AZTECS CONCLUDE 2010 SEASON WITH VISITS TO TCU & NEW MEXICO

- ◆ San Diego State will wrap up its 2010 campaign with a pair of Mountain West Conference matches on the road this week.
- On Wednesday, Nov. 24, the Aztecs will be in Fort Worth, Texas, to take on TCU at 7:00 p.m. (MT) at the University Recreation Center.
- ◆ On Friday, Nov. 26, SDSU will play its season finale against New Mexico at UNM's Johnson Center at 7:00 p.m. (MT).

SERIES RECORDS

- ◆ San Diego State has a record of 7-6 against TCU, but the Frogs have won six of the most recent nine meetings. That record includes a five-set Aztec victory in Peterson Gym in late September. The first two contests between the teams came during the 1997 season when SDSU and the Horned Frogs were members of the Western Athletic Conference. San Diego State won 3-0 in Peterson Gym and 3-1 in Fort Worth. The Aztecs are 4-3 vs. TCU in Peterson Gym and 3-3 in Fort Worth.
- ♦ The Aztecs are 28-17 in the series against New Mexico after defeating the Lobos in four sets earlier this season. Although SDSU has recorded wins in 15 of the last 22 meetings between the teams, the Lobos have been victorious in seven of the last nine. The series goes back to 1976 when the Lobos claimed a 3-1 victory in Peterson Gym. The schools have met annually since 1990 when both were members of the Western Athletic Conference. SDSU has a 9-9 mark against the Lobos in Albuquerque, 14-8 in San Diego and 5-0 on neutral courts.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

- ▶ TCU's record stands at 13-16 (4-11 MWC) as it prepares to play the Aztecs on Thursday. The Horned Frogs have lost six in a row and 10 of their last 11 matches. TCU is led by Irene Hester (3.69 kills, 2.83 digs per set) and Christy Hudson (2.62 kills, 2.77 digs per set). Hester leads the Mountain West Conference in kill average as well as points (4.30 per set) and service aces (0.39 per set).
- ♦ New Mexico enters the week with an overall record of 19-9 and a mark of 11-4 in the Mountain West Conference. The Lobos had an eight-match winning streak stopped at Brigham Young last Saturday. Top offensive players include Lisa Meeter (3.39 kills, 3.12 digs per set) and Taylor Hadfield (3.12 kills, 1.10 digs per set). UNM is holding opponents to just a .189 hitting percentage on the year.

COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- San Diego State Head Coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her second season with the Aztecs after being named the fourth head coach in program history last year.
- ◆ She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her record at SDSU is 30-29 (.508) and her career mark stands at 192-220 (.466).
- ◆ A three-time All-American as a player at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- Collins-Parker was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- She was one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

WINNING RECORD

- With wins in its final two home matches last week, San Diego State has ensured that it will finish the 2010 season at .500 or better.
- ◆ The last time that happened was in 2005 when the Aztecs ended with record of 16-16 overall and 8-8 in the Mountain West Conference.
- SDSU enters the week with a mark of 16-14 (8-6 MWC) with two matches remaining on it schedule.
- ◆ If Aztecs win one of their final two road contests they would finish above .500 both overall and in league play.

◆ The last time that happened was in 2002 when they finished 22-12 overall and 11-3 in the MWC.

SALISBURY'S RETURNS

- Since her return three matches ago, middle blocker Lauren Salisbury has averaged 2.13 kills and 1.13 blocks per set while hitting .469.
- ◆ She had suffered a wrist injury on Sept. 28 and was expected to miss the remainder of the 2010 season.
- With two matches remaining in her SDSU career, the senior is 16 kills shy of reaching the 1,000 mark.
- Salisbury is a two-time all-conference selection and was named to the 2010 preseason all-MWC squad as well.
- ◆ With a total of 41 block assists this season, her career total of 338 ranks 10th all-time and is three behind Angelica Jackson's (1984-87) ninth-highest total of 341.
- ◆ Salisbury's career hitting percentage of .328 ranks fifth on the Aztec top 10 list in that category.

MANASCO HEATS UP

- Senior Kelsey Manasco had one of her best matches of the season in the Senior Day contest against Air Force on Nov. 20.
- She recorded a career-high .611 hitting percentage and tied her season best with 12 kills.
- She also contributed four digs, two assists and a service ace in the win over the Falcons.
- Manasco had previously set a career high with a .550 hitting percentage in the win over UC Riverside on Oct. 26.

- Her 12 kills in that contest represented a season high as did her four block assists and 15.0 points.
- Against Wyoming (Oct. 28) she again recorded four block assists and added a season-high four assists which also tied her Aztec career best.

SHELTON SHINES

- In last weekend's two matches (vs. UNLV and Air Force), freshman Raegan Shelton averaged 4.00 kills and had a .400 hitting percentage.
- ◆ She tied her career best with 20 kills in the win over Brigham Young on Nov. 6.
- Her three blocks and six digs in that match were both one shy of her season bests.
- ◆ After missing four matches due to injury, Shelton came off the bench in the second set against Wyoming on Oct. 28 to notch 14 kills, four blocks, two service aces and a .414 attack percentage in the win over the Cowgirls.
- ◆ The four blocks represented her career high as an Aztec.
- ◆ In the win over host Arizona State on Sept. 3, she recorded a career-high 20 kills while hitting .500 for the match.
- ◆ She leads the team in kill average of 2.97 per set.

SEXTON LEADS THE OFFENSE

- Kyley Sexton's 11 kills in the win over UNLV on Nov. 18 led the Aztecs in that match.
- It marked the 15th time this season that she reached double figure in kills in a match.
- She added seven against Air Force to average 3.00 kills per set in last week's two contests.
- She is second on the team in kill average at 2.91 per set and is second in points (3.30 per set).
- Sexton recorded her fifth double-double of the season with 16 kills and 13 blocks in the win over TCU on Sept. 25.
- ◆ She set a career-high with 25 kills in the match vs. UCSB on Sept. 18. Her 27 points in that match was also a career best
- ◆ In the match against UC Irvine on Sept. 11, she set a career high with 21 digs.

FOUCH SETTING IT UP

- Freshman setter Johnna Fouch was perfect on seven kill attempts in SDSU's two matches last week (vs. UNLV and Air Force), hitting 1.000 over those contests.
- ◆ She continues to lead the MWC in assists with an average of 10.59 per set.
- Her assist average also ranks 56th in the nation (NCAA Division I), up four spots from a week ago.
- Fouch recorded 54 assists in the win at Brigham Young (Nov. 6), her secondhighest total of the season and just one short of her career high.
- ◆ Her 54 assists vs. BYU was the sixth time this season that she has had more than 50 in a match.
- She has had at least one block in each of the past six matches.
- She recorded her 10th double-double of the fall with 47 assists and 13 digs at Utah on Nov. 4.
- In the match vs. UC Irvine in Honolulu on Sept. 11, she set career bests with five total blocks and 32 digs.

HANNASCH PROVIDES SPARK

- Middle blocker Andrea Hannasch's overall blocking average of 1.25 per set equals her mark in MWC matches only.
- ◆ That average ranks third and fourth in the overall and league-only stats.
- ◆ Her two-year blocking average stands at 1.18 blocks pre set.
- She tied her career high in kills on Nov.
 4 at Utah and then set a new career-best two days later at Brigham Young.
- At Utah on Nov. 4, she recorded 16 kills to equal her personal best as an Aztec which she had achieved on five occasions.

- ◆ She is currently 31st in the nation in blocking. Those rankings include athletes from 319 Division I teams.
- ♦ Her average of 3.45 points per set leads the Aztecs.
- ◆ In addition, she is averaging 2.60 kills and 1.30 digs per set.

NASH ON THE ATTACK

- Freshman Summer Nash's last action came vs. CSU Bakersfield on Nov. 13. In that match she averaged 3.5 kills and 1.00 blocks per set.
- She set her career high in kills for the fourth time in five matches with 16 against Utah on Nov. 4.
- Nash had a string of six straight double figures kill matches end with the contest at Brigham Young on Nov. 6. In those matches she averaged 3.55 kills per set.
- ◆ Her kill average of 3.00 per set in conference matches would rank ninth in the league stats, but she is one set short of the number required to qualify for listing in the MWC statistics.
- ◆ Her .333 attack percentage in the contest at Brigham Young (Nov. 6) marked the 11th time in 22 matches this season that she has hit better than .300 in a match

JACKELS DIGS CAREER BEST

- Over SDSU's last five matches, libero Kristi Jackels has averaged 4.47 digs per set.
- ◆ She set a career high with 32 digs at Brigham Young on Nov. 6.
- ◆ Jackels becomes just the seventh Aztec to ever record 30 or more digs in a match, joining current teammate Johnna Fouch (who had 30 vs. UC Irvine in September) on that list.
- Her previous high in digs came at UC Santa Barbara in the final match of the 2009 season.
- She ranks sixth in the conference in digs this week with an average of 3.63 per set.
- Jackels had back-to-back 18-dig efforts earlier this season against Utah State and Arizona State.
- ♦ She has been in double figures in digs in 24 of SDSU's 30 matches.
- ◆ Her four aces against Northern Colorado on Aug. 28 are the most by an Aztec this year.
- She has recorded at least one assist in each of the last 12 matches and 20 of the last 21.
- Her four assists against Air force last Saturday (Nov. 20) matched her season best.

OROPEZA ON DEFENSE

- Freshman defensive specialist Kyla
 Oropeza has seen action in 29 of SDSU's
 30 matches this season and started on three occasions.
- She recorded eight digs in SDSU's two matches last week for a mark of 1.25 per set, just under her season average.
- Oropeza is averaging 1.33 digs per set and has appeared in 99 of the team's 110 sets this fall.
- In the win over Utah (Oct. 9), she had her second-highest dig total of the season with nine and tied her season best with two assists.
- She set her SDSU high with three assists in the win over Air Force last Saturday (Nov. 20).
- ◆ She was the server in the fifth set vs. the Utes on Oct. 9 when SDSU came from behind (7-13) to score eight straight points and win the match.

PEACOCK AT HER BEST

- Outside hitter Jessica Peacock is averaging 2.54 kills over her last four matches.
- She had seven kills and four blocks in the win over UNLV last Thursday (Nov. 18).
- ◆ She tied her SDSU career bests with six block assists and two service aces in the win over Cal state Bakersfield last Saturday (Nov. 13).

- She previously had her season high in blocks with six against UC Santa Barbara on Sept. 18.
- She set a career high hitting percentage (.562) in the contest vs. Seattle on Oct.
 15
- ◆ She had established career best in with 17 kills in the win over Utah on Oct. 9.
- Her 18.5 points in that match against Utah was her best total as an Aztec as well.

PEARSON PROVIDES SPARK

- ◆ Junior outside hitter Paije Pearson has totaled 10 blocks in the Aztecs' last three matches for an average of 1.11 per set.
- Her six block assists at Cal State
 Fullerton was her second-highest total of
 the season.
- She had a solid match in last Saturday's win at Brigham Young, finishing with six kills, nine digs, five blocks and a service ace.
- Pearson set a career high with seven blocks assists and seven total blocks in the win over Wyoming on Oct. 28.
- ◆ She has recorded six total blocks in a match three times this season. In addition to the Fullerton match, she also did it in contests vs. Utah and Seattle.
- ◆ Her 10 digs vs. Wyoming (Oct. 28) was the third time she reached double figures in that category this season.

CRACKING THE TOP 10

- In addition to Lauren Salisbury being among the top 10 in career hitting percentage (fifth) at .328, the SDSU record book will have a couple of other new top 10 entries by the end of the season.
- Andrea Hannasch is ninth in career block assists with 346 (Shannon Matthew is No. 8 at 358).
- ◆ With 124 this fall, Hannasch is also two block assists away from adding her name to the single-season top 10 in that category (Jennifer Hamilton and Megan Schauermann are tied for 10th with 126).
- ◆ Freshman setter Johnna Fouch enters the week with 1,165 assists and needs to average just 23 assists per match over SDSU's final two contests to crack the top 10. Andrea Clark currently ranks 10th with 1,211 assists in 1996.
- Salisbury has moved into the 10th spot in career block assists with 338 and needs three move into the No. 9 position.
- With 399 this season digs, Kristi Jackels' total ranks as the ninth-most in a season by an Aztec.

AZTECS IN THE OVERALL MWC STATS

- ◆ Johnna Fouch leads the league's setters at 10.59 assists per set.
- ◆ Andrea Hannasch is fourth in blocking (1.25 per set).
- Kristi Jackels is sixth in digs at 3.63 per set.
- ◆ Lauren Salisbury is sixth in hitting percentage (.311).

AZTECS IN THE LEAGUE-ONLY MWC STATS

- ◆ In league-only matches, Johnna Fouch ranks fifth in assists at 10.21 per set.
- Andrea Hannasch is fourth in blocks at 1.25 per set and 10th in points at 3.59 per set.
- Raegan Shelton stands ninth in kills at 3.17 per set.
- Kristi Jackels ranks sixth in digs at 3.55 per set.

AZTEC ON THE BLOCK

- SDSU's team blocking total (15.0 blocks -1 solo, 28 assists) against Cal State Bakersfield on Nov. 13 was its highest of the season.
- ◆ The 28 assists was the team's highest total in a match since recording the same figure at Air Force on Nov. 13, 2009.
- As a team SDSU has finished in double figures in blocking in 11 matches this fall including the last three in a row.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- In the win over UC Irvine on Sept. 18, the Aztecs recorded 108 digs as a team, their highest total in a match in over 10 years.
- In that contest, setter Johnna Fouch led SDSU with 32 digs, the most in a match by an Aztec since Aime Cordeiro had 33 against BYU on Nov. 2, 2007.
- The 32 digs were the 10th-most ever in a match by an SDSU player.

FRESHMEN NUMBERS

- San Diego State is one of three teams in the nation that lists nine true freshmen on its 2010 roster.
- Defending national champion Penn State and South Carolina are the only other two Division I schools with that many first-year players.
- Both Auburn and Maryland-Baltimore County have nine freshmen on their rosters, but that number includes redshirt freshmen who were at the schools last season.
- Among Mountain West Conference schools, UNLV has eight true freshmen and Air Force six.

ALL TOURNAMENT AZTECS

- ◆ Aztec junior outside hitters Kyley Sexton and Paije Pearson were named to the all-tournament team at the Aztec Invitational (Aug. 27-28) with Sexton picking up tournament MVP honors.
- ◆ Sexton average 3.90 kills, 2.40 digs and 0.50 blocks over SDSU's three matches.
- ◆ Pearson hit .300 with averages of 3.78 kills, 3.00 digs and 0.44 blocks.
- Outside hitter Raegan Shelton was named to the all-tournament team at the ASU Sheraton Classic in Tempe, Ariz., during the weekend of Sept. 3-4.
- Shelton averaged 3.40 kills and 3.79 points per set while hitting .389 over SDSU's three matches.
- ◆ Kyley Sexton was named to the alltournament team at the USD/SDSU Challenge (Sept. 17-18), her second alltourney honor of the 2010 season.
- ♦ Over SDSU's three matches she averaged 3.42 kills and 1.28 digs per set.

HANNASCH PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Middle blocker Andrea Hannasch was named the Mountain West Conference Player of the Week for her effort in the matches against New Mexico and TCU (Sept. 23 and 25).
- ◆ In a three-set sweep of New Mexico at home, Hannasch led all players with 12 kills and a career-best .688 hitting percentage. In the 3-2 home win over TCU, Hannasch tied a career-high with 16 kills.
- ◆ For the week, Hannasch averaged 3.50 kills, 1.62 blocks and 4.50 points per set, while hitting .535 (28-5-43) over eight sets. She also had two assists, one service ace and six digs in the two matches.
- Hannasch shared the MWC Player of the Week award with Colorado State middle blocker Megan Plourde.

PEARSON PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Paije Pearson was named the Mountain West Conference Player of the Week on Aug. 30 for her efforts during the season's opening weekend Aztec Invitational.
- She began tourney play with a 14-kill, six dig effort in the win over CSU Northridge. The 14 kills tied her SDSU career high at the time.
- ◆ In the Aztecs' sweep of Northern Colorado, she collected six kills, three digs and one block, then followed with career highs in kills (15) and digs (18) in the tournament's championship match vs. Cincinnati.

AZTEC NOTES

- Freshman defensive specialist Justine Ricigliano tied her season high with seven digs in the win at Brigham Young on Nov. 6.
- ◆ As a team, San Diego State has hit .300 or better in eight matches, their highest total since it reached that mark in nine matches during the 2005 campaign.
- ◆ The Aztecs are 15-2 in matches in which they have led in kills. They are 1-12 when trailing in kills.
- ◆ SDSU had only 11 attack errors vs. Air Force, the fourth time this season they have had that few in a match.
- ◆ The Aztecs are 3-3 in five-set matches this season.
- Andrea Hannasch is the lone Aztec to have recorded at least one block in each of SDSU's matches this season.
- ◆ Johnna Fouch is the only Aztec to have started every match this season. Fouch and libero Kristi Jackels are the only players to have appeared in every set in 2010.
