WHAT'S ON TAP THIS WEEKEND IN AZTEC BASEBALL

- ◆ San Diego State will travel for a neutral site contest and host three games during the Tony Gwynn Classic over a four-day period this week.
- ◆ On Thursday, Feb. 25, the Aztecs will be on The Diamond in Lake Elsinore, Calif., to take on the University of San Diego in a neutral site contest at 6:00 p.m.
- ◆ On Friday (Feb. 26) SDSU begins play in the Tony Gwynn Classic by facing Bryant at 6:00 p.m. at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- ◆ SDSU will then face either Kentucky or UC Santa Barbara on Saturday (Feb. 27) at 6:00 p.m. with Sunday's (Feb. 28) opponent and game time to be determined.

AZTECS ON THE AIR

- ◆ The Aztecs' Thursday through Sunday games this week will broadcast live on KCR Radio, San Diego State's campus station.
- ◆ KCR will broadcast a total of 17 games this season while seven others will be carried on ESPN 1700 in San Diego.
- ◆ A total of 11 of SDSU's 30 home games this season will be streamed live on the Mountain Digital Network.

SERIES RECORDS

- ◆ San Diego State leads the series with USD 71-54-3 since the teams first met during the 1962 season. Last season the Aztecs defeated the Toreros in both game the teams played against each other. The Aztecs are 48-30-2 at home and 23-23 away against the Toreros with a loss and a tie coming at neutral sites.
- ◆ Friday's contest between the Aztecs and Bryant will be the first-ever meeting between the schools on the baseball diamond.
- ◆ The Aztecs are 1-0 vs. Kentucky with the lone meeting between the teams, a 12-4 SDSU victory, coming in 2010 during the Aztec Invitational at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- ◆ San Diego State's record vs. UC Santa Barbara stands at 81-29-1 since the teams first met back in 1936. The Aztecs and Gauchos last played each other during the 2015 NCAA Regional at Lake Elsinore, Calif., when SDDU prevailed by a score of 4-3.

HEAD COACH MARK MARTINEZ

- ◆ Mark Martinez is in his second season as head coach of the Aztecs and 11th season as a member of the San Diego State staff.
- ◆ Martinez is just the fifth head coach in SDSU history since baseball was elevated to major sport status in 1936.
- ◆ Last season he led the Aztecs to their third consecutive Mountain West Championship and berth in the NCAA regionals as SDSU compiled a 41-23 record.

- ◆ Martinez was hired as an assistant coach for the Aztecs prior to the 2006 season and served for nine years under Head Coach Tony Gwynn. During that time he was promoted to the position of Associate Head Coach.
- ◆ Prior to his arrival at SDSU, Martinez was an assistant coach at the University of New Mexico for 17 seasons. During his time as a hitting and infield coach he helped develop the Lobos into one of the most prominent offensive teams in the

- nation, ranking among the top 11 in the nation in hitting his final four seasons.
- ◆ Martinez served as an assistant at his alma mater, Mesa State College in Grand Junction, Colo., from 1984-88. He played shortstop at the school from 1982-84, earning all-conference and all-district honors as a senior.
- ◆ He graduated from Mesa State with a bachelor's degree in physical education in 1984 and completed his master's in sports administration at New Mexico in 1990.

PITCHING ROTATION

- ◆ SDSU is expected to start junior right-hander Mike Diamond on the mound vs. San Diego on Thursday.
- ◆ For the weekend games, the Aztecs will go with the same Friday through Sunday rotation as last week: LHP Marcus Reyes on Friday, RHP Cody Thompson on Saturday and LHP Brett Seeburger on Sunday.

VERDON LEADS OFFENSE

- ◆ Freshman first baseman Jordan Verdon's .333 batting average is tied for the team lead after four contests.
- ◆ He hit his first collegiate home run on Tuesday in the win at UC Irvine, a solo shot in the sixth inning that gave the Aztecs a 2-1 lead.
- ◆ He has also been perfect in the field on 43 chances.
- ◆ Verdon is the lone newcomer to have started for SDSU over the first four contests of the new season.

PYATT DEBUTS

- ◆ Redshirt freshman Harrison Pyatt made his Aztec debut with the start at UC Irvine on Tuesday.
- ◆ He pitched five innings allowing one run on just three hits while striking out four.
- ◆ He did not surrender a walk in the contest.

HELDMAN SAVES

- ◆ Senior Brian Heldman recorded his (and SDSU's) first save of the 2016 season in the win at UC Irvine on Tuesday.
- ◆ He tossed the final two innings allowing one hit and hitting a batter to preserve the Aztecs' two-run lead.
- ◆ The save was the second of Heldman's two-year Aztec career.
- ◆ Last season he served primary as a late-inning set-up reliever.

GOOD START

- ◆ Two Aztec newcomers recorded hits in their first collegiate at bat during last weekend's series vs. No. 14 Oregon.
- ◆ Jordan Verdon singled to right center field in his first plate appearance in Friday night's contest.
- ◆ Fellow freshman Dean Nevarez delivered a single to center in his first plate appearance as a pinch hitter in Saturday's game.

GOING DEEP

- ◆ Senior left fielder Spencer Thornton hit SDSU's first home run of the season, a two-run shot in the series finale vs. Oregon on Sunday.
- ◆ Thornton led the Aztecs in RBI during the weekend with three.
- ◆ He also had one of the Aztecs' two stolen bases during the weekend.
- ◆ On Tuesday his leadoff double in the eighth inning started SDSU's two-run rally that broke a 2-2 tie and sent the Aztecs to a 4-2 victory.

ADKISON RETURNS

- ◆ Tyler Adkison returned to right field in the season opener after redshirting last year.
- ◆ The redshirt season was forced when he suffered a broken jaw after being hit in the face by a pitch during preseason batting practice.
- ◆ During last weekend's season-opening series he went 2-for-11 with a double, walk and stolen base.
- ◆ On Tuesday at Irvine he had an RBI single that drive in SDSU's fourth run in the 4-2 win over the Anteaters.
- ◆ He also stole a base in that game and is now 2-for-2 this season.

DOUBLING UP

- ◆ Sophomore designated hitter David Hensley recorded a double in each of the first two games of the season last weekend and added a third in the win at Irvine on Tuesday.
- ◆ Last season he finished with four doubles in 24 contests.
- ◆ He is tied for second on the team in slugging percentage at .533.

ON THE BASE PATHS

- ◆ Catcher CJ Saylor threw out one of the two runners attempting to steal on him last weekend. Both of those attempts by No. 14 Oregon came in the first game of the series.
- ◆ UC Irvine did not attempt a stolen base against the Aztecs on Tuesday.
- ◆ The Aztecs have been successful on three of their five attempts.

NEW COACHES

- ◆ The Aztecs have added a pair of new coaches to their staff for the 2016 season: Pitching Coach Sam Peraza and Volunteer Assistant Joey Centanni.
- ◆ Peraza arrives at SDSU after two seasons at Florida International. He also had previous experience at Cal State Northridge, Cal State Los Angeles and Eastern Oklahoma State.
- ◆ He is a 2002 graduate of San Diego State, where he pitched during the 2002 season.
- ◆ Centanni played four seasons as a pitcher and first baseman at Pacific, graduating in 2009. After college, he spent one season in the Baltimore Orioles organization before an injury ended his playing career.
- ◆ He later served as an associate scout for the Orioles in the San Diego area and coach locally at Francis Parker High School.

VETERAN HONOREES

- ◆ Five players who earned individual honors a year ago return for the 2016 season.
- ◆ Second baseman Alan Trejo was named to the all-tournament team at the 2015 NCAA Regional at Lake Elsinore, Calif.
- ◆ Pitcher Jacob Erickson, outfielder Spencer Thornton and designated hitter Justin Wylie earned all-tourney recognition at the 2015 Mountain West Conference Tournament.
- ◆ Outfielder Chase Calabuig was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American and a second-team all-Mountain West selection.

RETURNING POSITION STARTERS

- ◆ Among the returning starters are two members of the Aztec infield and two outfielders.
- ◆ The infielders include second baseman Alan Trejo (.266, 20 RBI) and first baseman Andrew Brown (.295, 17 doubles, 32 RBI).
- ◆ Brown is likely to begin the 2016 season as the Aztecs' third baseman.
- ◆ Also back are a pair of outfielders: Spencer Thornton (.317, 7 2B, 23 RBI) and Chase Calabuig (.305, 8 2B, 25 RBI).

RETURNING ON THE MOUND

- ◆ The Aztecs return eight full-time pitchers from last season's staff along with three others who could see time on the mound as well as at positions in the field.
- ◆ In addition to projected starters Marcus Reyes, Cody Thompson and Brett Seeburger, other top returnees includes relievers Jacob Erickson (2-1, 2.64; all-tourney at the Mountain West Tournament) and Brian Heldman (3-1, 3.52, 1 save).
- ◆ Second baseman Alan Trejo, outfielder Chase Calabuig and catcher CJ Saylor could also see spot duty on the mound if needed.

SAYLOR RETURNS BEHIND THE PLATE

- ◆ Junior CJ Saylor will resume duties at the catching position this season after serving at the Aztecs' closer a year ago.
- ◆ In 2015 he compiled a record of 3-3 with 11 saves and a 5.02 earned run average.
- ◆ He began his SDSU as a catcher where he hit .212 in 14 games as a redshirt freshman in 2014.
- ◆ Saylor could see occasional action on the mound this season as well.

PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

- ◆ Outfielder Chase Calabuig has been tabbed to the Preseason All-Mountain West team in a vote of the league's coaches.
- ◆ Calabuig batted .305 with eight doubles and 25 RBIs as season en route to second-team all-conference honors at the end of the 2015 campaign.
- ◆ He was also named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American by *Collegiate Baseball* magazine.

COLLEGE SPORTS MADNESS ALL-MW

- ◆ *College Sports Madness* also named Calabuig to its All-Mountain West first team while four other Aztecs earned second-team honors.
- ◆ That quartet included outfielder Spencer Thornton and third baseman Andrew Brown along with pitchers Marcus Reyes and Cody Thompson.

DRAFTED AZTECS

- ◆ Three current members of the SDSU squad have been drafted by Major League clubs.
- ◆ That trio includes junior catcher CJ Saylor (33rd rd. in 2012, Los Angeles Dodgers) along with sophomore outfielder Denz'l Chapman (32nd rd. in 2014, Oakland A's) and freshman first baseman Jordan Verdon (24th rd. in 2015, New York Mets).

AZTECS PICKED AS CO-FAVORITES

- ◆ San Diego State has been picked as co-favorite along with New Mexico to win the Mountain West title in the conference's preseason baseball poll.
- ◆ In a vote of the seven MWC head coaches, the Aztecs received three first-place votes and tallied 32 points as did the Lobos. Fresno State picked up the remaining first-place vote and tied for third in the poll with Air Force.
