## **Aztecs Host Utah State this Weekend**

San Diego State wraps up its home portion of the schedule this weekend with a three-game series against Utah State at SDSU Softball Stadium. The Aztecs (33-12, 16-2 MW) and Aggies (25-24, 10-8 MW) will play at 6 p.m. PT Friday, 4 p.m. PT Staturday and poop PT Sunday.

PT Saturday and noon PT Sunday.
All three games will be broadcast on Mountain West
Network (links will be available on GoAztecs.com).

Following Sunday's game will be a ceremony honoring SDSU's six departing seniors - Taylor Adams, Balint, Jessica Cordola, Alexa Schultz, Danielle Romanello and Nicole Siess.

San Diego State has won all six of its Mountain West series this season with four sweeps and is in first place in the league standings at 16-2, three games ahead of Boise State (13-5) and UNLV (13-5). The Aztecs have already won series against Boise State and UNLV and can clinch the league's automatic bid into the NCAA tournament with a sweep at home against USU this weekend regardless of what happens with the Broncos and Rebels. SDSU ends its regular season with a series at New Mexico from May 12-14.

Mac Barbara leads San Diego State in most offensive categories, including batting average (.413, 40th in NCAA), hits (57, T-62nd in NCAA), doubles (13, T-55th), home runs (14, T-45th in NCAA), RBIs (52, T-16th in NCAA), total bases (114, T-21st in NCAA), slugging percentage (.826, 24th in NCAA), walks (31, T-38th in NCAA) and on-base percentage (.518, 29th in NCAA). Barbara has reached base in 39 consecutive games, the longest streak in the country this year (overall or active).

Bella Espinoza (.390, 32 R, 55 H, 8 RBI, 12 SB), Taylor Adams (.319, 4 HR, 19 RBI, 19 R), Jillian Celis (.314, 22 RBI, 29 R, 7 2B, 10 BB), Jessica Cordola (.303, 2 HR, 16 RBI, 7 R, 5 2B) and AJ Murphy (.302, 2 HR, 22 RBI, 14 R, 2 2B) are also hitting over .300 for the Aztecs, who are hitting .302 overall.

Maggie Balint (15-5, 1.48 ERA, 176 opp. avg.) has won eight of a possible 12 MW Pitcher-of-the-Week awards, and is tied for second in saves (6), 14th in strikeouts (232) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.03), 15th in strikeouts per seven innings (10.73), tied for 22nd in ERA (1.48) and 35th in hits allowed per seven innings (4.44).

Dee Dee Hernandez (8-3, 1.93 ERA, 3 SV, 76.1 IP), Dani Martinez (5-2, 3.35 ERA, 48.0 IP) and Allie Light (5-2, 4.03 ERA, 1 SV, 40.0 IP) have also logged innings in the circle for SDSU.

## STACEY NUVEMAN DENIZ HEAD COACH | 1st Season (14th overall) | UCLA, 2002

- Was named San Diego State's fifth head coach in program history on June 8, 2021, taking over for SDSU's all-time winningest head coach Kathy Van Wyk.
- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 13 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- Over her first nine seasons as an assistant and associate coach, the Aztecs improved their batting average from .275 in 2008 (the year before she arrived) to a school-record .356 mark in 2017, and also in runs per game (3.98 to 6.61), home runs per game (0.23 to 1.09 (0.92 in 2017)), slugging percentage (.348 to .516) and on-base percentage (.347 to .418).
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a fourtime first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and

## **Scouting Utah State**

Utah State enters the weekend with a 25-24 overall record, including a 10-8 mark in Mountain West play. The Aggies were 9-3 in league play before losing a series (2-1) at UNLV from April 22-24 and then getting swept at home against Boise State last weekend (April 29-May 1).

USU is hitting .261 as a team, led by the 1-2 punch of Lexi Orozco and Gabriella Jimenez. Orozco is batting .386 (49-for-127) with 11 home runs, 43 RBIs, 29 runs, 13 doubles and 33 walks for a .748 slugging percentage and .500 on-base percentage. Jimenez, meanwhile, is hitting .301 (46-for-153) with 12 homers, 42 RBIs, 29 runs, six doubles and 18 walks for a .601 slugging percentage. Mazie Macfarlane has also been impressive with a .293 average, 42 runs, 11 doubles, 31 walks and 20 stolen bases.

Utah State has a 4.47 ERA in the circle with Kapri Toone leading the team in ERA (2.94), WHIP (1.44), wins (11-6), appearances (36), games started (20), complete games (5), saves (2), innings pitched (133.1) and opponent average (.275).

San Diego State leads the all-time series with the Aggies, 23-10.

## SDSU's Maggie Balint, AJ Murphy Named MW Players of the Week

San Diego State softball's Maggie :: SDSU MW PLAYERS OF THE WEEK Balint (West Grove, Pa.) and AJ Murphy (Goodvear, Ariz.) have each been named Mountain West Players of the Week, the league announced Tuesday. Balint was chosen as the MW Pitcher of the Week for the eighth time in 12 opportunities this season, while Murphy is MW Freshman of the Week for the second time.

San Diego State, which is No. 22 in the latest DISoftball.com rankings, has now won 16 of the 36 MW weekly awards this year, including eight pitchers of the Nevada week, seven freshmen and one player.

The duo led the Aztecs (33-12, 16-2 MW) to a series sweep at San Jose State by a combined 25-6 score. SDSU won, 7-1, on Friday, 10-2 in five innings on Saturday and 8-3 on Sunday.

Balint, who has now been named the MW Pitcher of the Week 10 times for her career, was 2-0 with a 0.64 ERA in 11 innings, striking out 17 with three walks. Balint limited the Spartans to a .175 average with just one of the seven hits going for extra-bases. The righthander picked up the win in the opener on Friday, allowing one unearned run on four hits and two walks over five innings, while striking out seven, exiting the game with San Diego

State up, 7-1. Balint earned the victory once again on Sunday, yielding one run on three hits and a walk over six innings, striking out 10 batters, while leaving with an 8-1 Aztec advantage.

On the season, Balint is 15-5 with six saves and a 1.48 ERA, striking out 232 against 33 walks, while limiting her opponents to a .176 average. Among the SDSU single-season leaders, Balint ranks first in strikeouts per seven innings (10.73), tied for first in saves (6), third in strikeouts (232), tied for third in winning percentage (.750), fourth in strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.03) and opponent average (.176), eighth in WHIP (0.85) and 10th in hits allowed per seven innings (4.44). Among the national leaders, Balint is tied for second in saves (6), 14th in strikeouts (232) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.03), 15th in strikeouts per seven innings (10.73), tied for 22nd in ERA (1.48) and 35th in hits allowed per seven innings (4.44).

Murphy, meanwhile, was 7-for-12 (.583) with five RBIs, a run, a double and two stolen bases, owning a .583 on-base percentage, while playing a perfect shortstop in three fielding chances. Murphy was 2-for-4 with two RBIs in SDSU's 7-1 win on Friday. She was then 2-for-4 with a career-high three RBIs and a double in San Diego State's 10-2, five-inning victory on Saturday. Murphy finished her weekend with a 3-for-4 outing with a run and a career-high two stolen bases in an Aztec 8-3 win on Sunday.

On the year, Murphy is batting .302 (35-for-116) with two home runs, 22 RBIs, 14 runs, four doubles and five walks, starting 42 of her 43 appearances.

## Aztecs 22th in D1Softball Rankings; Receiving Votes in Two Major Polls

San Diego State moved up two places to 22nd in the latest D1Softball rankings, which were released Monday on D1softball.com. The Aztecs (33-12, 16-2 MW) swept a series at San Jose State by a combined score of 25-6.

SDSU, which has won six consecutive games, is ahead of No. 23 Louisiana, No. 24 Wichita State and No. 25 LSU in the rankings, and just behind No. 20 Notre Dame and No. 21 Michigan. San Diego State has a victory over current No. 9 Washington and a 7-6, eight-inning loss to current No. 7 Northwestern. Oklahoma remains the top-ranked team with a 45-1 record, while Virginia Tech, Florida State, Arkansas

The Aztecs are the second-ranked team among Group of 5 programs, only trailing No. 19 UCF.

SDSU has been in the D1Softball rankings each of the last five weeks, debuting at No. 25 on April 4, rising to 24th (April 11) and 23rd (April 18) the next two weeks, coming in at No. 24 on April 25 and checking in at best of No. 22 today.

San Diego State has won all six of its MW series this season and is in first in the league standings at 16-2, three games ahead of Boise State and UNLV, which are each 13-5 in league play. The Aztecs have already won series against Boise State and UNLV and can clinch the division title with a sweep at home against Utah State this weekend regardless of what happens with the Broncos and Rebels. SDSU ends its regular season with a series at New Mexico from May 12-14.

For the 10th time over the last 11 weeks, San Diego State is receiving votes in the ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll. The Aztecs received 42 votes in the latest poll, which is voted on by coaching representatives of 10 Division I conferences as well as members of the media who consistently cover Division I softball across the country.

The 42 votes are the 26th-most votes in the poll and SDSU's most points in a poll this season. Oregon is ranked 25th in the poll with 69 points. Following San Diego State in the receiving votes group are Arizona (21), Louisiana (13), South Florida (9), Texas A&M (6), Wichita State (6), Nebraska (5), Oregon State (4), Mississippi State (3), Illinois (1) and Western Kentucky (1).

SDSU previously had three votes in the Feb. 22 poll (T-34th most in the country), 12 on March 1 (32nd), four on March 8 (31st), four on March 15 (29th), none on March 22, six on March 29 (T-32nd), six on April 5 (T-34th), five on April 12 (T-31st), 11 on April 19 (29th). and 17 on April 26.

Oklahoma has all 25 first-place votes and 625 points overall.

San Diego State is also receiving votes in the USA Today/NFCA poll for the fourth straight week. The Aztecs have five votes, which is 29th in the poll. Arizona is No. 25 with 46 votes, while Stanford (41), Louisiana (15), Nebraska (6) and SDSU (5) also have votes.

Oklahoma has all 32 first-place votes and 800 points overall.

San Diego State is also 21st in the latest Softball America poll and 25th by Extra Inning Softball.

Highest School Winning Percentage in Play
At 33-12, the Aztecs are threatening to finish with one of the highest winning percentages in program history. The .733 winning percentage is currently the highest in school history, just edging out the 2008 season when SDSU set a program record with 44 wins en route to a 44-17 finish (.721). San Diego State still has six regular-season games to play and possible postseason games.

## Mac Barbara Slugging Her Way into SDSU History

Mac Barbara is off to one of the best individual starts in program history.

Through 45 games, Barbara is batting .413 with 14 home runs, 52 RBIs, 13 doubles, an .826 slugging percentage and a .518 onbase mark. Among the NCAA leaders, Barbara ranks in a tie for 16th in RBIs (52), tied for 21st in total bases (114), 24th in slugging percentage (.826), 29th in on-base percentage (.518), tied for 38th in walks (31), 40th in batting average (.413), tied for 45th in home runs (14), tied for 55th in doubles (13) and tied for 62nd in hits (57).

Barbara's 14 home runs in 45 games are already the seventh most in San Diego State single-season history. Barbara also ranks second in OPS percentage (1.344), third in RBIs (52) and on-base percentage (.518), fourth in slugging percentage (.826), fifth in walks (31), sixth in batting average (.413), tied for sixth in extra-base hits (28), tied for seventh in total bases (114) and tied for 10th in doubles (13).

With two home runs against Stony Brook on March 6, Barbara became the fastest player in program history to reach 10 home runs in a season, doing so in SDSU's 21st game of the season. Barbara is currently six home runs behind the school record of 20 set by Hayley Miles in 2012.

## Maggie Balint Pitching Her Way into the SDSU Record Books

Maggie Balint is having her best season as an Aztec and one of the best seasons of her career. Balint, who was 28-4 with a 1.51 ERA at Oregon from 2017-18 en route to being named a all-region, all-Pac-12 and all-Pac-12 freshman pick as a freshman in 2017, is currently 15-5 with six saves, a 1.48 ERA in 151 1/3 innings. The right-hander has struck out 232 against just 33 walks, limiting the opposition to a .176 average. Balint, who has been named the MW Pitcher of the Week eight times in 12 tries this season, is ranked among the NCAA and SDSU single-season bests.

In the NCAA, Balint is tied for second in saves (6), 14th in strikeouts (232) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.03), 15th in strikeouts per seven innings (10.73), tied for 22nd in ERA (1.48) and 35th in hits allowed per seven innings (4.44).

Among the Aztec single-season leaders, Balint currently ranks first in strikeouts per seven innings (10.73), tied for first in saves (6), tied for third in winning percentage (.750), third in strikeouts (232), fourth in strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.03) and opponent average (.176), eighth in WHIP (0.85) and 10th in hits allowed per seven innings (4.44).

Despite only being in her third season with the Aztecs, on the career charts Balint ranks second in strikeouts per seven innings (8.23) and opponent average (.193), third in winning percentage (.690), fourth in saves (10), fifth in WHIP (0.98) and hits allowed per seven innings (4.89), sixth in strikeouts (470) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.12), tied for sixth in solo shutouts (since 1999) (12), ninth in wins (40) and tied for 10th in total shutouts (16).

## Start Me Up

San Diego State has had an incredible start to the Mountain West season. The Aztecs started 10-0 in league action and are currently 16-2 in MW play. So far in league games SDSU is outscoring its opposition, 92-42, in 18 games (5.1-1.5).

San Diego State has won all six of its MW series this season and is in first place in the league standings at 16-2, three games ahead of Boise State and UNLV, which are each 13-5 in league play. The Aztecs have already won series against Boise State and UNLV and can clinch the division title with a sweep at home against Utah State this weekend regardless of what happens with the Broncos and Rebels. SDSU ends its regular season with a series at New Mexico from May 12-14.

The 10-0 start was San Diego State's best conference start since the 2006 season, when the Aztecs started out 13-0. Below are SDSU's longest undefeated starts in league history (since 2000):

## A Dirty Dozen

## SDSU Wins the 31st Annual Campbell/Cartier Classic

For the record sixth time in the 31 years of the Campbell/Cartier Classic, San Diego State captured the tournament title from Feb. 17-

The Aztecs secured the tourney title for the third straight year after going 4-1, including wins over their final four games (8-0 in five innings over Army West Point on Friday, 7-3 over Army West Point and 11-0 in five innings over Southern Utah on Saturday, and 3-0 over California Baptist on Sunday. SDSU's lone setback was a 6-4 decision on Thursday when it entered the final inning with a 4-1 lead. Following the Aztecs (4-1) were California Baptist (3-1), CSUN (3-2), Southern Utah (1-4) and Army West Point (1-4).

### Aztecs Excel in Lid-Lifters

San Diego State has excelled in season-opening games since records were first kept in 1980.

Following a 3-1 victory over Middle Tennessee on Feb. 10, the Aztecs improved to 32-11 (.744) in lid-lifters in recorded program his-

SDSU has won nine of its last 10 season openers, 20 of its last 22 and 23 of its last 26.

San Diego State's only blemishes in the past 26 season-openers came in 2018 (lost to No. 25/25 Georgia, 23-2), 2012 (lost to Texas Tech, 5-4) and in 2000 (lost to UIC, 5-3).

Over the last 26 openers, the Aztecs have outscored their opponent, 149-81, or 5.7-3.1 per game in lid-lifters.

SDSU ended up recording back-to-back shutouts over the Toreros on 2021 opening day, the first time it had consecutive shutouts on a opening day since 2008.

## Aztecs Picked to Win the Mountain West with UNLV

The San Diego State softball team has been picked to win the Mountain West along with UNLV in a preseason poll voted on by the league's nine head coaches, the conference announced Feb. 3. The Aztecs have won a MW-record seven regular-season titles.

Both the Aztecs and Rebels received 57 points, but UNLV (5) had more first-place votes than SDSU (3). Fresno State had the other first-place vote and is tied with Boise State for third with 43 points, while Nevada was predicted fifth with 42 points. Rounding out the poll was Colorado State (35) in sixth, New Mexico (17) in seventh, and San José State and Utah State tied for eighth with 15 points.

Last year, San Diego State finished with a 28-16 record, its best winning percentage (.636) since the 2015 squad went 38-20 (.655) before falling in the NCAA Los Angeles Regional final to UCLA. It was also the ninth-best record in program history.

## Stacey Nuveman Deniz Named Program's Fifth Head Coach

San Diego State's Stacey Nuveman Deniz was named the softball head coach, director of athletics John David Wicker announced on June 8. A three-time U.S. Olympian, Nuveman Deniz is just the fifth head coach in program history after spending the last 13 seasons with the Aztecs as an assistant, associate head coach and head coach in waiting under SDSU's all-time winningest coach Kathy Van Wyk.

"I am humbled and honored to have this opportunity to lead San Diego State Softball into the future," Nuveman Deniz said. "Kathy Van Wyk spent 25 years building this program, and now it is my turn to take the reins and continue that growth. I would like to thank (SDSU director of athletics) John David Wicker for this opportunity and for the unwavering support he has shown me. The University, the city of San Diego and our incredible community have captured my heart and I truly am an Aztec for Life. I can't wait to get started."

Nuveman Deniz, who was hired at San Diego State following her stint with the U.S. team at the 2008 Beijing Olympics, helped SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 13 seasons on The Mesa. Over her first nine seasons as an assistant and associate coach, the Aztecs improved their batting average from .275 in 2008 (the year before she arrived) to a school-record .356 mark in 2017, and also in runs per game (3.98 to 6.61), home runs per game (0.23 to 1.09 (0.92 in 2017)), slugging percentage (.348 to .516) and on-base percentage (.347 to .418).

In 2018, Nuveman Deniz was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits, leading the team to the NFP Championship season series in her first year. In the spring of 2010, Nuveman Deniz served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team Selection Camp, at the Canadian Open Fast Pitch Women's International Championship and at the World Cup of Softball VI. She was also named to the USA Softball Coaching Pool in 2014 and was an assistant coach at the USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) National Team (JWNT) Selection Camp in January 2015.

In addition to her two Olympic gold medals (2000 and 2004) and silver medal in 2008, Nuveman Deniz helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003). Her 2004 Olympic gold medal team, meanwhile, was inducted into the U.S. Olympic hall of fame in July 2012.

Nuveman Deniz was a standout at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02). Nuveman Deniz is also ranked first in school history in games played (264), total bases (653) and on-base percentage (.600).

Among the current all-time NCAA leaders, Nuveman Deniz ranks first in home runs per game (0.34), total bases (653) and intentional walks (81), second in slugging percentage (.945), third in home runs (90) and walks (240), fifth in RBIs (299), seventh in batting average

In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs. For her efforts in the national title run, Nuveman was named to the all-Women's College World Series team. Nuveman Deniz was inducted into UCLA's hall of fame in October 2012.

Nuveman Deniz graduated from UCLA in 2002 with a degree in sociology and public policy and later earned her master's in kinesiology from Texas Women's University in 2012.

## Canadian Olympian Victoria Hayward Named Assistant Coach

Victoria Hayward was named an assistant coach for the San Diego State softball team, head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz announced Aug. 26, 2021. Hayward recently represented Canada at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics and has been a member of the Canadian Senior National Team since 2009.

Hayward has nine years of experience in the college ranks, most recently serving as the director of operations at UCF in 2019 and as an assistant coach at Maryland in 2018.

Prior to Maryland, Hayward helped guide UMass to back-to-back winning seasons in 2016 and 2017. UMass was one of the top hitting teams in the Atlantic 10 in 2017, finished second in regular-season standings and advanced to the A10 title game. At UMass, Hayward helped nine batters/position players earn all-conference honors and three Minutewomen hitters garnered NFCA All-Region selections during her tenure.

Hayward spent the 2015 season as a graduate assistant at LSU under head coach Beth Torina. The Tigers opened the year with 25 consecutive victories and spent three weeks as the top-ranked team in the country, before ending the season with a 52-14 record and a third-place finish at the Women's College World Series (WCWS). LSU's coaching staff was named the Division I South Region Staff of the Year by the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA).

As a player, Hayward made the Canadian squad in 2009 at 16 years old, becoming the youngest player ever to join the senior team. Hayward has been a mainstay in the outfield and has won numerous medals in international competition. She was the 19th overall selection in the 2014 National Pro Fastpitch Draft by the Pennsylvania Rebellion.

In college, Hayward starred at national power Washington, helping the Huskies to four NCAA tournaments. Hayward was a 2014 All-American, a four-time all-Pac-12 selection and a three-time Academic All-Pac-12 honoree (2011-14). UW won four NCAA Regional Championships during her career and advanced to the Women's College World Series in 2013. She finished her Washington career ranked seventh in runs (176), 10th in triples (7) and 12th in average (.351), while stealing a league-best 28 bases as a senior without committing an error.

## SDSU Adds Former UCLA Star and U.S. Olympian Rachel Garcia to Staff

Rachel Garcia, one of the most decorated players in NCAA soffball history, has joined San Diego State as a volunteer assistant coach, head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz announced Jan. 7.

Garcia, who most recently helped the United States to a silver medal at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics in the summer, garnered numerous accolades during her time at UCLA, including twice being named the Collegiate Woman Athlete of the Year (Honda Cup) for all sports (2019 and 2021) and three times the Honda Sports Award for softball (2018, 2019 and 2021). Garcia also won the Senior CLASS Award in 2021.

Garcia, who redshirted in 2020 while playing for Team USA on its Stand Beside Her Tour, also has been chosen twice as the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year (2018-19), and once each as the NFCA National Pitcher of the Year (2019) and the NFCA National Player of the Year (2018). Garcia was also the 2017 NFCA National Freshman of the Year.

In the circle, Garcia was 99-17 with a 1.43 ERA with 11 saves for her career with the Bruins, striking out 996 against 172 walks in 749 innings. Garcia tossed 28 shutouts and 66 complete games, while limiting the opposition to a .172 batting average. Her 2019 NFCA pitcher-of-the-year season featured a 29-1 record with a 1.14 ERA and seven shutouts in 202 innings, striking out 286 as UCLA captured the NCAA title.

At the plate, Garcia hit .337 for her career with 43 home runs, 175 RBIs, 103 runs and 32 doubles, while owning a .594 slugging percentage and a .430 on-base mark. When she was named the NFCA Player of the Year in 2018, Garcia hit .339 with 11 home runs and 54 RBIs in 61 games.

Garcia is also a four-time NFCA All-American (first team in 2018, 2019 and 2021, second team in 2017), four-time NFCA All-Region selection (2017, 2018, 2019 and 2021), three-time Pac-12 Player of the Year (2018, 2019 and 2021), 2019 Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year, 2017 Pac-12 Freshman of the Year and four-time all-Pac-12 selection (2017, 2018, 2019 and 2021).

Throughout her career, Garcia was a multi-time national player of the week (three times by USA Softball and twice by NFCA) and a two-time NFCA national player of the week. Additionally, Garcia was an 11-time Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week and a four-time Pac-12 Player of the Week.

Garcia has been with the USA National Team since 2018, helping the squad wind the gold medal at the 2018 WBSC Women's World Championship, and the 2019 USA Softball International Cup, Pan American Games and Japan Cup, before settling for a silver medal at Tokyo last summer.
