#### **Streaks**

- SDSU has dropped consecutive games for the first time in 80 games.
- SDSU had its 44-game home winning streak vs. unranked teams snapped.
- SDSU had its 41-game winning streak of holding opponents to under 50 percent shooting snapped.
- SDSU had its 23-game home winning streak vs. current Mountain West teams snapped.
- SDSU had its 10-game home winning streak snapped.
- SDSU had its nine-game home February winning streak snapped.
- SDSU had its four-game winning streak vs. New Mexico snapped.
- SDSU has its four-game home winning streak vs. New Mexico snapped.

#### **Trends**

- At 20-5, SDSU matches its second-best start in the 91-year history of the program (1984-85).
- SDSU is 43-6 as an AP Top-25 team and 38-6 when it is ranked in the Coaches' poll.
- San Diego State is 54-8 since the beginning of the 2010-11 campaign.
- SDSU is 40-2 vs. unranked foes as an AP Top-25 club. The Aztecs are 36-2 vs. unranked opponents when in the Coaches' poll.

## **Series Notes**

- Despite the loss, San Diego State is 11-4 against New Mexico since 2005-06.
- The Aztecs dropped to 21-12 all-time vs. New Mexico at home.

## Jamaal Franklin (16 points, 10 rebounds)

Recorded his eighth double-double of the season and ninth of his career... Has a double-double in eight of his last 12 games... The sophomore reached double figures for a career-high 13th straight game,  $21^{st}$  time this season and the  $22^{nd}$  time in his career... Led the team in rebounding for the  $12^{th}$  time this season and of his career... He has led the team in rebounding seven straight games.

# Tim Shelton (13 points, 2 charges drawn)

Scored a season-high 13 points... Tallied his most points scored since his redshirt freshman season (14 vs. Colorado State, March 4, 2009)... Recorded a season high for points in the first half alone (11)... Connected on his first three-point field goal of the season and first since the 2011 MWC Championship game vs. BYU (March 12, 2011)... Made a career-high four free throws in the first half and finished with four for the game... Posted his 13<sup>th</sup> career double-figure scoring effort; it was his first of the season... Drew two charges, giving him 27 on the season.

#### James Rahon (11 points)

Recorded his ninth double-figure scoring game of the season and his 20th of his Aztec career.

## Garrett Green (9 points, 2 blocks)

Produced his most points of the Mountain West season and most since scoring 14 vs. San Diego Christian... Had a season-high two blocks and tied his career-high (previously done four times while with LSU).
