A former walk-on, who earned a scholarship for his last two seasons of competition... A fierce competitor, who earned his way into the rotation and ultimately the starting lineup... Played his first two seasons at CSUN and turned himself into an all-conference caliber player by the end of his senior campaign... Compiled 28 double-figure scoring performances... Played in 120 games over his four-year career.

### At San Diego State

Played two highly successful seasons at SDSU... Played in 65 games and received the starting nod 28 times, including 27 in his final campaign... Helped the Aztecs to a 58-14 record, two straight Mountain West regular-season titles and two appearances in the NCAA tournament, including 2014's Sweet 16 berth... Scored in double figures 20 times... Led the team in scoring 14 times, rebounding three times and assists 14 times... Finished with the 16th highest conference victories total (30), the 17th-most three-pointers in school history (82) and the 21st-best three-point field-goal percentage (.360).

### As A Senior (2014-15 Season)

Named an all-Mountain West third-team performer by the coaches and the media... Played in 33 games, starting 27 times, including the final 26 games... Enjoyed a career season in which he averaged a career-best 10.7 points, 2.8 rebounds and 1.0 steals, while adding 1.5 assists... Shot a career-high 41.6 percent from the field and made a personal-best 54 three-pointers, which was the most on the team... Scored in double figures 16 times, including three 20-point efforts... Led the team in scoring 14 times, rebounding twice and in assists 11 times... Knocked down multiple three-pointers 13 times... Committed one turnover or less 23 times and only had five turnovers in his final 130 minutes... Led SDSU in scoring for the first time of his career with 15 points vs. CSUN (11-14-14)... Scored a career-high 22 points, his first 20-point effort of his career, on a personal-record eight field goals, including six three-pointers, in a career-best 38 minutes vs. Brigham Young (11-24-14)...

Knocked down a three-pointer with 10 seconds left in overtime to tie the game and force double overtime vs. BYU... Scored SDSU's first 12 points in the first 4 minutes, 12 seconds vs. UC Riverside (12-22-14) and ultimately finished with 18 points (5-8 3FG) in 21 minutes... Scored a team-high 19 points on a career-high-tying eight field goals, and dished a team-best three assists at Fresno State (1-3-15)... Led the team in scoring for the third straight game, going for a game-high 17 points on 5-of-7 shooting from three, and added four assists and zero turnovers in 27 minutes at Air Force (1-20-15)... Scored in double figures for a career-best fourth straight game when he went for 10 points at Colorado State (1-24-15)... Continued his scoring spree by putting up a game-high 16, with a career-high seven coming off free-throws, vs. Fresno State (1-27-15)... Led the team in scoring with 15 points and added two steals vs. Utah State (1-31-15)... Had a game-high 18 points (4-5 3FG) in 18 minutes and added a game-high three assists vs. Wyoming (2-11-15)... Knocked down a career-high eight field goals (four three-pointers) to lead all players with 20 points at New Mexico (2-17-15)... Led all players with 12 points and a season-high five assists vs. Nevada (3-7-15)... Exploded for a game-high 21 points on 8-for-10 shooting (5-6 3FG) at UNLV (3-12-15) in the MW quarterfinals... Made half of his shots (5-10 FG, 3-6 3FG) en route to a team-high 16 points in the MW semifinals vs. Colorado State (3-13-15)... At the MW Championship, led the Aztecs in scoring (12.3 points), connected on 52.0 percent (13-of-25) from the field, 50.0 percent (8-of-16) from three-point range, had three steals and did not commit a turnover in 87 minutes... Led all players with a season-high five assists vs. St. John's (3-20-15) in the second round of the NCAA tournament... Battled a stomach ailment in the third round of the NCAA tournament vs. Duke (3-22-15) and finished with six points and two rebounds in 24 minutes.

### As A Junior (2013-14 Season)

Played in 32 games (one start), including the final 29... Averaged 5.0 points and 1.6 rebounds... Had four double-figure

scoring games... Led SDSU in assists three times and in rebounding once... One of three rotation players with a better than 1.00 assist-to-turnover ratio (1.35)... Committed more than one turnover just four times... Had 17 turnover-free games... Recorded multiple steals five times... Knocked down at least one three-pointer 17 times and multiple threes on six different occasions... Ended the season with at least one three-pointer made in 17 of his last 26 games in which he attempted one... Enjoyed a six-game stretch (Dec. 18-Jan. 8) where he went 13-for-29 from behind the three-point arc (.448)... Played at least 20 minutes 11 times... Scored 14 points and pulled down a career-best seven rebounds vs. Southern Utah (12-18-13)... Performed well off the bench as he finished with 12 points, two assists and a career-high five steals vs. McNeese State (12-21-13)... Scored 14 points, including a career-high four three-pointers, and recorded a game- and season-high six assists, zero turnovers and two steals vs. St. Katherine College (12-27-13)... Pulled down six rebounds, which was one off his career high, and added three points at No. 16/17 Kansas (1-5-14)... Played huge minutes down the stretch before finishing with a season-high 28, while adding seven points, one assist, zero turnovers and one steal in the overtime win at Utah State (1-25-14)... Started his first career game at SDSU and turned in eight points in 24 minutes vs. Colorado State (2-1-14)... Enjoyed one of his finest games with a career-high 17 points on a career-high six field goals (6-7) and four three-pointers (4-5), and a team-high six rebounds and two assists in 25 minutes at Fresno State (3-1-14)... Scored six points vs. Utah State in the MW quarterfinals (3-13-14)... Played nine minutes in the NCAA second-round game vs. New Mexico State (3-20-14)... Made a three-pointer coming out a timeout and with one second left on the shot clock before finishing with five points and two rebounds vs. North Dakota State (3-22-14) in the third round of the NCAA tournament... Saw action in the NCAA Sweet 16 vs. No. 4/5 Arizona (3-27-14).

### As A Redshirt (2012-13 Season)

Used his redshirt season after transferring from Cal State Northridge prior to the 2012-13 academic year... Practiced with the team throughout the campaign.

### As A Sophomore at Cal State Northridge (2011-12 Season)

Saw action in 23 games and earned the starting nod 10 times... Averaged 6.8 points, the fifth-highest on the squad, and 2.1 rebounds in 21.1 minutes... Shot 83.1 percent from the free-throw line...

Connected on 20 three-pointers, the third-highest total on the team... Scored in double figures four times... First career start came vs. CSU Bakersfield (11-30-11) and he finished with five points and a season-high four assists... Grabbed a personal-best six boards at Santa Clara (12-3-11)... Went for a career-high 17 points at Pepperdine (12-10-11)... Followed with 10 points and a career-high six rebounds vs. Pacifica (12-17-11)... Scored 15 points and had a season-high four assists vs. UC Irvine (12-29-11)... Recorded 12 points and a career-high three steals vs. Long Beach State (1-7-12).

### As A Freshman at Cal State Northridge (2010-11 Season)

Played in 32 games as a true freshman... Averaged 3.2 points and 1.4 rebounds... Scored in double figures three times... Saw minutes increase in the last 19 games as he averaged 16.4 minutes during that time frame... Was 14-for-29 from beyond the arc in his last 16 games... Recorded 11 points and a season-high four rebounds vs. Cal State Fullerton (1-5-11)... Scored a career-high 12 points and added a personal-best seven assists vs. UC Irvine (2-5-11).

### High School

Attended Leuzinger High in Hawthorne, Calif.... Helped Leuzinger to the CIF Southern Section Div. I-A title in 2009-10... Averaged 12.3 points, 4.2 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 1.3 steals as a senior... Guided the Olympians to a 25-7 record in his final campaign... Earned first-team all-Bay League honors and was a first-team all-CIF Southern Section Div. I-A pick.
