

San Diego State Aztecs

2023-24 Record: 22-7 (H: 14-0; A: 5-7; N: 3-0) 11-5 MW
16-Time MW Champions, 15 Postseason Berths in Last 17 Years

- SDSU has won at least 19 games in 18 straight seasons.
- SDSU has advanced to the postseason in 15 of the last 17 seasons in which a champion was crowned (2006 NCAA, 2007-09 NIT, 2010-15 NCAA, 2016 NIT, 2018, 2021-23 NCAA).
- SDSU has won 78 of last 83 games when leading at the half.
- SDSU has won its last 113-of-121 when having a higher FG pct.
- SDSU is 5th nationally in winning percentage (.742) since the beginning of the 2005-06 season.
- Since its founding in 1999, no men's basketball program has won more Mountain West championships (regular-season and tournament) than San Diego State's 16.
- Since 2006, SDSU's 14 appearances in its conference championship game are tied for second most in Division I.

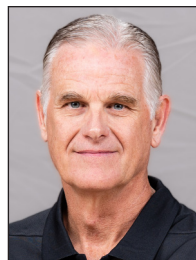
