### @AztecWBB Readies For Thursday Clash vs. UC Davis

Two teams looking to break into the win column for the first time this season will square off Thursday night when San Diego State takes on UC Davis at Steve Fisher Court at Viejas Arena. Opening tip is scheduled for 6:30 p.m. PT, with Aztec alumnus Chris Ello calling the action courtside for a Mountain West Network video stream available on GoAztecs.com.

The Aztecs (0-2) are coming off an 85-68 defeat to UC Riverside in their home opener on Monday. SDSU received double-digit scoring totals from three players, including a career-high 25 points by sophomore guard McKynzie Fort (Fontana, Calif.), who also set a personal best with an 11-for-12 performance at the free-throw line. However, the Aztecs were unable to keep pace with the high-octane Highlanders, who shot 50 percent from the floor (31-62) and outscored SDSU 40-24 in the paint.

Much like its season-opening 74-54 defeat at Long Beach State last week, the Aztecs stumbled out of the gates against UCR, connecting on just 17 percent (5-29) of their field-goal attempts in the first half while committing 13 turnovers. The Highlanders scored 23 points off those miscues to help build a commanding 46-27 lead by intermission and never looked back.

Similarly, the Aggies (0-2) have come up short in their first two games of the 2015-16 campaign, falling at home to both Stanford (74-45) and Pacific (66-53). UC Davis has experienced its own shooting woes early in the season, draining just 27.5 percent (28-102) of its attempts from the field, including an 18 percent clip (7-39) from three-point range.

SDSU will engage its third straight Big West Conference opponent when UC Davis invades "America's Finest City" this week. Thursday's showdown will mark just the fourth all-time meeting between the two schools, with the Aztecs holding a 2-1 lead in the series. SDSU has not played UC Davis since Nov. 17, 2006, when the Scarlet and Black claimed a 59-52 decision at home. The two sides also faced one another twice during the 2005 non-conference slate, with each team winning on its home floor.

The Aztecs will also be looking to snap a four-game losing streak to Big West opponents dating back to last season. Prior to that stretch, SDSU had won 14 of 16 meetings against the conference. The Aztecs, who are 98-88 against current Big West schools, will have two additional games against the league's Southern California contingent next month when it travels to Cal State Northridge on Dec. 7, followed by a home clash with Cal State Fullerton on Dec. 19.

Following Thursday's encounter, San Diego State will make its lone excursion outside of California prior to the holidays when it travels to the Pacific Northwest on Monday, Nov. 23 for a battle with Washington at Alaska Airlines Arena in Seattle. Game time is set for 7 p.m. PT.

## Scouting the Aggies

UC Davis returns two starters and nine letterwinners from last year's squad that finished with a 15-16 overall record and an 8-8 mark in conference play. The Aggies reached the semifinals of the Big West Conference tournament as the fifth seed last season before falling to eventual runner-up Cal State Northridge by a 61-47 count.

UCD (0-2) opened the 2015-16 campaign with a pair of defeats, at home, falling to Stanford in the opener on Nov. 13, 74-45, despite receiving a game-high 18 points from sophomore guard Rachel Nagel and a double-double by fellow classmate Pele Gianotti, who finished with 10 points and 11 rebounds. The Aggies were unable to regroup from their loss to the Cardinal, dropping a 66-53 decision to Pacific on Monday as Gianotti and sophomore wing Dani Nafekh tallied 11 points apiece.

UC Davis was picked to finish sixth in the Big West Conference race this year, while senior forward Alyson Doherty earned a spot on the preseason all-conference team. Doherty, a two-time all-Big West second-team honoree, is the Aggies' top returning scorer after averaging 13.4 points during the 2014-15 campaign, which ranked seventh in the conference, while her 50.5 field-goal percentage stood second. In addition, fellow senior Celia Marfone is back in the mix after starting all 31 games for UCD last year when she averaged 5.9 points and a team-best 6.7 rebounds, which ranked sixth in the Big West.

Former San Diego prep standout and UC Davis star Jennifer Gross is in her fifth season as head coach at her alma mater, where she has compiled a 59-65 overall record. Prior to her return to the Aggie program as an assistant coach in 2004, Gross served the same capacity for two seasons at San Diego State under Jim Tomey from 2002-04, following a successful four-year stint at University City High, where she helped lead the Centurions to four consecutive Western League titles, four straight CIF finals and two CIF titles. Gross was elevated to head coach at UCHS in 2000, posting an impressive 50-9 record in her two seasons at the helm.

The Aztecs are the first of two consecutive Mountain West opponents UC Davis will face during its non-conference slate this year. Following Thursday's clash, the Aggies will return to northern California to battle Air Force on Nov. 23.

### Notes With a 'W'

An SDSU victory over UC Davis on Thursday will mean:

- The Aztecs win their first game of the year and avoid their third 0-3 start in the last six years.
- SDSU snaps its four-game losing streak vs. Big West Conference foes and moves to 99-88 against that league's current alignment.
- The Aztecs win their third straight vs. the Aggies and improve to 3-1 in the all-time series.
- SDSU improves to 1-1 on the year in games following a loss.
- The Aztecs raise their home record to 75-28 since the 2008-09 campaign.

### UC Riverside Recap

San Diego State received double-digit scoring totals from three players, but it wasn't enough as visiting UC Riverside spoiled the Aztecs' 2015-16 home opener Monday night with an 85-68 triumph at Steve Fisher Court at Viejas Arena.

Sophomore McKynzie Fort led the SDSU charge with a career-high 25 points, highlighted by a personal-best 11-for-12 effort at the free-throw line, while fellow classmate Cheyenne Greenhouse finished with 14 points of her own, followed by senior Ahjalee Harvey, who tossed in 11 points, including a 6-for-6 performance at the charity stripe.

In all, the Aztecs (0-2) sank 27 of 36 free throws (75 percent); however, the Scarlet and Black connected on just 18 of 57 field goal attempts (29.4 percent) and were outscored by a 40-24 margin in the paint.

On the flip side, UCR (2-0) shot 50 percent from the floor (31-62) and tallied 32 points off 21 SDSU turnovers while maintaining an 18-5 advantage in bench scoring.

Individually, the Highlanders were paced by Réjane Verin's 22 points, while Annelise Ito contributed 18 points on 8-of-11 shooting and tied teammate Jazzmeen Williams for game-high honors with eight rebounds. Reigning Big West Conference player of the year Britany Crain also got into the act with 16 points, including a pair of

three-pointers, while Simone DeCoud dished out a game-high six assists off the bench.

For the second straight game, SDSU found itself in a deep hole, as UCR jumped out to a 7-0 lead in the first two-and-a-half minutes before the host school ended their scoring drought on Harvey's first triple of the evening. The Aztecs tried to keep things close after two Fort free throws narrowed the gap to four points once again at 11-7 with 5:28 remaining in the first quarter. However, the Highlanders broke the contest open with a 12-2 spurt over the next 2:45, capped by a Crain jumper, to give the visitors a commanding 23-9 advantage by the 1:43 mark.

UCR stretched the margin to 22 on two occasions in the second stanza, including a 37-15 spread following a Verin layup with 4:46 left before intermission. SDSU tried to mount a comeback, pulling to within 43-27 on two additional foul shot by Fort, but the Highlanders quickly neutralized the short-lived momentum on a triple by Akilah Martin with just 43 seconds to go.

Despite sinking 15 of 16 free throws in the first half and maintaining a 9-5 edge on the offensive glass, the Aztecs still found themselves trailing at the break 46-27, thanks to a 5-for-29 shooting effort (17.2 percent) and a 23-6 deficit in points off turnovers.

UCR kept firing on all cylinders in the second half, forging its biggest lead of the night at 75-47 on a layup by Michelle Curry with 7:16 to go in the contest. SDSU staged an impressive 20-6 run over the next four-and-a-half minutes to cut the margin in half. Fort sparked the outburst with eight points on two treys and a layup, with the latter trimming the deficit to 81-67 by the 2:47 mark of the fourth quarter.

SDSU had a chance to draw closer; however, two free throws went awry, while Verin scored four quick points on a layup and a jumper to extinguish the Aztecs' faint comeback hopes.

### UCR-SDSU Postgame Notes

- The Aztecs' 27 free throws matched their highest single-game total since Feb. 4, 2009 in a home victory over UNLV.
- In addition to her collegiate-best 25 points, McKynzie Fort set career highs in three-pointers (2), field-goal attempts (17), free throws (11) and free throw attempts (12). Fort also extended her games started streak to 26 in a row.
- Ahjalee Harvey drained all six of her foul shots to match a personal best set in home finale last year against UNLV.
- Cheyenne Greenhouse (14 pts) surpassed the double-digit plateau for the fourth time in her career and first since Dec. 9, 2014, at San Diego.
- Aleiah Brandon equaled her career best with four rebounds.
- Deidra Smith played in her 63rd consecutive game at SDSU.

### @AztecWBB Picked Sixth in MW Preseason Poll

San Diego State has been predicted to finish sixth the Mountain West preseason poll released on Oct. 28 by the league office. The voting panel consisted of the MW's 11 head coaches and select women's basketball media from around the conference.

The Aztecs, who placed seventh in the MW standings during the 2014-15 campaign, earned 135 points from the panel, trailing fifth-place UNLV (132) by just three points while topping seventh-place Wyoming (125) by 10 points.

Two-time defending regular-season champion Colorado State was picked to repeat once again after receiving 21 of 28 first-place votes and 237 points, just ahead of New Mexico, which garnered seven first-place votes and 221 points, while 2015 MW tournament champion Boise State followed closely in the third spot with six first-place votes and 215 points.

With the league's forecast, SDSU has not been selected to finish among the top three places in the MW preseason rankings in back-to-back years for the first time since the 2006-07 and 2007-08 campaigns. The Aztecs completed conference play where they were projected last season, landing in the seventh spot with an 8-10 record.

### Back Again

San Diego State returns three starters from a year ago, featuring sophomore McKynzie Fort, along with seniors Ahjalee Harvey and Deidra Smith. A 5-9 guard, Fort earned Mountain West all-freshman honors last spring after finishing third among conference rookies with 10.9 points per game in league play while averaging 3.2 rebounds and 1.7 assists. In addition, Harvey made a successful recovery from a knee injury that sidelined her for the final 22 games of the 2013-14 campaign with 25 starts in 29 appearances last season. The 5-6 point guard was SDSU's top ball-handler and main three-point threat in 2014-15, dishing out 2.3 assists per contest to go with 21 triples. Meanwhile, Smith has played in all 62 games for the Aztecs the past two years following her transfer from Boston College. The tallest member on the squad as a 6-2 forward, Smith is the team's top returning rebounder after averaging 3.5 caroms last season.

Third-year head coach Stacie Terry and staff welcome back four additional letterwinners, including juniors Ariell Bostick and Aleiah Brandon and sophomores Cheyenne Greenhouse and Lexy Thorderson. Fellow classmate Allison Brown, who made seven spot appearances last season, also finds herself in the mix once again.

### Noting the Newcomers

Of the 12 student-athletes on the current roster, four players will be wearing a Scarlet and Black uniform for the first time during the 2015-16 campaign. Guard Kymberly Ellison (Columbus, Ga.) practiced with the squad last year, but did not com-

pete after transferring from Georgia Tech, while fellow backcourt mate Geena Gomez (Huntington Beach, Calif.) utilized her redshirt season as well following her transfer from St. Joseph's (Pa.).

With the departure of forwards Erimma Amarikwa, Kristina Hunter and Desi Culberson, who accounted for 43 percent of SDSU's rebounding total and 38 percent of the team's scoring offense from a year ago, a pair of newcomers look to gain significant experience on the frontline this season. Junior Kylie Herd (Phoenix, Ariz.) received second-team All-America recognition and was named the Arizona JC player of the year as a sophomore last year at Mesa Community College, following a solid freshman campaign when she helped the Thunderbirds to the NJCAA Division II national championship. Not to be outdone, freshman Arantxa Gómez (Valencia, Spain) brings strong credentials with her to The Mesa after sharpening her skills as a six-year member on the Spanish club circuit, including an MVP performance in U18 regional competition last April.

SDSU alumnus Chris Ello begins his ninth season of calling the action and is a familiar voice in the San Diego area. In addition to his responsibilities with the Aztec women's basketball squad, Ello is a member of the football broadcast team as a sideline reporter for the school's flagship station, The Mighty 1090 AM.

Ello started his career in sports talk radio in San Diego on XTRA Sports 690 in the summer of 1994. He has accumulated a wealth of experience doing play-by-play for a variety of sports at every level, including stints with the SDSU football (1985), baseball (1998-99) and men's basketball (2006-07) squads.

From 1996-2006, Ello was the voice of the San Diego Gulls hockey team and has called the action for the San Diego Sockers (indoor soccer), San Diego Spirit (outdoor soccer), San Diego Wildcards (CBA) and San Diego Rip-tide (arena football). He also has experience broadcasting high school CIF football and basketball games since 2000.

For the third straight year, all regular-season Aztec home contests in 2015-16 will feature a live video stream via the Mountain West Network to supplement the audio call from Viejas Arena.

### 2015-16 By the Numbers

With excitement brewing for head coach Stacie Terry's third season on Montezuma Mesa, below are a few trends to watch for in 2015-16:

- SDSU enters the year having claimed 43 of its last 59 home games and has gone 75-28 on the Viejas Arena floor since the start of the 2008-09 campaign.
- The Aztecs have recorded 81 Mountain West victories in the last eight seasons after posting 31 wins in the league's first nine years.
- SDSU has won 44 straight games and is 74-1 over the last three seasons when leading with five minutes to go in the game, including an 12-0 mark in 2014-15. The Aztecs' lone blemish during that stretch was a heart-breaking 59-58 defeat at Washington in December 2012.
- SDSU is 35-17 in December games dating back to the 2006-07 campaign, with seven of those losses coming against teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national polls.
- The Aztecs have advanced to finals of the MW Championship in five of the last eight years after not winning a single game in the tournament's first eight years of existence.

### NCAA Rule Changes at a Glance

#### Game Format

- Beginning with the 2015-16 campaign, NCAA women's basketball games will be played in four 10-minute quarters.
- Teams will now reach the bonus and shoot two free throws on the fifth team foul in each quarter. Previously, teams reached a one-and-one bonus on the seventh team foul of each half and reached the double bonus (two shots) on the 10th team foul.
- In the four-quarter format, team fouls reset to zero at the start of each quarter. However, if a team reaches the bonus in the fourth quarter, that team would remain in the bonus during any additional overtime periods.

## Advancing the Ball

- Teams will be allowed to advance the ball to the frontcourt following a timeout immediately after a made basket in the last 59.9 seconds of the fourth quarter and any overtime periods.

- Teams will also be allowed to advance the ball to the frontcourt following a rebound or a change of possession. In these scenarios, the ball would be inbounded at the 28-foot mark on the side of the court where the scorer's table is located.

## 10-Second Backcourt Exceptions

- For the upcoming season, a team will not receive a new 10-second backcourt count when a throw-in results from the following situations:

- The ball is deflected out of bounds by the defense.

- There is a held ball and the possession arrow favors the offensive team.

- A technical foul is called on the offensive team while the ball is in its backcourt.

## Post Defense

- Defenders will be allowed to place a forearm or an open hand with a bend in the elbow on an offensive post player with the ball whose back is to the basket.

## Bands and Amplified Music

- In an effort to improve the overall fan experience, bands or amplified music may be played during any dead-ball situation during a women's basketball game. Previously, rules allowed music to be played only during timeouts and intermission.

## SDSU Holds Grand-Opening Ceremony for Jeff Jacobs JAM Center

San Diego State held a grand-opening ceremony for the 23,500-square foot Jeff Jacobs JAM Center on Sunday, Aug. 23. The event marked the official opening of the Aztecs' on-campus basketball performance center, which broke ground almost a year to the date on Aug. 27, 2014.

Speaking before the ceremonial ribbon cutting was SDSU president Elliot Hirshman, men's basketball head coach Steve Fisher and women's hoops senior guard Ahjalee Harvey.

Preliminary site work started in July 2014, just south of the Fowler Athletics Center and east of the football practice fields. The facility, which will support the continued growth and development of the SDSU men's and women's basketball teams, includes two full-length courts, eight baskets, locker rooms, film room, team lounges, athletic training room and coaches locker rooms.

Hundreds of supporters contributed to the effort to make the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center a reality. In addition to the naming gift from Jeff Jacobs, Hal and Debby Jacobs, Steve and Lisa Altman and Jim Morris, creating the name "JAM" Center, sizeable donations were made from the Manna Charitable Foundation and the Walter and Betty Zable Foundation. The total cost of the project was \$15 million.

The project was designed by J CJ Architecture and was built by The Hunt Construction Group.

San Diego native Stacie Terry enters her third year at the helm of the Aztec women's basketball team after she was named the eighth head coach in program history on May 15, 2013.

Despite a 12-19 record and an 8-10 mark in the Mountain West, Terry's squad still showed dramatic improvement on defense last season, finishing second in the conference and 34th nationally in opponent three-point field goal percentage, compared to 2014 when SDSU ranked last in the league and near the bottom of Division I in that statistic.

In addition, the Aztecs were fourth in scoring defense during MW play a year ago, allowing nearly 10 points per game fewer than the previous campaign and topped the conference in rebounding defense for the second straight season.

Under Terry's watch, forward Erimma Amarikwa capped off her collegiate career with honorable mention all-MW accolades, while guard McKynzie Fort gave SDSU's its second consecutive all-conference freshman honoree.

Terry's charges also made tremendous strides in the classroom, with the squad posting the highest collective GPA in program history during the fall of 2014, while five Aztecs landed a spot on the MW all-academic team, the most since 2001-02.

During her first season on Montezuma Mesa, Terry was saddled with the unenviable task of replacing four senior starters who accounted for nearly 64 percent of the team's scoring offense from the previous year, as well as overcoming the loss of two key players to injuries prior to conference play, Amarikwa, who was a preseason all-MW selection, and starting point guard Ahjalee Harvey.

Despite those obstacles and a demanding schedule featuring nine games against teams that eventually advanced to postseason competition, Terry's squad flashed its resiliency during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and a 9-9 ledger in the MW.

With Terry at the controls, the Aztecs led the league in rebounding margin and rebounding defense while ranking second in field-goal percentage.

Individually, Terry also oversaw the progress of senior center Cierra Warren, who became the fifth SDSU player in a six-year span to receive first-team all-MW recognition.

Prior to her arrival on The Mesa, Terry gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach at the Division I level for 14 years, including five under head coach Nikki Caldwell, who transformed UCLA into a powerhouse before restoring LSU to national prominence.

During Terry's two seasons at LSU, the Lady Tigers compiled a 45-23 overall record and earned two NCAA tournament bids, including a Sweet 16 appearance during the 2012-13 campaign. During that season, the Lady Tigers also posted six victories against ranked opponents and finished with their second-highest scoring average (69.0) in the last seven years. Under Terry's guidance, forward LaShondra Barrett garnered first-team all-Southeastern Conference accolades and received honorable mention All-America distinction in 2012 before becoming a first-round draft choice of the WNBA's Washington Mystics.

Prior to her appointment at LSU, Terry served as an assistant under Caldwell at UCLA from 2008-11, helping the Bruins gain national acclaim with a pair of NCAA

tournament appearances. During Terry's tenure, UCLA posted 72 overall victories, as the 2010-11 squad finished with a 28-5 record, setting a school record for fewest losses in a single season to go with a No. 7 national ranking. In addition, the Bruins signed the fourth-ranked recruiting class that season, according to ESPN Hoop-Gurlz, while Terry helped mentor first-team all-Pac-10 performers in Doreena Campbell, Darxia Morris and Jasmine Dixon, a 2012 honorable mention AP All-America selection, as well as all-conference freshman honorees Atonye Nyingifa and Markel Walker.

Terry spent the 2007-08 campaign at Southern Mississippi, as the Golden Eagles posted a 21-14 record and earned a postseason berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). While at Southern Miss, Terry spearheaded the development and coordination of the Lady Eagle recruiting campaign. Her responsibilities also included working with the perimeter players, scouting opponents and film breakdown, as well as coordinating all of the team's community service events.

Terry also coached for three seasons from 2004-07 as an assistant under Hall of Fame head coach Theresa Greutz at Illinois, where the Fighting Illini had three straight recruiting classes ranked among the top 25 in the nation, according to Blue Star Basketball, and made three consecutive trips to the WNIT. Her primary duties included defensive instruction and working with the perimeter players.

In addition, Terry coached at Dayton during the 2003-04 season following a three-year stint at Louisville from 2000-03. With the Cardinals, Terry's responsibilities encompassed recruiting, scouting, player development, summer camps and serving as a liaison for the program's community service outreach. Louisville captured the Conference USA regular-season title and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament in 2001 before making a WNIT appearance in 2002. She also assisted in signing the nation's 21st-ranked recruiting class in 2002-03, according to All-Star Girls Report. Terry recruited and coached all-Conference USA honoree Lori Nero, a draft choice of the WNBA's Houston Comets, as well as Sara Nord, who finished her collegiate career as the Cardinals' all-time assist leader and ranks among the top 15 scorers in school history.

Terry enjoyed a successful collegiate playing career at the University of Texas at Arlington, winning four varsity letters from 1994-98 under head coach Mike Dean. She earned first-team all-Southland Conference honors after leading the Mavericks in scoring with 17.4 points per game as a senior in 1997-98. Terry scored 1,169 points during her career at UTA and still ranks among the school's top 10 in three-point field goals made (third), assists (sixth), steals (seventh) and free-throw percentage (10th). She is just one of 17 players in Maverick history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau, while her .335 career three-point field-goal percentage is also a school and Southland Conference career record.

Terry played one season of professional basketball in Warsaw, Poland, averaging 12.0 points and 6.0 assists with the Polonia Phoenix, before returning to UT Arlington to begin her coaching career as a graduate assistant in 1999.

Terry prepped at El Capitan High and held the Vaqueros' career scoring record for three years following her graduation. She was inducted into the school's athletic hall of fame in 2008.
