## NOTES

The Huskies will face the winner of the San Diego-San Diego State match tomorrow at noon in the second round... Washington improves to 8-7 all-time in the NCAA Tournament, while American falls to 0-2 in the championship... The Huskies have won seven straight opening-round matches in the tourney... American advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive season and the second time in school history... After falling behind 5-0, America's number one doubles team of Garg and Kulcsar won three straight games off of the nation's 37th-ranked doubles team... Washington's Ari Strasberg scratched at number five, forcing Dillon Ruby to move up to five singles and Pete Scharler to play number six... Washington lost just 12 games in the three singles matches the Huskies won... The Huskies received victories from their ranked doubles team and their two ranked singles players.
