TEAM NOTES

- San Diego State fell to 7-6 against the Pac-12 since the start of the 2016 season.
- The Aztecs fell to 8-10 against teams that were in the Pac-12 at game time.
- SDSU fell to 20-6 in all games played in September since the start of the 2016 campaign.
- San Diego State fell to 74-32 (.698) since the start of the 2015 campaign.
- The Aztecs recorded their seventh and eighth interceptions of the season. SDSU has forced 10 turnovers through its four games this year.
- SDSU gave Oregon State its first two turnovers of the year.
- San Diego State has scored 23 points off its 10 turnovers forced this season (opponents have just seven points off SDSU's eight turnovers).
- The Aztecs held Oregon State to 26 points today after entering the game averaging 48.5 points per game.
- SDSU had its 17-game winning streak snapped when winning the turnover battle. San Diego State is now 20-3 under Brady Hoke when committing fewer turnovers than its opponent.
- SDSU had its six-game winning streak snapped when committing one of less turnovers. San Diego State is now 29-8 when committing one or less turnovers.
- The Aztecs had their eight-game winning streak when starting on at least the 30-yard line (today was the SDSU 32). SDSU is now 30-6 under Brady Hoke when starting on at least the 30-yard line.
- San Diego State had its 13-game winning streak snapped when its opponent starts inside the 25-yard line (was OSU 22 today). The Aztecs are 18-2 under Brady Hoke when their opponents start inside the 25-yard line.
- SDSU had its 16-game winning streak snapped when having an advantage in turnovers (+1) and average field position (+10). San Diego State is now 18-2 under Brady Hoke when having both advantages in turnovers and average field position.

SERIES NOTES

- San Diego State fell to 2-4 all-time against Oregon State.
- The Aztecs are now 1-3 on the road vs. OSU.

TRENDS

- The Aztecs lost the coin toss for the second time this season in four games.
- SDSU started with the ball for the 108th time in the last 149 games.
- San Diego State allowed an opponent to score on its opening possession for the second time this season, but just the ninth time since 2021 (31 games) and 30th time since 2015 (106 games).

PLAYER NOTES

- * **Jalen Mayden, Sr., QB (20-for-32, 256 yds., 0 TD, 1 INT | 14 att., 9 yds.)**
Fell to 7-5 as SDSU's starting quarterback ... Set season highs in completions (20) and passing yards (256).
- * **Jaylon Armstead, Jr., RB (11 att., 48 yds., 1 TD | 1 rec., 7 yds.)**
Scored his second rushing touchdown of the season and fourth of his career ... Now has five overall touchdowns for his career (also scored when recovering a blocked punt in 2022 opener vs. Arizona).
- * **Brionne Penny, Sr., WR (6 rec., 77 yds.)**
Posted career highs in both receptions (6) and receiving yards (77) ... Entered the game with two catches for nine yards this season.
- * **Mark Redman, Sr., TE (4 rec., 77 yds.)**
Had a career-high 77 receiving yards ... Already has 16 catches for 179 yards (11.2 avg.) and two touchdowns this year in four games (last year he had 21 receptions for 233 yards (11.1 avg.) and two touchdowns in 13 games).
- * **Zyrus Fiaseu, So., LB (7 tackles (3 solo), 1.0 TFL, 1 QBH)**
Led the team in tackles for the second straight game.

*** Cedarious Barfield, Sr., S (2 tackles (1 solo), 1 interception)**

Logged his third interception of the season in the fourth game for SDSU ... Now has four interceptions for his career ...

*** Jack Browning, Sr., K/P (1-for-3 FG, 52 LG | 6 P, 38.5 avg., 51 LG, 3 I20)**

Tied a career long with a 52-yard field goal ... Is now 3-for-4 for his career on 50-yard field goal attempts ... Made 1 of 3 of his field goal tries and is now 6-for-9 this season and 26-for-34 for his career ... His 26 field goals are the 10th most in program history.

OTHER NOTES

- **CB Dez Malone** started for the 15th straight game, the longest streak among offensive and defensive players.
- **CB Noah Tumblin** played in his 38th consecutive game, the longest streak on the team.
- **S Cedarious Barfield** played in his 42nd career game, the most among any current Aztec.
- Today's temperature was 77 degrees at kickoff.
- Today's attendance was 35,591.
