San Diego State Postgame Notes vs. Utah State

Final Score: No. 11 Utah State 81, No. 6 San Diego State 79 (OT)

Records: San Diego State (14-17); Utah State (8-22)

Team Notes

- SDSU finishes the season 14-17. Their 14 wins tied a career-high for head coach Stacie Terry-Hutson (2018-19).
- The Aztecs are now 16-19 all-time at the Mountain West Championships.
- SDSU falls to 3-5 all-time as the No. 6 seed.
- The Aztecs are now 4-5 all-time in the first round
- SDSU is now 12-2 as the higher seed.

Game Notes

- The Aztecs never held a lead but were tied seven times.
- SDSU trailed by as much as 15 points.
- The Aztecs outrebounded the Aggies 49-36 and 16-7 on the offensive glass.
- SDSU outscored Utah State 21-4 on second chance points.

Team Season Ending Notes

- The Aztecs shot 35.8 percent from three on the season, their best rate since the 1991-92 season (.404) and the second best in school history. SDSU has improved their three-point field goal percentage in each of the last six years.
- SDSU shot 41.7 percent from the field this season, their best since the 2013-14 season.

Player Notes

Taylor Kalmer

- Taylor Kalmer tied a career-high with 22 points and finished the year scoring in double-digits in 25 straight games, the longest streak for an Aztec in the Mountain West era (1999-present). November 21 was the last time she didn't score at least 10 points.
- Kalmer had at least three assists in 12 of her last 13 games.
- Kalmer played all 45 minutes, the 17th time she has played at least 38 minutes. She averaged 39.2 minutes per game in Mountain West games and entered the night leading the nation in minutes played.

Sophia Ramos

- Sophia Ramos had 19 points and nine rebounds.
- Ramos is 7-for-11 from three in four Mountain West Tournament games.
- Ramos averaged 6.5 rebounds per game, the most by an Aztec guard since Chelsea Hopkins in the 2012-13 season.
- Ramos shot 83.1 percent from the free throw line on the year, the eighth best in school history.
- Ramos made 113 free throws this season, the tenth most in school history.

Téa Adams

- Téa Adams had 10 points, her sixth straight game in double-digits after going eight consecutive games with less than 10 points.

Kennedi Villa

- Kennedi Villa set career-highs for points (9) and rebounds (9).
- Villa had a team-best plus/minus of +5.

Isabela Hernandez

- Isabela Hernandez shot 43.1 percent from three this season, the second-best in a single-season in school history (minimum 50 attempts).

Monique Terry

- Monique Terry connected on 40.3 percent of her three-pointers this season, the sixth-best in a single-season in school history (minimum 50 attempts).

Zayn Dornstauder

- Zayn Dornstauder finishes the season with a field goal percentage of 56.7, the eighth best in a single-season in school history.
