@AztecWBB Faces MW Contender CSU to Open Two-Game Homestand

Following an open date, the San Diego State women's basketball team returns to the court on Wednesday when it entertains Colorado State in a Mountain West showdown at Steve Fisher Court at Viejas Arena. Game time is set for 6:30 p.m. PT. SDSU alumnus Chris Ello will handle the play-by-play responsibilities for a live video stream via the MW Network on GoAztecs.com.

SDSU is coming off a hard-fought 78-73 loss at San José State on Jan. 6. The Aztecs battled back from a 15-point deficit in the first quarter to grab a 48-41 advantage by halftime, only to relinquish the lead after connecting on just 4 of 19 field goals in the final period. Meanwhile, the Rams dispatched the same Spartan squad by a 76-54 count at home last Saturday to remain one of just two unbeaten teams in MW play this season, along with Fresno State.

Wednesday's matchup will be the 50th meeting with CSU, marking SDSU's fourth-most frequently played opponent behind New Mexico (56), UNLV (51) and Wyoming (51). Despite maintaining a 27-22 advantage in the all-time series, including a 16-7 ledger in San Diego, the Aztecs have dropped four straight to the Rams, averaging just 46.8 points per game during that span. Last season, SDSU was saddled with a 49-36 defeat on Montezuma Mesa before CSU completed the sweep with a 65-42 decision in Fort Collins. Keeping with the trend, defense has typified the Aztecs-Rams rivalry of late, with the winning team scoring over 70 points just seven times in the past 33 games dating back to 2000. The last time SDSU tallied 70 points against CSU occurred on March 3, 2010, when the Scarlet and Black emerged with a 73-54 triumph on the road. The task at hand appears daunting once again, as the Rams top the conference in scoring defense (50.6 ppg), while the Scarlet and Black is averaging 60.4 points per contest.

Individually, the Aztecs are led by sophomore McKynzie Fort (Fontana, Calif.), who ranks fifth in the Mountain West for all games in scoring (14.8 ppg) and is tied for the fifth spot in steals (2.1/gm). In addition, the 5-9 guard is sixth among the league leaders with four 20-point performances to her credit. Meanwhile, senior Ahjaleé Harvey (Mountain View, Calif.) occupies the sixth position in conference games with a .400 three-point field-goal percentage and ranks 10th in scoring (13.0 ppg). Recently, Harvey moved into ninth place on the school's all-time list with 273 three-point field-goal attempts for her career.

For the season, SDSU owns a plus-1.6 turnover margin and has committed the third fewest turnovers in the MW with 206 overall (14.7/gm), trailing only Colorado State (166 - (11.9/gm)) and Wyoming (185 - (13.2/gm)). Through 14 games last year, the Aztecs ranked last in the conference with 301 turnovers (21.5/gm) and a minus-5.9 turnover margin.

Following Wednesday's encounter, San Diego State will square off against Boise State on Saturday, Jan. 16, at Steve Fisher Court at Viejas Arena to highlight Alumni Appreciation Weekend. Opening tip is set for 2 p.m. PT.

Scouting the Rams

Colorado State (13-1, 3-0 MW) sits a half-game behind Fresno State in the conference standings after posting a 76-54 triumph over San José State at home last Saturday. The Rams held the high-octane Spartans to 24 points below their season scoring average, while junior transfer Alana Arias tallied a game-high 16 points off the bench. In addition, CSU received a double-double from senior Emilie Hesseldal, who collected 10 points and 10 rebounds, while fellow classmate Jamie Patrick scored 10 points of her own. With the victory, the Rams won their 10th in a row after suffering their lone defeat of the 2015-16 campaign in a narrow 49-48 setback at Penn on Nov. 24.

Entering the week, CSU occupies the fifth spot nationally in both scoring defense (50.6 ppg) and field-goal percentage defense (.326) while ranking sixth in turnovers (11.9/gm) and ninth in turnover margin (+6.1/gm). In addition, the Rams top the Mountain West in scoring margin (+18.1 ppg) and assists (15.6/gm), and find themselves among the conference leaders in field-goal percentage (2nd - (.420)) three-point field goals made (2nd - 83), steals (2nd - 9.4/gm), blocked shots (2nd - 4.3/gm), rebounding margin (4th - (+3.9/gm)) and free-throw percentage (5th - (.681)).

Individually, CSU sports three players with double-digit scoring averages, including Patrick (11.5 ppg), junior Elin Gustavsson (11.1 ppg) and fellow classmate Ellen Nystrom (10.1 ppg). Nystrom, a preseason all-MW selection, ranks second in the league this week in assists (4.9/gm) and is listed third in steals (2.4/gm) and seventh in free-throw percentage (.778). Meanwhile, Patrick is the team's top three-point threat, draining 32 triples on the year for an average of 2.3 per game, which ranks fourth in the conference.

The Rams boast nine international players on their roster, including Arias (Brazil), Nystrom, Gustavsson, Veronika Mirkovic and Amanda Kantzy (Sweden), Hesseldal and Sofie Tryggedson (Denmark), Stine Austgulen (Norway) and Kincso Kelemen (Romania).

Head coach Ryun Williams is in his fourth season at the helm of the CSU program after serving a four-year stint at his alma mater South Dakota. Under Williams' tutelage, the Rams have won back-to-back MW regular-season championships, amassing a 30-6 record in conference play during that span.

Notes With a 'W'

An SDSU victory over Colorado State on Wednesday will mean:

- The Aztecs snap the Rams' 10-game winning streak.
- SDSU climbs back to the .500 mark with a 2-2 record in conference play and move to 7-8 overall.
- The Aztecs raise their record to 28-22 against CSU all-time, including a 17-7 mark in San Diego.
- SDSU improves to 4-4 on the year in games following a loss.

Aztecs-Rams: The Last Time We Met

San Diego State was able to trade some early punches on the road against Colorado State, but cold shooting in the second half ultimately derailed any hope of an upset as the Aztecs dropped a 65-42 decision at Moby Arena on Feb. 14, 2015.

SDSU scored a season-low 13 points after intermission, shooting just 29 percent (6-21) in the period and 37 percent (18-49) for the game to fall to 9-15 on the year and 6-7 in conference play. The Rams, meanwhile, had their perimeter game clicking from the outset, draining eight 3-pointers in the first half and 11 on the afternoon to help raise their record to 18-6 overall and 10-3 in the MW.

Despite owning a 36-31 rebounding advantage, the Aztecs were outscored 26-16 in the paint as CSU bottled up the middle, limiting SDSU forwards Erimma Amarikwa and Christina Hunter to just three points combined. In addition, the Rams tallied 23 points off 20 Aztec turnovers en route to sweeping the regular-season series for the second year in a row.

After suffering a 47-point defeat at Moby Arena in 2014, SDSU still had to feel good about its chances after keeping the score close midway through the first half as freshman McKynzie Fort hit a jumper to pull the Scarlet and Black to within one at 13-12 with 9:30 remaining. However, the Rams' Jamie Patrick quickly answered with a 3-pointer on the ensuing possession to ignite a 15-3 outburst that put the host school in front 28-15 by the 6:44 mark.

Patrick, who buried five triples in the opening period alone, tallied eight of her game-high 17 points during the run, while Hanne Mestdagh added the first of her three 3-pointers of the day.

The Aztecs managed to trim the deficit to single digits over the next

3:42 as a pair of triples by freshman Lexy Thorderson served as bookends to 12-4 run that pulled the visitors to within striking distance at 32-27 with 3:02 to go before halftime.

Whatever momentum SDSU built was quickly subdued however, as Patrick nailed two crushing 3-pointers down the stretch, including one at the buzzer that was aided by a friendly bounce, putting CSU up 38-29 heading into the locker room.

Stung, the Aztecs stumbled out of the gates after the break, misfiring on their first four shots of the second half, while the Rams scored six straight points, including baskets by Ellen Nystrom and Elin Gustavsson, along a pair of free throws by Alana Arias to forge a 44-29 advantage.

SDSU tried to rally once more as a pair of Fort jumpers sandwiched around an Amarikwa layup narrowed the gap to 44-35 with 12:49 to go. Shortly thereafter, however, AJ Newton and Victoria Wells converted and-one opportunities on back-to-back possessions, giving the Rams a comfortable 50-35 cushion with 9:14 left to play, and the Aztecs never threatened again.

SDSU, which came in averaging just 13 turnovers in its previous four games, posted 14 giveaways in the second half alone on Saturday, including seven in the final nine minutes, as CSU limited the Scarlet and Black to seven points the rest of the way.

Fort led the Aztecs with 17 points on 6-of-12 shooting, while Thorderson went 5-for-7 from the floor, tying her career-best with 12 points in the loss. In addition, junior Ahjalee Harvey (Mountain View, Calif.) dished out a season-high six assists and added six rebounds, while senior Chairese Culberson (Oakland, Calif.) contributed six boards of her own.

Rewind: SDSU-San José State Recap

In a tale of two halves, San Diego State came up on the short end of a 78-73 decision to San José State on Wednesday in a Mountain West clash at The Event Center in San José, Calif.

After exploding for a season-high 48 first-half points on 51.7 percent (19-37) shooting, the Aztecs (6-8, 1-2 Mountain West) were unable to maintain the same intensity in the final two periods, scoring 25 points for the remainder of the game while connecting on just 22.2 percent of their tries from the field (8-36).

Similarly, SDSU drained 7 of 13 three-pointers in the first two quarters, but hit just 1 of 11 shots from beyond the arc after the break, as the Spartans (5-9, 3-0 MW) rallied from a 13-point deficit to win their third straight to open conference play.

Individually, the Aztecs were led by sophomore McKynzie Fort, who totaled 16 points and seven rebounds, while senior Deidra Smith and sophomore Geena Gomez finished with 15 points apiece. Gomez's career-high point total included a personal-best four triples, while fellow classmate Cheyenne Greenhouse grabbed a season-high nine rebounds. In addition, SDSU received a six assists and a collegiate-best five steals from junior Ariell Bostick.

Leading 48-41 at intermission, the Aztecs scored six straight points to open the third quarter, as a Greenhouse layup provided the visitors their biggest cushion of the night at 54-41. However, SJSU uncorked a 9-0 run over a span of five minutes to narrow the gap to 54-50 by the 3:37 mark of the period. SDSU misfired on seven straight field-goal attempts during that stretch, allowing the Spartans to crawl back into contention.

The Aztecs ended the drought with a three-pointer by Gomez, who sank a free throw shortly thereafter to give SDSU a 59-53 advantage heading into the fourth quarter. However, the Aztecs experienced another prolonged slump, missing eight consecutive shots from the floor to open the final frame, as the Spartans fashioned an 11-2 spurt to take the lead for good at 64-61, capped by Emily Vann's demoralizing triple with 5:55 left in the contest.

The Aztecs found themselves in pursuit mode for the rest of the game and trailed 71-65 with 1:48 to go, before narrowing the gap to two after Smith converted a layup and subsequently drained two foul shots. However, Dezz Ramos notched an old-fashioned three-point play on SJSU's next possession to keep the Scarlet and Black at bay. SDSU had one last chance after Fort hit a layup with 43 seconds remaining, which tightened the score to 76-73. The Aztec defense clamped down and forced an errant shot by Nyre Harris, but Riana Byrd grabbed the rebound and promptly tossed in the clinching layup.

Ramos led all scorers with 22 points, while Byrd completed her second double-double of the year with 17 points on 8-of-12 shooting to go with 11 rebounds. The Spartans also received double-digit scoring performances from Harris, who notched 11 points, nine rebounds and seven assists, while Myzhanique Ladd finished with 10 points of her own. Collectively, SJSU closed with a rush, draining 9 of 13 field-goal attempts in the fourth quarter to go with a 6-for-7 clip at the free-throw line.

The Spartans also got off to a quick start in the first quarter, nailing six of their first eight shots from three-point range to help forge a 29-15 advantage by the 1:30 mark of the period. However, Gomez responded with a trey, while Smith added back-to-back layups, including a conversion right before the buzzer to cut the deficit to 31-22.

The Aztecs continued their surge in the second stanza, outscoring the host school by a 26-10 count during the quarter thanks to a 10-for-19 effort from the field, including a 5-for-9 clip from beyond the arc.

SDSU-San José State Postgame Notes

- The Aztecs lost for just the second time in 10 visits to San José.
- SDSU scored a season-high 26 points in the second quarter.
- The Aztecs recorded fewer turnovers than the opposition for the third game in a row and fourth time in their last five outings. SDSU is 5-3 on the year when committing fewer miscues than its adversaries.
- The Aztec bench outscored the Spartan reserves by a 29-23 tally. For the season, the SDSU bench has amassed 322 points (23.0/g).
- The Aztecs established a season high with 17 assists, including 14 in the first half alone.
- Deidra Smith (15 pts) played in her 75th consecutive game for SDSU, surpassing the 500-point mark for her career. In four games vs. the Spartans, she is averaging 15.0 pts and 7.3 rebounds while shooting 56.5 percent from the field (26-46).
- Ariell Bostick finished with a season-high six assists and a personal-best five steals.
- In addition to her point total, Geena Gomez set career highs in three-pointers made (4) and attempted (9), while her 12 field-goal tries overall marked a personal best.
- McKynzie Fort matched her season high with four assists.
- Lexy Thorderson (2) sank multiple treys for the sixth time this year. Last season, she drained two or more triples in just three games.

Take It to the Bank

With their victory over Wyoming on Dec. 30, the Aztecs have now won 49 in a row and improved to 79-1 since the 2012-13 campaign when leading with five minutes left in the game. The SDSU streak was in serious jeopardy at CSUN on Dec. 7 after the Matadors inched in front by a 66-65 margin with 20 seconds remaining. However, Lexy Thorderson's trey with 9.4 seconds to go saved the day for the Scarlet and Black.

The last time the Aztecs wound up losing a game after leading at the five-minute mark of the second half occurred in a heart-breaking 59-58 at Washington in December of 2012.

Comeback Kids

In three victories over Wisconsin, CSUN and Wyoming, San Diego State fought itself off the ropes, rallying from an 11-point deficit in each contest. Against the Badgers on Nov. 29, the Aztecs found themselves on the wrong side of a 32-21 score with three minutes elapsed in the third quarter before uncorking a 23-7 run to grab a 44-39 advantage. SDSU also trailed with under 10 seconds remaining, but Ariell Bostick saved the day with a late layup to send the game into overtime. The following week against the Matadors, the Aztecs overcame a 41-30 deficit at the 8:22 mark of the third period with a 12-0 run to climb back into contention. After six ties and four lead changes, CSUN went back in front 65-63 with 17 seconds to go. However, Lexy Thorderson tallied the go-ahead basket on a three-pointer with 9.4 seconds left, while Bostick added a late free throw to seal the win. In the MW opener against the Cowgirls on Dec. 30, SDSU trailed 15-4 with 5:21 elapsed in the first quarter before reeling off 15 unanswered points to take the lead for good.

Nothin' Like Home Cookin'

Despite its modest 4-4 home record to start the season, SDSU has claimed 47 of its last 63 games on Montezuma Mesa and has gone 79-32 (.712) at Steve Fisher Court since the start of the 2008-09 campaign. The Aztecs have finished with a winning record at home in eight of the last nine years.

Spreading the Wealth

A total of nine Aztecs have scored in double digits at least once this season, while six have accomplished the feat on two or more occasions. That is especially notable since there are only 12 players on the active roster. In addition, SDSU has had six games this season in which three players scored in double figures (UC Riverside, Wisconsin, CSUN, San Diego Christian, Wyoming and San José State).

Fort Tabbed MW Player of the Week

McKynzie Fort was named Mountain West Women's Basketball Player of the Week for her stellar performances in three games from Nov. 23-29, as announced by the league office. With her award, the Aztec sophomore garnered weekly conference accolades for the first time in her career and first for SDSU this season.

Fort averaged 17.3 points, 3.7 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 3.3 steals, helping the Aztecs to a 2-1 record during that stretch. The 5-9 guard

was the team's top scorer in all three games, connecting on 66.7 percent of her shots on 24 of 36 field-goal attempts, all inside the arc.

After recording 16 points on 8-of-13 shooting and four rebounds in a tough road loss to Washington on Nov. 23, Fort almost single-handedly propelled the Scarlet and Black to a 64-54 triumph over North Dakota State in the opener of the SDSU Thanksgiving Classic last Friday, posting a game-high 20 points and a personal-best five steals. Against the Bison, the Etiwanda High alumna drained a collegiate-high 10 field goals on 12 tries (83.3 pct) and matched her season best with four rebounds.

Not to be outdone, Fort capped off her brilliant week with a 16-point, 4-steal effort in the Aztecs' thrilling 63-57 overtime victory over Wisconsin on Sunday, sinking 6 of 11 attempts from the floor to go with four clutch free throws. Against the Badgers, she converted two critical and-one opportunities, including one to punctuate a timely 23-7 run that erased an 11-point deficit in the second half.

In addition, Fort received MW Player of the Week honors from the website CollegeSportsMadness.com after her exceptional effort vs. Cal State Fullerton on Dec. 19. Against the Titans, Fort recorded the second-best scoring output of her career with a game-high 22 points, including 14 in the second half as the Scarlet and Black pulled away for the victory. The 5-9 guard matched her collegiate best with 10 field goals on 14 attempts (71.4 percent) and posted three rebounds, three steals and two assists to help SDSU pull away for the win.

For the season, Fort is averaging a team-high 14.8 points per game on 46.5 percent shooting and leads SDSU with 29 steals. She now has 10 double-digit scoring performances this year and 30 for her career.

Earlier this year, Fort set a career high with 25 points against UC Riverside in the Aztecs' home opener on Nov. 16, and established collegiate bests in three-pointers made (2), field-goal attempts (17), free throws (11) and free throw attempts (12).

@AztecWBB Picked Sixth in MW Preseason Poll

San Diego State has been predicted to finish sixth the Mountain West preseason poll released on Oct. 28 by the league office. The voting panel consisted of the MW's 11 head coaches and select women's basketball media from around the conference.

The Aztecs, who placed seventh in the MW standings during the 2014-15 campaign, earned 135 points from the panel, trailing fifth-place UNLV (132) by just three points while topping seventh-place Wyoming (125) by 10 points.

Two-time defending regular-season champion Colorado State was picked to repeat once again after receiving 21 of 28 first-place votes and 237 points, just ahead of New Mexico, which garnered seven first-place votes and 221 points, while 2015 MW tournament champion Boise State followed closely in the third spot with six first-place votes and 215 points.

With the league's forecast, SDSU has not been selected to finish among the top three places in the MW preseason rankings in back-to-back years for the first time since the 2006-07 and 2007-08 campaigns. The Aztecs completed conference play where they were projected last season, landing in the seventh spot with an 8-10 record.

Back Again

San Diego State returns three starters from a year ago, featuring sophomore McKynzie Fort, along with seniors Ahjalee Harvey and Deidra Smith. A 5-9 guard, Fort earned Mountain West all-freshman honors last spring after finishing third among conference rookies with 10.9 points per game in league play while averaging 3.2 rebounds and 1.7 assists. In addition, Harvey made a successful recovery from a knee injury that sidelined her for the final 22 games of the 2013-14 campaign with 25 starts in 29 appearances last season. The 5-6 point guard was SDSU's top ball-handler and main three-point threat in 2014-15, dishing out 2.3 assists per contest to go with 21 triples. Meanwhile, Smith has played in all 62 games for the Aztecs the past two years following her transfer from Boston College. The tallest member on the squad as a 6-2 forward, Smith is the team's top returning rebounder after averaging 3.5 caroms last season.

Third-year head coach Stacie Terry and staff welcome back four additional letterwinners, including juniors Ariell Bostick and Aleiah Brandon and sophomores Cheyenne Greenhouse and Lexy Thorderson. Fellow classmate Allison Brown, who made seven spot appearances last season, also finds herself in the mix once again.

Noting the Newcomers

Of the 12 student-athletes on the current roster, four players will be wearing a Scarlet and Black uniform for the first time during the 2015-16 campaign. Guard Kymberly Ellison (Columbus, Ga.) practiced with the squad

last year, but did not compete after transferring from Georgia Tech, while fellow backcourt mate Geena Gomez (Huntington Beach, Calif.) utilized her redshirt season as well following her transfer from St. Joseph's (Pa.).

With the departure of forwards Erimma Amarikwa, Kristina Hunter and Desi Culberson, who accounted for 43 percent of SDSU's rebounding total and 38 percent of the team's scoring offense from a year ago, a pair of newcomers look to gain significant experience on the frontline this season. Junior Kylie Herd (Phoenix, Ariz.) received second-team All-America recognition and was named the Arizona JC player of the year as a sophomore last year at Mesa Community College, following a solid freshman campaign when she helped the Thunderbirds to the NJCAA Division II national championship. Not to be outdone, freshman Arantxa Gómez (Valencia, Spain) brings strong credentials with her to The Mesa after sharpening her skills as a six-year member on the Spanish club circuit, including an MVP performance in U18 regional competition last April.

Listen Live

For the 15th consecutive year, Aztec women's basketball fans will have an opportunity to listen to live play-by-play of regular-season games over the internet at www.goaztecs.com.

SDSU alumnus Chris Ello begins his ninth season of calling the action and is a familiar voice in the San Diego area. In addition to his responsibilities with the Aztec women's basketball squad, Ello is a member of the football broadcast team as a sideline reporter for the school's flagship station, The Mighty 1090 AM.

Ello started his career in sports talk radio in San Diego on XTRA Sports 690 in the summer of 1994. He has accumulated a wealth of experience doing play-by-play for a variety of sports at every level, including stints with the SDSU football (1985), baseball (1998-99) and men's basketball (2006-07) squads.

From 1996-2006, Ello was the voice of the San Diego Gulls hockey team and has called the action for the San Diego Sockers (indoor soccer), San Diego Spirit (outdoor soccer), San Diego Wildcards (CBA) and San Diego Riptide (arena football). He also has experience broadcasting high school CIF football and basketball games since 2000.

For the third straight year, nearly all regular-season Aztec home contests in 2015-16 will feature a live video stream via the Mountain West Network to supplement the audio call from Viejas Arena.

NCAA Rule Changes at a Glance

Game Format

- Beginning with the 2015-16 campaign, NCAA women's basketball games will be played in four 10-minute quarters.
- Teams will now reach the bonus and shoot two free throws on the fifth team foul in each quarter. Previously, teams reached a one-and-one bonus on the seventh team foul of each half and reached the double bonus (two shots) on the 10th team foul.
- In the four-quarter format, team fouls reset to zero at the start of each quarter. However, if a team reaches the bonus in the fourth quarter, that team would remain in the bonus during any additional overtime periods.

Advancing the Ball

- Teams will be allowed to advance the ball to the frontcourt following a timeout immediately after a made basket in the last 59.9 seconds of the fourth quarter and any overtime periods.
- Teams will also be allowed to advance the ball to the frontcourt following a re-

bound or a change of possession. In these scenarios, the ball would be inbounded at the 28-foot mark on the side of the court where the scorer's table is located.

10-Second Backcourt Exceptions

- For the upcoming season, a team will not receive a new 10-second backcourt count when a throw-in results from the following situations:
 - The ball is deflected out of bounds by the defense.
 - There is a held ball and the possession arrow favors the offensive team.
 - A technical foul is called on the offensive team while the ball is in its backcourt.

Post Defense

- Defenders will be allowed to place a forearm or an open hand with a bend in the elbow on an offensive post player with the ball whose back is to the basket.

Bands and Amplified Music

- In an effort to improve the overall fan experience, bands or amplified music may be played during any dead-ball situation during a women's basketball game. Previously, rules allowed music to be played only during timeouts and intermission.

SDSU Holds Grand-Opening Ceremony for Jeff Jacobs JAM Center

San Diego State held a grand-opening ceremony for the 23,500-square foot Jeff Jacobs JAM Center on Sunday, Aug. 23. The event marked the official opening of the Aztecs' on-campus basketball performance center, which broke ground almost a year to the date on Aug. 27, 2014.

Speaking before the ceremonial ribbon cutting was SDSU president Elliot Hirshman, men's basketball head coach Steve Fisher and women's hoops senior guard Ahjalee Harvey.

Preliminary site work started in July 2014, just south of the Fowler Athletics Center and east of the football practice fields. The facility, which will support the continued growth and development of the SDSU men's and women's basketball teams, includes two full-length courts, eight baskets, locker rooms, film room, team lounges, athletic training room and coaches locker rooms.

Hundreds of supporters contributed to the effort to make the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center a reality. In addition to the naming gift from Jeff Jacobs, Hal and Debby Jacobs, Steve and Lisa Altman and Jim Morris, creating the name "JAM" Center, sizeable donations were made from the Manna Charitable Foundation and the Walter and Betty Zable Foundation. The total cost of the project was \$15 million.

The project was designed by JCJ Architecture and was built by The Hunt Construction Group.

San Diego native Stacie Terry enters her third year at the helm of the Aztec women's basketball team after she was named the eighth head coach in program history on May 15, 2013.

Despite a 12-19 record and an 8-10 mark in the Mountain West, Terry's squad still showed dramatic improvement on defense last season, finishing second in the conference and 34th nationally in opponent three-point field goal percentage, compared to 2014 when SDSU ranked last in the league and near the bottom of Division I in that statistic.

In addition, the Aztecs were fourth in scoring defense during MW play a year ago, allowing nearly 10 points per game fewer than the previous campaign and topped the conference in rebounding defense for the second straight season.

Under Terry's watch, forward Erimma Amarikwa capped off her collegiate career with honorable mention all-MW accolades, while guard McKynzie Fort gave SDSU's its second consecutive all-conference freshman honoree.

Terry's charges also made tremendous strides in the classroom, with the squad posting the highest collective GPA in program history during the fall of 2014, while five Aztecs landed a spot on the MW all-academic team, the most since 2001-02.

During her first season on Montezuma Mesa, Terry was saddled with the unenviable task of replacing four senior starters who accounted for nearly 64 percent of the team's scoring offense from the previous year, as well as overcoming the loss of two key players to injuries prior to conference play, Amarikwa, who was a preseason all-MW selection, and starting point guard Ahjalee Harvey.

Despite those obstacles and a demanding schedule featuring nine games against teams that eventually advanced to postseason competition, Terry's squad flashed its resiliency during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and a 9-9 ledger in the MW.

With Terry at the controls, the Aztecs led the league in rebounding margin and rebounding defense while ranking second in field-goal percentage.

Individually, Terry also oversaw the progress of senior center Cierra Warren, who became the fifth SDSU player in a six-year span to receive first-team all-MW recognition.

Prior to her arrival on The Mesa, Terry gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach at the Division I level for 14 years, including five under head coach Nikki Caldwell, who transformed UCLA into a powerhouse before restoring LSU to national prominence.

During Terry's two seasons at LSU, the Lady Tigers compiled a 45-23 overall record and earned two NCAA tournament bids, including a Sweet 16 appearance during the 2012-13 campaign. During that season, the Lady Tigers also posted six victories against ranked opponents and finished with their second-highest scoring average (69.0) in the last seven years. Under Terry's guidance, forward LaShondra Barrett garnered first-team all-Southeastern Conference accolades and received honorable mention All-America distinction in 2012 before becoming a first-round draft choice of the WNBA's Washington Mystics.

Prior to her appointment at LSU, Terry served as an assistant under Caldwell at UCLA from 2008-11, helping the Bruins gain national acclaim with a pair of NCAA

tournament appearances. During Terry's tenure, UCLA posted 72 overall victories, as the 2010-11 squad finished with a 28-5 record, setting a school record for fewest losses in a single season to go with a No. 7 national ranking. In addition, the Bruins signed the fourth-ranked recruiting class that season, according to ESPN Hoop-Gurlz, while Terry helped mentor first-team all-Pac-10 performers in Doreena Campbell, Darxia Morris and Jasmine Dixon, a 2012 honorable mention AP All-America selection, as well as all-conference freshman honorees Atonye Nyingifa and Markel Walker.

Terry spent the 2007-08 campaign at Southern Mississippi, as the Golden Eagles posted a 21-14 record and earned a postseason berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). While at Southern Miss, Terry spearheaded the development and coordination of the Lady Eagle recruiting campaign. Her responsibilities also included working with the perimeter players, scouting opponents and film breakdown, as well as coordinating all of the team's community service events.

Terry also coached for three seasons from 2004-07 as an assistant under Hall of Fame head coach Theresa Greutz at Illinois, where the Fighting Illini had three straight recruiting classes ranked among the top 25 in the nation, according to Blue Star Basketball, and made three consecutive trips to the WNIT. Her primary duties included defensive instruction and working with the perimeter players.

In addition, Terry coached at Dayton during the 2003-04 season following a three-year stint at Louisville from 2000-03. With the Cardinals, Terry's responsibilities encompassed recruiting, scouting, player development, summer camps and serving as a liaison for the program's community service outreach. Louisville captured the Conference USA regular-season title and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament in 2001 before making a WNIT appearance in 2002. She also assisted in signing the nation's 21st-ranked recruiting class in 2002-03, according to All-Star Girls Report. Terry recruited and coached all-Conference USA honoree Lori Nero, a draft choice of the WNBA's Houston Comets, as well as Sara Nord, who finished her collegiate career as the Cardinals' all-time assist leader and ranks among the top 15 scorers in school history.

Terry enjoyed a successful collegiate playing career at the University of Texas at Arlington, winning four varsity letters from 1994-98 under head coach Mike Dean. She earned first-team all-Southland Conference honors after leading the Mavericks in scoring with 17.4 points per game as a senior in 1997-98. Terry scored 1,169 points during her career at UTA and still ranks among the school's top 10 in three-point field goals made (third), assists (sixth), steals (seventh) and free-throw percentage (10th). She is just one of 17 players in Maverick history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau, while her .335 career three-point field-goal percentage is also a school and Southland Conference career record.

Terry played one season of professional basketball in Warsaw, Poland, averaging 12.0 points and 6.0 assists with the Polonia Phoenix, before returning to UT Arlington to begin her coaching career as a graduate assistant in 1999.

Terry prepped at El Capitan High and held the Vaqueros' career scoring record for three years following her graduation. She was inducted into the school's athletic hall of fame in 2008.
