San Diego State Looks to Match Best Start in the Last Decade; Begins City Showdown Week on Saturday Night Against UC San Diego

Following a wild opening week of the season, San Diego State (1-1) begins defense of its city championship on Saturday night against UC San Diego (0-1) at Cox Arena. Game time is set for 7:05 p.m. PST and everyone in attendance will receive a 2004-05 San Diego State men's basketball poster and fans will have the opportunity to get player autographs following the game.

There is no live television for the game, snapping the Aztecs' school-record of 17 consecutive games carried on the tube; however, the game can be heard on XPRS-1090 AM (The Mighty 1090).

The Aztecs begin their quest for their third consecutive city championship following a dramatic come-from-behind victory over 2004 NCAA Tournament team Monmouth, 69-65. San Diego State trailed by as many as 18 points in the first half and 14 points in the second half, but used a 26-12 run to end the game. The 18-point deficit marked the largest come from behind victory in the tenure of sixth-year head coach Steve Fisher. San Diego State led for just 62 seconds in the contest, including the final 46 seconds.

Sophomore forward Marcus Slaughter led SDSU in scoring for a second straight game with 18 points and seven rebounds. Sophomore guard Brandon Heath, who scored the Aztecs' final six points, added 16 points and a career-best nine rebounds. The Aztecs overcame 42.6 percent field goal shooting and 17 turnovers by outrebounding the Hawks, 41-20.

UC San Diego is playing its third game of the season, dropping a 74-35 decision at San Diego last Saturday night before rebounding for a 62-54 victory over Pomona Pitzer on Tuesday. The Tritons, under first-year coach Bill Carr have just one senior on the roster. Parker Berling leads the Tritons with 17.5 ppg and 8.5 rpg.

Saturday will mark the seventh game between the schools, with San Diego State claiming the six previous encounters. The Aztecs have outscored the Tritons 516-344 in the series history, and have won the six previous games by an average of 28.7 points. Last season, SDSU claimed a 76-51 victory at Cox Arena. The 25-point margin of victory was the smallest in the series since the Aztecs won the inaugural meeting 70-65 on Dec. 5, 1969.

This is the third game of the season opening four-game homestand and the Aztecs are looking to improve to 2-1 and match their best three-game record to open a season since the 1994-95 squad opened 3-0. In the past nine seasons, SDSU has opened 2-1 five times. During that span SDSU has finished .500 or better four times and has started 2-1 in three of those four seasons.

Tidbits..

- With a victory, San Diego State can match its best start after three games since the 1994-95 squad opened 3-0. Since that time, five Aztec teams have opened 2-1, three have stared 1-2 and one opened 0-3. Since the 1994-95 season, Aztecs teams that have opened 2-1 have averaged 15.2 wins and have finished .500 or better in three of five years. Since the 1994-95 season, Aztecs teams that have opened 1-2 or 0-3 have averaged 9.5 wins and have finished .500 or better just once in four seasons
- Although San Diego State has six seniors on its roster, due to a number of circumstances (most noteably injuries), the class has accounted for just 28 of SDSU's 141 points this season. Four of the six seniors have yet to score this season, with Aztec senior Chris Manker accounting for 26 of the class' 28 points. In fact the senior and juniors on the squad (nine players total) have accounted for 51 points or 36.2 percent of SDSU's

San Diego State posted a 14-16 record last season, its fourth straight season with at least 14 victories marking the first time the Aztecs have accomplished that feat since the 1981-82 through 1984-85 seasons. SDSU, which has advanced to postseason play in two of the last three seasons, will open the season with three returning starters and eight returning letterwinners. In his coaching career, Fisher has guided all eight teams in which he returns at least three starters off a team he coached the preceding season to the postseason, including twice at San Diego State. The last time the Aztecs returned at least three starters was in 2002-03 when SDSU claimed the school's first Division I postseason victory (over UC Santa Barbara) and advanced to the second round of the postseason NIT. The last time SDSU returned as many as eight letterwinners was the 2001-02 season, when the Aztecs posted a 21-12 record, claimed the Mountain West Conference championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

San Diego State-UC San Diego: The Series

- ▶ San Diego State owns a 6-0 series lead over UC San Diego. The teams, which first played on Dec. 5, 1969, are meeting for the fifth consecutive season.
- ▶ This is the seventh meeting between the teams and all seven have been home games for the Aztecs. The teams have met at the Sports Arena (1969), Peterson Gym (1981) and Cox Arena (2000, 01, 02, 03 and 04).
- ▶ The current six-game series win streak for SDSU in the series is tied for the fourth longest active streak. Active is a relative term, as the Aztecs have not faced any of the three opponents with longer current losing streaks since 1956.
- ▶ The Aztecs have outscored the Tritons in the previous six meetings by a combined 516-344 (an average of 86.0-57.3). Other than a five-point victory in the first game of the series, San Diego State has had a decisive edge, winning by margins of 35, 32, 45, 30 and 25
- ▶ Last season's 25-point margin of victory for San Diego State was the smallest in the series since the 70-65 decision in the first meeting between the teams on Dec. 5, 1969.
- ▶ Last Meeting: San Diego State scored on its first six possessions, jumped out to a 16-2 lead, and led by no less than 16 in the second half on its way to a 76-51 victory over UC San Diego at Cox Arena on Dec. 6, 2003.

The Aztecs improved to 5-2 on the season, which marked the earliest point on the calendar year that SDSU registered five wins in its history, and matched its best record since 1984-85.

SDSU shot a season high 50.9 percent from the field, including 58.6 percent in the first half. Leading five Aztecs in double-figures was Wesley Stokes with 18 points on six-of-nine shooting.

Junior Chris Manker registered then career-highs in both scoring and rebounding with 12 points and nine boards. Chris Walton recorded his second career double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds, while Aerick Sanders and Brandon Heath also poured in 12 points apiece.

Stokes tallied eight assists, while Heath posted eight rebounds and four assists, which were season highs at the time for the Aztec starting backcourt.

▶ Marcus Slaughter made his first career start and posted seven points and seven rebounds in 30 minutes in last season's game.
