San Diego State-Nevada Postgame Notes (Game 3)

Final Score: (--/rv) San Diego State 3, Nevada 1

Records: San Diego State (28-9, 5-1 MW); Nevada (21-16, 3-6 MW)

Next Game: San Diego State at Fresno State | Friday, April 11, 2014 | 6 p.m. PT | Fresno, Calif.

Team Notes

- * San Diego State improved to 28-9 on the season, which matches its best 37-game start in school history (also 2006)
- * That mark (.757) would be the best in school history if the season ended today. The current best record is the 2008 squad, which finished 44-17 (.721).
- * The Aztecs won for the 10th time in 11 games (.909) and 17th time in 19 contests (.895)
- * SDSU has won 30 of its last 39 Mountain West games (.769)
- * San Diego State swept Nevada and has now won its last five series in the MW

Streaks/Trends

- * San Diego State won 25th straight game when leading after five innings (17-0 this year)
- * The Aztecs improved to 18-3 when scoring first
- * SDSU improved to 26-3 when leading at any point in the game
- * San Diego State improved to 21-1 with 13 straight victories when it outhits its opponent
- * The Aztecs improved to 27-1 when scoring just three or more runs
- * SDSU had its 10th game this year without an error. San Diego State is 8-2 in those games.

Series Notes

- * SDSU improved to 15-3 all-time against Nevada.

Player Notes

LHP Danielle O'Toole (W, 7.0 IP, 6 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 8 K)

Won her 20th game of the season, which is already tied for seventh in SDSU single-season history ... Improved to 20-4 (.833), which is the best record in school history ... Also had her 16th complete game of the season ... Now has at least eight strikeouts in six games this year.

2B Katie Mathis (2-for-3, 2B, RBI, R)

Had her seventh multi-hit game of the year ... SDSU is now 17-6 this year when she gets at least one hit and 44-14 over her career ... Had her second go-ahead RBI of the season, fifth go-ahead run and first game-winning run.

1B Kayla Bufardeci (2-for-3, R)

Recorded her sixth multi-hit game of the season ... SDSU improved to 14-1 this season when she gets at least one hit and 23-5 over her career ... Had her first go-ahead run of the year.

LF Kayla Jordan (1-for-3, RBI, SB)

Had her 12th stolen bases of the season ... Is now 12-for-13 (.923) on stolen bases attempts this year, which is tied for the seventh-best mark in SDSU single-season history (teammate Dominique Dinner is fifth at .941 (16-for-17)).

RF Patrice Jackson (0-for-2, RBI, SF)

Had her ninth sacrifice fly of her career, which is a new school record ... It is Jackson's third career record (also total bases (320) and home runs (42) ... Recorded her team-leading fifth game-winning RBI of the year.
