexington, S.C.) and sophomore Cali Decker (Lake Mary, Fla.) garnered second-team accolades.

NFCA member head coaches from each respective region voted on the teams and all student-athletes are now eligible for the 2023

NFCA Division I All-America squads.

Barbara, an NFCA third-team All-American last year, is batting .366 (56-for-153) with 13 home runs, 45 RBIs, 34 runs, eight doubles, a triple, 32 walks and seven stolen bases for a .686 slugging percentage and .476 on-base mark. A member of the preseason USA Softball Player of the Year Watch List, Barbara is sixth in SDSU single-season history in walks (32), eighth in slugging percentage (.686) and OPS percentage (1.162), tied for eighth in home runs (13) and ninth in on-base percentage (.476). Barbara also was named to the all-MW first team for a second consecutive year and was a four-time MW Player of the Week.

Light, meanwhile, enters NCAA Super Regional play with a 15-6 record, school-record seven saves and a 1.85 ERA in 128 1/3 innings, striking out 106 against just 20 walks, limiting the opposition to a .209 average. Light was also named the MW Pitcher of the Year, a first-team all-MW pick and was a four-time MW Pitcher of the Week.

Decker is hitting .374 (55-for-147) in her first season at SDSU after transferring from Florida with six home runs, 40 RBIs, 29 runs and 25 walks, posting a .524 slugging percentage and a .467 on-base percentage. Decker, a second-team all-MW selection and a member of the MW All-Tournament Team, is tied for sixth in San Diego State single-season history in sacrifice flies (4) and 10th in on-bas percentage (.467).

**Allie Light Named Mountain West Pitcher of the Year**

San Diego State softball junior Allie Light (Lexington, S.C.) was named the Mountain West Pitcher of the Year, the league announced May 10. Light was one of a league-high seven all-MW selections for the Aztecs.

The postseason awards were voted on by the league's nine head coaches and take into account MW games only.

Light was joined on the all-MW first team by sophomore Mac Barbara (Long Beach, Calif.) and junior Makena Brocki (Chino Hills, Calif.), while four SDSU players landed on the second team, including senior Sarah Lehman (Iowa City, Iowa), junior Jillian Celis (Corona, Calif.), and sophomores Cali Decker (Lake Mary, Fla.) and Bella Espinoza (Huntington Beach, Calif.).

Light became San Diego State's 11th MW Pitcher of the Year - the most in league history - and second straight Aztec to win the award (Maggie Balint in 2022). SDSU's other winners have been San Diego State hall of famer Sandra Durazo (2001), Bre DeSanta (2002), Celena Velasquez (2003 and 2004), Christina Ross (2006 and 2008), Samantha Beasley (2010), Rebecca Arbino (2013) and Danielle O'Toole (2014).

Light was 7-1 with two saves and a 1.37 ERA in league play across 61 1/3 innings, striking out 36 against 12 walks, while limiting the opposition to a .213 average. Light, who won four MW Pitcher-of-the-Week awards on the season, topped the MW in league games in ERA, and is tied for first in saves, third in appearances (16), tied for third in wins and fourth in opponent batting average, while pitching for the top pitching staff in the conference.

In all games, Light is 15-6 with an Aztec single-season record seven saves and a 1.85 ERA, striking out 106 with just 20 walks allowed in 128 1/3 innings, holding her opponents to a .209 average.

Barbara made her second straight all-MW first team after being named the MW Player of the Year in 2022. A two-time MW Player of the Week this season, Barbara batted .459 (28-for-61) in league play with eight home runs, 24 RBIs, 18 runs, three doubles, 14 walks and five stolen bases, while posting a .902 slugging percentage and a .564 on-base mark. Barbara's eight home runs were tied for the most in MW-only games. She also was solo second in slugging percentage, on-base percentage, OPS percentage (1.466), total bases (55) and batting average, while ranking in a tie for fourth in RBIs. Overall, Barbara is batting .366 (56-for-153) with 13 home runs, 45 RBIs, 33 runs, eight doubles, 32 walks, seven stolen bases, a .686 slugging percentage and a .476 on-base percentage.

Brocki made her first all-MW team after hitting .371 (23-for-62) in league play with 19 RBIs, 13 runs, eight doubles, four triples, a .629 slugging percentage and a .423 on-base mark. Brocki's eight doubles were the second most in league games, while her four triples were tied for second. Overall, Brocki is hitting .294 (42-for-143) with a home run, 32 RBIs, 22 runs, 13 doubles, five triples and six stolen bases.

Lehman made the most of her one season on The Mesa, going 4-2 in league action with a save and a 3.05 ERA in 39 innings. Lehman, who was a second-team all-Big East selection last year at DePaul after spending 2019-21 with Iowa, struck out 49 in league play and limited her opponents to a MW-low .186 average. Overall, Lehman is 11-4 with three saves and a 2.44 ERA, posting 108 strikeouts in 89 innings, holding the opposition to a .182 average.

Celis made her second MW second team (2021), posting a .313 average (21-for-67) with three home runs, 21 RBIs, 20 runs, seven doubles, three triples and a .642 slugging percentage. Celis, who has started 180 consecutive games, is hitting .349 overall with six home runs, a team-high 48 RBIs, 42 runs, 14 doubles, three triples, a .570 slugging percentage and a .419 on-base percent

Decker landed on the all-MW second team in her first season at SDSU after transferring from Florida, batting .386 (22-for-57) with a home run, 14 RBIs, 15 runs, 12 walks and a .493 on-base mark. In all games, Decker is hitting .374 (55-for-147) with six homers, 40 RBIs, 29 runs, 25 walks and a .467 on-base mark.

Espinoza made her second all-conference team after earning first-team honors as a freshman last year. In MW games, Espinoza hit .352 (25-for-71) with 25 runs, 10 walks and 13 stolen bases with her 25 runs ranking in a tie for first and her 13 stolen bases second. Overall, Espinoza has team highs of a .391 average (72-for-184), 56 runs and 30 stolen bases.

**Makena Brocki Named to College Sports Communicators Academic All-District Team**

San Diego State softball junior second baseman Makena Brocki (Chino Hills, Calif.) has been named to the 2023 Academic All-District Team, the College Sports Communicators (CSC) announced today.

The Academic All-District teams are divided into eight geographic districts across the United States and Canada, and recognize the nation's top student-athletes for their combined performances athletically and in the classroom. Academic All-District honorees advance to the CSC Academic All-American Team ballot, where first-, second- and third-team All-America honorees will be selected next month.

To be nominated, a student-athlete must be a starter or important reserve with at least a 3.50 cumulative grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) at her current institution.

Brocki is a criminal justice major with a 3.70 GPA, and a two-time Mountain West Scholar-Athlete (2021-22) and two-time MW Spring All-Academic Team (2021-22) selection.

On the field, Brocki earned all-MW first-team accolades after hitting .371 (23-for-62) in league play with 19 RBIs, 13 runs, eight doubles, four triples, a .629 slugging percentage and a .423 on-base mark. Brocki's eight doubles were the second most in league games, while her four triples tied for second. Overall, Brocki is hitting .294 (42-for-143) with a home run, 32 RBIs, 22 runs, 13 doubles, five triples and six stolen bases.

Brocki is the first San Diego State player to earn Academic All-District honors since Samantha Camello in 2016 and just the sixth Aztec since 2004. Camello eventually was named a second-team CoSIDA (now CSC) Academic All-American that year.

**SDSU Softball Tops Player of the Week Winners**

The Aztecs once again had the most Mountain West Pitcher and Players of the Week on the season. SDSU's seven MW Pitcher or Player of the Week awards are the most in the league. Boise State was ranked second with five winners, followed by Utah State (4), New Mexico (3), UNLV (3), Fresno State (1), San Jose State (1) and Colorado State (0).
