Gael SPOTLIGHT

• According to @JGTrends on Twitter, the Gaels have the most difficult non-conference schedule in the NCAA, based on the strength of schedule. The Gaels play seven teams inside the top-100 according to KenPom, matching the number they had last year.

• In the initial round of the NCAA's Net Rankings, the Gaels are #16 in the country and #1 in the West Coast Conference. Last year, the Gaels finished the season #19 in the NET Rankings. SMC is 2-2 in Quad 1-2 games, and 5-1 in Quad 3-4 games, which puts them at #19 in the NET Rankings actively.

• In addition to the matchup against No. 1 Houston, the Gaels will play No. 22 San Diego State on December 10 in their first game of the Jerry Colangelo Classic. Saint Mary's returns to the event on December 21 to face Wyoming.

• "That Saint Mary's team is a really good team. I was telling our guys when we watched the film today that they do some things that we aspire to do. I think he does a great job. That guy could coach anywhere. He's as good as any coach I've faced. When he gets those guys to play and pay attention to detail, that's what we preach all the time. About Saint Mary's

» SMC concludes the 2021-22 season with the highest winning percentage (.748) and 3rd-most NCAA Tournament appearances (4) of any NCAA Division I men's basketball program in the state of California over the last decade.

» Saint Mary's has the ninth best win percentage of any Div. I team in the nation over the last seven seasons.

» SMC has a 126-45 record (.737) winning percentage against non-conference opponents over the last 10+ years.

» Over the past 11 years, SMC posted a 137-41 (.770) overall record in West Coast Conference play.

» Saint Mary's has participated in postseason (8 NCAA, 7 NIT) in each of the last 15 seasons, the fourth-longest active streak in the NCAA.

» Saint Mary's has finished t-2nd or higher in the WCC in 13 of the last 15 seasons.

» SMC has won 25 or more games 11 times in the last 15 seasons.

» The Gaels went 30-6 in the regular season of 2017-18, marking the most single-season wins in program history.

» Former SMC standouts Patrick Mills, Matthew Dellavedova, and Jock Landale, are on active NBA rosters. Mills won the NBA title in 2014 with San Antonio and is under contract with Brooklyn. Dellavedova won the NBA title with Cleveland in 2016 and re-joins the NBA with Sacramento. Landale was traded to Phoenix this summer. Tommy Kuhse, Jordan Ford, and Malik Fitts are currently in the G-League.

FROM THE MISSOURI STATE GAME

The early activation of Saxen and his 19 points led to the Gaels owning a decisive 48-18 advantage on points in the paint, their largest of the season... Alex Ducas was also shutout in the first half like Mahaney, but managed to score nine points in the second half... after turning the ball over at least 13 times in four-straight games, the Gaels coughed it up just seven times on Wednesday night, their second-lowest mark of the year... nine of the 10 Gaels to play scored, and all 10 had at least one rebound.

23 IN A ROW!!!

With the win over Vermont, Saint Mary's now has broken the all-time record for most consecutive home wins, snapping a record that had stood for over 10 years. The previous record began with a 77-72 win over Portland on January 16, 2010 and ended with a loss to No. 25 Utah State on February 19, 2011. The home winning streak actually spanned three seasons, with it beginning on February 22, 2021 against Pepperdine and ending with the loss to New Mexico on November 30, 2022 (23 games).

JOHNSON ON LOU HENSON AWARD WATCH LIST

Logan Johnson was added to the Lou Henson Award watch list, continuing to gain recognition for his outstanding play for Saint Mary's. The award, which is presented annually to the top mid-major player in division I college basketball, honors the former Illinois and New Mexico State head coach who won 775 games in 41 seasons.

This marks the first time a Gael has been named to the Lou Henson Award watch list since Jordan Ford in 2019. No Gael has been on any watch list since Ford during his senior season.

Johnson is the only player from the West Coast Conference chosen to the watch list for the Lou Henson Award. SMC has seen two of the players this season on the list, with Max Abmas (Oral Roberts) and Aaron Estrada (Hofstra) also landing on the list.

HE'S PRETTY GOOD

For the second time this season, Aidan Mahaney has been better than the rest of his young counterparts in the West Coast Conference. Just announced by the conference office, Mahaney has been named the WCC's Freshman of the Week for the second time this season, and his first weekly award since the opening week of the year. With the award win, Mahaney becomes the first freshman at Saint Mary's to win the award multiple times in a single season. He is also the first freshman in the WCC this year to win the award for the second time.

Since the award's creation, Mahaney is the second Gael to take home the award, joining Leemet Böckler (December 7, 2020). His 25 points scored in his collegiate debut are the most points scored by a Gael in his collegiate debut in the Randy Bennett era, eclipsing Patty Mills (17) and Matthew Delavedova (19).

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

Saint Mary's lands a pair of players on the conference's annual Preseason All-WCC squad in the form of Logan Johnson and Alex Ducas, while the Gaels are picked to finish second in the standings.

Saint Mary's received 73 votes to trail only Gonzaga (81) in the projected polls, while receiving one first place vote. BYU and San Francisco are in a tie behind the Gaels for third, while Portland has made the jump up to fifth in the preseason poll. Last year,

Randy Bennett, Saint Mary's Head Coach

A four-time West Coast Conference Coach of the Year (2022, 2016, 2011, 2008) and 2010 Sporting News WCC Coach of the Year, Randy Bennett, took over as the head men's basketball coach prior to the 2001-02 season.

On Nov. 10, 2017, Saint Mary's and head coach Randy Bennett announced the signing of a new 10-year contract that will keep Bennett in charge of the program through the 2026-27 season. In 2021-22, Bennett led the Gaels to their 14th straight postseason appearance and a number-five seed in the NCAA Tournament, the best seed in program history.

Entering his 22nd season, he is the school's all-time wins leader, guided SMC to 15 post-season appearances (8 NCAA and 7 NIT), led the Gaels to their first post-season victory and had a player drafted (Patrick Mills, 2009) by the NBA for the first time since 1984. Four Gaels are currently playing in the NBA.

Bennett is second all-time among WCC coaches in career league wins and has a 480-200 (.706) record while compiling a 224-91 (.711) mark in WCC regular-season competition heading into the 2022-23 season. Bennett became the winningest coach at SMC when the Gaels defeated East Tennessee State in the semifinals of the Rainbow Classic on December 21, 2007, passing James Weaver (110-67), who held the record for 47 years.

He has led SMC to at least the semifinals of the WCC Tournament 19 of his past 21 seasons, and 12 championship game appearances. His side captured WCC Tournament titles in 2010, 2012, and 2019.

In addition to team accomplishments, Bennett has had 26 players earn All-WCC recognition, with 36 first team and eight honorable mention selections. He coached Mickey McConnell, Matthew Dellavedova and Jock Landale to WCC Player of the Year honors. In 2011, he served as an assistant coach for the USA team that competed in the FIBA U19 World Championship. in Latvia.

the Gaels finished second in the WCC after going 12-3, including a win over the conference champion, Gonzaga.

Logan Johnson was selected for the Preseason All-WCC team for the second consecutive year after landing postseason honors each of the last two years. Last season, Johnson averaged 11.9 points per game and led the conference with 67 total steals, the second-most in a single season in Saint Mary's history. The Mountain View native also set career-highs in assists per game (2.6) and rebounds per game (4.1) en route to being named All-WCC Second Team.

Alex Ducas makes his first appearance on the Preseason All-WCC team after the best season of his collegiate career. The senior out of Geraldton, Australia set career-highs with 10.3 points per game, 0.9 assists per game and steals per game, and 29.8 minutes per game. Ducas continues to be the best three-point shooter on the team, leading the team with 67 made three-pointers and was selected to the All-WCC Second Team for the first time in his career.

This season marks the first time since the 2019-20 season that the Gaels have had multiple players land on the Preseason All-WCC team, when Jordan Ford and Malik Fitts were chosen before the season.

AUSSIE, AUSSIE, AUSSIE!

Saint Mary's embarked on a Foreign Tour in August of 2022, spanning 14 days including the travel days. The Gaels played six games Down Under, including five against NBL or NBL1 teams.

SMC began the trip in Sydney before heading to Melbourne and Perth along the way. There was plenty of time for sightseeing, including a boat tour of the Sydney Harbour, the Sydney Tower, multiple zoos, and an AFL game between the West Coast Eagles and the Fremantle Dockers.

On the basketball side of things, the Gaels went 6-0 on the foreign tour, their first undefeated foreign tour in program history. That included wins over teams like Melbourne United (recent home of Matthew Dellavedova), and a 17-point comeback win over the Southeast Melbourne Phoenix, who have Dane Pineau on the current roster.

"The number one thing this does is help you become a team," head coach Randy Bennett said about the trip. "You get to know each other, you get tight. You spend 12 days together on the road. You learn how to travel, you learn your teammates...

that's the big one."

"The other thing is that you get to play six games, and that's how you get good, by playing games," continued Bennett. "You need practice, you need reps, you need all that summer stuff, but the way you really gain confidence as a player and a team is by having success in games. We got that, we got like a fifth of a season on this trip. So that's the true value."

DUCAS DEBUTS WITH AUSTRALIA AT FIBA WORLD CUP

The first round of FIBA World Cup qualifying has concluded, with the Australia Boomers punching their ticket to the second round. In their final qualifying game on July 3, Saint Mary's guard Alex Ducas made his debut for the Boomers as they took down China 71-48 to keep an unblemished qualifying record intact.

Ducas checked into the win over China late in the fourth quarter, with the Boomers having already taken command of the game. Jack McVeigh and Clint Steindl (former SMC Gael) had been injured earlier in the game, opening the door for Ducas to make his debut. The experience was even sweeter for Ducas, who used to be a floor mopper for the Boomers while growing up in Australia.

KENPOM FACTS

Saint Mary's begins the 2022-23 season ranked 47th by KenPom. That ranking put them third in the WCC behind Gonzaga (3rd) and BYU (44th). Actively, the Gaels are 23rd in KenPom and second in the West Coast Conference.

Out of 363 schools, the Gaels defensive efficiency continues to be elite, ranking eighth in KenPom at 87.8 points per 100 possessions. They are holding opponents to the ninth-lowest field goal percentage on two-point shots (40.5%), and the fourth-lowest percentage of assists on made field goals (35.0%). The Gaels are also allowing the fifth-lowest percentage of opposing offensive rebounds at 19.8%.

ALL ABOUT THAT DEFENSE

The Saint Mary's defense was elite during the 2021-22 season, even without factoring in any KenPom metrics. Saint Mary's was ranked ninth in the NCAA in fewest points allowed per game, at 60.4. That number was even better in their 16 home games, with the Gaels giving up just 58.2 points per game inside University Credit Union Pavilion.

BALL DISTRIBUTION IS KEY

Over the past four-plus seasons, Saint Mary's is 76-12 in games with 10 or more
