### Aztec Softball Plays Host to 25th Annual Campbell/Cartier Classic

The San Diego State softball team opens its home portion of the 2015 schedule this weekend with the 25th annual Campbell/Cartier Classic at SDSU Softball Stadium.

This year's classic features five teams, including the Aztecs (3-2), Central Michigan, North Dakota State, Oregon State and Seton Hall.

The five teams will play a combined 12 games over the four days with two on Thursday, five on Friday, four on Saturday and one on Sunday.

SDSU, which is receiving votes in the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll, will play host to North Dakota State (4-1) at 6 p.m. PT Thursday, Oregon State (5-1) at 4:30 p.m. PT Friday, Seton Hall (5-0) at 7 p.m. PT Friday and Central Michigan (0-4) at 4:30 p.m. PT Saturday.

The tournament is named after Susanne Campbell and Karin Cartier, who lost their lives during the 1991 softball season in a single-car accident that took place in Rosarito, Mexico. It left a lasting mark on teammates, coaches and the program. To pay tribute to Campbell and Cartier, the Aztec softball team renamed the SDSU Spring Classic in 1994 to the Campbell/Cartier Classic in memory of their friendship and fine athletic ability.

After one weekend, the Aztecs have four players batting over .300 (min. 9 at-bats), including junior Kayla Bufardeci (Castro Valley, Calif.) (.333, RBI, R), sophomore Jaylene Ignacio (Oceanside, Calif./El Camino HS) (.333, HR, 3 RBI, R), junior Leia Ruiz (Chino, Calif.) (.308, 3 RBI) and senior Kayla Jordan (San Diego/Bonita Vista HS) (.308, 4 R).

Sophomore Erica Romero (Corona, Calif.) has logged 23 of the team's 33 innings in the circle, going 2-2 with a save and a 2.13 ERA. Sophomores Andi Smith (Orangeville, Utah) (0-0, 2.80 ERA) and Sydnee Cable (Huntington Beach, Calif.) (1-0, 5.60 ERA) have also pitched five innings apiece.

HEAD COACH | 19TH SEASON | CS FULLERTON, 1983

- As a player, Van Wyk earned All-America honors and won the Broderick Award, given to the best player in the nation, in 1982 after going 35-1 with a 0.18 ERA. The victories remain a school single-season record and .972 winning percentage was an NCAA Division I record until 2001. Her phenomenal season included four no-hitters, six one-hitters, back-to-back perfect games, 26 shutouts and 270 strikeouts.
- Is the school's all-time winningest coach with 620 career victories, including a program-best 44 wins in 2008
- Earned her fifth Mountain West Coach of the Year award in 2014 after leading the Aztecs to a 16-8 mark in league play. She also won the award in 2002, 2006, 2008 and 2013.
- Has led SDSU to 10 NCAA tournament appearances (2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014)
- Guided San Diego State to its seventh MW regular season title in 2014 with a 16-8 record. The team's other championships came in 2002, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2012 and 2013.
- Coached her sixth and seventh All-Americans in 2013 in Lorena Bauer and Patrice Jackson. Bauer was a first-team Easton All-American, while Jackson garnered second-team honors.
- Has coached 64 all-conference selections, 29 NFCA all-West Region selections, nine MW Pitchers of the Year, seven MW Freshmen of the Year, two MW Players of the Year and 114 conference player/pitcher of the week winners

The Aztec softball home games that are scheduled for the Mountain West Network this season are North Dakota State on Feb. 12 (6 p.m. PT), Florida on March 1 (11:30 a.m. PT), Arizona on March 18 (7 p.m. PT), UNLV on March 21 (6 p.m. PT) and March 22 (Noon PT), Fresno State on April 2 (6 p.m. PT), San José State on April 10 (6 p.m. PT), April 11 (6 p.m. PT) and April 12 (Noon PT), New Mexico on April 24 (6 p.m. PT), April 25 (6 p.m. PT) and April 26 (11 a.m. PT), and Oregon State on May 8 (6 p.m. PT) and May 9 (Noon PT).

Additional road conference games will be added week to week.

**25th Annual Campbell/Cartier Classic Info**

The San Diego State University Campbell/Cartier Classic is an annual event held in the memory of former Aztec softball players Susanne Campbell and Karin Cartier. Campbell and Cartier lost their lives during the 1991 softball season in a single-car accident that took place in Rosarito, Mexico. It left a lasting mark on teammates, coaches and the program.

Campbell, a three-year starting catcher, was in her senior year. She had a .344 batting average, was an all-Western Athletic Conference selection and led the Aztecs in many offensive and defensive categories. She also set several single-season and career records and is among the top softball athletes to wear an SDSU uniform.

Cartier, a transfer pitcher from Hawai'i, had an excellent 1991 season at SDSU. She was emerging as a top pitcher and great hitter. Along with Campbell, Cartier was one of the strongest Aztecs in the weight room and possessed good leadership abilities and Division I playing experience.

To pay tribute to Susanne Campbell and Karin Cartier, the San Diego State softball team renamed the SDSU Spring Classic in 1994 to the Campbell/Cartier Classic in memory of their friendship and fine athletic ability. The 2015 tournament will be the 25th annual classic.

The 2015 version of the Campbell/Cartier Classic will once again be one of the strongest tournaments in the nation.

This year's classic features five teams, including the Aztecs (3-2), Central Michigan (0-4), North Dakota State (4-1), Oregon State (5-1) and Seton Hall (5-0). Altogether, the five teams are a combined 17-8 (.680). The five teams will play a combined 12 games over the four days with two on Thursday, five on Friday, four on Saturday and one on Sunday.

**SDSU Softball Receiving Votes in the Latest ESPN.com/USA Softball Poll**

The San Diego State softball team is receiving votes in the latest *ESPN.com/USA Softball* Poll.

The Aztecs, who went 3-2 last weekend at the SoCal Collegiate Classic, picked up four votes in the latest poll after getting none in the preseason poll. The four votes is good enough for the 34th most in the country, one behind USC Upstate (5) and ahead of Stanford (3), Mississippi State (3), South Florida (3), Cal State Northridge (2), Ohio State (2), Oregon State (2), North Carolina (1) and North Carolina State (1). South Alabama is ranked 25th with 28 points.

The Aztecs were once again left out of the *USA Today/NFCA* Poll.

**SDSU Excels in Lid-Lifters**

San Diego State has excelled in season-opening games since Kathy Van Wyk took over the reigns of the program in 1997.

With a 2-0 win vs. Purdue last Friday, the Aztecs have won three straight season-opening games, 14 of their last 15 season-openers and 17 of the 17 lid-lifters in head coach Kathy Van Wyk's 19-year tenure.

SDSU's only blemishes in the past 19 season-openers under Van Wyk came in 2012 (lost to Texas Tech, 5-4) and in 2000 (lost to Illinois-Chicago, 5-3).

Over the 19 years under Van Wyk, San Diego State has outscored its opponent, 101-44, or 5.32-2.32 per game in lid-lifters.

Since records were first kept in 1980, the Aztecs are 26-10 (.650) in their opening games.

**San Diego State Softball Picked Second in MW Preseason Poll**

The three-time defending Mountain West champion San Diego State softball team has been picked to finish second in a preseason poll voted on by the league's nine head coaches, the conference announced on Feb. 3.

The Aztecs garnered 54 points, including one first-place vote, nine behind Fresno State's 63 points and seven first-place votes. UNLV was picked third with 44 points and the other first-place vote, while Colorado State (43) and San José State (34) rounded out the top five. Boise State (33) was predicted to come in sixth, and Nevada (26), Utah State (18) and New Mexico (9) also received votes in the preseason poll.

SDSU finished with a 40-19 record in 2014 and advanced to its seventh straight NCAA tournament, which is the third-longest streak among non-Power 5 Conference programs in the country and the 20th-longest overall. San Diego State's 40 victories were the fourth most in program history and most since winning a school-record 44 times in 2008. The Aztecs also finished the 2014 campaign with seven school records, including batting average (.301), on-base percentage (.397), runs (301), hits (467), RBIs (270), walks (226) and times hit by pitch (30).

SDSU returns seven starters from last year's team, including 2014 NFCA All-West Region third-team selection Sydnee Cable (Huntington Beach, Calif.), who hit a team-high .356 with a home run, 32 RBIs, 22 runs and a .515 on-base percentage as a freshman, and 2014 all-MW first-team pick Jaylene Ignacio (Oceanside, Calif./El Camino HS) (.279, 5 HR, 22 RBI), also in her first season last year.

San Diego State also welcomes back Lorena Bauer (San Diego/Steele Canyon HS), who batted .401 with 13 homers and 49 RBIs en route to being named a first-team Easton All-American in 2013 before redshirting last year. Additionally, two-time USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Watch List member (2013-14) Hayley Miles (Antelope, Calif.) (.283, 6 HR, 32 RBI, 31 R in 2014) and Kayla Jordan (San Diego/Bonita Vista HS) (.292, 3 HR, 22 RBI, 20 SB in 2014) figure to contribute as seniors.

**Jenavee Peres Named to 2015 USA Softball Junior WNT**

San Diego State freshman Jenavee Peres (Garden Grove, Calif.) has been named to the 2015 USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) National Team (JWNT), the USA Softball Women's National Team Selection Committee (WNTSC) announced on Jan. 5.

Peres is one of 17 athletes that made the team after the two-day camp, which was contested on Jan. 3-4 in Irvine, Calif., where the WNTSC evaluated the invitees on position drills and simulated games.

The WNTSC will represent the United States at the World Cup of Softball X in Southern California (June 30-July 5) and the International Softball Federation (ISF) Junior Women's World Championship (Aug. 9-15) this summer.

"We have a good mix of speed and power and I'm very excited to see what we can do defensively," head coach Tairia Flowers said. "Overall, we have a good group of girls and will head into the summer with some experience with athletes having a full college season under their belt. We've also got a few young ones who will just be finishing up their high school careers. The staff and I are looking forward to the summer and we know that these girls will be ready to go when we head to Oklahoma City for the ISF World Championships."

The Aztecs are one of 11 NCAA Division I universities that are represented on the team and one of only two (also Louisiana-Lafayette) with a player from a non-Power 5 Conference.

Team USA is looking to reclaim the gold medal at the ISF Junior Women's World Championship (JWWC) after falling to Japan, 4-0, at the 2013 JWWC in Canada. This marks the first time since 1995 that an ISF JWWC will be held in the United States.

Joining Flowers (Cal State Northridge head coach) on the coaching staff include Trisha Ford (Fresno State head coach), Kristie Fox (UT Arlington head coach) and Tim Walton (Florida head coach). Current SDSU associate head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz was an assistant coach at the JWNT selection camp.

Peres came to The Mesa after playing her club ball for the Firecrackers under coach Tony Rico and her prep ball at Garden Grove High School. Peres hit .556 over her career at GGHS with 30 home runs, 118 RBIs, 98 runs, 22 doubles, five triples and 34 stolen bases. She also finished her prep career with a 1.120 slugging percentage and a .620 on-base percentage. As a senior in 2014, Peres batted .623 (48-for-77) with 14 homers, 48 RBIs and 40 runs, while posting a 1.350 slugging percentage and a .691 on-base mark.

**Four Softball Players Earn College Sports Madness MW Preseason Honors**

Four San Diego State softball players picked up preseason recognition from *College Sports Madness*, the website announced Feb. 1.

Senior Lorena Bauer (San Diego/Steele Canyon HS) and sophomore Jaylene Ignacio (Oceanside, Calif./El Camino HS) were each named to the first team, while sophomore Sydnee Cable (Huntington Beach, Calif.) and junior Monica Downey (San Diego/Madison HS) made the second team.

Bauer redshirted the 2014 campaign, but hit .401 with 13 home runs and 49 RBIs in 2013. Ignacio earned all-league accolades last year as a freshman, batting .279 with five homers and 22 RBIs. Cable, meanwhile, hit .356 with a home run and 32 RBIs, and Downey batted .323 with eight RBIs.

Kathy Van Wyk was also honored by the website as the preseason coach of the year.

**SDSU Signs Three to National Letters of Intent**

The San Diego State softball team has signed three athletes to National Letters of Intent, head coach Kathy Van Wyk announced Nov. 13. The three - Reyna Jamison (San Diego/Mater Dei Catholic High), Julie McDonald (Carlsbad, Calif./Carlsbad High School) and Molly Sturdivant (Santa Ana, Calif./El Modena High School) - will join a program that has won three straight Mountain West titles and has advanced to seven consecutive NCAA tournaments.

Jamison, a local product out of Mater Dei Catholic High School in San Diego (Chula Vista), also played with the So Cal Breakers club team under coach Mike Imoto. Jamison, an infielder in high school, has batted .364 with 32 RBIs, 57 runs, 14 doubles, six triples and 19 stolen bases over his career so far (according to MaxPreps.com). She has also posted a career .462 on-base percentage and .493 slugging mark. As a junior in 2014, Jamison hit .423 (33-for-78) with 18 RBIs, 16 runs, seven doubles, three triples, a homer and six stolen bases, while owning a .505 on-base percentage and .628 slugging percentage.

Jamison earned first-team all-Mesa League honors last year and second-team all-CIF accolades while at MDCHS. Over her three-year career at Mater Dei, she has led the Crusaders to a 66-26 (.717) record (22-8 in 2012, 25-7 in 2013 and 19-11 in 2014).

McDonald, another local student-athlete out of Carlsbad High School, played her club ball with OC Batbusters under coach Bruce Richardson. McDonald, who was mainly used as a pitcher at CHS and also as a first baseman, was 4-4 with a 3.03 ERA over 64 2/3 innings last year as a junior (according to MaxPreps.com). She struck out 35, holding opponents to a .263 batting average.

McDonald has helped the Lancers to back-to-back first division championships (2013-14) at CIF's and a combined 43-14-1 (.750) record over the past two seasons. She also pitched for the OC Batbusters at the 2013 16U Premier national championship game and earlier with So Cal Athletics, where the top club team won four straight national championships. McDonald also plays soccer and basketball for Carlsbad High.

Sturdivant, meanwhile, plays her club ball with the So Cal Fillys under coach Pat Kelly and has starred at El Modena High School in Orange, Calif. Sturdivant, who has played third base and catcher, batted .475 (29-for-61) with five home runs, 27 RBIs, 20 runs and four doubles as a junior at EMHS last year (according to MaxPreps.com). As a freshman with Foothill HS in 2012, she hit .338 with eight homers, 23 RBIs, 12 runs and three doubles. Sturdivant, who also has played club ball with the Hurricanes, Case Batbusters and Firecrackers Snyder, led the Fillys with a .545 batting average last year at the national championships.

A scholar-athlete, Sturdivant has been named a second-team all-league selection three straight years (2012-14) and the team's offensive player of the year each of those seasons. A top-15 freshman to watch by OC Varsity in 2014, she helped each of her high school teams (FHS in 2012, EMHS in 2013-14) make the CIF playoffs..
