SAN DIEGO STATE SELECTED MOUNTAIN WEST MEN'S BASKETBALL PRESEASON FAVORITE

San Diego State has been predicted to win the 2022-23 Mountain West regular-season title as voted by select media and announced Wednesday morning ahead of the Conference's virtual media days.

The Aztecs received 16 first-place votes and earned 216 points in the 2022-23 MW Men's Basketball Predicted Order of Finish. SDSU returns six letterwinners from last year's squad, including four starters Matt Bradley, Lamont Butler, Keshad Johnson and Nathan Mensah. Joining head coach Brian Dutcher and the Aztecs in 2022-23 are five newcomers, headlined by MW Preseason Newcomer of the Year Darrion Trammell.

Wyoming was picked second in the preseason poll with 204 points and the remaining four first-place votes, while Boise State was selected third with 166 points.

Colorado State was chosen to finish fourth with 156 points, New Mexico fifth with 136 points, UNLV sixth with 110 points and Fresno State seventh with 101 points. Utah State is eighth with 96 points, Nevada ninth with 73 points, San José State is 10th with 35 points and Air Force is 11th with 27 points.

MW BY THE NUMBERS

- 1** Utah State is connecting on 42.7 percent of its attempts from long range, ranking **first** nationally in 3-point field goal percentage.
- 1** UNLV has a turnover margin of +7.3 this season, which is the top turnover margin in the country.
- 2** UNLV has **two** wins over nationally-ranked opponents in 2022-23. The Runnin' Rebels defeated then-No. 21 Dayton in November and upset then-No. 21 New Mexico on Jan. 7.
- 4** New Mexico is 18-2 (.900) on the season, which is the **fourth**-best winning percentage in Division I men's basketball.
- 6** Colorado State owns an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.63 in 2022-23, which is the **sixth**-best assist-to-turnover ratio in the country.
- 7** New Mexico is one of **seven** team programs with two or fewer losses on the season.
- 8** The Mountain West has **eight** squads with an overall record of .500 or better.
- 9** San José State has a rebound margin of +8.0 this season, marking the top rebound margin in the MW and the **ninth**-best in the nation.
- 17** New Mexico's offense is averaging 81.9 points per game in 2022-23, which ranks **17th** in the country in scoring offense.
- 19** Nevada's **Kenan Blackshear** is one of **19** players to record a triple double in 2022-23. The senior tallied 12 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists against William Jessup (11/16).

MOUNTAIN WEST NOTEBOOK

- The Mountain West has six teams ranked in the top 100 and five programs in the top 35 of the Jan. 23 NET rankings.
- The MW is one of three conferences (Big 12, 7; Big Ten, 5; MW, 5) that have five or more teams ranked among the top 35 of the NET rankings.
- The Mountain West has the fifth-best conference NET ranking among the 32 Division I conferences. The MW trails the Big 12, Big Ten, SEC and Big East.
- The MW owns a 99-39 (.717) nonconference record in 2022-23, which is the fifth-best nonconference record among the 32 conferences in the nation.
- The Mountain West is the only Conference in the country that has five teams with 15 or more wins on the season.
- The MW is one of five conferences (Big 12, Big Ten, C-USA and SEC) that owns a nonconference winning percentage of .700 or better.
- The Mountain West's nonconference winning percentage (.717) is the Conference's best nonconference winning percentage since 2012-13 (.761).
- Mountain West teams have a combined nine wins against teams from the Big Ten, Pac-12 and SEC this season.
- Three Mountain West squads (Nevada, 7; San Diego State, 11; UNLV, 17) rank among the top-20 toughest schedules in 2022-23 according to the NCAA.
- New Mexico returned to the *Associated Press* Top 25 this week, ranking No. 25. The Lobos are also receiving votes in the *USA Today* Coaches Poll. Additionally, San Diego State is receiving votes in both polls, while Boise State is garnering votes in the AP poll.
- Nevada senior **Kenan Blackshear** recorded 12 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists against William Jessup (11/16), registering the first triple double by a Nevada player since 1979.
- New Mexico senior guard **Jaelen House** was named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Midseason Watch List by the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA). House is one of 50 players nationwide to be named to the list, which honors top candidates for the award annually given to the nation's top player.
- For the second time in as many years, San Diego State senior **Matt Bradley** has been included on the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame's initial watch list for the Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award.
- Wyoming junior **Graham Ike** is the first Cowboy to be named to the Karl Malone Watch List since the 2014-15 season. Ike is one of 20 members listed to the watch list.
- Colorado State senior **Isaiah Stevens** is one of 20 watch list candidates for the 2023 Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Award. He was a finalist for the award in 2022.
