### Aztecs Ready for No. 15/17 Virginia Tech at NCAA Los Angeles Regional

The San Diego State softball team returns to the campus of No. 6/6 UCLA to play No. 15/17 Virginia Tech in the NCAA Los Angeles Regional this weekend at Easton Stadium.

The Aztecs (31-18) earned the No. 3 seed in the double-elimination regional after winning a second-straight Mountain West tournament, hosted last weekend at Boise State. SDSU plays the Hokies (39-12-1) at 3 p.m. PT Friday on ESPUN. The host Bruins (37-10), the No. 6 overall seed in the tournament, meet Grand Canyon (48-11) in the other game at 5:30 p.m. PT. The NCAA Los Angeles Regional is the toughest in the country according to average RPI (31.50).

SDSU is playing in its 14th NCAA tournament and third straight under third-year head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz. San Diego State, which also made the tournament in 2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2022 and 2023, is 22-26 all-time in the NCAA championship, has advanced to seven NCAA regional finals and one NCAA Super Regional, and won at least one game in the double-elimination regional in 12 of its previous 13 appearances.

The Aztecs are playing in Los Angeles for the sixth time out of their 14 appearances in a NCAA regional (also 2001, 2006, 2010, 2012, 2015 and 2023), owning a 13-10 record at Easton Stadium. Last season, SDSU went 3-0 at the Los Angeles regional, which also featured UCLA and Grand Canyon, and lost a best-of-three series at Utah, 2-1, for the right to play in the Women's College World Series.

The regional winners will advance to super regional competition for a best-of-three series from May 23-26 at eight campus sites.

The Mountain West Co-Player of the Year and reigning MW Tournament MVP Mac Barbara leads San Diego State in a host of offensive categories, including average (.383), hits (51), home runs (14), RBIs (48), walks (33), slugging percentage (.774) and on-base percentage (.503). Former Bruin Alyssa Garcia (.325, 2 HR, 24 RBI) and Cali Decker (.305, 2 HR, 23 RBI) are also hitting over .300 for the Aztecs, who are hitting .285 as a team.

Dee Dee Hernandez (10-4, 3 SV, 2.53 ERA, 72.0 IP), Cece Cellura (8-5, 4 SV, 2.60 ERA, 102.1 IP) and Allie Light (12-7, 2 SV, 2.62 ERA, 120.0 IP) have done a bulk of the pitching for SDSU, which has combined for a 2.52 ERA in 333 innings.

**STACEY NUVEMAN DENIZ**  
**HEAD COACH | 3RD SEASON (16TH OVERALL) | UCLA, 2002**

- Was named San Diego State's fifth head coach in program history on June 8, 2021, taking over for SDSU's all-time winningest head coach Kathy Van Wyk.
- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 14 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- In her first season as SDSU's head coach in 2022, San Diego State went 39-16 (.712) for the second-best winning percentage in school history, winning the Mountain West regular-season title for the first time since 2014.
- Was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in 2022 in her first season as head coach and again this year.
- Is 109-51 (.681) as head coach at SDSU leading the Aztecs to a MW Tournament title each of the last two years.
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs.

**SDSU/NCAA Notes**

- \* The Aztecs are playing in its 14th NCAA tournament overall and third straight, but just the third since 2015.
- \* SDSU is in its third NCAA tournament under third-year head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz.
- \* All 14 NCAA tournament appearances have come this century, including 2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2022, 2023 and now 2024.
- \* San Diego State is 22-26 all-time at the NCAAs, with five of the losses coming at the hands of UCLA (twice in 2001, and once in 2006, 2010 and 2015).
- \* SDSU has advanced to seven NCAA regional finals (2001, 2006, 2011, 2012, 2015, 2022 and 2023) out of its 13 appearances, making it to one NCAA Super Regionals (last year at Utah).
- \* San Diego State has made the regional final in five of its six trips to Easton Stadium (2001, 2006, 2012, 2015 and 2023), only not qualifying in 2010.
- \* The Aztecs have won at least one game in the double-elimination regional in 12 of its 13 appearances.
- \* SDSU is 21-14 in the tournament when playing as a neutral team (1-12 as the road squad).
- \* San Diego State is 13-10 all-time in Los Angeles in the NCAA tournament, going 3-2 in the eight-team field in 2001, and in the current four-team field 2-2 in 2006, 1-2 in 2010, 2-2 in 2012, 2-2 in 2015 and 3-0 in 2023.
- \* The Aztecs have made the regional final in five of their six appearances at UCLA.
- \* SDSU is the No. 3 seed in the four-team regional for its eighth consecutive NCAA tournament appearance (also 2011-15, and 2022-23). San Diego State is 13-12 all-time as the No. 3 seed, advancing to five regional finals (2011 in Tempe, 2012 in Los Angeles, 2015 in Los Angeles, 2022 in Tempe and 2023 in Los Angeles).
- \* The Aztecs are playing in the tournament's toughest regional for the sixth time over their last seven appearances (also 2012, 2013, 2015, 2022 and 2023). The exception was the 2014 season in Tempe, which still featured ninth-ranked Arizona State and No. 20 Michigan. This year's Los Angeles Regional averages a 31.50 RPI, ahead of two regionals tied at 35.50 (Gainesville and Columbia). More on that below.

**Aztecs Playing in the Toughest NCAA Regional (Again)**

No stranger to playing tough competition, San Diego State will once again play in the toughest region out of the 16 regionals of the NCAA tournament.

This weekend's NCAA Los Angeles Regional features UCLA (No. 10 in the final regular season RPI), Virginia Tech (No. 20), the Aztecs (No. 35) and Grand Canyon (No. 59), which comes out to an average RPI of 31.50. The next-toughest regional based on average RPI is both the Columbia Regional (No. 6 Missouri, No. 26 Washington, No. 43 Indiana and No. 67 Omaha) and the Gainesville Regional (No. 7 Florida, No. 33 South Alabama, No. 41 Florida Atlantic and No. 61 Florida Gulf Coast), for averages of 35.50.

This marks the sixth time in SDSU's last seven appearances that it has played in the toughest region. In 2012, San Diego State played with a group at the NCAA Los Angeles Regional that averaged 30.75 (next best was 31.50). In 2013 at the NCAA Tempe Regional, the Aztecs' quartet averaged a 36.00 RPI (next toughest was 39.75). In 2015, SDSU played at the NCAA Los Angeles Regional, which had an average RPI of 31.00 (No. 2 was Eugene Regional at 36.00). In 2022, San Diego State played at the NCAA Tempe Regional, which had a 36.25 (next toughest was 37.00). Then last year the Aztecs played at the NCAA Los Angeles Regional, which had a 32.00 (next toughest was 39.00). The only exception to the rule over the last seven appearances was 2014 at the NCAA Tempe Regional, where San Diego State still had No. 4/4 Arizona State and No. 13/13 Michigan to contest with.

### Mac Barbara Named Mountain West Co-Player of the Year

San Diego State softball junior Mac Barbara (Long Beach, Calif.) has been named the Mountain West Co-Player of the Year, the league announced on May 8. Barbara joins Nevada's Gabby Herrera as the Players of the Year for the conference. She is one of four Aztecs named to an all-conference team while SDSU Head Coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz earned Mountain West Coach of the Year honors.

The postseason awards are voted on by the league's nine head coaches and take into account Mountain West games only.

Barbara is joined on the All-Mountain West First Team by pitchers Dee Dee Hernandez and Allie Light while catcher Cali Decker represents the Scarlet and Black on the conference's Second Team.

The first Aztec to win Mountain West Player of the Year multiple times, Barbara also earned the honor in 2022. Hayley Miles, who won the award in 2012, is the only other Aztec to be a Co-Player of the Year while Jenavee Peres (2017), Lorena Bauer (2015) and Patrice Jackson (2013) have won the award outright.

Starting in all 22 conference games, Barbara hit .418 while reaching base at a .536 clip and slugging .776 during Mountain West play. 13 of her 28 hits during that time went for extra bases, including five home runs. The slugging first baseman scored 18 times while driving in 17 runs for the Aztecs. During the championship-clinching weekend series against UNLV, she went 3-4 at the plate in each of the final two games including a pair of two-run homers and a double in Saturday's clinching victory while earning Mountain West Player of the Week honors. Barbara's .712 slugging percentage on the season ranked fifth in the conference while her overall .491 on-base percentage was third as UNLV's Ariana Martinez was the only player to finish ahead of her in both categories. Her 31 walks on the season were better than all Mountain West players except Boise State's Sydney Groves.

Nuveman Deniz brings home Coach of the Year for the second time in three years, also having won in 2022. Her predecessor, Kathy Van Wyk, won Coach of the Year accolades five times (2002, 2006, 2008, 2013-14). Nuveman Deniz led the Aztecs to a Mountain West regular season title, going 15-7 in conference play while the Aztecs spent the whole season atop Mountain West in RPI, going as high as 31.

Hernandez makes the conference's First Team for the first time after making the All-Mountain West Second Team in 2022. She pitched to a 2.44 ERA with a 7-2 record in her 13 appearances during conference play. Hernandez earned a save and struck out 19 batters in 37 1/3 innings while allowing just two home runs. Her 2.45 overall ERA finished second in the conference, trailing only Nevada's Tyra Clary. Hernandez was able to limit opposing offenses, finishing top three in the conference in hits allowed (2nd, 67), runs allowed (1st, 28), earned runs allowed (1st, 24), walks allowed (3rd, 16) and doubles allowed (2nd, 8).

Last season's Mountain West Pitcher of the Year, Light lands on the all-conference First Team for the second consecutive season. She finished just behind her teammate with a 2.45 ERA while starting eight of her 16 conference appearances. Pitching to a 4-1 record in Mountain West games, Light led the team with 54 1/3 innings while striking out a team-high 27. She also earned a pair of saves.

Earning All-MW Second Team for the second time in two seasons as an Aztec, Decker also started in each of the Aztecs' 22 conference games. The transfer from Florida hit .348 against Mountain West opposition while getting on base at a .430 average. She hit one home run and scored eight times while driving in 14 runs.

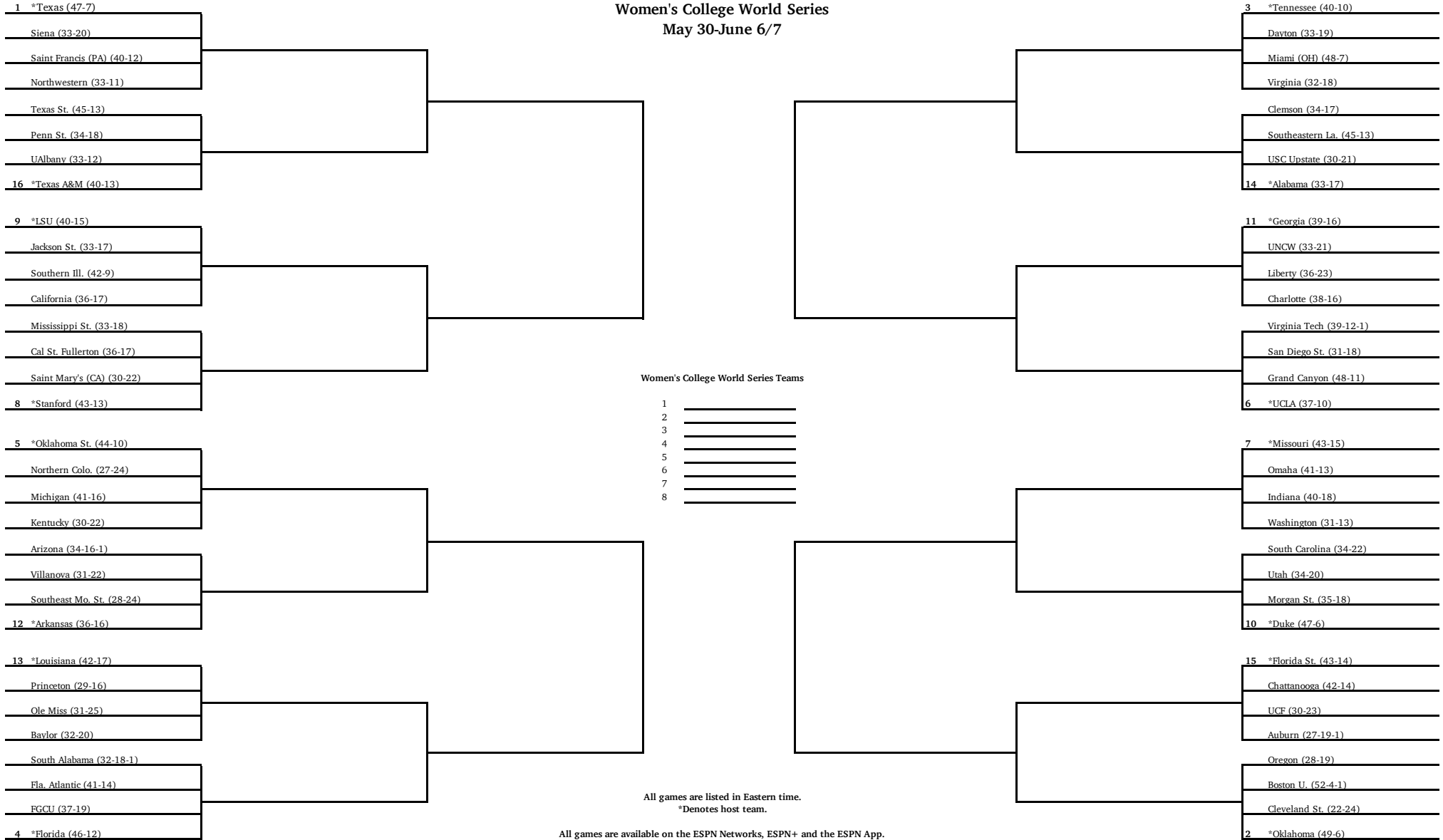
