Postgame Football Notes – San Diego State vs. Nevada

Nov. 9, 2019

SDCCU Stadium | San Diego, Calif.

Team Notes

- San Diego State had its four-game winning streak snapped. The Aztecs had gone 48 days without a loss prior to tonight with their last loss coming in Sept. 21 vs. Utah State.
- SDSU had one turnover in the game and has now gone nine straight games with one or less turnovers, tied with Oregon State for the longest active streak in the country.
- The Aztecs saw their 35-game winning streak snapped when holding their opponents to 17 or less points. SDSU is now 50-2 in the Rocky Long era when keeping its opponent to 17 or less points.
- San Diego State dropped to 43-4 in the Rocky Long era when holding its opponent to less than 300 yards of total offense.
- The Aztecs are now 42-14 in the Rocky Long era when allowing less than 100 yards rushing.
- SDSU dropped to 43-5 in the Rocky Long era when its opponent recorded 15 or less first downs.
- SDSU fell to 60-12 in the Rocky Long era when recording one or less turnovers.
- SDSU dropped to 66-7 in the Rocky Long era when holding its opponent to less than 24 points.
- SDSU has still won 25 of its last 36 (25-11) games, 32 of its last 45 (32-13), 45 of its last 59 (45-14) and 46 of its last 63 since the 2015 season (46-17).

Series Notes

- San Diego State dropped to 7-5 all-time against Nevada.
- SDSU fell to 5-2 all-time against Nevada at home, including a 5-1 mark at SDCCU Stadium.

Trends

- San Diego State started with the ball for the 93rd time in the last 106 games.
- The Aztecs held their opponent scoreless on their opening possession for the seventh time this season and 46th time since 2015 (63 games).

Player Notes

* Ryan Agnew, Sr., QB (18-for-35, 196 yds., 0 TD, 1 INT)

- Was 18-for-35 for 196 yards with an interception.
- Dropped to 13-3 as the team's starting quarterback.

* **Chance Bell, So., RB (11 att., 40 yds.. 1 TD)**

- Ran for 40 yards on 11 carries with a touchdown.
- The touchdown was his second of the season and second of his career.

* **Kyahva Tezino, Sr., LB (9 tackles, 1.0 sacks, 2.5 TFL)**

- Had nine tackles, a sack and 2.5 tackles for loss.
- Tied for the team lead in tackles, making it 18 times he has led the team or tied for the team lead in tackles (all over the last 27 games).
- The 2.5 TFL tied a season high.

* **Dwayne Johnson Jr., Jr., AZT (9 tackles)**

- Had nine tackles.
- Tied for the team lead in tackles, making it three times this season (and for his career) that he led the team in tackles.

* **Matt Araiza, RS-Fr., K (2-for-2 FG, Long 44, 1-for-1 PAT)**

- Was 2-for-2 in field goal attempts and 1-for-1 in PATs.
- Had multiple field goals for the fourth straight game and sixth time this season (and career).
- Is now 16-for-18 on the season in field goal attempts. His 88.9 field goal percentage is third in SDSU single-season history.

Other Notes

- WAR Tariq Thompson started for the 35th consecutive game, the longest streak on the team (offense/defense).
- LB Troy Cassidy played in his 46th straight game, the longest streak on the team.
- CB Darren Hall recorded his first interception of the season and third of his career.
- Tonight's attendance was 27,973.
- Tonight's weather was 64 degrees.
- Tonight's Honor Warrior was Marshall Faulk (1991-93).
