Big Notes

- The 44-point margin of victory is the 13th largest in school history and largest since a 53—point victory over Cal State Dominguez Hills (99-46) on Dec. 12, 2018.
- San Diego State scored a season high and Dutcher era high 92 points.
- San Diego State has won 25 straight games when scoring 90 or more points.
- The Aztecs shoot above 50 percent from the field and have won 80 straight games at home when making at least half of their field goal attempts.
- The Aztecs held their eighth opponent this season to 40 percent or less from the floor. SDSU has won 16 straight in that situation.
- San Diego State forced 22 turnovers, the most it has forced in a game this season.

Big Picture

- San Diego State remains one of four undefeated teams in the country.
- San Diego State improves to 11-0 and continues the second-best start in the program's 99 seasons.
- San Diego State's 11-game win streak is the longest of the Brian Dutcher era and equals the fourth longest in school history.
- In San Diego State history there have been seven win-streaks of at least 11 games. Brian Dutcher has been on the sidelines for six of them.
- Brian Dutcher improves to 2-0 lifetime against San Diego Christian as a head coach and overall is 9-0 against the Hawks (counts his time as an assistant).
- San Diego State has won all nine meetings against the Hawks and is a perfect 9-0 against SDC in Viejas Arena history.
- San Diego State is 89-14 in its last 103 home games.
- The Aztecs are 33-5 at home in the Dutcher era.
- San Diego State has won 17 straight games and are 49-8 in the Dutcher era when leading at intermission.
- San Diego State is 15-1 in its last 16 home games and is 33-5 at Viejas Arena in the Brian Dutcher era.
- The Aztecs are 53-14 in its last 67 games played during the month of December.
- San Diego State is 26-9 in its last 35 games played on Wednesdays

Game Trends

- Ten San Diego State players scored in tonight's game with four reaching double figures.
- After trailing 2-0, San Diego State scored the next 14 points of the game and never trailed after the run.

- San Diego State had first half runs of 14-0, 9-0 and 8-0.
- San Diego State had second half runs of 12-0, 8-0 and 7-0.
- Four of San Diego State's 16 first-half field goals were dunks.
- San Diego State forced San Diego Christian into 10 consecutive missed field goals.
- The Aztecs missed their final six shots of the game and still shot 52.4 percent from the field.

Yanni Wetzell – game-high 17 points, 7-10 FGs, game-high 6 rebounds, 2 steals

The senior reached double figures for the sixth time this season (6-0) and the 14th time in his career... Wetzell had 12 points combined in his previous two games... Led SDSU in scoring for the second time this season and in rebounds for the third time this season... Came into the game shooting 60.0 percent from the field and went 7-for-10 from the floor... He is now shooting 61.3 percent for the season.

KJ Feagin – 12 points, game-high 8 assists, 0 turnovers, 4 rebounds

Reached double figures for the fourth time this season (4-0) and the 60th time in his career... Produced a season-high and game-high eight assists with no turnovers... Now has 11 assists and no turnovers in his last two games and 40 assists and 16 turnovers this season... Connected on two treys marking his fourth multiple-trey game of the season.

Jordan Schakel – 10 points, 2-4 3FGs, 3 rebounds

Posted his seventh double-figure scoring game of the season and the 17th of his career (15-2)... This is his second straight double-figure scoring game (11 vs. SJSU)... Made two treys and has at least one three-point field goal in 10 of 11 games this season... Went 2-for-4 from distance and is 26-of-53 this season (49.1 percent).

Malachi Flynn – 10 points, 6 assists, 2 rebounds

After seeing his nine-game double-figure scoring game snapped, he reached double figures... He has 10+ points in 10 games this season and 47 games in his career... Posted his fourth game this season with six or more assists... Season totals: 56 assists, 15 turnovers, 3.73 assist-to-turnover ratio... Posted his seventh straight game with multiple treys.

Trey Pulliam – career-high 9 points, 4-6 FGs, 2 rebounds, 2 assists

Scored a career-high nine points (had seven points in previous four games combined)... Has an assist in each of his last 10 games... Made four field goals (had made no more than two in a game).

Nolan Narain – 3 points, 5 rebounds, 17 minutes played

Saw his first action of the season... Prior to tonight his last game action came on March 16, 2019... Had five rebounds in just 17 minutes of action.

Entering Today

- Entering the day, San Diego State was one of four unbeaten teams in the nation and the only one from either the Pacific Time Zone or the Mountain West Conference.
- San Diego State was 1st in NET.
- San Diego State was 1st in strength of record.
- San Diego State was 9th in the Sagarin Ratings.
- San Diego State was 20th in BPI.
- San Diego State was 32nd in KenPom
