Defensive End • 6-3 • 260 • Irvine, Calif. • Saddleback JC

- At San Diego State: Came to SDSU in 2015 with three years of collegiate experience, including two years at Arizona ... Excellent pass rusher who performed well in limited action his first year (2015) and as a regular starter in 2016 ... Started the final 16 games of his career, including two Mountain West championship games and two bowl contests.
- 2016 (Senior): Was a honorable-mention all-Mountain West performer ... Was named a preseason first-team all-Mountain West selection by Lindy's Sports, a second-team pick by Athlon Sports and a third-team honoree by Phil Steele's 2016 College Football Preview ... Had 49 tackles (21 solo), including 7.5 tackles for loss, six sacks for 38 yards, a fumble recovery, a pass breakup and 12 quarterback hurries in 14 starts on the season ... Started for the third straight game and third time overall in the opener against New Hampshire, coming up with two tackles and a 5-yard sack (and TFL) ... Made three stops with 1.5 TFL for six yards vs. California ... Also added a QBH ... Came up with three tackles (two solo) at Northern Illinois ... Had three stops (one solo) with a 6-yard sack (and TFL) in another start at South Alabama ... Registered four tackles (three solo) against UNLY, while adding a guarterback hurry ... Made two stops (one solo) with a 8-yard sack (and TFL) at Fresno State ... The sack came on a 3rd and 5 play on the SDSU 40-yard line, which forced the Bulldags to punt down, 17-3 ... Made two guarterback hurries in another start against San José State ... Came up with a tackle and a QBH at Utah State in a start ... Made three assisted stops and a quarterback hurry in a start against Hawai'i ... Had a season-high seven stops (four solo) and a quarterback hurry in a start at Nevada ... Came up with six tackles, a pass breakup and a quarterback hurry at Wyoming ... Started for a 14th straight game against Colorado State, but did not find the stat sheet ... Had a big game at Wyoming in the MW Championship, registering five tackles, including two sacks (and tackles for loss) for 14 yards, a fumble recovery and a quarterback hurry ... The fumble recovery was the first of his career ... His final sack for five yards late in the fourth quarter came on fourth down and allowed SDSU to kneel down for the victory ... Had huge game against Houston in the Las Vegas Bowl, recording a career-high and team-high-tying 10 tackles, including a 5-yard sack and tackle for loss ... For his efforts was named to the Associated Press All-Bowl team as an honorable mention selection.
- 2015 (Junior): Played in the team's only 14 games with two starts, collecting 24 tackles (15 solo) with nine tackles for loss, 7.5 sacks, a pass breakup, a forced fumble, a blocked kick and eight quarterback hurries ... Led the team in quarterback hurries and ranked second in sacks despite starting only the final two games ... Logged his first snaps in a reserve role against San Diego, making two tackles (one solo) ... Recorded two tackles (one solo) with 0.5 tackles for loss off the bench at California ... Had one tackle in a reserve role vs. South Alabama, while adding a pass breakup and a guarterback hurry ... Had a good game at Penn State, making a solo tackle - a 3-vard sack (and TFL) - and blocking a field goal attempt ... The sack and blocked field goal were the first of his career ... Played again off the pine against Fresno State, but did not record a stat for the first time of the year ... Did not record a stat at Hawai'i ... Also didn't find the stat sheet at San José State ... Had a solo tackle in a reserve role against Utah State ... Came up with an assisted tackle at Colorado State, which went down as a 1/2 tackle for loss ... Did not make the stat sheet in reserve time vs. Wyoming ... Had the best game of his career at UNLV at the time, making three tackles (two solo) with career bests of 2.5 tackles for loss (13 yards), a pair of sacks for 12 yards and three quarterback hurries ... Logged his most time of his Aztec career with Alex Barrett missing most of the game with a knee injury ... Had another good game off the bench vs. Nevada, making a solo tackle - a 4-yard sack (and TFL) - with his first career forced fumble, and a quarterback hurry ... Made his first career start against Air Force in the Mountain West Championship game, making three tackles (two solo) and recording the team's only quarterback hurry ... Had a huge game vs. Cincinnati in the Hawai'i Bowl, recording career highs of nine tackles (six solo), 3.5 sacks and 3.5 tackles for loss for 25 yards ... The 3.5 sacks set a Hawai'i Bowl record, were the most in a bowl game this season, were tied for the third most in a game in program history and were tied for the 10th most in a game in the country in 2015 ... The nine tackles also tied teammates Na'im McGee and Kameron Kelly for the most in the game ... For his efforts, he was named to the USA Today Sports All-Bowl Team and the Associated Press All-Bowl Team.
- At Saddleback JC (2014): Played in all 10 games at Saddleback College in 2014, registering
 46 tackles (23), 9.5 sacks, 13 tackles for loss, a 34-yard fumble recovery, an interception and
 two pass breakups ... Was named to the all-California team by CCCFCA and the NCS League
 First Team.
- At Univ. of Arizona (2012-13): Was at Arizona from 2012-13, making two tackles (one solo) in 12 games in 2013 and redshirting the 2012 campaign.
- High School: Was a PrepStar All-American and Parade All-American at Woodbridge High in

- Irvine, Calif. ... Picked as a *Tacoma News Tribune* Western 100 ... Also was on the *CalHiSports* all-state first team (medium schools) ... Logged 87 tackles and 22 sacks as a senior, earning Pacific Coast League Defensive MVP honors ... Also was an all-Orange County and all-CIF honoree ... Played in the Cal-State All-Star game ... Added 21 receptions for 382 yards and 5 TDs at tight end ... Was a four-star recruit by Rivals, and a three-star pick by ESPN, Scout and 247sports.
- Personal: Kyle Christopher Kelley was born Sept. 3, 1993, in Santa Monica, Calif. ... Son of Charles and Colleen Kelley ... Picked Arizona out of high school over offers from Arizona State, Colorado, Florida, North Carolina State, Northern Illinois, Oklahoma, UCLA, Utah, Vanderbilt, Washington and Washington State ... Is majoring in social science.
