

#### THIS WEEK

Under the guidance of second-year head coach Mike Friesen, the San Diego State women's soccer team will open the 2008 campaign on Friday, Aug. 22, when it heads north to take on Cal State Northridge. Kickoff is set for 4:30 p.m. PT at Matador Soccer Field.

#### LAST TIME OUT

San Diego State's 2007 season ended in the semifinals of the Mountain West Conference tournament in Provo, Utah, as the Aztecs fell to host and eventual champion Brigham Young. The Scarlet and Black concluded the campaign with a 9-8-3 overall record and a 4-2-1 mark in MWC action, placing second in the regular season standings. SDSU returns 17 letterwinners and seven starters from last year's team.

#### SERIES HISTORY VS. CAL STATE NORTHRIDGE

The season opener for both the Aztecs and Matadors will mark the sixth meeting between the two programs. SDSU leads the all-time series by a 4-1 count and is 1-0 when playing in Northridge. The Scarlet and Black fell to CSUN, 2-1, in an exhibition match last year in San Diego. The Matadors also won the last regular season contest with a 2-1 overtime victory in 2005.

#### SCOUTING THE MATADORS

Cal State Northridge returns 15 letterwinners and seven starters from a squad that concluded the 2007 season with a 5-10-3 overall record and a seventh-place finish in the Big West Conference. Led by senior captains Nalena Betancourt and Tryna Tafoya, the 2008 Matadors will be bolstered by a defensive backline that returns three players who appeared in all 18 matches during the 2007 season. Tafoya, who notched a goal and an assist last year, is currently tied for sixth in school history with nine career helpers. CSUN will look for offense from a mixture of veterans and incoming talent. Junior Adrienne Dickerson and sophomore Farryn Townley will both be counted upon to find the back of the net, while senior Kristal Phillips will also look to lead the squad after missing last season. Phillips had six goals, four assists and 16 points in 2006.

#### FOR OPENERS

The San Diego State women's soccer team is 11-7-1 all-time in season openers. Although the Aztecs are just 3-4 when kicking off a new year on the road, they are an impressive 5-0 when opening against schools in the Big West Conference.

#### 2008 CAPTAINS

This season, the Aztec women's soccer team will have two captains in junior defender Millie Allen and redshirt sophomore midfielder Cat Walker.

Allen, a 2007 all-MWC second-team selection, appeared in every game last season. The Thornton, Colo., native scored her first career goal against Cal Poly (Sept. 14) and added the gamewinner in the Aztecs' 1-0 upset over Arizona on Sept. 30. Allen has earned the starting nod in 46 career contests.

Walker was named a co-captain last year but suffered a season-ending injury in an exhibition game. As a freshman in 2006, the Folsom, Calif., native started 17 of the 19 contests she appeared in and tied for second on the team with three goals scored.

#### NO PLACE LIKE HOME

San Diego State is looking forward to an eightgame home schedule. In 2007, five of the Aztecs' nine victories were won on at SDSU Sports Deck. In its home opener on Sunday, Aug. 31, the Scarlet and Black will be looking to revenge last year's 3-0 loss to Arizona State. The Aztecs and Sun Devils will square off at 1 p.m.

#### MINDING THE NET

San Diego State returns its top goalkeeper from a year ago in sophomore Aubree Southwick. The Danville, Calif., native started 20 games in 2007, playing in all but 82 minutes during the season.

Southwick wasted no time in etching her name in the SDSU record books, racking up a single-season leading 106 saves. On the career charts, she currently ranks second in goals against average (0.90) and is tied for fourth in shutouts (10).

Also returning for the Aztecs is senior Christi Yount, who had a pair of saves in two games played last season. As a freshman in 2005, the Mission Viejo, Calif., native started 10 matches, compiling 35 stops and a 1.09 goals against average. Yount has four career shutouts to her credit.

#### THE COACHES

After spending three years as an assistant on the San Diego State coaching staff, including two as associate head coach, Mike Friesen enters his second season as the Aztecs' head coach. In 2007, Friesen led SDSU to a 4-2-1 conference record, marking its most league wins since the 2000 campaign.

Nat Gonzalez, who spent three seasons as the associate head coach at Southern California and was the head men's soccer coach at UC Riverside prior to his stint at USC, is in his second year on The Mesa. Gonzalez was a four-year goalkeeper at UCLA from 1988-91 and was a member of the Bruins' 1990 national championship squad.

Jayme Hardwick enters her first season as a member of the SDSU women's soccer coaching staff. Hardwick was a four-year letterwinner as a midfielder at Purdue from 2002-05.

#### 2007 POSTSEASON HONORS

Goalkeeper Aubree Southwick racked up the awards last season, becoming the first player in Mountain West Conference history to earn two individual awards when she was tabbed the defensive player of the year and freshman of the year. The first-team all-MWC pick also garnered freshman All-America recognition.

Joining Southwick on the all-MWC first team was Jackie Ragudos, while Millie Allen and Jessica Girdner were both selected to the second team.

#### SDSU SPLITS PAIR OF EXHIBITION GAMES

San Diego State opened exhibition play with a 2-1 loss to Long Beach State at George Allen Field on Saturday, Aug. 16. The Aztecs held an early 1-0 lead after Cat Walker found the back of the net at the 12:58 mark of the first period, but the 49ers came storming back with a pair of second-half goals from Hayley Bolt.

SDSU returned to action two days later, playing host to UC San Diego. After a scoreless first half, the Aztecs came out of the break firing, with goals from Walker and freshman Taylor Canatsey. SDSU's defense was able to shut down UCSD the rest of the way, holding on for the 2-0 victory.

### SDSU PICKED TO FINISH IN TIE FOR THIRD

San Diego State was picked to finish in a tie for third place with Utah in the Mountain West Conference regular season standings. The Aztecs and Utes each received 36 points in the 2008 preseason coaches' poll, while Brigham Young was tabbed as the favorite with 49 points.
