### WHAT'S ON TAP THIS WEEKEND IN AZTEC BASEBALL

- > San Diego State will continue Mountain West action with a three-game weekend series at Air Force.
- > The first contest of that set is scheduled for Friday, May 12, at 3:00 p.m. MT at Falcon Field in Colorado Springs, Colo.
- > The Aztecs and Falcons will also meet up for games on Saturday (May 13) and Sunday (May 14) at 2:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. MT respectively.

### AZTECS ON THE AIR

- > All three games at Air Force will have live video streaming on the Mountain West Network with Live Stats available for all three contests vs. the Falcons.
- > Links for the broadcasts as well as live stats will be on the SDSU web site (GoAztecs.com).

### SERIES RECORD

- > San Diego State's all-time record against Air Force stands at 103-24 since the teams first met in 1961.
- > The Falcons are one of three teams against which SDSU has recorded 100 wins. The other two are New Mexico (111) and Utah (102).
- > The Aztecs have won the last 56 of the last 65 meetings between the teams. The Falcons and Aztecs split six regular-season contests during the 2016 season.
- > The Aztecs are 57-8 vs. the Falcons in San Diego and 39-16 at Air Force's home field. The Aztecs have won all seven meetings at neutral sites.

### SCOUTING THE FALCONS

- > Air Force enters the week with a record of 24-22 overall and 11-15 in the Mountain West (fourth place).
- > AF is led by centerfielder Adam Groesbeck (.413, 20 2B, 34 RBI), third baseman Bradley Haslam (.402, 19 2B, 10 HR, 51 RBI) and shortstop Tyler Zabojnik (.383, 22 2B, 7 HR, 45 RBI).
- > Air Force leads the nation in batting average (.346), scoring (9.0 runs per game), doubles (127) and slugging percentage (.549).
- > The Falcons are also fifth as a team in on-base percentage (.419).
- > Their team earned run average stands at with a 7.47.

**REYES PITCHER OF THE WEEK**

- > San Diego State senior left-hander Marcus Reyes has been named the Mountain West Baseball Pitcher of the Week for games played through Sunday, May 7, 2017.
- > He made two relief appearances last week, including one at UCLA on Tuesday (May 2) and another at San José State on Sunday (May 7).
- > He entered the contest against UCLA with runners at second and third and two outs and proceeded to strike out the next batter to end the threat. He tossed 3.1 innings in that contest and retired ten consecutive batters against the Bruins, including three via the strikeout.
- > On Sunday, he came into a tied game against the Spartans in the eighth inning with two on and two out. After allowing an infield single, he retired the next batter to end the inning and maintain the tie score. He went on to retire the next six batters to pick up the win.
- > In a total of 5.2 innings last week, Reyes allowed one hit (infield single) to the 18 batters he faced (.056 batting average against), struck out five and did not give up a walk.

**SHEEHAN HITS AWAY**

- > After redshirting during the 2016 season, senior Danny Sheehan has returned for his final year and claimed the starting shortstop role he held in 2015.
- > He currently appears on 75-player the watch list for the Brooks Wallace Award presented to the nation's top shortstop.
- > Sheehan is currently on a 14-game hitting streak during which he has gone 21-for-50 (.420) with three doubles, a triple, three home runs, 14 RBI and 14 runs scored.
- > He has driven in at least one run in eight of the last 10 games.
- > He had a 13-game hitting streak end on April 3 vs. San Francisco.
- > During that 13-game streak, he went 18-for-46 (.391) with six doubles, 9 RBI and 10 runs scored.
- > He appears among the top 10 in six offensive categories in Mountain West game stats.
- > Sheehan has been hit by pitch 14 times this season to bring his career total to 27. That ranks seventh on the SDSU all-time top 20 in that category. The 14 HBPs is the fourth most ever in a season by an Aztec.

**HENSLEY SWINGS AWAY**

- > David Hensley had a nine-game hitting streak come to an end in the series finale at UC Santa Barbara on April 23.
- > Since that game, he has hit safely in eight straight games and has now done so in 17 of SDSU's last 18 contests.
- > Over that span, he is hitting .459 (34-for-72) with four doubles, a triple, three home runs, 14 RBI and 17 runs scored.
- > He has doubled in each of the past three contests.
- > Hensley hit his first home run of the season (and second of his SDSU career) in the contest at UNLV on Friday, April 14.
- > He added homers in back-to-back games vs. New Mexico on April 29-30.
- > He is hitting .461 in Mountain West play entering the weekend.

**TREJO DOES IT ALL**

- > Alan Trejo has been stellar both at the plate and on the mound in 2017.
- > Over the last 16 games he is hitting .371 (26-for-70) with three doubles, a home run, 13 RBI and 14 runs scored.
- > He recorded his first win on the mound in the victory over Nevada on April 9, tossing two late scoreless innings.
- > He recorded his second win in the 12-inning victory over San Jose State on Saturday (May 6).
- > He had an 18-game hitting streak end in the April 2 game vs. San Jose State.
- > During that streak he hit .311 (28-for-90) with six doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI and 19 runs scored.
- > Trejo leads the team in runs scored (43), hits (68), doubles (14) and stolen bases (10).

**ADKISON MAKES HIS MARK**

- > Outfielder Tyler Adkison was named a second team Perfect Game/Rawlings Midseason All-American. He has also been added to the 40-player watch list for the Golden Spikes Award, presented to the top amateur player in the country.
- > He is on a five game hitting streak during which he is batting .350 (7-for-20) with two doubles, two homes runs, six RBI and four runs scored.
- > He hit his team-leading 13th home run of the season in the contest at San Jose State on Sunday (May 7).
- > It marked the fourth time this season that he has homered in back-to-back contests.
- > He was one of the hottest hitters in the nation over a 10-game span from March 11-26.
- > In those 10 contests, he batted .649 (24-for-37) with four doubles, a triple, six home runs, 23 RBI and 16 runs scored.
- > His slugging percentage over that span was 1.297 and he had a .723 on-base mark in those games.
- > Adkison set an SDSU record by reaching base 15 consecutive times (via either a hit or walk) from March 18 to March 25. In those four games, he had four singles, three doubles, a triple, 2 HR and five walks.
- > His 10 consecutive hits over that span was also a new SDSU record.

**VERDON GETS ON BASE**

- > First baseman Jordan Verdon had a streak of reaching base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in consecutive games end at 26 in the April 22 contest at UC Santa Barbara. It is the longest such streak by an Aztec in 2017.
- > After starting SDSU's first 46 games at first base, he was utilized in the designated hitter role in the first two contests at San Jose State last weekend (May 5-6).
- > He ranks among the top 25 players in the nation in triples and sacrifice flies.
- > He had a seven-game hitting streak end on March 21 in the game against Long Beach State. During that streak he hit .345 (10-for-29) with a home run, seven RBI and six runs scored.
- > Verdon had a personal season-best eight-game streak earlier in the year.
- > During that streak he went 13-for-37 (.351) with a double, two triples, five RBI and six runs scored.
- > He committed his first error this season on May 2 at UCLA and his fielding percentage now stands at .998 after 49 games (one error on 466 chances).

**CALABUIG HEATING UP**

- > Chase Calabuig hit his sixth homer of the year at San Jose State on Saturday (May 6).
- > In the game at UCLA on May 2, he finished the game with four hits to tie his career best in a single game.
- > He first set his career-high of four hits in the contest at UC Riverside on April 18.
- > Calabuig had a season-best nine-game hitting streak end in the opener at UC Santa Barbara on Friday, April 21.
- > During that streak he batted .412 (14-for 34) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI and six runs scored.
- > He is hitting .329 (23-for-70) over the Aztecs' last 17 games with two doubles, four home runs, 16 RBI and 15 runs.

**ERICKSON PROVIDES RELIEF**

- > Junior left-hander Jacob Erickson has been impressive out of the bullpen this season as a middle reliever.
- > He has walked nine and struck out 25 over 40.1 innings.
- > He picked up his fifth win of the year on April 21 vs. UC Santa Barbara.
- > Erickson has been involved in four of the Aztecs' five shutout wins in 2017.

**NEVAREZ COMES THROUGH**

- > Catcher Dean Nevarez suffered a concussion prior to last weekend's series at San Jose State when he was hit by a line drive in practice and he did not appear in any of those games. His availability for this coming weekend is uncertain.
- > He is hitting .368 over the most recent 11 games in which he has appeared.
- > Included in that span are four doubles, a triple, three home runs, 12 RBI and 12 runs scored.
- > He hit his sixth home of the year at UCLA on Tuesday (May 2) that tied the game at 4-4 in the fourth inning.
- > He is hitting .358 in conference play with 19 RBI in the 18 games (13 starts) in which he has played.
- > Nevarez's first two home runs this season came in the series finale against UNLV in San Diego on March 19.
- > He is the second Aztec to homer twice in a game this season as Tyler Adkison accomplished the feat against Nevada in Reno on March 11.

**SAYLOR SAVES**

- > Senior right-hander CJ Saylor has recorded 12 saves along with a win this season as the Aztecs' closer.
- > He picked up his 12th save of the year when he tossed the final inning in the Aztecs' 8-6 win at UCLA on Tuesday, May 2.
- > Saylor's ERA now stands at 1.48 and opponents are hitting .179 against him.
- > He has recorded 29 strikeouts and four walks in his last 19.2 innings pitched (17 appearances).

**AZTECS ON NATIONAL WATCH LISTS**

- > Five San Diego State baseball players have been named to four postseason national awards watch lists.
- > Danny Sheehan is a candidate for the 2017 Brooks Wallace Shortstop of the Year Award while Brett Seeburger and Dominic Purpura are on the list for National Pitcher of the Year. In addition, closer CJ Saylor is on the 40-man Stopper of the Year award watch list and outfielder Tyler Adkison is on the watch list for the Golden Spikes Award, presented to the top amateur player in the nation.
- > Sheehan, a senior from Covina, Calif. (South Hills HS), is currently hitting .344 with 13 doubles, five home runs, 40 RBI and 41 runs scored over 49 games. His fielding percentage stands at .974 and he has been involved in 41 doubles plays.
- > Seeburger, a senior from Monrovia, Calif. (La Salle HS), enters the week with a record of 9-1 and a 3.21 earned run average. SDSU's regular Friday night starter, Seeburger is first in the Mountain West in earned run average.
- > The other Pitcher of the Year candidate from the Mountain West is SDSU senior left-hander Dominic Purpura (Hinsdale, Ill.), a second-year Aztec by way of Orange Coast College. Purpura is 6-2 this season and his 3.74 earned run average is second in the Mountain West stats this week.
- > Saylor, a senior from West Covina, Calif. (South Hills HS), is 1-0 with 12 saves and a 1.48 ERA. He has recorded 41 strikeouts over 30.1 innings.
- > Adkison, a junior outfielder from Culver City, Calif. (Mater Dei HS), is currently hitting .356 and leads the Aztecs in home runs (13), RBI (44), slugging percentage (.712) and on-base percentage (.470).

**PLAYER OF THE WEEK I**

- > Junior outfielder Tyler Adkison was named the Mountain West Player of the Week for his performance in SDSU's four games during the week of March 14-20.
- > In the contest at USD (March 14) and three-games vs. UNLV (March 17-19), he batted .688 (11-for-16) with three doubles, three home runs and 11 RBI.
- > He compiled a 1.438 slugging percentage and a .737 on-base average in the four games.

**PLAYER OF THE WEEK II**

- > Outfielder Tyler Adkison made it back-to-back Mountain West Player of the Week awards when he earned the honor for games played March 20-26.
- > In SDSU's four games that week, Adkison (Culver City, Calif., Mater Dei HS) hit .538 with a triple, home run, seven walks and seven RBI.

**PLAYER OF THE WEEK III**

- > Junior right fielder David Hensley was named the Mountain West Player of the Week for his performance in four games during the week of April 9-16.
- > Over those four games he hit .647 (11-for-17) with a double, triple, home run, six RBI and seven runs scored.
- > He recorded at least three hits on three of SDSU's four contests that week.

**PITCHER OF THE WEEK I**

- > Senior lefty Brett Seeburger earned his first conference Pitcher of the Week award for his performance in the second game of Saturday's (March 25) doubleheader at Fresno State.
- > He tossed a one hit shutout over eight innings, allowing just an infield single and facing one batter over the minimum.
- > Seeburger retired the first 14 batters he faced before allowing a two-out infield single in the bottom of the fifth inning. He went on to retire the next 10 batters through the eighth inning.
- > Over his eight innings of work, he struck out a season-high seven batters and did not allow a walk.
- > For his effort Seeburger was also selected a National Player of the Week by *Collegiate Baseball* and the Madness Mountain West Baseball Player of the Week by *CollegeSportsMadness.com*.

**PITCHER OF THE WEEK II**

- > Senior left-hander Brett Seeburger has been named the Mountain West Pitcher of the Week for the second time during the 2017 season.
- > Seeburger tossed 7.1 innings of shutout ball vs. league-leading New Mexico last Friday (April 28).
- > He allowed only three singles with three walks and six strikeouts. Only one Lobo runner reached as far as second base.
- > He held UNM to a .130 batting average in the game after it had entered the contest with a .317 team average.

**AZTECS AMONG THE NATIONAL LEADERS**

- > Entering this week's action, San Diego State ranked among the national leaders in several categories both as a team and individually.
- > There are currently 300 teams playing baseball in NCAA Division I.

- > Freshman Hayden Petrovick picked up the win with three late scoreless innings and senior CJ Saylor notched his first save of the year.

**NEW STAFF**

- > The Aztecs made just one staff change for the 2017 season with the addition of former SDSU player Brandon Decker as Director of Player Personnel.
- > Decker was an infielder and outfielder at San Diego state for four seasons (2007-10) before going on to play professional baseball for two years.
- > For the past two seasons, he has been at USD serving as Torero baseball's Director of Player Personnel.

**DRAFTED AZTECS**

- > Three current members of the SDSU squad have been drafted by Major League clubs.
- > That trio includes pitcher CJ Saylor (33rd rd. in 2012, Los Angeles Dodgers) along with outfielder Denz'l Chapman (32nd rd. in 2014, Oakland A's) and first baseman Jordan Verdon (24th rd. in 2015, New York Mets).

**AZTEC NOTES**

- > SDSU's series vs. New Mexico (April 28-30) was its 10th weekend series of the season and the first three-game series (of 11) that the Aztecs have failed to win in 2017.
- > The Aztecs have not lost more than two games in a row this season and that has occurred on three occasions (Feb. 24 and 25 vs. Tennessee and Seton Hall; March 26 and 28 at Fresno State and at USC; April 29-30 vs. New Mexico).
- > In the game at UCLA on Tuesday (May 2), the relief trio of Jacob Erickson (3.1 IP), Jorge Fernandez (1.0 IP) and CJ Saylor (1.0 IP) retired the final 16 consecutive Bruin hitters.
- > The Aztecs are 27-1 when leading after six innings, 28-1 when leading after seven and 29-0 when leading after eight.
- > SDSU has committed 41 errors in its first 49 contests for a .979 fielding percentage. The team record for fielding percentage in a season is .978 set during the 2013 campaign.
- > The Aztecs have committed more than one error in a game only six times in 2017.
- > The Aztecs have stolen at least one base in eight of their last nine games. Alan Trejo leads the team with 10 steals while freshman Julian Escobedo is a perfect 9-for-9 on his stolen base attempts.
- > The April 22 game at UC Santa Barbara marked the first time this season that SDSU did not have the same starting four infielders in a game. Second baseman Alan Trejo was replaced by freshman Jacob Maekawa while third baseman Andrew Brown made way for David Hensley.
- > Third baseman Andrew Brown has missed the past nine games with a right oblique (muscle) strain. He is doubtful for this weekend at Air Force.
- > Junior David Hensley's 17 career sacrifice bunts tie him for 11th on the SDSU career top 20 in that category.
- > Sophomore Jordan Verdon's 11 career sacrifice flies tie him for 12th on the SDSU career top 20 list.
- > First baseman Jordan Verdon and shortstop Danny Sheehan are the only two player to have started every game. Sheehan has made all his starts at shortstop while Verdon has made 47 at first base and two at DH. Alan Trejo has started in 48 of the team's 49 contests, all at second base.
