San Diego State Looks To Close 2001 On A Winning Note Versus Detroit Sunday

The San Diego State women's basketball team bids au revoir to 2001 Sunday afternoon when the Aztecs host Detroit for a 2 p.m. tip-off in Cox Arena. The game is the second of a three-game homestand and final one of the calendar year for San Diego State (6-5), which appears ready to hit the new year on a serious roll.

Winners of three of their last four, the Aztecs are coming off their most complete game of the season -- a 47-point drubbing of Radford Friday night. San Diego State had five players score in double figures for the first time this year and combined to shot a season-best 58 percent from the field en route to an impressive 89-42 victory.

But it wasn't just the SDSU offense that was firing on all cylinders as the Aztecs held Radford to just 30 percent shooting, collected a season-high 20 steals, and forced the Highlanders into a season-worst 31 turnovers. San Diego State also finished with a 17-rebound advantage on the boards (41-24).

The win pushed the Aztecs one game over .500 for the fourth time this season. San Diego State will try to make two games over for the first time this year against a Detroit team that has fallen on hard times of late.

The holiday season has not been kind to the Titans (4-5), who found a lump of coal in the form of a three-game losing streak in their stocking. UDM opened the season a respectable 4-2 but hasn't won since a 70-51 victory at Central Michigan Dec. 8th. Most recently, the Titans squandered a 28-point outburst from senior Michelle James in its 69-59 loss at UC Irvine Friday.

Detroit Titans (4-5)

Detroit got 28 points from Michelle James but just five other Titans were able to find the basket. The Titans trailed UCI by as many as 23 points in the second half before slicing the deficit to four with just under five minutes to play. UDM could manage just four points the rest of the way, however, as the Anteaters put the contest on ice.

James' scoring outburst was nothing new for the senior guard, who has already tallied at least 20 points three times this season and enters Sunday's game as Detroit's leading score with a 17.0 ppg scoring average.

Senior Molly Peterman is the only other Titan averaging double digits at 11.3 ppg. The Aztecs would be wise to keep Peterman off the free throw line, where she is connecting on over 84 percent of her attempts.

Sophomore forward/center Randee Henry has paced UDM on the glass this season, gobbling up over seven rebounds (7.2) per game.

Like Deja Vu All Over Again

If the start to the 2001-02 season seems similar to last year it is. Last season, San Diego State opened the year 3-5 and was coming off back-to-back losses, including a close defeat at San Jose State on Dec. 6, before getting red-hot and putting together a six-game winning streak during the holidays.

However, SDSU appears to be heating up just in time for the new year and has won three of its last four games resulting in a 6-5 record through 11 games for the second straight year.

Cookin' In Cox

Cox Arena continues to be a winning edge for the

Aztecs. Dating to the start of last season. San Diego State is 14-10 (.583) versus non-conference competition overall but 8-3 (.727) in Cox Arena, including 4-2 this season.

In fact, since the beginning of the 2000-01 campaign, 12 of SDSU's 19 overall wins (63 percent) have come in the friendly confines of Cox Arena.

averaging almost 16 points per game more at home this season and is shooting almost 7 percentage points higher, while limiting opponents to just over nine fewer

Don't Bring A Losing Streak In Here

Detroit is the fourth San Diego State opponent to enter its game versus the Aztecs with an extended losing streak. So far this season, the Aztecs have been able to add to the misery, extending UMKC's run of losses to five games, Sacramento State's streak to eight and Radford's slide to five. Detroit has lost three straight.

Better On The Boards

San Diego State has out-rebounded both of its last two opponents and enters the Detroit game nearly dead even in rebounding this season (36.4-36.8). Prior to the Creighton game, the Aztecs had been out-boarded in four straight and were averaging -3.4 rpg on the season.

SDSU posted its largest rebounding margin of the year Friday against Radford, grabbing 41 boards to RU's 24. The Highlanders' 24 rebounds were also the fewest by an Aztec opponent on the season.

Last year SDSU finished up -4.1 in rebounding.

You Gotta Make Your Free Throws

After struggling from the charity stripe in the season's first seven games, San Diego State has connected on over 70 percent of its free throws in each of the last four games, including a season-best 75 percent (18-for-24) against Radford Friday night.

All Or Nothing

Most of San Diego State's games have fallen into one of two categories this season -- blowouts or nailbiters. Already, four of SDSU's games have been decided by fewer than five points, while four others have been routs of the 20-plus point variety. Only three have finished up in the mid-range 8-15 point category.

San Diego State has already notched three 20-plus point wins this season, including its 47-point blowout of Radford on Friday. By comparison, SDSU had only three 20-plus point wins all of last year.

On the flip side, the Aztecs are 2-2 in down-to-thewire finishes. During 2000-01, SDSU was involved in only six late-game nailbiters for the entire season, win-

San Diego State is 1-2 in middle-of-the-road games this year, defeating Cal Poly by nine, falling to Cal by 14 and losing at Creighton by 11.

Either Way It's All Good

San Diego State has found it can win with both defense and offense this season. Through 11 games, the Aztecs are a perfect 3-0 when scoring at least 70 points. SDSU is also perfect (5-0) when holding an opponent below 60 points.

Traditionally its been San Diego State's defense that has brought home wins for the Aztecs, who are 24-6 (.800) over the past two seasons when holding an opponent under 60 points.

Getting Defensive

San Diego State has picked up the defensive intensity of late, holding five of its last seven opponents below 40

percent shooting and all seven below 42 percent. The Aztecs, who entered the week ranked fourth in the Mountain West in field goal percentage defense at 38.8 percent, have now held over half of their 2001-02 opponents under 40 percent from the field, including San Jose State (36 percent), Sacramento State, (27 percent -- a season-low for an SDSU opponent), UMKC (33

percent), and Radford (30 percent) in four of their last five games. Since SDSU's win over Navy on Nov. 25th, opponents have connected on just 136-of-383 (35.5 percent) attempts from the field.

Stop, Thief

San Diego State's defensive intensity has been most obvious of late in the steals category. Over the last four games -- three of which were SDSU wins -- the Aztecs have registered double-figures steals three times, including a season-high 20 against Radford. SDSU is a perfect 4-0 this year when reaching double-digits in steals.

More Keys To Victory

Rebounding and turnovers continue to be keys to victory for San Diego State. The Aztecs have out-rebounded five opponents and come away winners four times. Creighton, which held SDSU to 35 percent shooting from the field, is the only Aztec opponent to survive being outboarded by SDSU. Sacramento State and UMKC are the only SDSU opponents to out-rebound the Aztecs and lose.

On the turnover front, San Diego State is 5-1 when committing fewer miscues. The only time the Aztecs have won the turnover battle but lost the war came versus UCSD when SDSU had three fewer miscues than the Tritons.



■ Head Coach Barb Smith

Rebounding is one of the keys to victory in basketball. It's also a key to succeeding in life. And San Diego State head coach Barb Smith went hard to the glass during the 2000-01 season, her fourth with the Aztecs. After getting out to a tough start during her first three years at SDSU, Smith got the Aztecs pointed back in the right direction last season, posting a number of milestones of her tenure, including number of overall victories (13), number of conference victories (5), number of non-conference victories (8), number of road victories (5) and longest winning streak (6). Now in her fifth season on The Mesa, she owns a career record of 45-73 (.381).

Returning eight letterwinners, including four starters, and bringing in four highlyprized recruits didn't seem to resonate with Mountain West Conference media members as the San Diego State women's basketball team was tabbed to finish seventh in the league's preseason poll.

For the first time in the conference's brief history, a team other than Utah was selected to win the league by the preseason prognosticators. Colorado State, which advanced to the second round of last year's NCAA Tournament, captured nine first-place votes to take the top spot. Utah was second in the poll with five votes.

Feeling Positive

San Diego State may have committed 21 turnovers Friday night versus Radford, but they also had 24 assists, marking the first time this season the Aztecs have had a positive assist-to-turnover ratio.

Hot Shots

After hitting on a season-low 33 percent from the field at TCU, San Diego State has shot 40 percent or better in 4-of-5 games, including a season-high 58 percent against Radford on Friday.

The Aztecs have now shot a least 40 percent in 8-of-11 games this season, including four games over 45 percent. By comparison, SDSU opponents have reached the 40-percent plateau in just 5-of-11 contests.

As Easy As One, Two, THREE

One of San Diego State's biggest area of improvement on offense has come from behind the arc. The Aztecs shot a respectable 33.6 percent a year ago but are hitting over 37 percent of their 3-pointers this season.

Just Shoot Me!

San Diego State is not only more accurate from beyond the arc this season, it is also much more productive. Entering Sunday's game versus Detroit, the Aztecs are averaging 5.0 3-pointers per game, up significantly from the 3.6 they averaged a year ago.

Whose Got Next?

Through 11 games, the scoring has been spread around by the Aztecs, who have had five different players turn in high-point honors.

Spreading The Wealth

San Diego State has also had seven players score in double digits at least twice. Atim Otii leads the way with eight double-digit scoring games with Ashonda Williams not far behind with seven. Claire Swinbank owns six double-figures games, Jamey Cox five, Morgan Vargas three, and Missy Schomaker and Valencia Howard two.

New To You

After using the same starting lineup in the first eight games of the season, SDSU head coach Barb Smith has shaken things up of late and has used a different set of starters in each of the last three games. Atim Otii, Jamey Cox and Claire Swinbank are the only Aztecs to have started all 11 games this season.

Double Plays

In addition to being the Aztecs' leading scorer, Otii also leads the team in rebounding (6.1 rpg) and in double-doubles (3). The senior notched No. 3 of the season last week at Creighton with 12 points and a career-besttying 12 rebounds. Otii has also recorded double-doubles this year versus Cal Poly (16-10) and Navy (17-11).

More Than Ever Before

Otii entered 2001-02 with two career double-doubles. She has already exceeded that number this season alone and now owns five for her career. She is the only Aztec to post a double-double this year.

Starts Piling Up For Otii

San Diego State senior Atim Otii made her 66th straight start at Creighton Saturday. She is the only Aztec to start every game over the past two-plus seasons.

As Advertised

Junior-college transfer Ashonda Williams came to San Diego State with a reputation as a big-time scorer after pouring in over 1,200 points in just two seasons at Contra Costa College. Through 11 games, Williams has already finished in double figures seven times and has led the Aztecs in scoring in five games, including her 10-point outing Thursday at UMKC. She is averaging 9.3 ppg to rank fourth on the team in scoring.

Bombs Away

For two years, the Aztecs have been looking for an outside shooter to compliment Jamey Cox. It appears that search is now over as newcomer Ashonda Williams continues to knock down shot after shot from beyond the arc.

Williams, who led the California state JC ranks in three-point shooting last season, has been more than solid since arriving at SDSU and trails only Cox in both 3-pointers made (17) and leads the team in 3-point shooting percentage among players with more than 10 makes (39 percent).

Scho-Shines

Missy Schomaker (pronounced SHOO-maker) finally cracked the starting lineup last week at UMKC and Creighton, after supplying the Aztecs with plenty of solid minutes off the bench this season.

The Lincoln, Neb., native had her best outing in nearly a year versus San Jose State, scoring a team- and season-high 14 points in 26 minutes of work. She has also had solid performances against UC San Diego, scoring a team-high 13 points and grabbing a career-best eight rebounds and against Sac. State with eight points, six boards and four assists in just 17 minutes on the floor. At UMKC, the senior had perhaps the most clutch performance of her career, drilling back-to-back treys to help the Aztecs rally from an eight-point second half deficit.

Mac's Back

After eight long weeks of rehab, Nicolette McCartny is finally back in the Aztecs' lineup. A projected starter entering the season, the sophomore forward suffered a severe ankle sprain in practice Nov. 3rd and had been unavailable for action.

McCartny finally saw her first playing time against San Jose State but didn't have a big impact until the UMKC game when she knocked down the game-winning shot with 11.3 second to play.

The sophomore came back against Creighton to make her first start of the year and finished with six points and a career-high eight rebounds, before scoring seven points in just 15 minutes of work against Radford.

Cox Back In Double Figures

Jamey Cox snapped a four-game drought of non-double figure scoring games with her 13 points against Radford. She has now scored in double digits four times this season and 39 times during her 65-game career.

3-Point Threat

Jamey Cox continues to show why she is considered one of the Mountain West's most dangerous players from beyond the arc. Cox, who has connected on 36 percent (20-for-56) of her 3-point attempts this season and has hit at least one three in 10-of-11 games on the year. Cox entered the week ranked No. 14 in the Mountain West Conference in 3-point shooting and No. 5 in 3-pointers made per game. She has now made 140 treys during her two-plus year career at SDSU to rank No. 2 all time in that category.

Five Finger Discount

Senior Claire Swinbank has added a new feature to her game this season ... steals. Swinbank had a careerhigh six versus Sacramento State. She added five more since and now has 25 on the season, good for fifth in the Mountain West Conference.

More 'Bank Shots

Claire Swinbank has gotten her final season off to a strong start. The senior guard has scored in double figures in 5-of-10 contests, including a team-best 13-points last Saturday at Creighton and a season-high 15 points at California.

Poised From The Perimeter

Jamey Cox and Ashonda Williams may get most of the recognition as SDSU's top outside threats, but Claire Swinbank as been the Aztecs' most consistent shooter from the perimeter thus far.

Swinbank, who almost single-handedly shot San Diego State back into the Creighton game with three straight jumpers during at 10-1 run late in the contest, is connecting on 44 percent of her attempts from the field, including 50 percent (6-for-12) from beyond the arc.

Swinbank is also second the team in assists with 52 (4.7 apg), including a career-best nine versus Navy.

Two Can Play At That Game

In addition to ranking among the Mountain West Conference's top scorers, Jamey Cox and Claire Swinbank are also among the league's top playmakers. Cox has had at least six assists in 9-of-10 games this year, including a season-high eight against Radford Friday. She now has 60 assist this season. Swinbank, who has 52 on the year, added another six against Radford and has had at least for assists in five straight

All Windex Team Candidate

Head coach Barb Smith calls her a "little Charles Barkley." And junior-college transfer Valencia Howard has certainly been a welcome addition at SDSU especially in the rebounding department. Through 11 contests, Howard is second on the team in rebounding and with a 5.5 boards per game average despite making just one start.

Howard finally had her break out game on the scoreboard versus Sacramento State. The junior, who averaged a double-double last season at Contra Costa College, scored a career-high 12 points on a perfect 4for-4 shooting from the floor and a 4-for-5 from the line. She was back in double-digits versus Radford, scoring 10 points against the Highlanders.
