San Diego State Opens 2008-09 Campaign Looking for Fourth Consecutive Postseason Bid; Faces UC San Diego on Saturday

San Diego State opens its 88th season of basketball, its 39th at the Division I level and 10th under national championship coach Steve Fisher on Saturday against UC San Diego, a Division II program that finished 18-12 last season and advanced to the NCAA West Regionals.

The tilt is the first of three consecutive games the Aztecs play at Cox Arena to open the 2008-09 campaign. On Tuesday, SDSU will face 15th-ranked Arizona State and the homestand concludes with a contest against long-time rival Fresno State the following Saturday.

Game Tidbits:

- ▶ The Aztecs have won three consecutive season openers and are looking to put together their first four-game win streak in openers since winning four straight from 1993-94 to 1996-97.
- ▶ San Diego State, which has been selected to finish second in the Mountain West Conference by *The Sporting News*, returns all five starters and its top eight scorers off last season's team.
- ▶ This is the ninth time Steve Fisher has returned at least four starters off a team he has coached the previous season and the eight previous times he has guided those teams to postseason play (6 NCAA Tournaments, 2 NITs).
- ▶ The Aztecs have won their last eight games against city foes (UCSD and San Diego) at Cox Arena.
- ▶ The game marks the first time since the 2004-05 season in which San Diego State has opened a campaign at home. The last three years the Aztecs opened in Fresno, Calif. (2007-08), Moraga, Calif. (2006-07) and Fairbanks, Alaska (2005-06).

Starting the Season Off Right

Under Steve Fisher, the Aztecs have started the season off with a victory seven times in nine seasons. San Diego State began the Fisher era with three straight wins and have won four of the last six, including the last three. Last year, SDSU defeated Liberty, 62-50, at the World Vision Classic in Fresno, Calif.

In their two losses, the Aztecs were competitive in both as they fell, 75-70, to Eastern Washington in 2002-03 and in overtime to UC Santa Barbara, 80-72, in 2004-05.

As a program, San Diego State is 20-18 in season-opening games in the Division I era and 55-32 in school history. Individually, Fisher is 14-3 (.824) in season-opening tilts.

No Place Like Cox Arena

San Diego State is 7-2 in home season openers under Steve Fisher and will be looking to win its fourth straight. Not only is it tough for visitors to beat the Aztecs in their home opener, but it has been downright difficult to win on Montezuma Mesa, period.

In the last three seasons, SDSU has posted a home record of 38-7. Only twice in the Fisher era have the Aztecs not recorded a winning home record (1999-00: 5-10; 2004-05: 7-9). When you take the other six seasons, San Diego State is a combined 84-25 (.771).

A Look at the Tritons

▶ Head coach Chris Carlson begins his second year at UCSD and is coming off a first season where he guided the Tritons to an 18-12 record (11-9 CCAA).

▶ UC San Diego returns 11 letterwinners and three starters off a team that advanced to the NCAA West Regionals.

▶ UCSD's leading returning scorers are Jordan Lawley (11.4) and Kelvin Kim (9.4). Shane Poppen returns as the team's leader rebounder from 2007-08 after averaging 4.4 a game.

▶ This game is the first of the season for UC San Diego and the first of four straight on the road. Following their game with San Diego State, the Tritons head north to take on Pacific on Wednesday night.

San Diego State-UC San Diego Series History

▶ SDSU and UC San Diego are meeting for the 10th time in school history. The Aztecs have never lost to the Tritons.

▶ The last eight games between the two San Diego universities have been decided by double figures. In the first-ever meeting, the Aztecs won by five, 70-65, on Dec. 5, 1969.

▶ The average score in the series: San Diego State 84.7, UC San Diego 55.9.

▶ SDSU has scored at least 76 points eight times, while holding UCSD to 60 points or fewer on seven different occasions.



In the summer during the month of August, fans cast their vote at GoAztecs.com for the top-10 games of the Steve Fisher Era in honor of the national championship head coach entering his 10th season on Montezuma Mesa. A ballot, which featured 28 games, was comprised with the input from local media, the men's basketball and SDSU administrative staff. Each week a game was revealed leading up to the season opener. Last Year's Meeting

San Diego State received a career game from freshman Billy White as the Aztecs defeated UC San Diego, 76-60, in their home opener at Cox Arena.

White, who earned his first career start, made his first nine baskets and finished the game connecting on 10-of-11 shots en route to a career-and game-best 20 points. The Las Vegas native also added a career- and game-high nine rebounds and a personal-best three blocked shots in 29 minutes.

The game was tight throughout the first half with the Tritons owning a slim 22-21 lead with 5:17 left in the half. But the Aztecs ended the first 20 minutes on a high note scoring 10 unanswered points and finishing the half on a 15-5 run to go into the locker room up 36-27.

At the beginning of the second half, UCSD cut the SDSU lead to three within the first 1:50, but the Tritons would not get any closer the rest of the way as the Aztecs cruised to their fourth straight double-digit win.

Joining White in the double-figure scoring column was Kelvin Davis, who tied his career high with 15 points, and Kyle Spain, who added 12.

Henry Patterson led UCSD with 16 points and nine rebounds, while Jordan Lawley contributed 13 points.

Notes from the Game:

- ▶ San Diego State improved to 4-0 for the second straight season. It was also the first time in SDSU's Division I history that it started 4-0 in consecutive seasons.
- ▶ The Aztecs were 4-0 to begin a season for just the

fifth time as a Division I school.

- ▶ The Aztecs had a season low in turnovers (6) and their fewest since having eight last season at Syracuse.
- ▶ The home-opening attendance of 6,706 was SDSU's largest since 1999-00.
- ▶ Freshman Billy White made his first career start. ... He set a career high in points (20) and blocked shots (3). ... White posted his second career double-figure scoring effort of the year. ... He made his first nine baskets before missing with under six minutes left in the game. ... White led the team in scoring for the first time in his career and rebounding for the second time. ... White posted his first 20-plus point effort of his career.
- ▶ Junior Kyle Spain posted his fourth straight game with at least one three-point field goal. It was the first time in his career he made at least one three-pointer in four straight games. ... He recorded his fourth straight double-figure scoring game (12) for the first time in his career.
- ▶ Junior Kelvin Davis scored in double-figures (15) for the third straight game after only scoring five in the season opener vs. Liberty.
- ▶ Sophomore Jon Pastorek recorded a season high in points (4) and minutes (15).

Fisher Enters 10th Season on The Mesa

Head coach Steve Fisher begins his 10th season at San Diego State today. The national championship coach has compiled an Aztec record of 147-130, led them to four 20-win seasons and trips to the 2002 and 2006 NCAA Tournaments and the 2003, 2007 and 2008 postseason NITs.

In 2003, Fisher coached SDSU to its first-ever Division I postseason tournament victory and guided the Aztecs to their first Division I postseason road win in 2007.

In addition to having a career 331-212 record, Fisher led San Diego State to the 2002 and 2006 Mountain West Conference tournament titles, making it the first MWC school to win multiple conference tourney crowns, and the 2006 MWC regular season championship.

all 29 games as a freshman (2004-05) en route to earning all-MWC accolades and in 28 of 33 games as a sophomore (2005-06). It was in his sophomore year that he helped the Aztecs win the MWC regular season and tournament titles and earn a berth in the NCAA Tournament before a back injury limited him to just two games in 2006-07 as a junior. Last season, Thomas played in 29 games, while making eight starts, and helped SDSU to its third straight 20-win campaign and postseason appearance. Overall, Thomas enters his fifth season having played in 88 career games, while earning the starting assignment 26 times.

Shelton Granted Medical Hardship Waiver

Tim Shelton was granted a medical hardship waiver by the NCAA and will be a freshman for 2008-09, it was announced Sept. 23. With the decision, Shelton will now have four years remaining to complete four seasons of eligibility.

The Fresno, Calif., native played in four games as a freshman last season and made three starts, helping the Aztecs to victories in all four games. Shelton underwent knee surgery on Nov. 20 and was declared out for the season by head coach Steve Fisher prior to SDSU's game at Loyola Marymount on Nov. 28.

Shelton was one of four Aztecs to average in double figures by averaging 10.0 points, while shooting 55.2 percent from the field and 77.8 percent from the free-throw line. Shelton also averaged 4.8 rebounds and 1.3 steals per contest.

Shelton's injury led to Billy White being inserted into the starting lineup where he made 28 starts and averaged 8.5 points, 5.9 rebounds, 1.0 assists, 1.4 steals and shot 61.5 percent from the field. At season's end, the Las Vegas, Nev., product was named the MWC freshman of the year and earned a spot on the all-conference third team.

Four or More Starters Returning for Fisher Equals Postseason

In his coaching history, Steve Fisher plus four or more returning starters has resulted in tremendous success. Eight previous times Steve Fisher has returned four or more starters from a team coached, with those clubs advancing to the NCAA Tournament on six occasions and winning the postseason NIT championship once. Bland Returns as Head Manager

Former San Diego State guard Tony Bland has rejoined the program as head manager. Bland, one of 22 players in school history to score 1,000 career points, is currently a full-time student at the University and is in the process of finishing course work to earn his degree.

Bland, who was a two-year Aztec letterwinner in 2002 and 2003, transferred to SDSU after playing in 64 games, while making 33 starts in two seasons at Syracuse. In all four of his collegiate seasons, his teams posted winning records and made the postseason. In addition, Bland-led teams won 21 or more games and advanced to the NCAA Tournament three different times.

As a two guard who could play the point, Bland had one of the best mid-range games in college basketball while playing for two national championship coaches in Syracuse's Jim Boeheim and Steve Fisher.

In 2001-02, Bland's first season at SDSU, he became the first player in MWC history to rank in the league's top 10 in scoring and assists and top 20 in rebounding in the same season. That same year, Bland helped the Aztecs advance to the NCAA Tournament, SDSU's first appearance in the tour-

ney since 1985. The following season, Bland guided San Diego State to the NIT where it recorded the school's first Division I postseason victory and an appearance in the second round.

Bland ended his college career with 1,368 points, 331 rebounds, 319 assists and 127 steals in 127 career games (95 starts). While at SDSU, he played in all 63 games and made 62 starts. During his time at San Diego State, the Aztecs went 37-26 and appeared in consecutive postseason tournaments for the second time in the school's Division I history.

In two seasons at SDSU, Bland led the Aztecs in points 27 times, rebounds seven times and assists 26 times. He had 56 double-figure scoring games at SDSU (70 career, counting 14 at Syracuse), while ranking 18th in scoring (1,012, most among two-year players), seventh in career scoring average (16.1) and ninth in minutes played since the 1978-79 season (2,182) upon completion of his eligibility.

Following his collegiate career, Bland earned an invitation to take part in the Indiana Pacers training camp before playing in the United States Basketball League (USBL) where he played for former NBA player John Starks. During his stint in the USBL, Bland averaged 18.7 points, 5.1 rebounds and 5.7 assists en route to earning the league's Rookie of the Year award. From there, Bland participated in the Sacramento Kings' training camp in the fall of 2004 before signing a contract with the team. Following his stay with Sacramento, Bland played in Russia before moving on to the NBDL's Albuquerque Thunderbirds, where he played for two seasons for former NBA player Michael Cooper and won a championship in 2005-06. Shortly thereafter, Bland went overseas to play in Europe before returning to Montezuma Mesa.

Aztecs Sign Five During Early Signing Period

San Diego State signed five players during the signing period that started Wednesday, Nov. 12. The Aztecs added Eric Lawton, Kawhi Leonard, Chase Tapley, Malcolm Thomas and Alec Williams. Everyone except for Thomas, who will be a junior, will be a freshman in 2009-10. Below is a more in-depth look at the class:

Eric Lawton

Lawton, from West Valley High School in Hemet, Calif., is a 6-1, 160-pound guard who led West Valley to the 2008 CIF Southern Section Division III-AA title and a spot in the CIF Southern California Division I State Basketball Championships. Overall, West Valley finished the 2007-08 season with a 25-4 record and a 12-1 mark in the Sunbelt League. Individually, Lawton averaged 20.3 points, 2.5 rebounds, 5.0 assists and 2.7 steals as a junior. His season led to him being named the Division III-A co-player of the year by the Southern California Interscholastic Basketball Coaches Association and to the all-area second-team by *The Press-Enterprise* in Riverside, Calif.

Kawhi Leonard

A 6-6, 210-pound small forward, Leonard helped King High School in Riverside, Calif., to a 32-3 record (8-0 Ivy League) in 2007-08. King advanced to the CIF Division I Southern Section finals where Leonard went on to score 23 points against Comp-

ton Dominguez. As a junior, Leonard averaged 17.3 points and 6.5 rebounds. An all-area second-team choice by *The Press-Enterprise*, Leonard is rated among the best at his position by various recruiting sites. *Rivals.com* ranks him as a four-star player, the 14th-best small forward in America and the 76th-best player at any position. Meanwhile, Leonard is *Scout.com's* 25th-best small forward and is ranked 34th at his position by *ESPN.com*.

Chase Tapley

Tapley, a 6-2, 185-pound guard from Sacramento, Calif., led Sacramento High School to its first-ever CIF Division III state finals appearance in 2007-08 after helping the Dragons to their first CIF Northern California Regional Championship. In the state title game, Tapley went for 35 points, nine rebounds and four steals en route to averaging 22.2 points, 4.8 assists and 4.6 steals for the season. Tapley comes from a basketball family as his father played college basketball at Arkansas State.

Malcolm Thomas


Thomas is currently at San Diego City College after spending his 2007-08 freshman season at Pepperdine. During his stay in Malibu, Thomas averaged a team-best 8.8 rebounds and 2.0 blocks and was the Waves' second-leading scorer at 12.5 points behind current Aztec Tyrone Shelley, while shooting 51.4 percent from the field. The 6-9, 220-pound forward played in all 32 games, made a team-high 28 starts and averaged a team-high 30.2 minutes. Prior to his stint at Pepperdine, Thomas was a standout player at nearby Crawford High School. In his final season as prep, Thomas averaged 13.2 points, 12.8 rebounds and 5.3 blocks in helping Crawford to a section title. In two seasons at Crawford, Thomas blocked 215 shots to rank seventh all-time in CIF San Diego Section history and had 168 in 2005-06. Thomas will be a junior in 2009-10.

Alec Williams

A native of San Juan Capistrano, Calif., Williams inks with the Aztecs after earning all-Trinity League second-team honors during a 2007-08 season in which he averaged 14.4 points at JSerra Catholic High School. Williams, a 6-6, 230-pound forward, guided the Lions to a 19-9 record and was an Orange Holiday Classic all-tournament team selection as a junior. Prior to JSerra, Williams played at Aliso Niguel High School.
