SERIES NOTES

- San Diego State fell to 2-5 all-time against Oregon State.
- The Aztecs are 1-2 vs. the Beavers at home.
- SDSU has lost the last five games in the series after winning the first two in 1972 and 1975.

TEAM NOTES

- San Diego State was shut out for just the third time in the last 219 games (streak started on Nov. 25, 2006).
- The Aztecs were shut out by a Pac-12 school for the first time since Sept. 18, 1982 at California (L, 28-0).
- The Aztecs allowed a first-quarter touchdown for just the second time in the last 11 games.
- SDSU has gone 17 straight games without allowing more than seven points in the first quarter and has allowed seven or fewer points in 25 of the last 26 first quarters.

TRENDS

- The Aztecs lost the coin toss for the second time this season.
- SDSU started with ball for the 115th time over the last 159 games.
- San Diego State allowed its opponent to score on its opening possession for just the 10th time in 27 games since 2022, 11th time in 40 games since 2021 and 33rd time since 2015 (116 games).

PLAYER NOTES

* **Danny O'Neil, TR-Fr., QB (11-for-24, 107 yds., 0 TD, 0 INT)**

Fell to 1-1 as the team's starting quarterback . . . Extended his streak to 57 passes to start his collegiate career without an interception.

* **Marquez Cooper, Sr., RB (13 att., 53 yds., 0 TD | 2 rec., 19 yds.)**

Now has 4,132 rushing yards for his career, which is tied with Louisville's Lamar Jackson (2015-17) for the 115th most in NCAA FBS history (according to SportsReference.com).

* **Chris Johnson, Jr., CB (9 tackles (7 solo), 1 PBU)**

Led the team in tackles for the first time of his career . . . His nine tackles were a career high.

* **Tyler Pastula, Sr., P (7 P, 48.6 avg., 3 I20, 3 50+, 63 LG)**

Averaged 48.6 yards per punt, which is his career high (min. 4 punts) . . . Three of his punts went over 50 yards including a long of 63 yards . . . Three of his punts also landed inside the 20-yard line.

OTHER NOTES

- RB **Marquez Cooper** started for the 34th consecutive game, the longest streak among the Aztec offensive and defensive players.
- **Cooper's** 44 career starts are the most among any current Aztec offensive or defensive player.
- P **Tyler Pastula** played in his 47th consecutive game and 47th game overall, both the longest and most among any current Aztec.
- Tonight's temperature was 87 degrees at kickoff, the second-warmest game in Snapdragon Stadium history.
- Tonight's attendance was 25,318.
- Tonight's Aztec Honor Warrior was Christian Chapman (2015-18).
- The Aztec shield was carried out tonight by LB **Tano Letuli**.
