SDSU Men's Golf Set for MW Championships

The San Diego State men's golf team will be aiming for its third consecutive conference title this week when it travels to the desert for the Mountain West Championships, May 3-5, in Tucson, Ariz. For the seventh straight season, the 54-hole event will be contested on the par-71, 7,144-yard Catalina Course at the OMNI Tucson National Golf Club.

The nine-team field will play 18 holes on each of the three days, following a practice round on Thursday. The Aztecs, who have been idle since April 14, received the No. 3 seed are slated to tee off with No. 1 New Mexico and No. 2 UNLV in the first group on Friday, starting at 7 a.m. PT, while the pairings for the final two rounds with be based on team standings. A live scoring link will be available courtesy of Golfstat on GoAztecs.com.

SDSU will be returning to the Catalina Course for the second time this season after logging an eighth-place finish at the Don Puckette National Invitational Tournament, March 16-17.

Aztec Lineup For This Week

For the fifth time this season, San Diego State head coach Ryan Donovan will employ the starting lineup of senior Tom Berry (New Haw, Surrey, England), sophomore Xander Schauffele (San Diego, Calif.), freshman Riccardo Michelini (Carpi, Italy) and juniors James Holley (Chatsworth, Calif.) and Austin Kaiser (Atascadero, Calif.). The combination was last utilized at the ASU Thunderbird Invitational and also comprised five-sixths of the SDSU delegation at the Western Intercollegiate.

Berry is lone Aztec with MW championship experience among the group, tying for fifth out of 40 golfers at last year's tournament, while Schauffele competed in the Big West conference championships in 2012 as a freshman at Long Beach State, finishing in a tie for 20th in a 45-man field. Meanwhile, the three remaining SDSU players, Michelini, Holley and Kaiser are set to make their conference debuts.

The Competition

Four of SDSU's opponents this week find themselves among the top 100 in the latest Golfstat rankings released May 1. New Mexico is the highest rated team, checking in at No. 6, followed by UNLV (34th), Fresno State (81st) and Colorado State (83rd). The Aztecs, who landed in the 52nd position, will also square off against Air Force (118th), Nevada (125th), Wyoming (174th) and Boise State (178th). TCU, which captured three tournament titles in 2007, 2011 and 2012, dropped out of the MW to join the Big 12 Conference last summer.

SDSU owns a 6-8 record in head-to-head results against six conference foes during the 2012-13 campaign, including undefeated marks vs. Nevada (3-0) and Wyoming (1-0). The Aztecs have also split their four encounters with Fresno State (2-2), while New Mexico (3-0), Colorado State (1-0) and UNLV (2-1) have maintained the upper hand against the Scarlet and Black. In addition, this week's championships will afford SDSU its first look at Air Force and Boise State this season.

Individually, 10 of the top-20 finishers return from last year's conference championships, including the Aztecs' Tom Berry, who tied for fifth along with Colorado State's Kirby Pettitt and James Erkenbeck of New Mexico.

A Look At The Course

For the seventh straight year, the Mountain West Championships will be held on the Catalina Course at the Omni Tucson National Golf Resort & Spa. Designed by Robert Van Hagge and Bruce Devlin, the Catalina Course is known for its magnificent views, traditional parkland-style layout and treelined fairways. Nestled in the foothills of the Santa Catalina Mountains, the course also includes eight sparkling lakes and 80 bunkers, while the 18th hole is considered to be one of the finest and most challenging finishing holes on the PGA Tour. Home to over 30 PGA events, including the prestigious Chrysler Classic of Tucson, as well as several NCAA tournaments, the Tucson National has been selected as one of Golf Digest magazine's "75 Best Golf Resorts in North America."

Backspin: Aztecs Capture Second Straight MW Title in '12

The San Diego State men's golf team claimed its second consecutive Mountain West Conference championship with a five-stroke victory over second-place TCU at the par-71, 7,144-yard OMNI Tucson National Golf Resort. The Aztecs logged a final-round 286 to give themselves a three-day total of 8-under 844, becoming the first school to earn back-to-back MW titles since 2005-06.

SDSU led at the conclusion of all three rounds in a tournament that featured four teams ranked in the top 45 nationally. The Aztecs were up by just a single stroke after 18 holes Friday and pushed that to a five-stroke advantage after day two, which is also the margin they eventually ended up winning by. The squad has now finished in the top two at the Mountain West Conference championships four consecutive seasons and its 54-hole score of 844 matches as its best ever total at this event.

All five Aztec golfers finished in the top 20 on the individual leaderboard, including three in the top 10. Senior Alex Kang and junior Tom Berry were the co-leaders through 36 holes, but dropped back to fourth and fifth place respectively after both carding their highest rounds of the event.

Kang's fourth-place performance was his third in the top 10 in three career appearances at the conference tournament, as he finished third in 2011 and tied for seventh as a freshman in 2009. He logged 14 total birdies in the 54 holes this weekend, which were the most by anyone in the 40-golfer field, and ended up at 3-under 210, including a final-round 73. Kang has now been in the top five on five occasions in 2011-12, and has placed in the top 10 six times in 13 total events.

Aztecs At The MW Championships

In the 13-year history of the Mountain West, San Diego State has won two team championships, capturing back-to-back titles in 2011 and 2012. The Aztecs also tied for the top spot in 2009, but lost in a team playoff to TCU after rallying from a five-stroke deficit in regulation.

In addition, SDSU has finished second five times (2010, 2009, 2006, 2003, 2001), placed fourth on three occasions (2005, 2004, 2002), came in fifth twice (2007, 2000) and ended up in the seventh position once (2008).

The Aztecs' best individual performance was recorded in 2001 when John Lepak posted a 3-over 219 to win by one stroke at Sunriver Resort in Oregon. SDSU's Adam Porzak also tied for first place in regulation in 2007, but came up just short in a one-hole playoff to Robby Ormand of TCU.

The Aztecs have routinely fared well individually at the MW tournament, placing one player among the top four in each of the last seven seasons and 12 times overall.

Mountain West History 101

- Six schools have won at least one Mountain West title with just two, San Diego State and New Mexico, claiming consecutive championships. UNLV finished atop the standings in two of the first three MW championships in 2000 and 2002, BYU placed first in 2001 and 2007, UNM won four in a row from 2003-06, while TCU earned its lone title in 2009. Three teams have combined to win the four most recent tournaments with Colorado State doing so twice during that span in 2008 and 2010.
- Six different schools have had a player win the individual title, including SDSU (2001), UNLV (2000, 2004, 2008, 2011), New Mexico (2003, 2009), Colorado State (2002, 2010), BYU (2005) and TCU (2007).
- The inaugural MW Championships took place on the Nicklaus Tournament Course at the PGA West complex in La Quinta, Calif., before moving to the Crosswater Course at Sunriver Resort in Sunriver, Ore., for six straight years from 2001-06. The tournament has since been played in Arizona on the Catalina Course at the OMNI Tucson National Resort and will return in 2014 as well.

2012-13 Season Capsule

- Entering the MW Championships, SDSU is ranked 46th nationally in the latest Golfweek/Sagarin ratings and 52nd by Golfstat.
- SDSU boasts two players among the top-five league leaders in stroke average: Tom Berry (3rd (71.94)) and Xander Schauffele (4th (72.18)).
- The Aztecs impressed in their only home tournament of the season, capturing the team title at the Lamkin Grips San Diego Classic at San Diego Country Club, March 11-12 in Chula Vista. SDSU recorded three top-10 individual finishes, featuring Xander Schauffele's third-place effort, followed by Austin Kaiser (sixth) and Tom Berry (seventh).
- Tom Berry was named MW Golfer of the Month for September after winning the prestigious PING/Golfweek Preview to go with a sixth-place finish at the season-opening Kikkor Golf Husky Invitational.
- · The Aztecs placed fifth in five other events, including their

last outing at the 67th annual Western Intercollegiate in Santa Cruz on April 13-14. As a team, SDSU led the field with six eagles for the tournament. Individually, Xander Schauffele tied for fourth-place en route to capturing MW Golfer of the Week honors.

• Schauffele owns two of the Aztecs' lowest rounds of the season in relation to par, carding a 6-under 65 during the second round of the Alister Mackenzie Invitational in October, followed by a 6-under 66 during the first round of the Don Puckette N.I.T. in March. In addition, Berry registered an opening-round 5-under 66 at the ASU Thunderbird Invitational last month.

Just A Chip Shot Away

The winner of this week's Mountain West Conference championship earns an automatic bid to the NCAA regional tournament, May 16-18. This year's six regional sites include Karsten Golf Course in Tempe, Ariz., home of the ASU Thunderbird Invitational, where San Diego State has competed for eight straight years and 10 of the last 11 seasons. The Aztecs could also be sent to the Palouse Ridge Golf Course in Pullman, Wash., the University Course at LSU in Baton Rouge, La., the Golden Eagle Country Club in Tallahasse, Fla., the Scarlet Course in Columbus, Ohio, or The Blessings Golf Club in Fayetteville, Ark.

In all, 81 teams and 45 individuals not on those squads will be divided up among the six regional tournaments. The participants will be selected by the NCAA men's golf committee and are scheduled to be announced on May 6 at 6 p.m. PT on NCAA.com.

A total of 30 schools and two individuals (not on those qualifying teams) will advance to the NCAA championships, May 28-June 2, at Capital City Club in Alpharetta, Ga. The Aztecs have made the national championships 22 times in school history, including six times (1999, 2003, 2005, 2008, 2011, 2012) since the regional format made its debut.

Head Coach Ryan Donovan

Ryan Donovan is in his 10th season at the helm of the SDSU golf program after serving as an assistant in 2003. Since taking the reins, he has directed the Aztecs to 24 tournament titles and five NCAA national championship appearances. In both 2011 and 2012, he received Mountain West Coach of the Year honors and was named a finalist for the Dave Williams Award, which is handed out annually to the national coach of the year in Division I men's golf. Donovan was also was tabbed the Eaton Golf Pride West Region Division I Men's Coach of the Year by the GCAA following the 2010-11 campaign. A native of Yorba Linda, Calif., Donovan was a four-year member of the Aztec golf squad before graduating in 2001
