A San Diego State graduate in 2000, Alex Waske has gone on to have a successful professional tennis career. Since 2002, the native of Germany has played in all four grand slam events. His two best showings came in the doubles draw of the 2005 Australian Open and the 2006 French Open. At the Aussie Open, he and Jurgen Melzer defeated the world's No. 1 team in the opening round, before falling in the semifinals. In the French Open, Waske and Andrei Pavel suffered a similar fate as they lost to the top-ranked Bryan brothers in a semifinal contest.

In addition to having success as a tour player, Waske also represented his country in the 2005 World Team Cup. Teaming with Tommy Haas, the duo secured the crucial doubles point as Germany upset Argentina in the finals. Waske and Haas have also joined forces in Davis Cup play, posting three wins from 2004-05.

In the 2006 Davis Cup, Waske clinched the victory for Germany with a singles victory over Paradorn Srichaphan of Thailand, 6-4, 7-5, 7-6 (12). Waske's victory enabled Germany to advance to the main draw of the 2007 Davis Cup.

Before moving on to the professional ranks, Waske was a singles All-American in 2000 and a three-time letterwinner at San Diego State, where he put his stamp on the Aztec record book. In singles, Waske is second all-time in career winning percentage (.6517, (.793)), tied for sixth in victories in a season (27 - 1999) and is tied for the eighth spot (27-8 (.771)) for winning percentage in a season.

In doubles, along with Adam Webster, the pair is tied for fifth in career victories (24), while ranking seventh in career team winning percentage (.774) and 11th in team victories for a season with 15. They are also tied for the sixth-best (9-2, (.818)) winning percentage for a team in a season in 2000. With Frank Morgan as his partner, the duo is ranked fifth in team victories for a season with 23, and 10th in team career winning percentage (.697).

As an individual doubles player, Waske ranks fifth in career doubles winning percentage (.740), seventh in individual career doubles victories with 57, and is tied for 10th all-time in individual doubles victories in a season (23).

In his three years on Montezuma Mesa, Waske was a member of three NCAA tournament teams, including 2000's round of 16 squad. Previously, the 1999 team advanced to the second round before falling to UCLA.

Individually, Waske played in three NCAA tournament singles draws, with his top effort coming in 2000, when he moved on to the round of 32.
