

#10/11 SDSU Aztecs

2013-14 Record: 14-1; 3-0 MW
 Four Straight NCAA Tournament Appearances

- The Aztecs have won at least 20 games in a school record eight straight seasons and 23 or more in five consecutive seasons.
- San Diego State has advanced to postseason play each of the last eight seasons (2006 NCAA, 2007-09 NIT, 2010-13 NCAA).

Trends:

- SDSU is 6th nationally in win pct. since the beginning of 2010-11, trailing Ohio St., Kansas, Syracuse, Duke and Wichita St.
- This season, SDSU ranks among the national leaders in FG pct. defense (1st, 35.7), effective FG pct. defense (2nd 39.8), points allowed (3rd, 55.7).
