Back-to-Back Mountain West Regular-Season Champions

- The Aztecs have won at least 20 games in a school-record seven straight seasons and 25 or more in four consecutive seasons.
- San Diego State has advanced to postseason play each of the last seven seasons (2006 NCAA, 2007-09 NIT, 2010-12 NCAA).


Trends:

- SDSU has been nationally ranked (AP) the last 21 weeks, which extends the school record.




