## Aztec Basketball Plays Host to Eighth Annual San Diego Surf 'N Slam, Dec. 28-30

► **When & Where:** Friday, Dec. 28, 2012, Viejas Arena (12,414), San Diego, Calif., 5 p.m. PT

► **Live Media:** A live audio webcast featuring Chris Ello, as well as live stats will be available on goaztecs.com.

► **SDSU Head Coach Beth Burns:** Burns (Ohio Wesleyan, 1979) is in the eighth year of her second stint as head coach at San Diego State. She led the Aztecs for eight seasons from 1989 to 1997, before returning in 2005. She has an overall head coaching record of 356-247 in 21 seasons, and she is 275-182 in her 16 campaigns at SDSU.

► **SMU Head Coach Rhonda Rompola:** Rompola (SMU, 1983) is in her 22nd season coaching at her alma mater and has compiled a career record of 338-255. During her tenure, Rompola has guided the Mustangs to seven NCAA tournament berths and four WNIT appearances. In addition, she has earned coach of the year honors on six occasions.

► **Series History:** SMU has captured all four previous meetings between the two schools.

► **Up Next:** SDSU will face either Harvard or No. 14 Oklahoma State on Sunday, Dec. 30. The consolation game gets underway at noon, while the championship final is set to tip off at 2 p.m.

### NEWS & NOTABLES

■ After a nine-day hiatus, San Diego State opens the eighth annual San Diego Surf 'N Slam Classic on Friday when it battles SMU starting at 5 p.m.

■ After fielding just three schools last year, the tournament returns to its four-team format this season, with No. 14 Oklahoma State squaring off against Harvard in the other semifinal matchup on Friday, beginning at 7 p.m.

■ The Aztecs are coming off a 90-41 conquest of Fresno Pacific at home in their last outing on Dec. 19 to move to 7-3 on the season.

■ SDSU has advanced to the championship game of the San Diego Surf 'N Slam Classic each of the last four years, winning three times in 2008, 2009 and 2011, while Texas A&M took home the title in 2010.

**SDSU IN REGULAR-SEASON HOME TOURNEYS**

■ This year marks the eighth straight season that SDSU has played host to a tournament. Prior to 2005, the last time the Aztecs conducted a home tourney was in November 2000, when SDSU went 1-1 at the Pacific Bell Classic.

■ The Aztecs did not play host to a regular-season tournament in Beth Burns' first stint as head coach from 1989-97.

■ SDSU women's hoops has played host to 22 home tournaments in its previous 36 years of existence.

■ The Aztecs are 20-2 in the first game of a home tournament and has won the team title 12 times, including each of the first four.

■ SDSU has split games in seven of its last 10 home tournaments. The team won the first game and lost the second in 1998, 1999, 2000, 2006 and 2010, and did the opposite in 2005 and 2007.

■ The Aztecs are 7-1 in the last four Surf 'N Slams, winning the title over No. 4 Texas in 2008, vs. Auburn in 2009, and against Penn in 2011.

**FAST FACTS: SURF 'N SLAM CLASSIC**

■ This season's Surf 'N Slam Classic returns to a four-team format with two games each day separated by an off day. Last year's tournament was comprised of three teams (SDSU, Penn, UNC Greensboro) with a single game on three consecutive days.

■ Five different schools from five different conferences have won a tourney championship game in the Surf 'N Slam's seven seasons. SDSU is the only back-to-back winner in 2008 and 2009.

■ Harvard, Oklahoma State and SMU are all making their first Surf 'N Slam appearances. The Crimson are the third Ivy League squad to play in the tourney, joining Brown (2006), and Penn (2011), while the Cowgirls are the third Big 12 school to compete in the event, following Texas (2008) and Texas A&M (2010), which bolted for the Southeastern Conference in time for the 2012-13 campaign. Similarly, SMU is the second Conference USA school in the field, joining UTEP, which made the trek west in 2008 as well. The Mustangs are also the fifth representative from the Lone Star State in the tournament's eight-year history.

■ SDSU and SMU have tangled with one another in four previous encounters. However, the Aztecs have faced neither Harvard nor Oklahoma State in the program's 37-year existence.

■ SDSU has an all-time Surf 'N Slam record of 10-4. The Aztecs have earned at least a split every season and advanced to the championship game five times (3-2), winning the title on three occasions.

■ A total of five teams have been ranked in the AP top 25 when playing in the Surf 'N Slam, including No. 14 Oklahoma State this season, along with No. 7 Texas A&M (2010), No. 4 Texas (2008), No. 11 Georgia (2006) and No. 17 George Washington (2006).

**THE LAST TIME OUT**

Five players scored in double figures for the Aztecs to highlight a convincing 90-41 triumph over Fresno Pacific in their final tune-up before the Christmas break on Dec. 19. Sophomore Erimma Amariwka tied her career high with 16 points to help SDSU (7-3) secure its third straight victory and keep the Division II Sunbirds (0-10) winless on the year.

Amariwka shot 7-for-10 on the evening and added seven rebounds, while seniors Courtney Clements (17 pts.), Malia Nahinu (13 pts.) and sophomore Kristina Hunter (12 pts., 5-6 FG) also joined in on the offensive bonanza for the Aztecs, who posted their highest scoring game since putting up 91 points against Navy at home on Dec. 18, 2007. Not to be outdone, senior Chelsea Hopkins notched her second straight double-double after finishing with 10 points and a collegiate-best 13 assists.

As a team, SDSU recorded season bests of 36 field goals made and 54 rebounds, with Nahinu tying for game-high honors with eight caroms. The Aztecs also came up big defensively, limiting FPU to 24 percent shooting (15-63), including an 18 percent clip (6-34) in the second half.

SDSU had its transition game working early in the first half as four consecutive layups, including one by Clements at the 14:41 mark, provided the host school an 18-4 cushion. The Sunbirds cut the deficit to single digits on two occasions over the next 4:41, including a 24-16 spread following a Keairra White jumper with 10 minutes left before intermission. On the ensuing possession, however, freshman Aleiah Brandon tallied her first basket in a scarlet and black uniform to spark a 22-11 run, giving the Aztecs a 46-27 advantage heading into the locker room.

SDSU kept firing on all cylinders, opening with a 17-0 run over the first 5:42 of the second half as the game quickly turned into a runaway. In all, 11 out of 12 Aztecs who saw playing time against contributed to the final point total.

**LENDING A HELPING HAND**

Over the last two games, senior Chelsea Hopkins has racked up 22 assists, including a career-high 13 in the aforementioned victory over Fresno Pacific. The 5-8 point guard also dished nine helpers at Cal Poly, falling one shy of a rare triple-double after finishing with 17 points and 10 rebounds.

With her performances, Hopkins has taken over the Mountain West lead in assists with 6.3 per outing, despite having seven fewer helpers (70-63) than the second-place player in UNLV's Rmanii Haynes, who has played in two more games.

Hopkins also topped the league in that category during the 2011-12 campaign, marking the fourth straight year an Aztec has led the MW in assists or assist average and five out of the last six years.

**HEAD COACH BETH BURNS**



The winningest coach in SDSU women's basketball history, Beth Burns is in her 21st season as a collegiate head coach and her 16th overall at the helm of the Aztecs.

Since returning for her second stint on Montezuma Mesa in 2005,

Burns has taken the program to new heights, including a trip to the NCAA Sweet Sixteen, three NCAA tournament appearances (2009, 2010, 2012) and two conference regular-season (2009, 2012) and tournament titles (2010, 2012).

Last season, she directed the Aztecs to both the outright Mountain West regular-season (12-2) and tournament titles. The team made its third trip to the NAAs in the past four years and its 25 total victories not only tied for second in program history, but also are SDSU's most in 18 years. As a result, Burns captured her second MW Coach-of-the-Year honor.

Burns picked up her 350th career victory on Nov. 14 against UC Irvine. She enters Saturday's game with a 356-247 (.590) overall record, including a 275-182 (.602) mark in her 16 years (1989-97, 2005-present) on The Mesa.

**AZTECS AMONG MW LEADERS**

Seniors Courtney Clements, Chelsea Hopkins and Malia Nahinu finds themselves among the Mountain West leaders entering this weekend. Clements tops the league in scoring (19.4 ppg), field goals (.77) and 3-pointers (2.4/gm), while Hopkins occupies the top spot in assists (6.3/gm), ranks second in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.1) and is fourth in rebounding (7.0/gm). Not to be outdone, Nahinu took over the No. 1 slot in blocks (2.2/gm) and ranks second in field-goal percentage (.532).

**TAKING CARE OF THE BALL**

The Aztecs are just one of two teams in the Mountain West to boast a positive turnover margin entering this week. SDSU is +2.6 in that statistic, good for second in the league behind Fresno State's +5.6 spread.

In their last outing against Fresno Pacific, the Aztecs posted a season-low seven turnovers in an 90-41 win. During the 2011-12 campaign, SDSU didn't produce a single-digit turnover total until the 30th game when the Scarlet and Black finished with six miscues in their 73-55 semifinal victory over Wyoming at the MW tournament.

**GETTING DEFENSIVE**

In keeping with a familiar trend, the Aztecs have limited the opposition to an average of 52.9 points per game and a .332 field-goal percentage, both tops in the MW entering the week.

Last year, SDSU gave up 54.4 points a game to lead the conference, while its .362 field-goal percentage defense ranked second.

**WELCOME TO THE CLUB**

Earlier this season, Courtney Clements became the 17th player to surpass 1,000 points in an Aztec uniform. Through 10 games this year, Clements has amassed 1,085 points during her career on The Mesa and has reached the 20-point plateau on 20 occasions, including five of her last eight outings. In 2011-12, she finished with 556 points, good for 11th place on the Aztecs' single-season charts.

**BLOCK PARTY**

As previously mentioned, Malia Nahinu tops the MW this week with an average of 2.2 blocks per game. Against Fresno Pacific on, the SDSU senior posted with three rejections in the Aztecs' 73-56 win. With her performance, Nahinu has 94 blocks in her career on The Mesa, moving into ninth place on the school's all-time list.

**AZTECS COLLECT MW WEEKLY HONORS**

Just 10 games into the young season, San Diego State has already picked up three Mountain West Player of the Week awards after claiming six a year ago. Senior Courtney Clements was selected in consecutive weeks, Nov. 26 and Dec. 3, while Chelsea Hopkins received the distinction on Dec. 17.

Against USC, Clements scored a game-high 25

points, including a trio of 3-pointers. She also came away with six rebounds, two assists, one block and a steal, as the Aztecs rolled to an 80-46 victory.

The previous week, Clements earned all-tournament honors at the Omni Hotels Classic in Boulder, Colo., after averaging 22.5 points and 3.0 rebound-sin two games. Against Auburn, she drained a career-high six triples, finishing with a game-best 26 points to help SDSU cruise to an 78-57 win. Despite a loss to host Colorado the next night, Clements came away with game-high honors once again with 19 points on 9-of-17 shooting.

Hopkins, meanwhile, came within a whisker of a rare triple-double in the Aztecs' 73-56 road victory at Cal Poly after finishing with a season-high 17 points to go along with 10 rebounds and nine assists. She also tied her career best with eight field goals on 14 attempts and came away with two steals in 39 minutes.

With those performances, Clements now boasts five career weekly honors, while Hopkins has three to her credit.

**HOME SWEET HOME**

The Aztecs have emerged victorious in their first three home games this season and are a combined 47-13 (.783) on the Viejas Arena court since the 2008-09 campaign.

**WOMEN'S HOOPS SIGNS QUARTET TO NLI's**

Head coach Beth Burns announced the addition last month of four talented recruits who will join the Aztecs for the 2013-14 season. Those signing National Letters of Intent include Ariell Bostick (Oakland, Calif.), Chloe Johnson (Phoenix, Ariz.), Alyssa Lawrence (New Rochelle, N.Y.) and Briteesha Solomon (San Diego, Calif.).

**AZTEC EXCELLENCE**

San Diego State finds itself in elite company regarding the recent success of its football and men's and women's basketball programs. Since the fall of 2011, the three Aztec teams have posted a combined record of 86-29 (.748), which ranks sixth in the nation as of Dec. 25. Below are the top 10 schools with their combined records for FB, MBB and WBB during that span.

**DECEMBERS TO REMEMBER**

The Aztecs are a combined 30-9 during December since 2006. Four of those losses came to teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national poll in No. 2 UConn, No. 7 Texas A&M, No. 17 George Washington and USC (rv). The other five defeats were at Washington on Dec. 5, at Washington State and against USD in 2011, vs. Pepperdine in overtime in 2009 and against Quinnipiac in the opening contest of the 2007 Surf 'N Slam.

Of course, it should be noted that SDSU has played 29 of those 39 December contests at home.

**WITH A WIN...**

An Aztec victory over SMU will mean:

- SDSU advances to the Surf 'N Slam finals for the fifth straight year.
- SDSU defeats the Mustangs for the first time in five meetings.
- SDSU extends its winning streak to four games.
- SDSU improves to 5-0 at home this season.
- SDSU's 8-3 record matches its best start to a season since the 2008-09 squad also went 8-3.
- SDSU raises its record to 31-9 in December games since 2006.

**SMU TIDBITS**

The Mustangs (8-3), who are making their first venture of the season outside the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex this weekend, had their three-game winning streak snapped in a 61-59 loss to Wichita State on Dec. 22.

Junior Keena Mays made a big splash in her debut for SMU, earning Conference USA Player of the Week honors after averaging 24 points in three games, including a 33-point effort against Stephen F. Austin on Dec. 19. Senior Alisha Filmore has also picked up the scoring slack for the Mustangs, averaging 12 points per game while leading the team with 26 steals. In addition, junior Akil Simpson tops the squad with 7.5 rebounds per outing, while fellow classmate Korina Baker has posted team-highs of 44 assists and 13 three-pointers.

Collectively, SMU has shot nearly 39 percent from the field this season, 34 percent from beyond the arc and

65 percent at the free-throw line. In addition, the Mustangs have outscored the opposition by an average of 11.1 points this season and have committed an average of 6.5 fewer turnovers per contest. SMU has won eight of nine games this season when scoring over 60 points, with a 76-70 defeat at TCU on Nov. 28 the lone exception.

The Aztecs and Mustangs faced one another as members of the Western Athletic Conference during the 1997-98 campaign. SMU was victorious in Dallas by a 71-62 count before handing SDSU a 66-54 setback in San Diego.

Mustang head coach Rhonda Rompola is just 12 wins off of reaching the 400-victory plateau in her career.
