Aztecs Notes

Neva Lost

San Diego State has never lost to UC San Diego. The teams played in La Jolla in 1990 and 1991 with SDSU winning the first 1-0 and tying the second 1-1. The pair have met again each of the last two years with a 2-2 tie on the Sports Deck in 2022 and a 3-2 Aztec win in La Jolla last season.

Ahh... Perfection

SDSU has faced Eastern Washington twice and outscored them by a margin of 5-0 in a pair of wins. SDSU won a 3-0 result played in Missoula, Montana, in 2001 and had a 2-0 victory in Cheney last season.

Staycation

The Aztecs are at home for seven of their eight nonconference matches this season, with last week's match at Texas the only match on the road prior to Mountain West play.

Shortening the Match

The Aztecs have won 14 straight matches when leading at halftime

On the Board

The Scarlet and Black were able to score a goal against two of the top defensive squads in the country during a stretch of three consecutive matches against ranked opponents (the first time SDSU played three straight ranked opponents in the MW era (since 1999)) with Kali Trevithick finding the back of the net against Stanford and Emma Gaines-Ramos scoring at Texas.

Goins Gets a Goal

On August 18, SDSU tied Weber State 1-1 on the Sports Deck with Grace Goins scoring the goal for SDSU.

Meep Meep

San Diego State opened 2024 with a 3-0 win over the Cal State Bakersfield Roadrunners on August 15. Denise Castro, Emma Gaines-Ramos and Olivia Sekimoto each scored while Carlin Blake and Kali Trevithick picked up assists. Alexa Madueno earned her 23rd career shutout and third in three matches at Snapdragon Stadium.

GOAT Watch in Goal

Goalkeeper Alexa Madueno is up to 21 saves so far this season (third in the Mountain West), bringing her career total to 329 and putting her nine behind Aubree Southwick's program record of 338. Madueno also ranks in the top seven in school history in shutouts (3rd, 23) and goals against average (8th, 1.31). She trails Southwick's school record of 26 shutouts by just three.

Defense Wins Championships

- In 2023, Madueno tallied 101 saves, becoming the second player in program history to notch 100+ saves in a season. Against her contemporaries around the conference, Madueno had the best save percentage in the Mountain West (.835) and the second most saves while leading the team to top three finishes in goals against average (0.99, 2nd) and saves (107; 3rd).

New Kids on the Block

- San Diego State has had four freshmen debut so far this season, all against Cal State Bakersfield. Forward Mia Lane, midfielder Riley Gumm, midfielder Alexyz Nakamoto and forward Alexis Leath appeared against the Roadrunners. Goalkeeper Brynn Korpela and midfielder Karoline Lundstrom are the only two Aztecs who have yet to appear in a collegiate match.

Castronaut

- Last season's leader in goals, assists and points, midfielder Denise Castro ranked in the top three in the Mountain West in all three categories in 2023. She scored her first goal of 2024 in the season opener against Cal State Bakersfield. Castro has 26 career goals, good for sixth most in program history.

All About the Gain(e)s(-Ramos)

- Forward Emma Gaines-Ramos also scored her first goal of the season in the season opener. The Chula Vista native became the first Aztec with multiple goals this season after scoring at Texas, the first goal allowed at home by the Longhorns in 2024.

Kali Living

- Forward Kali Trevithick is tied for the Aztec lead in points and assists through five matches. She had an assist against Cal State Bakersfield when she passed to Castro for her goal. After not playing against Weber State, Trevithick returned against Stanford, when she scored her first goal of the season on a penalty kick. She followed it up with another assist at Texas.

A Historic Goal

- Trevithick's goal was the first time the Aztecs scored against Stanford in their last three matches and sixth total San Diego State goal in the teams' 11 meetings. The last time SDSU got on the board against the Cardinal was on August 30, 2009, in a 5-2 defeat. In addition, Trevithick scored the first San Diego State goal against Stanford in the fourth meeting in San Diego. The goal also marked the Aztecs' second goal in four matches against top two-ranked teams in the Mountain West era (since 1999).

- Midfielder Olivia Sekimoto wasted no time in getting going in the season opener. In just the 14th minute of the Aztec season, Sekimoto found the back of the net for her first goal and the game winner against the Roadrunners. Sekimoto picked up her first assist of the season on Emma Gaines-Ramos' goal at Texas.

Goins All the Way

- Defender Grace Goins entered the season with no career goals and just one assist. That changed against Weber State as she scored her first career goal in the 1-1 tie on the two year anniversary of her lone career assist.

B-Lockay

- Midfielder Carlin Blake leads the Aztecs with a pair of assists. Blake assisted Sekimoto's game winner against Cal State Bakersfield and Goins' first career goal against Weber State to become one of two players in the Mountain West with multiple assists through the first week of play.

Got My Eye On You

- Three Aztecs: Denise Castro, Emma Gaines-Ramos and Grace Goins were named to the Mountain West Preseason Watch List.

Pacific Top 10

- The Aztecs were ranked No. 4 in the Pacific Region by United Soccer Coaches in each of the season's first two regional polls.

Run it Back

- SDSU brings back ten starters from last season's Mountain West champions, including their top two goal scorers in Dori Savage and Denise Castro who scored six and ten goals, respectively.

Back in (Red and) Black

- San Diego State returns six of seven All-Mountain West players from last season. Denise Castro was named the Mountain West Offensive Player of the Year and First Team All-Conference while returners Alexa Madueno, Alexys Ocampo and Olivia Sekimoto joined her on the first team. Emma Gaines-Ramos and Grace Goins earned spots on the All-Conference Second Team while All-MW First Team member Kiera Utush graduated and is the lone Aztec representative not to return this fall.

At The Peak

- The Aztecs finished 9-1-1 in Mountain West play last season to take home their 12th Mountain West championship and 11th since Mike Friesen took over head coaching duties in 2007.

Hold On, We're Going Home

- After bringing home last year's Mountain West regular season title, San Diego State will host this season's Mountain West tournament at the Sports Deck. Quarterfinal matches will take place on Sunday, November 3, semifinal matches will occur on Wednesday, November 6 and the final is on Saturday, November 9.

Iron Mike

- Head Coach Mike Friesen begins his 18th campaign leading the Mountain West's most successful women's soccer program. Friesen has guided his squad to 11 Mountain West championships (five tournament and six regular season), and five NCAA Tournament appearances, both the most among any current league head coach. Now in his 18th season of conference play, Friesen has an 107-35-19 record. His 107 league victories are the most by any head coach in Mountain West history (the inaugural season of the MW was in 1999).

Past the Century Mark

- Friesen finished the 2023 campaign with 107 career regular season Mountain West wins at the helm of San Diego State women's soccer. The 17-year MW veteran head coach is the only coach in conference history to reach the 100 Mountain West wins plateau. The closest to his mark is Boise State's Jim Thomas, who has 65 conference wins.

Like Mike

- Friesen's 187 victories (187-116-47) since the start of the 2007 season, the year he took control of the program, are the most by any current coach in the Mountain West. Boise State's Jim Thomas' 118 victories in that time frame ranks second among current MW head coaches.

Chasing Greatness

- Friesen is just three wins from tying Jennifer Rockwood's (Brigham Young) conference record for overall wins with 190 and four victories from having the top spot all to himself.

Looking into the Crystal Ball

- San Diego State is picked to finish in first place in the MW coaches' preseason poll. This marks the 14th time in 15 seasons the Aztecs have been picked to finish in either first or second place. The only time SDSU was lower than second place in the preseason poll in the last 15 years was in 2019, a year in which the Aztecs were predicted to finish fourth. That team went 10-9-1, shared the Mountain West regular-season title at 8-2-0, and reached the championship match of the league tournament.

Best in the (Mountain) West

- The Aztecs have won ten of the last 23 MW trophies (regular season and tournament), all of which have come under the direction of head coach Mike Friesen. In total, the 18th-year head coach has guided San Diego State to 11 conference titles.

Top of the Mountain (West)

- San Diego State has earned 12 Mountain West titles since the conference's inception in 1999. SDSU was the regular season champions in 1999, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2019 and 2023. The program was the tournament champion in 2009, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2017. The Aztecs' lead all current teams in each category and have the most regular season titles while trailing only Brigham Young (7 tournament titles, 13 overall) in all-time titles.

Above the Rest

- SDSU holds a lead in the all-time series against every current conference member. The records: Air Force (24-1-1, .942), Nevada (13-2-0, .867), Colorado State (8-1-2, .818), San Jose State (15-2-4, .810), Utah State (9-1-3, .808), Fresno State (15-5-2, .727), Wyoming (18-7-2, .704), UNLV (20-10-2, .656), Colorado College (7-3-4, .643), Boise State (10-8-0, .556) and New Mexico (14-11-8, .545).
