SAN DIEGO STATE SELECTED MOUNTAIN WEST MEN'S BASKETBALL PRESEASON FAVORITE

The 2023 NCAA tournament runner-up San Diego State has been predicted to win the 2023-24 Mountain West regular-season title as voted on by select media and announced Thursday morning ahead of the Conference's media day.

The Aztecs received 25 first-place votes and earned 333 points in the 2023-24 MW Men's Basketball Predicted Order of Finish. SDSU returns four letterwinners from last year's squad, including two starters Lamont Butler and Darrion Trammell. Joining head coach Brian Dutcher and the Aztecs in 2023-24 are seven newcomers, headlined by MW Preseason Newcomer of the Year Reese Waters.

Boise State was picked second in the preseason poll with 299 points and four first-place votes, New Mexico was selected third with 278 points and a first-place vote. Nevada was picked fourth with 240 points and the remaining first-place vote.

Colorado State was chosen to finish fifth with 218 points, UNLV sixth with 199 points, San José State seventh with 124 points and Fresno State eighth with 115 points. Utah State is ninth with 105 points, Wyoming 10th with 74 points and Air Force is 11th with 61 points.

MW BY THE NUMBERS

- One MW team is ranked in the Associated Press poll as Colorado State ranks No. 13. Three other programs (Nevada, New Mexico, San Diego State) are receiving votes.
- The Mountain West is one of **two** conferences (Big 12) with at least four teams with one or fewer losses on the season.
- The Mountain West is one of **four** conferences (Big 12, 7; SEC, 6; MW, 5; Big Ten, 5) with five or more teams ranked among the top 40 of the current NET rankings.
- The Mountain West is one of **five** conferences (A10, Big 12, Big Ten, SEC) with at least five teams with 10 or more wins on the year.
- Among the 32 conferences, the Mountain West ranks seventh in NET rankings with an average NET of 102.5.
- Seven of the 11 MW teams have played in the NCAA tournament over the last eight seasons.
- Utah State has won 11 games in a row, which is tied for the fourth-longest win streak in the NCAA.
- Mountain West teams have posted 36 wins by 20 wins or more points this season.

MOUNTAIN WEST NOTEBOOK

- The Mountain West is celebrating its 25th season of men's basketball during the 2023-24 campaign.
- In the current NET rankings, the Mountain West has five programs ranked among the top 40: Colorado State (15), San Diego State (22), Nevada (34), New Mexico (36) and Utah State (38).
- The MW is one of three conferences (Big 12, Big Ten) that have every school ranked among the top 222 of the current NET rankings.
- The Mountain West is 103-38 (.730) in nonconference action in 2023-24, the fourth-best nonconference record among the 32 conferences. The MW has had a nonconference winning percentage of .600 or better in each of the last four seasons.
- The top five teams in the MW standings (Colorado State, Nevada, New Mexico, San Diego State and Utah State) are a combined 60-6 on the season.
- Best in the WEST. The Mountain West is 24-7 against the Pac-12 (6-1) and West Coast Conference (18-6) in 2023-24.
- The Mountain West is one of four conferences (Big 12, Big Ten, SEC) to have five or more teams with a winning percentage of .800 or better.
- The Mountain West is the only conference to have all its teams finish the nonconference slate with a winning percentage above .500.
- For the sixth week in a row, Colorado State is ranked in both the *Associated Press* poll and the *USA Today* Coaches poll. The Rams are No. 13 in the *AP* poll and rank No. 14 in the coaches poll.
- Heading into the ninth week of the season, Nevada, New Mexico and San Diego State are receiving votes in both of the national polls.
- Two MW guards rank among the top three in the nation in total assists. Utah State's **Darius Brown III** ranks second with 99 assists, while Colorado State's **Isaiah Stevens** is third with 95 assists.
- Two players from the Mountain West are among the top 16 in the country in double-doubles posted. San Diego State's Jaedon LeDee and Utah State's Great Osobor are tied for 16th with six each.
- Mountain West programs have won six nonconference tournaments
 this season. Colorado State won the Hall of Fame Classic, Nevada
 won the Diamond Head Classic, New Mexico won a share of the
 Ball Dawgs Classic title, San Diego State won both the SoCal
 Showcase and Continental Tire Main Event and Utah State won
 the Cayman Islands Classic.
