WHAT'S ON TAP THIS WEEK IN AZTEC BASEBALL

- Following Tuesday's 2-0 loss at USC, San Diego State will now return to Mountain West action with a three-game series vs. San Jose State at home this weekend.
- The opening game of that set is scheduled for Friday, March 31, at 6:00 p.m. at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- The Aztecs and Spartans will also meet up for games on Saturday (April 1) and Sunday (April 2) at 2:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. PT respectively.

AZTECS ON THE AIR

- Friday's game against San Jose State will be streamed live on the Mountain Digital Network. Saturday's and Sunday's contests will be broadcast on 1700 AM radio in San Diego.
- In addition, live stats will also be available for all three contests vs. SJSU. Links for the video and radio broadcasts as well as live stats will be on the SDSU web site.
- A total of 14 of SDSU's 31 home games this season will have live video streaming on the Mountain Digital Network. In addition, nine contests will be broadcast live on ESPN 1700 in San Diego with the remaining 13 carried live on KCR.

SERIES RECORD

- The Aztecs have a record of 65-30 against San Jose State in a series that began in 1938.
- Last season the Aztecs won the lone weekend series between the teams, taking two of three contests in San Jose in mid-May. SDSU also defeated the Spartans in the opening game of the Mountain West Tournament by a score of 7-3. SDSU is 13-4 vs. SJSU since the Spartans joined the Mountain West for the 2014 season.
- The Aztecs are 35-12 vs. San Jose State in San Diego, 26-18 in San Jose and 4-0 at neutral sites.

SCOUTING THE SPARTANS

- San Jose State enters the week with a record of 9-14 overall and 5-4 in the Mountain West, tied for third place in the league standings. The Spartans will host Santa Clara Wednesday night before traveling to San Diego.
- SJSU is led by shortstop Aaron Pleschner (.348, 3 2B, 7 RBI) and center fielder Kellen Strahm (.341, 3 2B, 4 RBI). First baseman Shane Timmons leads the team with three home runs and 14 RBI.
- The Spartans are hitting .261 as a team with a 5.63 earned run average.

HEAD COACH MARK MARTINEZ



- Mark Martinez is in his third season as head coach of the Aztecs although he is in his 12th season as a member of the San Diego State staff. He is just the fifth head coach in SDSU history since baseball was elevated to major sport status in 1936.
- > His record as head coach at SDSU stands at 78-70 (.527).
- Martinez was hired as an assistant coach for the Aztecs prior to the 2006 season and served for nine years under Head Coach Tony Gwynn. During that time, he was promoted to the position of Associate Head Coach.
- > Prior to his arrival at SDSU, Martinez was an assistant coach at the University of New Mexico for 17 seasons. During his time as a hitting and infield coach, he helped develop

the Lobos into one of the most prominent offensive teams in the nation, ranking among the top 11 in the nation in hitting his final four seasons.

- > Martinez served as an assistant at his alma mater, Mesa State College in Grand Junction, Colo., from 1984-88. He played shortstop at the school from 1982-84, earning all-conference and all-district honors as a senior.
- > He graduated from Mesa State with a bachelor's degree in physical education in 1984 and completed his master's in sports administration at New Mexico in 1990.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK (AGAIN)

- > Outfielder Tyler Adkison made it back-to-back Mountain West Player of the Week awards when he earned the honor for games played March 20-26.
- Over last week's four games, Adkison (Culver City, Calif., Mater Dei HS) hit .538 with a triple, home run, seven walks and seven RBI.
- > He compiled a 1.048 slugging percentage and a .700 on-base mark.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- > Senior lefty Brett Seeburger earned his first conference Pitcher of the Week award for his performance in the second aame of Saturday's (March 25) doubleheader at Fresno State.
- > In that contest, he tossed a one hit shutout over eight innings, allowing just an infield single and facing one batter over the minimum.
- >> Seeburger retired the first 14 batters he faced before allowing a two-out infield single in the bottom of the fifth inning. He went on to retire the next 10 batters through the eighth inning.
- > Over his eight innings of work, he struck out a season-high seven batters and did not allow a walk, while throwing 97 pitches.
- > For his effort Seeburger was also selected a National Player of the Week by *Collegiate Baseball* and the Madness Mountain West Baseball Player of the Week by *CollegeSportsMadness.com*.

TREJO COMING ON

- Second baseman Alan Trejo is currently on a 15-game hitting streak during which he is batting .342 (26-for-76) with six doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI and 17 runs scored.
- > He had a string of scoring at least once in 11 consecutive games end in the loss at USC on Tuesday (March 28). He has now done so in 14 of the last 16 contests.
- > Trejo leads the team in runs scored, doubles and stolen bases.
- He led off the contest at No. 25 USD on March 14 with a home run on the first pitch of the game. It was the first time SDSU opened the game with a homer by the leadoff batter since Justin Wylie did it last season at Cal State Fullerton.
- > Trejo has also made six appearances on the mound this season and is 0-1 with a 2.57 earned run average.

BROWN STAYS CONSISTENT

- > Third baseman Andrew Brown continues to be one of the Aztecs' most consistent hitters.
- > Over the past 11 games he is hitting .412 (21-for-51) with two doubles, seven RBI and 10 runs scored.
- > He had a personal season-best seven-game hitting streak end in the series finale vs. Cal Poly on March 5.
- > During that streak he batted .355 (11-for-31) with two doubles, a home run, six RBI and five runs scored.
- > Brown leads the squad with 40 hits. He is second on the team in RBI with 17 and in doubles with six.

ADKISON ON FIRE

- > Outfielder Tyler Adkison is hitting .585 (24-for-41) over SDSU's last 11 games with four doubles, a triple, six home runs, 23 RBI and 16 runs scored.
- > His slugging percentage over that span in 1.171 and he has a .667 on-base mark in those games.
- Entering the week, he led NCAA Division I in batting average (.537), slugging percentage (1.074) and on-base percentage (.623).
- Adkison set an SDSU record by reaching base 15 consecutive times (via either a hit or walk) from March 18 to March 25. In those four games, he had four singles, three doubles, a triple, 2 HR and five walks.
- > His 10 consecutive hits over that span was also a new SDSU record.
- > In the contest at Nevada on March 11, he hit two home runs. The last time an Aztec had two homers in a game prior to that was when Adkison hit a pair at Air Force on March 20, 2016.
- Adkison has two four-hit games and two five-RBI contests this season. He is the lone Aztec with a four-hit game and one of two players (along with Dean Nevarez) to have five RBI in a game.

VERDON STREAK ENDS

- > First baseman Jordan Verdon had a seven-game hitting streak end last Tuesday (March 21) in the game against Long Beach State. During that streak he hit .345 (10-for-29) with a home run, seven RBI and six runs scored.
- > He had scored at least once in each of the last eight contests prior to the shutout at USC on Tuesday (March 28). He has now crossed the plate in 11 of SDSU's last 13 games.
- > Verdon had a nine-game streak earlier in the year.
- > During that streak he went 13-for-37 (.351) with a double, two triples, five RBI and six runs scored.
- > He is second on the team in multiple-RBI games with six.
- > He hit his third home run of the year, a three-run shot, in the 12-0 win at Fresno State last Saturday (March 25)
- > He is the lone SDSU infielder without an error after 25 games (252 chances).

ERICKSON PROVIDES RELIEF

- > Junior left-hander Jacob Erickson has been impressive out of the bullpen this season.
- > In his last 12 appearances covering 18.2 innings, he has allowed one run on 13 hits with six strikeouts.
- > In the process, he has lowered his earned run average to 1.54.
- > He picked up a win on March 25 at Fresno State, tossing two perfect innings in SDSU's 5-4 win over the Bulldogs.
- > In his victory at No. 25 USD on March 14, he tossed three innings, facing 10 batters and allowing just a single.
- > Erickson has been involved in three of the Aztecs' four shutout wins in 2017.

SHEEHAN HITS AWAY

- After redshirting during the 2016 season, senior Danny Sheehan has returned for his final year and claimed the starting shortstop role he held in 2015.
- > He is currently on a 10-game hitting streak during which he has gone 15-for-37 (.405) with five doubles, six RBI and nine runs scored.
- Sheehan has been hit by pitch eight times this season to bring his career total to 21. That ranks 11th on the SDSU all-time top 20 in that category.

BIBLE RETURNS

- > Last week, sophomore outfielder Chad Bible made just his second appearance since beginning chemotherapy treatment for Hodgkin's lymphoma that was diagnosed in January.
- > As a pinch hitter in the bottom of the eighth in the contest vs. Long Beach State March 21, he doubled down the right field line to drive home SDSU's final run in the victory over LBSU.
- > Bible started in left field in each of SDSU's first five contests this season, going 6-for-20 with a double and an RBI.
- > He also made a pinch-hitting appearance on March 7 vs. USC and is now batting .318 in the seven games he has played.

MARTINEZ SOLID AT DH

- Designated hitter Andrew Martinez had a pair of hits in the game at USC on Tuesday (March 28) to raise his batting average to .317.
- > He connected for his third home run of the season, a two-run shot, in the game vs. Long Beach State on March 21.
- > He also had a run-scoring single in that game to end the night with three RBI.
- > He has been the Aztecs' designated hitter in 24 of their 25 contests in 2017.
- > Martinez played the past three seasons at UC Irvine, graduating last year with one season of eligibility remaining after redshirting there one year (2013).
- > The native of nearby Chula Vista (Mater Dei HS), he chose to compete for the Aztecs in his final season.

NEVAREZ GOES DEEP

- Catcher Dean Nevarez saw a season best four-game hitting streak end in the series finale at Fresno State on Sunday (March 26).
- > Over those four games he went 7-for-12 (.583) with a double, two home runs and seven RBI.
- > His two home runs came in the series finale against UNLV in San Diego on March 19.
- He is the second Aztec to homer twice in a game this season as Tyler Adkison accomplished the feat against Nevada in Reno on March 11.

CALABUIG HEATING UP

- > Prior to Tuesday's contest at USC., center fielder Chase Calabuig had gone 12-for-39 (.308) over the previous 10 games with four doubles, two triples, a home run, six RBI and seven runs scored.
- > He had a .590 slugging percentage over those 10 games.
- In the first 14 contests of the season, he had totaled seven hits and posted a .171 batting average, which he has raised by over 60 points (.232) in the last 11 contests.

SAYLOR STANDS TALL ON THE MOUND

- > Senior right-hander CJ Saylor has recorded five saves along with a win this season as the Aztecs' closer.
- > His latest save came last Saturday (March 25) when he tossed the ninth inning of SDSU's 5-4 win at Fresno State.
- After surrendering his second and third earned runs of the year in the finale at Fresno State on Sunday (March 26), his ERA now stands at 1.93 and opponents are hitting .235 against him.

PURPURA IMPRESSIVE

- > Senior left-hander Dominic Purpura had his second no-decision of the season in the opener at Fresno State on Saturday (March 25)
- > In that contest he tossed six innings, allowing four runs on eight hits.
- > In both of his no-decisions in 2017, the Aztecs rallied to win the game.
- > His six strikeouts in his first appearance of the year vs. Pacific on Feb. 19 tied his SDSU career high.

- > Junior outfielder Tyler Adkison was named the Mountain West Player of the Week for his performance in SDSU's four games during the week of March 14-20.
- In the contest at USD (March 14) and three-games vs. UNLV (March 17-19), he batted .688 (11-for-16) with three doubles, three home runs and 11 RBI.
- > He compiled a 1.438 slugging percentage and a .737 on-base average in the four games.
- > His homers came in three different contests and he struck out only once in 19 plate appearances.
- > Adkison was also named the Madness Mountain West Player of the Week by CollegeSportsMadness.com.

STREAKS

- > Alan Trejo has the current longest hitting streak for the Aztecs at 16 games. Danny Sheehan has a 10-game streak in progress.
- > Trejo has reached base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in the past 16 games with Jordan Verdon next at 12 in a row.
- > Andrew Brown has recorded a team-leading 14 multiple-hit contests with Trejo and Adkison second at nine.
- > Adkison leads the team with seven multiple-RBI games with Verdon right behind him with six.

AZTEC NOTES

- > After opening the season with a 3-4 record, San Diego State is 13-5 in its last 18 contests.
- > Over the last 10 contests, the Aztecs are hitting .339 to .262 by opponent. They also have a team ERA of 3.92 while opponents' ERA is 6.62.
- > The Aztecs are 14-0 when leading after six innings, 14-1 when leading after seven and 16-0 when leading after eight.
- > SDSU has committed 16 errors in its first 25 contests for a .983 fielding percentage. The team record for fielding percentage in a season is .978 set during the 2013 campaign.
- > Logan Boyer has allowed no runs on just two hits with 10 strikeouts over his last seven relief appearances (9.1 innings).
- > Junior Jorge Fernandez has made two starts and five relief appearances this season and has yet to allow a run in his 14.1 innings pitched.

- > Sophomore Jordan Verdon's nine career sacrifice flies tie him for 20th on the SDSU career top20 list.
- > Hensley has hit safely in each of the past six contests, going 8-for-22 (.364) with a double, RBI and two runs scored.
