# Final Score: Grand Canyon 79, San Diego State 73

## **Big Notes**

- **Micah Parrish** surpassed the 1,000-career point plateau with a 3-pointer with 3:45 to play in the first half and finished the game with a total of 10 points and sits at 1,006 points for his career.
- Jaedon LeDee recorded a double-double (24 points and 10 rebounds) for the sixth time this season and eighth time in his career...all have come while at SDSU.
- San Diego State sits at 102-61 (.628) in true road games, since the start of the 2009-10, season which is the sixth best record in the nation in that timeframe.

## <u>Team Notes</u>

- SDSU stands at 9-6 against the current members of the Western Athletic Conference.
- San Diego State loses for the first time in four games in which it has shot between 40.0 and 50.0 percent in a game and is now 169-43 in the category since March 3, 2010.
- SDSU loses for the 67<sup>th</sup> time in the last 160 games (93-67) in which its opponent attempts more free throws than the Aztecs.
- Under Brian Dutcher, SDSU is 107-22 in games in which it commits fewer turnovers than its opponent.
- SDSU had its 11-game win streak snapped and fell for just the 24<sup>th</sup> time in 127 games under Brian Dutcher when the Aztec bench outscores its opponent's bench.
- The Aztecs trailed 35-28 at the half and are now 22-30 in the Dutcher era when trailing at intermission.
- The Aztecs are now 35-15 in their last 50 games when wearing their black jerseys.

- San Diego State stands at 27-10 under Brian Dutcher in the month of December and as a program is now 69-18 in its last 87 games in the month of December.
- SDSU falls for just the 36th time in the last 86 games under Brian Dutcher when its opponent attempts more free throws than the Aztecs.
- San Diego State's six turnovers are its second fewest of the season. SDSU's season low is five turnovers vs. California.
- The Aztecs are now 43-12 in their last 55 games played on Tuesday.
- San Diego State falls to 51-26 under Brian Dutcher when its opponent scores first.
- SDSU outscored Grand Canyon 11-5 in the points off turnovers.
- San Diego State's bench outscored Grand Canyon's bench 17-3.
- San Diego State outscored Grand Canyon 6-2 in fast break points

# <u>Series Notes</u>

- San Diego State sits at 1-4 against Grand Canyon in the all-time series, including 1-1 in its last two meetings.
- With both team competing as full-fledged Division I programs, SDSU and Grand Canyon have split its two meetings.

# <u>Game Flow</u>

- Grand Canyon won the tip.
- Grand Canyon scored the first points of the game on a 3-pointer at 19:18.
- Jaedon LeDee scored the Aztecs first points on a three-point play (a layup and free throw) at 18:38.
- San Diego State used a 9-3 run (including a 7-0 spurt) over 4:06 midway through the first half to turn an 8-11 deficit into a 17-14 lead with 7:57 to play in the period.
- With a 3-pointer at the 3:45 mark of the first half, Micah Parrish surpassed the 1,000-point plateau for his collegiate career.
- San Diego State opened the second half with a 13-4 run to turn a 7-point halftime deficit into a 41-39 lead w/ 15:47 to play.
- San Diego State was outshot 60.0 percent to 48.4 percent in the second half, but the Aztecs outscored the Antelopes 45-44 in the second 20 minutes.
- At the final buzzer, the game had been tied seven times and there were 10 lead changes.

# **Player Notes**

## Micah Parrish – 10 points, 3-10 FG, 3-7 3PFG, 4 steals, 3 rebounds, 1 assist

Surpassed the 1,000-point plateau (1,006 points) for his career becoming the fourth Aztec to surpass 1,000 points since the start of the 2019-20 season... Has scored in double figures in six games this season (5-1) and reached double digits for the 48<sup>th</sup> time in his career (29-19)... Four steals match a career-high, which he has achieved nine times.

## Jaedon LeDee – 24 points, 9-16 FG, 2-3 3FG, 4-6 FT, 10 rebounds, 1 steal

Had his sixth double double of the season, the most in a season since Jalen McDaniels had 11 in 2018-19... Has eight total double doubles, all since he began competing for San Diego State... Scored in double figures for the ninth time this year, 20<sup>th</sup> time as an Aztec, and 28<sup>th</sup> of his career... Knocked down multiple 3-pointers for the first time in his college career... Finished with double-digit rebounds for sixth game this year and 10th time in his career.

# Reese Waters – 11 points, 6-6 FT, 2-9 FG, 3-4 3FG, 4 rebounds, 1 assist, 1 steal

Scored in double figures for the eighth time this season (6-2) and 24th time in his career... In going 6-of-6 from the line he moves to 36-of-36 for the season, which leads the nation in consecutive free throws to open the season... Grabbed at least four rebounds for the sixth time this year.

## Darrion Trammell – 11 points, 3-7 FG, 4-4 FT, 1 assist, 1 rebound, 1 steal

Scored in double figures for the first time this season, 19<sup>th</sup> time as an Aztec and 68 time in his career... Made at least four free throws in a game without a miss for the 14<sup>th</sup> time in his collegiate career (11-3)... Competed in his 100<sup>th</sup> career game.
