#AztecWBB Wraps Up Non-Conference Slate at UC Riverside Tuesday

San Diego State concludes its non-conference schedule on Tuesday when it travels north to battle UC Riverside at SRC Arena, beginning at 2 p.m. PT. A live audio stream will be available on GoAztecs.com, with Chris Ello handling play-by-play responsibilities. In addition, the Aztecs-Highlanders contest will feature streaming video courtesy of Big West TV.

SDSU looks to put the brakes on a three-game losing streak, including a 65-54 defeat at the hands of CSUN at home in its last outing on Saturday. The Aztecs were led by junior Erimma Amarikwa's 14 points, while sophomore Chloe Johnson tied her career-high with 13 points and three steals. The Scarlet and Black also received a boost from sophomore Ariell Bostick, who scored 10 points for the second straight game after returning to the active roster following a severe knee injury last season.

Conversely, the Highlanders have dropped four of their last five after opening the year with five consecutive wins. UCR fell to 3-1 at home this season after suffering a heartbreaking 74-71 loss to Washington on Saturday, as the Huskies rallied from a 17-point deficit early in the second half.

Despite the relative proximity of both schools, SDSU will be facing the Highlanders for just the eighth time in school history. The Aztecs have won three straight in the series and own a 5-2 advantage all-time. Last season, SDSU overcame a 14-point deficit in the first half to escape with a 58-57 victory at Viejas Arena in the opening game of the San Diego Surf 'N Slam. The Aztecs also emerged triumphant in their last visit to the Inland Empire with a 66-59 decision in December of 2009 and are 2-1 overall on UCR's home floor.

Tuesday's matchup with the Highlanders will be SDSU's fourth and final encounter with a Big West school this season, while the Aztecs represent UCR's fourth Mountain West opponent of the year. Earlier, the Highlanders dispatched San José State (100-80) and New Mexico (70-62) before falling to Fresno State (73-61).

Despite previous losses to Long Beach State and CSUN this year, SDSU has still captured 14 of its last 17 meetings against current members of the Big West, including a 64-58 win over UCSB at home on Dec. 7.

Entering the week, the Aztecs find themselves among the top half of the Mountain West in three-point field goal percentage defense (2nd - .284), rebounding defense (3rd - 36.3/gm) and rebounding margin (5th - (+2.6)). Individually, Hunter (6.4/gm) and Amarikwa (6.3/gm) occupy the 11th and 12th spots in the conference in rebounding.

Scouting the Highlanders

UC Riverside is off to a 6-4 start this season, having already matched its victory total from a year ago when it finished with a 6-23 overall record. The Highlanders are coming off a narrow 74-71 defeat to Washington at home last Saturday, the same squad that knocked off the Aztecs two days earlier. Against the Huskies, UCR had five players in double figures, led by Annelise Ito, who tallied 20 points on 9-of-14 shooting, followed by Simone DeCoud (14 pts), Brittany Crain (13 pts), Michelle Curry (13 pts) and Dynese Adams (11 pts). The Highlanders built a seemingly insurmountable 17-point advantage with five minutes elapsed in the second half before Washington stormed back, taking the lead for good on a three-pointer by Kelsey Plum with 10 seconds remaining.

Entering the week, Crain leads the Big West in scoring with 23.4 points per game, which ranks sixth in the nation. A first-team all-Big West selection a year ago, Crain also tops the conference with 2.8 steals per contest and ranks third with a team-best 7.8 rebounds per outing. In addition, UCR boasts two other players with double-digit scoring averages in DeCoud (13.9 ppg) and Ito (11.1 ppg). DeCoud, who was named Big West Freshman of the Year last season, occupies the sixth spot in the conference with 3.7 assists per game, while Ito is tied for the sixth position in rebounds (6.8/gm).

As a team, the Highlanders are shooting 41.9 percent from the field, including a 38.3 percent clip from three-point range, which tops the Big West and ranks 17th in the country. DeCoud and Crain are UCR's main threats from beyond the arc, draining 20 triples each, while Akilah Martin has eight treys of her own. In addition, DeCoud's .455 three-point percentage (20-44) leads the conference and is 31st in the nation. The Highlanders have been adept at taking care of the ball this season as well, averaging just 12.9 turnovers per game, which ranks 16th in the country.

Head coach John Margaritis is in his 10th year at the helm of the UCR program, having compiled a 150-165 record, highlighted by a trio of first-round NCAA tournament appearances in 2006, 2007 and 2010. Margaritis was named Big West Coach of the Year following the 2006-07 campaign after the Highlanders claimed both the regular-season and conference tournament titles.

Prior to assuming the reins at UCR, Margaritis spent eight seasons as an assistant at Northern Arizona from 1996-2004, following a three-year stint at Cal State San Bernardino, where he served as interim head coach for the 1995-96 campaign. He began his coaching career at his alma mater Northeastern Illinois, where compiled a record of 83-53 in four years with the NAIA program.

Aztec forward Erimma Amarikwa and Highlander guard Tahvia Morrison both attended Vanden High School in Vacaville, Calif.

Rewind: Aztecs-Highlanders 2013 Edition

Ariell Bostick scored a career-high 12 points, including five straight down the stretch as the Aztecs rallied for a 58-57 triumph over UC Riverside in the opening game of the ninth annual San Diego Surf 'N Slam Classic at Viejas Arena on Dec. 28, 2013.

With the victory, SDSU (3-6) won back-to-back games for the first time all season, while the Highlanders (4-8) dropped their fifth in a row.

SDSU also witnessed double-digit scoring efforts by Desi Culberston, who finished with 11 points, seven rebounds and three assists, while senior Cierra Warren and sophomore Deajanae Scurry tallied 10 points apiece. In addition, the Aztecs received a key contribution from Danesha Long, who totaled seven points and a personal-best 10 rebounds, including six on the offensive glass.

Despite a lackluster performance at the free-throw line in which it sank just 11-of-23 foul shots (47.8 percent), SDSU won the turnover battle for the second game in a row (11-14), scoring 13 points off 11 Highlander miscues in the second half to help fuel its comeback effort. The Aztecs also withstood seven UCR three-pointers, including one by Simone DeCoud, which narrowed a five-point SDSU lead to 57-55 with 13 seconds left in the contest.

The Aztecs trailed by as many as 14 points in the first half and found themselves on the wrong side of a 39-28 score with two minutes elapsed in the second period, before uncorking a 13-0 run over the ensuing 6:16, as a jumper in the lane by Deidra Smith gave the host school its first lead since the opening tip, 41-39, with 11:48 left

on the clock. However, the Highlanders answered with a 7-0 blitz of their own, reclaiming a 46-41 advantage following a Natasha Hadley basket at the 10:25 mark.

SDSU responded to the challenge with consecutive buckets by Warren, Kristina Hunter and Scurry to vault in front, 47-46, with 7:16 remaining. Moments later, Annalise Ito's jumper gave UCR its last lead of the afternoon before Warren drained three free throws, while Culberson converted a layup to put the Aztecs back in front, 52-48.

The Highlanders managed to tie things up following a pair of Hadley foul shots and a Jamila Williams' jumper. However, Bostick came up huge on SDSU's ensuing possession, burying a three-pointer from the left wing with 1:16 left to put the Scarlet and Black up for good, 55-52. After an Ito misfire from beyond the arc at the UCR end, Bostick displayed some more flair with a key layup to extend the Aztec advantage to 57-52.

The Highlanders would not go away quietly, however, as DeCoud drilled a triple with 13 seconds to go, cutting the margin to 57-55. After a quick foul by Hadley, Bostick nailed one of two free throws before another three-point attempt by DeCoud hit the side of the rim with six seconds on the clock. Akilah Martin converted a layup with two seconds left, but the Aztecs were able to inbound the ball and escape with the one-point win.

DeCoud finished with a game-high 14 points, including a 4-for-8 performance from three-point territory to go with

The Last Time Out: Aztecs-CSUN

Despite having three players finish in double figures, San Diego State was unable to avoid its third straight defeat on Saturday with a 65-54 loss to CSUN at Viejas Arena.

The Aztecs shot just 29 percent from the field (17-58), including a 1-for-10 clip from three-point range to fall to 3-7 on the season. Meanwhile, the Matadors capitalized on 22 SDSU turnovers, scoring 19 points off those miscues to help raise their record to 9-2 overall.

Individually, the Aztecs were led by junior Erimma Amarikwa (Vacaville, Calif.), who finished with 14 points, while sophomore Chloe Johnson (Phoenix, Ariz.) tied her career best with 13 points on 5-of-6 shooting. In addition, the SDSU cause was aided by sophomore Ariell Bostick (Oakland, Calif.), who scored 10 points for the second straight game, while senior Kristina Hunter (Fairfield, Calif.) snared a game-high 10 rebounds and posted two blocks.

CSUN didn't fare much better from the floor, connecting on just 21 of its 61 field-goal attempts (34 percent). However, the Matadors matched the Aztecs efficiency from the free-throw line as both teams went 19-for-23 (83 percent) from the charity stripe.

Despite getting outrebounded 45-40, the visitors also outscored SDSU 28-24 in the paint and maintained a 13-8 advantage on second-chance points en route to the win.

Janae Sharpe paced the Matadors with a game-high 20 points and grabbed six rebounds, while Ashlee Guay finished with 17 points and six boards of her own.

The contest witnessed four lead changes and three ties early in the first half, with the Aztecs building a pair of five-point advantages, including a 20-15 spread at the 9:17 mark following two foul shots by junior Deidra Smith (Aurora, Colo.). SDSU was unable to sustain the momentum, however, misfiring on six straight field goal attempts over the ensuing 5:34, while committing four turnovers. CSUN took advantage of the Aztecs' woes, uncorking an 11-0 run to take the lead for good, 26-20, with 3:43 left in the period.

SDSU managed to trim the margin to three by halftime, 30-27, before suffering another ill-timed drought after the break. The Aztecs went just 2-for-7 from the perimeter in the first six-and-a-half minutes of the second half, allowing the Matadors to build a 42-32 cushion by the 13:26 mark.

SDSU would only get as close as seven points the rest of the way, as a Johnson layup and a Bostick free throw cut the margin to 46-39 with 8:05 left on the clock. However, CSUN countered with an 11-5 spurt over the next four minutes to forge its largest lead of the game at 57-44. Sharpe sank four foul shots during that stretch, while Camille Mahlknecht and Caroline Gilling added layups to help keep the host school at bay.

Noting the CSUN Game

■ The Aztecs posted their highest free-throw percentage of the season (82.6) after draining 19 of 23 attempts from the charity stripe. Over the last two games, San Diego State has drained 78.4 percent of its foul shots (29-37) after making just 61.6 percent in its previous eight contests.

■ For just the third time this season, the Aztecs finished with more offensive rebounds (18-15) than the opposition.

■ Ariell Bostick has recorded at least one steal in six straight games dating back to last year and in 18 of 25 career outings.

■ In addition to tying her career high with 13 points, Chloe Johnson matched her collegiate best with five field goals made and three steals.

Welcome to the Club

Senior Khristina Hunter and junior Erimma Amarikwa each surpassed 500-point barrier for their careers earlier this season. Amarikwa achieved the milestone with a 15-point performance against Idaho State at the San Juan Shootout on Nov. 27, while Hunter accomplished the feat with a basket and a free throw at USD on Dec. 9. In addition, the Fairfield, Calif., native eclipsed the 400-rebound plateau with eight boards against the Toreros.

Elsewhere, senior Desi Culbertson (430) is also on pace to reach 500 career points before the season ends, junior while Ahjalee Harvey recently notched her 100th field goal in an Aztec uniform.

Decembers to Remember

The Aztecs are a combined 34-16 during the month of December since 2006. Eight of those losses came to teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national poll, including a defeat to Washington (rv) on Dec. 18, following a pair of setbacks to No. 23 Texas A&M and North Carolina State (rv) last season. The Aztecs have also come up short in previous years against No. 2 UConn, No. 7 Texas A&M, No. 14 Oklahoma State, No. 17 George Washington and USC (rv). The other eight defeats were against CSUN last Saturday, at USD on Dec. 9, vs. UCLA in 2013, at Washington in 2012, at Washington State and against USD in 2011, vs. Pepperdine in overtime in 2009 and against Quinnipiac in the opener of the 2007 Surf 'N Slam. Of course, it should be noted that SDSU has played 37 of those 50 December contests at home.

Fort Named Top MW Preseason Freshman; Aztecs Picked Seventh

San Diego State point guard McKynzie Fort was tabbed as the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year in a combined vote of the league's 11 head coaches and select media members. on Oct. 14.

Fort is the fifth consecutive Aztec player to garner top MW preseason freshman accolades, following in the respective paths of Chloe Johnson, Deajanae Scurry and Desi Culbertson, as well as Melissa Sweat, who received such distinction prior to the 2010-11 campaign.

Fort, who led the powerful Etiwanda High School program to the Southern Regional finals of the CIF playoffs as a senior last season, was a first-team all-state selection and Baseline League most valuable player honoree before earning all-area recognition by the *Los Angeles Times*.

As a team, SDSU was predicted to finish seventh in the preseason poll released by the conference office. SDSU earned 134 points from the panel, trailing UNLV (143 pts.) by just nine points for sixth place.

Defending regular-season champion Colorado State was picked to repeat after receiving 21 of 28 first-place votes and 276 points, comfortably ahead of Boise State, which received four first-place votes and 241 points, while Wyoming was slotted for the third position with three first-place votes and 235 points.

This year marks the first time since the beginning of the 2007-08 campaign that SDSU has not been selected to finish among the top three places in the MW preseason rankings.

Noting the Newcomers

In addition to McKynzie Fort, the Aztecs' highly touted freshman class includes two other former prep stars in Cheyenne Greenhouse (Riverside, Calif.) and Lexy Thorderson (Castle Rock, Colo.), both of whom could play significant roles in SDSU's fortunes this season. Greenhouse was a first-team all-CIF selection after leading Canyon Springs High to the Division I state championship as a senior in 2013-14. She also collected the Inland Empire League's most valuable player award and received first-team all-conference recognition for the fourth straight year.

Thorderson, meanwhile, garnered numerous postseason accolades at Rock Canyon High, where she finished her prep career as the school's all-time leading scorer. A nominee for the McDonald's All-America team, Thorderson led the state of Colorado in 3-point field goals made as a senior, earning second-team class 5A all-state distinction.

SDSU also solidified its depth for the 2015-16 season after junior Kym Ellison (Georgia Tech) and sophomore Geena Gomez (St. Joseph's) transferred to The Mesa in the summer of 2014. The two players will not be eligible to compete this season due to NCAA rules, but will serve as valuable assets to the team in practice.

2013-14 Rewind

After winning a program-record 27 games and capturing its second straight Mountain West regular-season championship, San Diego State faced a year of transition during the 2013-14 campaign. Not only did the Aztecs have to adjust to a brand new coaching staff, but they were also forced to overcome the loss of four senior starters who accounted for 64 percent of the team's scoring from the previous year. With five newcomers on board, growing pains were certainly inevitable. However, SDSU flashed its resiliency throughout the season, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and tying for sixth in the MW standings with a 9-9 mark. Below are some additional obstacles the Aztecs endured last year:

- SDSU had to replace two starters, Erimma Amarikwa and Ahjalee Harvey, who were lost for the year after suffering injuries during the non-conference schedule. As a result, the Aztecs employed 10 different starting lineups last season compared to just three in 2012-13.
- In addition, SDSU was faced with a difficult schedule featuring nine games against teams that advanced to postseason competition, including four squads that finished among the AP Top 25: South Carolina, Texas A&M, North Carolina State and USC.
- SDSU dropped four very close games during the non-conference slate by an average of three points in losses to Sacramento State, USC, San Diego and UCLA.

Despite these tribulations, the gritty Aztecs found success on the court during the 2013-14 campaign. Below are a few of the accomplishments of last year's squad:

- SDSU led the Mountain West as team in rebounding margin (+7.6) and rebounding defense (33.1/game).
- The Aztecs also ranked second in the conference in field-goal percentage (.419) and offensive rebounds (15.3/game).
- SDSU averaged over 40 rebounds per contest (40.6) for the third straight season, representing its longest stretch since a six-year span from 1984-89.

- The Aztecs handed two-time defending MW tournament champion Fresno State its only home loss in conference play with a 70-69 upset on a late basket by Danesha Long. Coupled with a win at Fresno in 2013, SDSU is the only MW team to defeat the Bulldogs twice on the road in the past two years.

- The Aztecs topped the 80-point barrier in back-to-back conference games for the first time since joining the Mountain West after scoring 88 points in consecutive home victories over San José State and Utah State.
- Elsewhere, Stacie Terry tied for the second-highest victory total (13) ever by a first-year SDSU head coach in program history.

2014-15 By the Numbers

With a new season already underway, below are a few trends to watch for the remainder of the 2014-15 campaign:

- SDSU has claimed 37 of its last 50 home games and has gone 69-25 (.742) on the Viejas Arena floor since the start of the 2008-09 campaign.
- The Aztecs have recorded 65 Mountain West victories in the last six seasons after posting 31 wins in the league's first nine years.
- SDSU is 65-1 over the last three-plus seasons when leading with five minutes to go in the game, including its victory over UC Santa Barbara on Dec. 7. The Aztecs' lone blemish during that stretch was a heartbreaking 59-58 defeat at Washington in December 2012.
- SDSU is 34-16 in December games dating back to the 2006-07 campaign, with eight of those losses coming against teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national polls.
- The Aztecs have advanced to finals of the MW Championship in five of the last seven years after not winning a single game in the tournament's first eight years of existence.
- For the second straight season, SDSU will play 18 conference games. The Aztecs will complete a home-and-away slate with eight squads, while facing San José State (home) and Utah State (away) just once.

SDSU Holds Groundbreaking Ceremony for Jeff Jacobs JAM Center

San Diego State held a ceremonial groundbreaking for the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center, the men's and women's basketball performance center, on Aug. 27. The JAM Center is scheduled to be completed by August 2015 and in time for the start of the 2015-16 campaign.

SDSU President Dr. Elliot Hirshman, men's hoops head coach Steve Fisher and Jeff Jacobs spoke before a selected group of invited guests, which included Steve and Lisa Altman, and Jim and Susan Morris, as well as members of both the Aztec men's and women's basketball programs. The master of ceremonies for the event was the voice of San Diego State men's basketball, Ted Leitner.

Preliminary site work started in July where the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center will be located, just south of the Fowler Athletics Center and east of the football practice fields. The facility, which will support the continued growth and development of the SDSU men's and women's basketball teams, includes two full-length courts, eight baskets, locker rooms, film rooms, team lounges, athletic training room and coaches locker rooms.

Hundreds of supporters contributed to the effort to make the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center a reality. In addition to the naming gift from Jeff Jacobs, Hal and Debby Jacobs, Steve and Lisa Altman and Jim Morris, creating the name "JAM" Center, sizeable donations were made from the Manna Charitable Foundation and the Walter and Betty Zable Foundation. The total cost of the project is \$14.5 million, of which \$12.5 million in private funding has been raised. No state funds will be used to construct this building.

The project was designed by JCY Architecture and is being built by The Hunt Construction Group.

STACIE TERRY

Head Coach Second Season UT Arlington (1998)

San Diego native Stacie Terry was named the eighth head coach in the history of the San Diego State women's basketball program on May 15, 2013.

During her first season on Montezuma Mesa, Terry was saddled with the unenviable task of replacing four senior starters who accounted for nearly 64 percent of the team's scoring offense from the previous year, as well as overcoming the loss of two key players - forward Erimma Amarikwa, a preseason all-Mountain West selection, and starting point guard Ahjalee Harvey - to injuries prior to conference play.

Despite those obstacles and a demanding schedule featuring nine games with teams that eventually advanced to postseason competition, Terry's squad flashed its resiliency during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and a 9-9 mark in the MW.

Under Terry's guidance, the Aztecs led the league in rebounding margin and rebounding defense, while ranking second in field-goal percentage.

Individually, Terry also oversaw the progress of senior center Cierra Warren, who became the fifth SDSU player in the last six years to receive first-team all-MW recognition.

Prior to her arrival on The Mesa, Terry gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach at the Division I level for 14 years, including five under head coach Nikki Caldwell, who transformed UCLA into a powerhouse before restoring LSU to national prominence.

During Terry's two seasons at LSU, the Lady Tigers compiled a 45-23 overall record and earned two NCAA tournament bids, including a Sweet 16 appearance during the 2012-13 campaign. During that season, the Lady Tigers also posted six victories against ranked opponents and finished with their second-highest scoring average (69.0) in the last seven years. Under Terry's guidance, forward LaShondra Barrett garnered first-team all-Southeastern Conference accolades and received honorable mention All-America distinction in 2012 before becoming a first-round draft choice of the WNBA's Washington Mystics.

Prior to her appointment at LSU, Terry served as an assistant under Caldwell at UCLA from 2008-11, helping the Bruins gain national acclaim with a pair of NCAA tournament appearances. During Terry's tenure, UCLA posted 72 overall victories, as the 2010-11 squad finished with a 28-5 record, setting a school record for fewest losses in a single season to go with a No. 7 national ranking. In addition, the Bruins signed the fourth-ranked recruiting class that season, according to ESPN HoopGurlz, while Terry helped mentor first-team all-Pac-10 performers in Doreena Campbell, Darxia Morris and Jasmine Dixon, a 2012 honorable mention AP All-America selection, as well as all-conference freshman honorees Atonye Nyingifa and Markel Walker.

Terry spent the 2007-08 campaign at Southern Mississippi, as the Golden Eagles posted a 21-14 record and

earned a postseason berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). While at Southern Miss, Terry spearheaded the development and coordination of the Lady Eagle recruiting campaign. Her responsibilities also included working with the perimeter players, scouting opponents and film breakdown, as well as coordinating all of the team's community service events.

Terry also coached for three seasons from 2004-07 as an assistant under Hall of Fame head coach Theresa Greutz at Illinois, where the Fighting Illini had three straight recruiting classes ranked among the top 25 in the nation, according to Blue Star Basketball, and made three consecutive trips to the WNIT. Her primary duties included defensive instruction and working with the perimeter players.

In addition, Terry coached at Dayton during the 2003-04 season following a three-year stint at Louisville from 2000-03. With the Cardinals, Terry's responsibilities encompassed recruiting, scouting, player development, summer camps and serving as a liaison for the program's community service outreach. Louisville captured the Conference USA regular-season title and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament in 2001 before making a WNIT appearance in 2002. She also assisted in signing the nation's 21st-ranked recruiting class in 2002-03, according to All-Star Girls Report. Terry recruited and coached all-Conference USA honoree Lori Nero, a draft choice of the WNBA's Houston Comets, as well as Sara Nord, who finished her collegiate career as the Cardinals' all-time assist leader and ranks among the top 15 scorers in school history.

Terry enjoyed a successful collegiate playing career at the University of Texas at Arlington, winning four varsity letters from 1994-98 under head coach Mike Dean. She earned first-team all-Southland Conference honors after leading the Mavericks in scoring with 17.4 points per game as a senior in 1997-98. Terry scored 1,169 points during her career at UTA and still ranks among the school's top 10 in three-point field goals made (third), assists (sixth), steals (seventh) and free-throw percentage (10th). She is just one of 17 players in Maverick history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau, while her .335 career three-point field-goal percentage is also a school and Southland Conference career record.

Terry played one season of professional basketball in Warsaw, Poland, averaging 12.0 points and 6.0 assists with the Polonia Phoenix, before returning to UT Arlington to begin her coaching career as a graduate assistant in 1999.

Terry prepped at El Capitan High and held the Vaqueros' career scoring record for three years following her graduation. She was inducted into the school's athletic hall of fame in 2008.
