No. 9 Men's Golf Heads To 15-Team U.S. Intercollegiate

The San Diego State men's golf team takes its four-tournament win streak to the Bay Area for the U.S Intercollegiate, March 30-April 1 in Stanford, Calif. The 54-hole, three-day event will take place at the par-70, 6,727-vard Stanford Golf

The Aztecs moved into the top 10 of the golfstat.com rankings this past Wednesday and are currently rated ninth nationally. They will be one of 15 teams in this weekend's tournament, which also includes No. 5 Washington, No. 6 UCLA, No. 8 USC, No. 12 Oregon and host and No. 13 Stanford. SDSU is the only Mountain West squad represented as Colorado, Fresno State, Nevada, Oregon State, Pepperdine, USF, San Jose State, UC Davis, Utah and Washington State round out

The Aztecs are returning to the U.S. Intercollegiate, after a one-year hiatus, as the 2011 edition was not played. The team was runner-up by just three strokes in its most recent appearance in 2010 behind only then No. 6 Oregon.

The tournament will feature live scoring on goaztecs.com, as well as golfstat.com. Schools will tee off from either the No. 1 or No. 10 holes starting as early as 8 a.m. PT each day.

After having eight golfers compete in the most recent tournament, ninth-year head coach Ryan Donovan will bring just five student-athletes with him to Stanford this week. Seniors Colin Featherstone (Fallbrook, Calif.), Matt Hoffenberg (Simi Valley, Calif.), Alex Kang (Oak Park, Calif.) and J.J. Spaun (San Dimas, Calif.) and junior Tom Berry (New Haw. England) compose the veteran line-up.

Spaun, Kang and Berry all participated in the most recent U.S. Intercollegiate back in 2010, while Hoffenberg played in the 2008 edition, finishing as the top Aztec in 13th place.

U.S. Intercollegiate Tid-Bits

The U.S. Intercollegiate first started in 1968 and has been played 42 times overall. The Aztecs finished first in both 1977 and 1978, while Gary Simoni (1977), Lenny Clements (1979) and most recently, Mark Warman (2003), earned medalist honors. Warman logged a school record round of 62 en route to his first career title.

Other previous U.S. Intercollegiate winners include Tom Watson (1971), Corey Pavin (1982), Bill Mayfair (1987), Casey Martin (1995) and Joel Kriebel (1996-97).

SDSU, Spaun Reach The National Top 10

The San Diego State men's golf team moved into the national top-10 rankings, which were released Wednesday by Golfstat.com. The Aztecs jumped from 12th into ninth place, while senior J.J. Spaun is currently the 10th-ranked golfer in the nation.

SDSU has won each of its last four tournaments, including the North Ranch Intercollegiate, the Farms Invitational, the National Invitational Tournament and most recently, the Barona Collegiate Cup. The Aztecs have boasted the firstplace finisher at all four events with the final three individual titles captured by Spaun, who currently leads the Mountain

West with a 70.63 season stroke average.

San Diego State's four tournament titles this year tie for fourth nationally, behind only No. 1 Texas, No. 2 UNLV and No. 10 Arkansas, which have all won five times. The Aztecs are 13th nationally by Golfweek/Sagarin, while Spaun is ranked No. 15 by that publication with an overall record of 565-95-13 (as of March 25).

Rewind: SDSU Rallies To Win At Barona

The No. 12 San Diego State men's golf team rallied for its fourth consecutive victory by edging No. 10 USC by two strokes with a 54-hole total of 29-under 1,051 at the annual Barona Collegiate Cup in Lakeside, Calif., March 22-23. The Aztecs won at the par-72, 7,393-yard Barona Creek Golf Course for the third year in a row and were led by senior J.J. Spaun, who earned medalist honors for the third-straight event and the third time overall in an 11-day span.

The host squad had an eight-stroke lead through 36 holes. but then fell behind the Trojans with only three holes to go. SDSU's six starters responded to the deficit by carding nine total birdies over the final four holes, combining to go 6-under during that span, while USC went 2-under par.

Spaun was one of the team's two seniors to card three birdies over the final four holes to give him a three-stroke win in the individual race with a 14-under 202. The All-American posted efforts of 67-67-68 to extend his streak of consecutive sub-70 rounds to seven in a row.

Spaun's three individual titles in 2012 are the most by an SDSU player in a single calendar year since Kevin Riley also won three in 1990 and gives him five overall in his decorated Aztec career.

Fellow senior Alex Kang also played a huge part in the SDSU comeback with three consecutive birdies on his final four holes to vault him into seventh place. Kang carded 14 birdies and an eagle in the 54 holes for a season-low 10-under 206 and his fourth top-10 finish of 2011-12.

Senior Colin Featherstone had three-straight rounds of even-par or better to tie for 14th with a season-best 211, while junior Tom Berry made it four Aztecs in the top 20 on the individual leaderboard with his 3-under 213. Senior Matt Hoffenberg and freshman Wilson Bateman rounded out the starting line-up in a tie for 46th at 4-over 220.

The team also had a pair of individual competitors with Cameron Tennant (Woodland Hills, Calif.) tying for 63rd at 8-over 224 and Evan Emerick (Carlsbad, Calif.) coming in 107th at 34-over 250.

Head Coach Rvan Donovan

Ryan Donovan is in his ninth season at the helm of the SDSU golf program after serving as an assistant in 2003. Since taking, he has directed the Aztecs to 23 tournament titles and four NCAA national championship appearances.

In 2010-11, he was named a finalist for the Dave Williams Award, which is handed out annually to the national coach of the year in Division I men's golf. Donovan also became the first Aztec named Mountain West Coach of the Year and was tabbed the Eaton Golf Pride West Region Division I Men's Coach of the Year by the GCAA.

A native of Yorba Linda, Calif., Donovan was a four-year member of the Aztec golf squad, before graduating in 2001.
