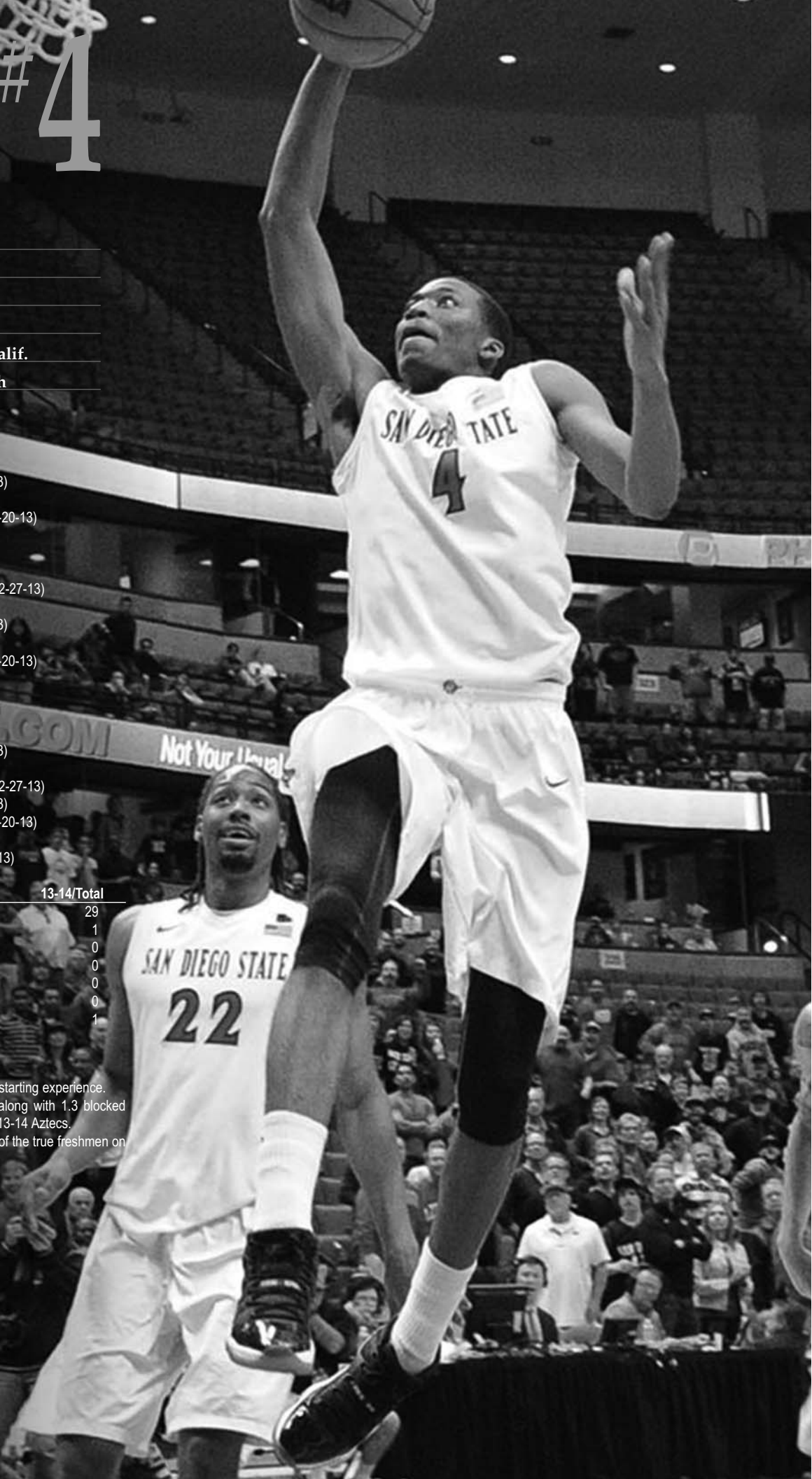

A returning wing who saw significant action in his first year on campus... A high-motor player who has the ability to lock down his opponent... Is a good passer and can knife his way into the paint... Worked on getting stronger in the off-season and improving his jump shot.

As A Freshman (2013-14 Season)

Averaged 2.5 points and 1.2 rebounds in 10.6 minutes... Per 40 minutes, he averaged 9.5 points, 4.4 rebounds, 1.3 blocked shots and 2.4 steals... Played in 29 games, the most among the team's true freshmen, and started one game... Blocked 10 shots, the seventh most on the team... Saw action in the first 16 games of the season and averaged 13.7 minutes and nearly one steal per game (15 steals)... Logged 20 or more minutes four times in the first nine games of the season (17.4 mpg)... Scored seven points all on free throws (7-8) in 20 minutes vs. UC Riverside (11-8-13)... The 20 minutes were the most of any Aztec reserve... Played a bench-high 20 minutes vs. No. 6/5 Arizona (11-14-13)... Set career highs in points (8) and steals (3) vs. San Diego Christian (11-20-13)... Matched his career high with eight points and three rebounds vs. No. 25/rv Marquette (12-1-13)... Set a career high with three blocked shots vs. Washington (12-8-13)... Scored a career-high eight points to go along with a career-best three steals and 25 minutes vs. Southern Utah (12-18-13)... Started his first career

game vs. McNeese State (12-21-13) and finished with one point, two rebounds, two blocked shots and two steals in 19 minutes... Had a career-high three assists and three steals, while adding six points vs. St. Katherine College (12-27-13)... Matched his career high with three field goals and three rebounds, and added six points, one blocked shot and a steal in 14 minutes vs. Colorado State (2-1-14)... Had two points, two rebounds and two assists vs. Utah State in the MW quarterfinals (3-13-14)... Saw action in the NCAA third-round game vs. North Dakota State (3-22-14).

Helped Sheldon to a 27-6 overall record and a 10-0 mark in league play in 2012-13... Averaged 18.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 4.0 assists his final season... A four-star recruit by Rivals.com... Rated the 19th-best player at the small forward position and No. 103 on the Rivals 150... ESPN.com gave him a score of 80 and a four-star rating... ESPN listed him at No. 20 for his position, No. 18 in the region and No. 12 in the state... pegged him the 106th-best player nationally, No. 20 at his position and eighth-best in California... Earned 2012-13 MaxPreps California Boys Basketball Division I second-team honors and was on the all-Northern California first-team... 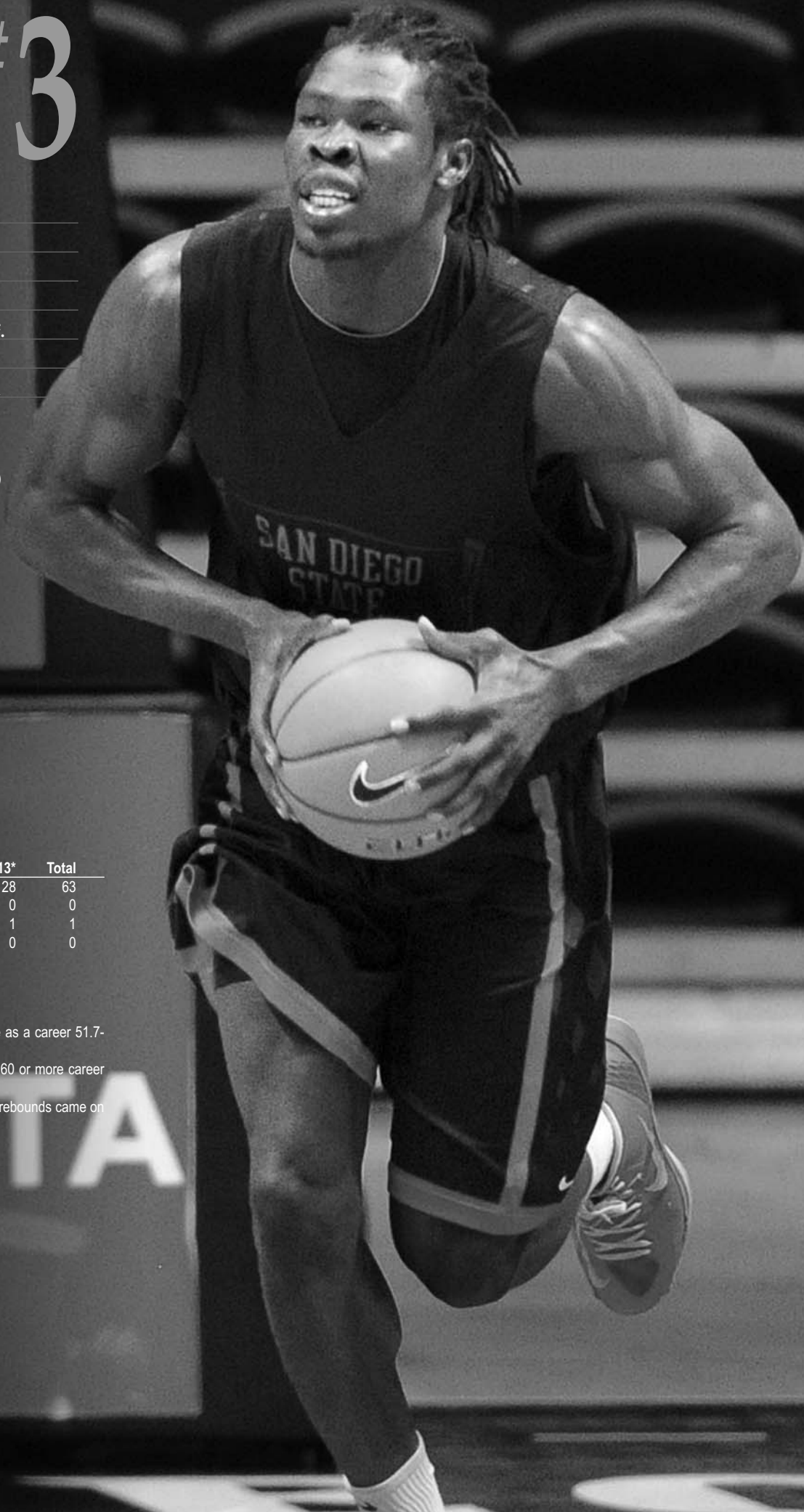

A versatile forward who is perhaps the strongest player on the team... Has an array of low-post moves, but can also step out and hit a jumper, which includes three-point attempts... Will provide an inside offensive threat... Worked hard in the weight room and on the practice floor where he improved his ball-handling, defense and offensive skills.

As A Redshirt (2013-14 Season)

Redshirted after transferring from Arizona prior to the 2013-14 academic year... Practiced with the team the entire season.

As A Sophomore at Arizona (2012-13 Season)

Was a part of a 27-8 Arizona team that advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA tournament... Averaged 1.9 points and 2.0 rebounds in 8.5 minutes... More than 40 percent of his minutes played during the season came in his last 10 appearances (99 of 239), though he played in just two of UA's last six games... 42.9 percent of his rebounds came on the offensive glass (24 of 56)... Played in the team's first 14 games and logged double-figure minutes in half of those outings... At one stretch, he played in 11 straight Pac-12 games where he averaged 2.2 rebounds... Equaled a then-career high with three field goals on the way to six points and two rebounds vs. UTEP (11-15-12)... Posted his first career double-figure scoring game with 10 points and four

rebounds vs. Northern Arizona (11-28-12)... Posted season-high totals of six rebounds and three blocks vs. Oral Roberts (12-18-12)... Collected six boards vs. East Tennessee State (12-22-12)... Put forth the best game of his career with six points and a career-high eight rebounds in a collegiate-best 24 minutes vs. Stanford (2-6-13)... Collected two points, two boards and a block in his NCAA tournament debut vs. Harvard (3-23-13)... Averaged 11.5 points and 5.0 rebounds to go with four blocked shots in the Summer of Thunder Tour of the Bahamas prior to the season... Connected on 7-of-9 field-goal attempts in 32 minutes.

As A Freshman at Arizona (2011-12 Season)

Helped Arizona to a 23-12 record and an NIT berth... Played in all 35 games... Averaged 2.8 points and 2.3 rebounds in 12.2 minutes... Led the team in blocked shots with 29... Shot a team-best 56.3 percent from the floor... Was UA's blocked shot leader 16 times... Scored six or more points seven times and had at least five rebounds on five different occasions... Played at least 17 minutes 11 times... Logged double-figure minute totals 23 times... Posted six points, a season-high seven boards and a block vs. Duquesne (11-9-11)... Put forth his best effort of the season with eight points, four boards and two blocks at California (2-2-12)... Blocked a season-high four shots at Stanford (2-4-12)... Equaled a season high with eight points (4-of-4 FT) vs. Colorado (2-9-12)... Hit a season-best 4-of-7 free throws on the way

to equaling a season-high with eight points at Washington State (2-16-12) to go with four rebounds... Saw two minutes of action vs. UCLA (3-8-12) in the Pac-12 tournament, but contributed a key and-one, finishing with three points... Collected four points, four rebounds and three blocks vs. Oregon State (3-9-12) at the Pac-12 tourney... Tallied two points, two boards and two steals vs. Colorado (3-10-12) in the Pac-12 tournament... Hit 4-of-6 FGs in Arizona's Pac-12 tourney run... Had five points and five boards vs. Bucknell (3-14-12) in the NIT.

High School

Prepped at Herbert Hoover High School in San Diego, Calif.... Rated as the No. 73 overall prospect in the country and the No. 9 forward by Rivals.com to go with a scout grade of 94 by ESPN.com... Finished his prep career with more than 2,000 points (2,133), ranked second on the national high school career blocked shot list (1,120), and was second in California high school history in rebounds (1,732) and games played (135)... Averaged 23.4 points, 14.9 rebounds and 7.8 blocked shots as a senior in leading Hoover to a 26-8 record and a berth in the CIF San Diego Section Division II champi-
