# Final Score: No. 19/19 San Diego State 81, San Jose State 78

### **Big Notes**

- Forward **Jaedon LeDee** recorded his second game of at least 30 points and at least 10 rebounds of the season (also: vs. Washington 11/19/23) and is one of two players in the country who have accomplished the feat twice this season (also: Kansas' Hunter Dickinson).
- Jaedon LeDee has San Diego State's eighth game of at least 30 points and at least 10 rebounds since the start of the 1996-97 campaign. LeDee and Jamaal Franklin have done it twice (Franklin did it on 2/25/12 vs. Colorado State and on 3/3/12 vs. TCU)
- The Aztecs improve to 4-0 this season over northern California schools (Stanford, California, Saint Mary's & San Jose State) and 34-4, since 2010-11 versus northern California programs (Stanford, California, Saint Mary's, San Jose State, San Francisco, Pacific and Sacramento State).
- SDSU improves to 27-7 (.794) in their last 34 Mountain West road games.
- San Diego State beats San Jose State for the 12th straight time and has now won 18 of the last 19 (18-1) since Feb. 27, 1999.

#### **Team Notes**

- SDSU improves to 42-25 under Brian Dutcher in road contests.
- Under Brian Dutcher, the Aztecs move to 37-14 in games in January and as a program has won 81 of its last 106 (81-25) games in the first month of the year.
- SDSU improves to 252-139 (.645) all-time in Mountain West games.
- San Diego State is now 55-26 under Brian Dutcher when its opponent scores the first bucket of the game and as a program is 126-52 in its last 178 games in which its opposition scores first.

- The Aztecs win their 19th straight game when leading at the half. SDSU has won 211 of their last 235 (211-24) when leading at intermission.
- San Diego State wins for the 401st time in the last 415 games (401-14) when leading with five minutes to play. Under Brian Dutcher, when leading with five minutes to go, the Aztecs have won 19 straight and are 148-10 (.937).
- SDSU moves to 110-23 under Brian Dutcher and 236-48 in its last 284 games when outscoring the
  opponent's bench.
- The Aztecs move to 27-10 (.697) on Tuesdays under Brian Dutcher.
- The Aztecs won the battle of the boards and moves to 120-12 under Brian Dutcher when they outrebound their opponent and has won 21 straight when its outrebounds its opponent.
- The Aztecs have won 72 of their last 75 games when outrebounding their opponent (72-3) and 261 of their last 299 (261-38).
- The Aztecs improve to 134-9 (.937) under Brian Dutcher when shooting better than their opponent.
- SDSU outscored San Jose State in the following situations:
  - 14-6 in points off turnovers
  - 38-24 in points in the paint
  - 18-9 in second chance points
  - 12-9 in bench points

#### **Series Notes**

- San Diego State improves to 48-35 against San Jose State and has won its last 12 against the Spartans.
- SDSU's 12-game win streak against San Jose State is currently its longest against a Mountain West opponent.
- Head coach Brian Dutcher improves to 12-0 against San Jose State, including 4-0 at the Provident Credit Union Event Center.
- San Diego State is now 7-1 all-time against San Jose State in Mountain West road games with 5 of the 7 wins coming by double digits.
- The Aztecs have now won 18 of the last 19 (18-1) in the series.

#### **Game Flow**

- San Diego State won the tip.
- San Jose State scored the first points on 3-point play at 19:13.
- San Diego State scored its first points of the game on a free throw at 18:59.
- SDSU used a 7-0 in a 16-16 tie to open a 23-16 advantage at the 9:27 mark.
- The Aztecs held their biggest lead of the game with 6:47 to play in the first half, 29-21.
- From the 6:47 mark on in the first half, neither team had more than a five-point lead in the game.

### **Player Notes**

### Jaedon LeDee - 31 points, 8-14 FG, 1-2 3FG, 14-19 FT, 10 rebounds, 2 assists

Had his eighth double-double of the season (SDSU is 7-1) and 10th of his career... Logged second 30-point, 10 rebound game of the season and his career... Scored in double figures for the 15th time this season in 15 appearances... Now has 34 career double-figure scoring games, 26 of which have come in the 54 games he has played as an Aztec... Led the Aztecs in scoring for the 11th time of the season... Recorded his eighth game of the season with at least 10 rebounds (12th time of his career)... Topped SDSU in rebounding for the 12th time this season and 31st time of his career... Now has two of SDSU's five games with at least 30 points, 10 rebounds and 2 assists since 1996-97 and is the only Aztec to accomplish it twice.

### Lamont Butler - 16 points, 6-10 FG, 2-4 3FG, 2-3 FT, 2 rebounds, 1 assist, 1 steal

Reached double figures for the fifth time in his last 10 games, sixth time this season and 32<sup>nd</sup> of his career... Made multiple three-pointers for the 22nd time in his career (17-5) and fifth time this season (5-0)... Hit on 60.0 percent of his shots for the first time this season and 16th time in his career (SDSU is 14-2 when he does).

## Micah Parrish — 13 points, 5-9 FG, 1 rebound, 3 assists, 1 steal

Reached double figures for the 11th time this season and 53rd time in his career... Led the team in assists for the third time this season and fourth time in his college career.

# Jay Pal — 10 points, 3-6 FG, 1-1 3FG, 3-3 FT, 9 rebounds, 2 blocks

Recorded his third double digit scoring game and 30th game in his career... Pulled down a season-high in rebounds (9)... Blocked multiple shot for the fourth time in 2023-24 (4-0) and 23<sup>rd</sup> of his college career (14-9)
