- The much anticipated trip to Hawaii is finally here as Ohio State makes the trek to compete in the prestigious Maui Invitational this week.
- The Buckeyes will open the tournament against San Diego State on Monday. The last meeting between the two teams also came in the opening round of the 2003 Maui Invitational. SDSU won that game 83-61. All-time, San Diego State leads the series 2-1.
- This is the fourth appearance in the Maui Invitational for Ohio State. The Buckeyes finished fifth in 2003, third in 1993 and fifth in 1988. Ohio State has gone 2-1 in each of its previous three appearances.
- This week will be the first trip to Hawaii for all but two of Ohio State's 14 players. Justice Sueing, a Hawaii native, and Zed Key are the only two players who have visited the islands in the past. Key's high school team, Long Island Lutheran, played in a holiday tournament in Hawaii during his senior season.
- Ohio State has opened the year with three consecutive victories at home over Robert Morris, Charleston Southern and Eastern Illinois. The defense has held each opponent to fewer than 60 points and the Buckeyes have not lost under head coach Chris Holtmann when opponents fail to reach 60 points.
- Opponents are shooting just 30.2 percent against the Buckeyes which is the best defensive shooting percentage in the Big Ten and is in the Top 10 nationally.
- Zed Key has had a double-double in each of the first three games and is now just the third Buckeye in the last 40 years to open a season with three consecutive double-doubles. He joins Keita Bates-Diop (2017) and Evan Turner (2009).
- Freshman Brice Sensabaugh has been in double-figures in each of his first three collegiate games. He scored 17 vs. Robert Morris, 14 vs. Charleston Southern and a game-high 20 vs. Eastern Illinois. He is just the fourth Buckeye since 2000 to score 10 or more in his first three career games, joining Greg Oden in 2006, Kosta Koufos in 2007 and Jared Sullinger in 2010. Not bad company.
- The FIFA World Cup starts this week and, this may or may not be a note, but Ohio State has made the NCAA Tournament in each of the last six World Cup years.

RECAPPING THE EASTERN ILL. GAME

- Led by freshman Brice Sensabaugh and a stout defensive effort, the Ohio State men's basketball team pushed their early-season record to 3-0 with a 65-43 victory over Eastern Illinois on Wednesday evening.
- The Buckeye reserves were the key in the ball game, as the Ohio State bench outscored the Panther reserves 40-7. Sensabaugh notched his first 20-point game, adding seven to his first-half total. The first-year guard is averaging a team-best 17 points per game through the opening three contests of the season.
- In addition to Sensabaugh, Gayle and senior Tanner Holden added eight points, each, while Okpara finished with four. Key posted another double-double, totaling 10 points and finishing with a career-high 14 rebounds.
- Defensively, Ohio State held Eastern Illinois to 25 percent shooting (16-of-64) for the game. The 43-point output by the Panthers marked the tenth time in the Chris Holtmann era that the Buckeyes have held their opponent under 50 points. It's also the third-lowest scoring output by an Ohio State opponent in that same time period.

BUCKEYES IN MAUI

- Ohio State is making its fourth appearance in the Maui Invitational this week. They also participated in the 1988, 1993 and 2003 events.
- All-time, Ohio State is 6-3 in the event. The Buckeyes have gone 2-1 in each of their three trips Maui.
- In 2003, Ohio State also opened against San Diego State, falling 83-61 to the Aztecs. The Buckeyes then rebounded with wins over Central Michigan and Villanova.
- The 1993 tournament was the best finish for the Buckeyes. They beat Tennessee Tech before losing to Kentucky and then topping Boston College to finish third.
- In 1988, OSU lost to Oklahoma before rebounding with wins over DePaul and Vanderbilt.
- Ohio State's Director of Player Development Terence Dials played in the 2003 Maui Invitational for the Buckeyes. He averaged a double-double in the three games with 11.7 points, 10.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists. That included a 14-point, 14-rebound effort against Central Michigan. Dials had nine points, eight rebounds, three assists and two blocks against San Diego State in the opening round.

OHIO STATE VS. THE MAUI FIELD

- Ohio State holds a combined record of 23-17 against the other seven teams in the Maui Invitational field.
- The Buckeyes are 1-2 all-time against San Diego State. The teams split a home-and-home series in 1995 and 1996 with each team winning on its home floor and then SDSU won the 2003 Maui opener.
- Against in-state rival Cincinnati, the Buckeyes are 8-4 all-time. The teams met in back-to-back Final Fours in 1961 and 1962 with UC winning both games. Since then, the Buckeyes have won the last three meetings, including a 64-56 win in the 2018 season-opener in Cincinnati.
- Against Arizona, the Buckeyes are 2-1. They won a neutral site regular season game in 1971 and then also beat the Wildcats in the 2013 Sweet 16 on a LaQuinton Ross three-pointer with two seconds remaining. Arizona won the most recent meeting, a 73-58 win in the 3rd round of the 2015 NCAA Tournament in Portland, Ore.
- Looking at the other side of the bracket, the Buckeyes are 1-2 vs. Arkansas, 6-3 against Creighton, 4-4 against Louisville and 1-1 against Texas Tech.

60 POINTS IS THE DEFENSIVE NUMBER

- Ohio State has limited each of its first three opponent to under 60 points for the game.
- The Buckeyes are 42-0 under head coach Chris Holtmann when holding its opponent to fewer than 60 points

DOUBLE-DOUBLES TO START THE YEAR

- Zed Key has had a double-double in each of the first three games of the season. He had 13/10 vs. Robert Morris and 17/13 vs. Charleston Southern and 10/14 vs. Eastern Illinois
- Key joins Keita Bates-Diop (2017) and Evan Turner (2009) as the only Buckeyes to start the year with a double-doubles in the first three games in the last 40 seasons. Jared Sullinger had two double-doubles to start the 2010 season.
- Bates-Diop opened the 2017 season with three-consecutive doubles-doubles while Turner had five-consecutive in the 2009 season.
- Since 1970, just six Buckeyes have started a season with three consecutive double-doubles: Key (2022), Bates-Diop (2017), Turner (2009), Clark Kellogg (1980), Herb Williams (1979, 1978, 1977) and Luke Witte (1970)

FRESHMEN WITH 10+ TO START A CAREER

- Freshman Brice Sensabaugh came to Ohio State known for his scoring. He has started the season doing just that.
- Sensabaugh has been in double figures in each of the first three games, scoring 17 on opening night, 14 vs. Charleston Southern and a game-high 20 against Eastern Illinois.
- Since 2000, just four Buckeyes have began their collegiate careers with three games of 10 or more points. Sensabaugh joins Jared Sullinger in 2010, Greg Oden in 2006 and Kosta Koufos in 2007.
- Koufos scored 61 points in his first three games while Sullinger netted 58. D'Angelo Russell scored just six points in his second game but followed it with a 32-point effort to total 54 points in his first three games.
- Sensabaugh is shooting 50 percent from the floor and has scored 51 points.

NO CASE OF THE MONDAYS

- Ohio State won its season-opener 91-53 over Robert Morris on Monday, Nov. 7
- The Buckeyes are now 9-0 on Mondays under head coach Chris Holtmann
- In fact, the Buckeyes have won their last 13 games on Mondays. The last lost on a Monday was Jan. 20, 2014 at Nebraska.
- There is just the potential of two more Monday games on the schedule this season -- Monday, Nov. 21 vs. San Diego State in Maui and Monday, April 3 for the NCAA Championship Game in Houston (just sayin...)

WELCOME BACK JUSTICE

- Much was made about Justice Sueing and his health over the last year and a half but he silenced a lot of that noise with his performance on opening night.
- The Hawaii native scored a game-high 20 points on 8-of-14 shooting with three steals, two assists and a block.
- The 20 points were two-shy of his Ohio State high.

ZED KEY SHOOTS THREES??

- After not attempting a three-pointer in his first two seasons, junior forward Zed Key connected from long range on his first two career attempts in the season opener against Robert Morris.
- His first three was the first points for Ohio State of the 2022-23 season. If you say you had a Key Three as your first Buckeye points of the season, I call BS.
- He finished the night with 13 points and 10 rebounds for his third career double-double.

TRANSFERS STARTING QUICK

- On a team full of new faces, three of the most veteran new faces in transfer Isaac Likekele, Tanner Holden and Sean McNeil needed to hit the ground running. They did just that on opening night.
- Likekele led the Buckeyes with a great all-around performance, scoring nine points, grabbing nine rebounds and dishing-out six assists.
- Holden didn't miss a shot, going 5-for-5 from the floor, including 1-of-1 from deep and 1-of-1 from the line to finish with 12 points.
- McNeil, who was brought to be the team's sharp-shooter, knocked-down a pair of threes and also dished-out a pair of assists.

NEW FACES, HALF THE EXPERIENCE

- Ohio State returns just four players from last year's roster and just three that have played a game in an Ohio State uniform prior to this season.
- The three returners made up just 14 percent of the scoring from last year's team.
- Of those 10 new players, six are true freshmen and four are transfers.
- Last season, the Buckeyes were a largely experienced group, having a total of 1,001 career games played entering the year. That was the most of any team in college basketball.
- This year, the Buckeyes have just about half of that total with 529 of collegiate game experience

20-WIN SEASONS

- The Buckeyes are one of just three Power 5 programs to win 20 games the previous five years, joining Kansas and Oregon.
- Broadening it out to three other conferences, Houston and Memphis from the AAC, Creighton from the Big East and Gonzaga from the WCC have also won 20 games in each of the last five seasons
- Head coach Chris Holtmann's teams have won 20 or more games in each of the last nine seasons.

HOLTMANN SIGNS ANOTHER TOP CLASS

- **Chatman - 6-4, 175, CG, Minneapolis, Minn.** No. 31 prospect overall and 8th-best combo guard in the 247 composite national rankings. Top-ranked player in the state of Minnesota
- **Middleton - 6-7, 190, G/W, Miami, Fla.** A five-star prospect, ranked 18th nationally according to ESPN. Ranked 38th nationally and the second ranked player in the state of Florida in the 247 composite rankings
- Versatile perimeter player who plays on one of the most talented teams in the country at Sunrise Christian
- **Parks - 6-10, 250, Saint Mary’s, Ohio** EPSN four-star prospect and a Top-10 ranked center nationally. Strong, physical post player. Has scored over 1,000 points in his high school career
- **Royal - 6-6, 210, W/F, Pickerington, Ohio** Consensus four-star recruit who is ranked 26th according the On3 rankings. Top-ranked player in Ohio. Led Pickerington Central to a DI state title in 2022 as a junior. Scored a game-high 20 points in the win.

TEAM NAMES THREE CAPTAINS FOR 2022-23 SEASON

- Zed Key, Isaac Likekele and Justice Sueing were all selected to lead Team 124 this year.
- **Key** is the Buckeye’s leading returning scorer and rebounder. He averaged 7.8 points and 5.6 rebounds per game last year and has also led the team in shooting percentage each of the last two seasons.
- **Likekele** is one of the most versatile and dynamic players in the Big Ten. The Oklahoma State transfer has scored over 1,000 points in his career and at just 6-5, he has also pulled down more than 600 career rebounds. He recorded over 100 assists in three of his four seasons in Stillwater and will be used in a multitude of ways this season.
- **Sueing** has now been named a captain for the second consecutive season. The 6-6 wing appeared in two games last season after starting in all 31 games during the 2020-21 campaign. He averaged 10.7 points and 5.5 rebounds per season in 2020-21 while shooting nearly 50 percent from the floor and 37 percent from long range. He also led team in steals and scored an Ohio State high 22 points in the Big Ten Tournament Championship game against Illinois.

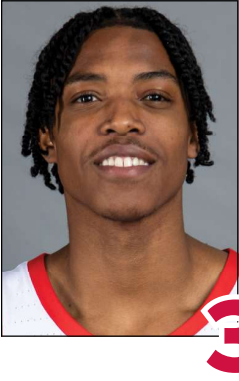

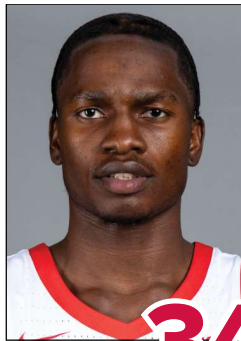
