Game / General Notes

- San Diego State won its 29th consecutive exhibition game.
- Point guards junior Lamont Butler and senior Darrion Trammell, combined for 10 assists and just four turnovers while forcing seven SDCC turnovers.
- Senior transfer forward Jaedon LeDee had a team-high 13 points to go along with nine rebounds. He scored
 eight consecutive points for the Aztecs as part of an 8-0 San Diego State run in the first half.
- San Diego State shots a staggering 65.7 percent in the second half (23-of-35) and finished the game hitting a total of 38-of-69 (55.1 percent).
- After making 6-of-20 from three-point range in the first half (30.0 percent), the Aztecs improved to 6-of-14 in the second half (42.9 percent).
- San Diego State forced 26 turnovers and was +12 in the turnover category this evening.
- All 12 available scholarship players saw time in the first half. The Aztecs played 17 different players in the game.
- San Diego State had 24 assists on 38 made baskets.
- San Diego State's five starters combined to play only 67:25 of the contest. The bench accounted for 132:35.

Game Flow

- Matt Bradley scored the first basket of the game on a layup.
- Trailing 4-2 at the first media timeout, the Aztecs went on a 15-2 run to open a 17-6 advantage. The run
 covered 4:30 of game time.
- San Diego State had five runs of out scoring San Diego Christian at least 8-0, including runs of 14-0 and 11-0, both in the first half.
- The Aztecs opened the second half on an 11-0 run on buckets from Mat Bradley, Darrion Tramell, Lamont Butler and Keshad Johnson (2).
- Jaedon LeDee scored eight consecutive points for the Aztecs as part of a 8-0 run in the first half.

Player Notes

Jaedon LeDee – 13 points, 9 rebounds, 4-of-6 FGs

The senior transfer tied for the team's leading scorer... He was 4-of-6 from the floor, including 2-of-3 from the bonus distance... Made 3-of-4 from the line... His nine rebounds were a game high... He played 16:44.

Keshad Johnson — 13 points, 3 rebounds, 4 assists, 1 steal, 6-7 FGs,

The senior was extremely efficient going 6-of-7 from the floor, including a monster dunk... He made 1-of-2 3-point attempts... His big night came while playing 17:15 of the game.

Matt Bradley – 13 points, 4-of-9 FGs, 5-of-6 FTs, 1 rebound, 1 steal

The senior was part of a triumvirate of Aztecs to score 13 points... Led the team in both free throws and attempts.

Elijah Saunders - 11 points, 5 rebounds, 2 assists, 5-of-6 FGs

In his first action, the freshman was an impressive 5-of-6 from the field... Knocked down 1-of-2 3-pointers... His five rebounds were tie for second on the team... Played 14:27
