Aztecs Notes

Let's Ride

The Aztecs and Broncos have faced off 20 times with 11 Aztec wins and no ties. San Diego State is 5-3 when facing the Broncos at home including wins in the last three matches and five of the last six. SDSU won 1-0 last season and has wins in four of the last seven meetings but the Broncos won 2-0 in the regular season this year.

Tourney Time

This is SDSU's 24th tournament appearance out of 25 Mountain West Championships. The Aztecs have made it every year except 2018 and hold a 21-13-7 record all time in tournament matches. San Diego State is 9-7-2 in the Semifinal round and 7-8-2 when facing Boise State. The Aztecs are 2-4-1 as the No. 4 seed and 1-3-1 when facing the top seed.

Home Cooking

After Sunday's action, San Diego State is a perfect 6-0-0 with a 17-2 goal differential against MW opponents at home this season. The Aztecs beat Nevada (5-0), UNLV (2-0), San Jose State (2-1), Fresno State (4-0) and Colorado State (1-0) on the Sports Deck before taking down the Rebels again 3-1 in the MW Championship. SDSU was perfect (6-0-0) on the SDSU Sports Deck in conference last season as well. San Diego State's last time doing anything but winning at home against Mountain West opposition was a 1-0 defeat at the hands of UNLV on October 16, 2022.

Like Mike

Friesen's 194 victories (194-121-48) since the start of the 2007 season, the year he took control of the program, are the most by any coach in MW history after passing Brigham Young coach Jennifer Rockwood's 190 while the Cougars were in the Mountain West. Boise State's Jim Thomas' 127 victories rank second among current MW head coaches.

GOAT in Goal

Goalkeeper Alexa Madueno led the Mountain West with 96 saves and 5.05 per game and was fourth with a .756 save%. She is 19th nationally in saves (99), 64th in saves per game (4.95) and 80th in shutouts (6). Madueno owns the program records for saves (407) and shutouts (28) while ranking eighth in goals against average (1.34) and has the third most saves in a season in program history this season (owns three of the top seven seasons). Among active DI players, she ranks fourth in saves, is tied for 15th in shutouts and is third in goalkeeper minutes.

Above the Rest

SDSU holds a lead in the all-time series against every current MW member. The records: AFA (24-1-2, .926), Nevada (14-2-0, .875), CSU (9-1-2, .833), SJSU (16-2-4, .818), USU (9-1-4, .786), Fresno State (16-5-2, .739), Wyoming (18-7-4, .690), UNLV (22-10-2, .676), Colorado College (7-3-5, .633), UNM (15-11-8, .559) and Boise State (11-9-0, .550).

All-Conference Special

- SDSU has four representatives on this season's All-Mountain West teams. Denise Castro led the way for the Aztecs, earning a spot on the All-Mountain West First Team. Meanwhile, Trinity Coker, Emma Gaines-Ramos and Kali Trevithick each were named to the All-Mountain West Second Team.

On the Board

- The Scarlet and Black were able to score a goal against two of the top squads in the country during a stretch of three consecutive matches against ranked opponents (the first time SDSU played three straight ranked teams in the MW era (since 1999)) with Kali Trevithick scoring against Stanford and Emma Gaines-Ramos scoring at Texas.

Meep Meep

- San Diego State opened 2024 with a 3-0 win over Cal State Bakersfield. Denise Castro, Emma Gaines-Ramos and Olivia Sekimoto each scored while Carlin Blake and Kali Trevithick picked up assists. Alexa Madueno earned her 23rd career shutout and third in three matches at Snapdragon Stadium.

Weekly Winners

- Several Aztecs have won weekly awards this season. Denise Castro was named MW Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 30 while Dori Savage won the awards on Nov. 2. Alexa Madueno earned conference Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 30 and Mia Lane was named conference Freshman of the Week on Sept. 30 and Nov. 2. Trinity Coker was named to the Top Drawer Soccer National Team of the Week on Oct. 28.

New Kids on the Block

- Alexyz Nakamoto scored against Eastern Washington, becoming the first Aztec freshman to score a goal since Logan Nidy in 2022. She scored again in her next match against Utah Valley. Mia Lane followed it up with a goal of her own as well as an assist vs. Nevada, making the duo the first pair of Aztec freshmen to score in the same season since Denise Castro and Alexys Ocampo in 2021. Lane added her second goal of the season against New Mexico.

Castronaut

- Last season's leader in goals, assists and points, midfielder Denise Castro is on top of the team leaderboards in goals (10) and points (23) again this season. Castro had the second most goals and goals per game (0.47) in the MW as well as third most points and points per game (1.11) while ranking 46th in the nation in goals and 67th in points. She had a five point performance with a brace and an assist vs. EWU. To begin conference play, Castro had another brace vs. Nevada and an additional goal against UNLV. She scored in consecutive wins over San Jose State and Fresno State and in the waning minutes of the match to tie Wyoming 3-3. Castro is in third in points (84) and goals (35) in program history. In the First Round of the MW tournament, Castro scored once more, this time just 72 seconds into the match.

- All About the Gain(e)s(-Ramos)
- Forward Emma Gaines-Ramos also scored in the season opener and at Texas, the first goal allowed at home by the Longhorns in 2024. She struck once more vs. Eastern Washington. Gaines-Ramos had two assists against both Nevada and UNLV. Gaines-Ramos scored at Utah State. She tallied three points with a goal and an assist vs. Fresno State and did the same at UNM. She tied for fourth in the MW in assists (7), assists per game (0.39), and points (19) and fifth in points per game (1.06) this year .
- Kali Living
- Forward Kali Trevithick had an assist against Cal State Bakersfield. She scored her first goal of the season on a penalty kick vs. Stanford and followed it up with another assist at Texas. She also had the game winner against Fresno State. Trevithick had a career night in the first round of the Mountain West Championship, scoring twice to lead the Aztecs past UNLV 3-1.
- A Historic Goal
- Trevithick's goal was the first time the Aztecs scored against Stanford in their last three matches and sixth total San Diego State goal in the teams' 11 meetings. The last time SDSU got on the board against the Cardinal was on August 30, 2009, in a 5-2 defeat. In addition, Trevithick scored the first San Diego State goal against Stanford in the fourth meeting in San Diego. The goal also marked the Aztecs' second goal in four matches against top two-ranked teams in the Mountain West era (since 1999).
- good 4 u
- Midfielder Olivia Sekimoto wasted no time in getting going in the season opener. In just the 14th minute of the Aztec season, Sekimoto scored her first goal and the game winner against the Roadrunners. Sekimoto picked up her first assist at Texas.
- Coker Classic
- Defender Trinity Coker scored her first two goals of the season to begin MW competition. After getting on the board against Nevada, Coker followed it up with the game-winner against UNLV. She added two more points with assists at Air Force and vs. San Jose State. Coker set a career-high with four points on a goal and two assists in the 3-3 tie at Wyoming.
- B-Lockay
- Midfielder Carlin Blake is second on the team with six assists. Blake had assists vs. Cal State Bakersfield and against Weber State before a two assist performance against EWU. She had two more assists at New Mexico. She finished the season tied for seventh in the Mountain West in assists and eighth in assists per game. Blake scored vs. Utah Valley and Fresno State.
- Got My Eye On You
- Three Aztecs (Denise Castro, Emma Gaines-Ramos and Grace Goins) were named to the Mountain West Preseason Watch List.
- Pacific Top 10
- The Aztecs have been ranked in the top ten in the Pacific Region by United Soccer Coaches four times this season.
- Run it Back
- SDSU brings back ten starters from last season's Mountain West champions, including their top two goal scorers in Dori Savage and Denise Castro who scored six and ten goals, respectively.
- Back in (Scarlet and) Black
- San Diego State returns six of seven All-Mountain West players from last season. Denise Castro was named the Mountain West Offensive Player of the Year and First Team All-Conference while returners Alexa Madueno, Alexys Ocampo and Olivia Sekimoto joined her on the first team. Emma Gaines-Ramos and Grace Goins earned spots on the All-Conference Second Team while All-MW First Team member Kiera Utush graduated and is the lone Aztec representative not to return this fall.
- At The Peak
- The Aztecs finished 9-1-1 in Mountain West play last season to take home their 12th Mountain West championship and 11th since Mike Friesen took over head coaching duties in 2007.
- Iron Mike
- Head Coach Mike Friesen is in his 18th campaign leading the Mountain West's most successful women's soccer program. Friesen has guided his squad to 11 Mountain West championships (five tournament and six regular season), and five NCAA Tournament appearances, both the most among any current league head coach. Now in his 18th season of conference play, Friesen has an 113-37-22 record. His 113 league victories are the most by any head coach in Mountain West history.
- Past the Century Mark
- After last week's action, Friesen is up to 113 career regular season Mountain West wins at the helm of SDSU women's soccer. The 18-year MW veteran head coach is the only coach in conference history to reach the 100 Mountain West wins plateau.
- Looking into the Crystal Ball
- San Diego State is picked to finish in first place in the MW coaches' preseason poll. This marks the 14th time in 15 seasons the Aztecs have been picked to finish in either first or second place. The only time SDSU was lower than second place in the preseason poll in the last 15 years was in 2019, a year in which the Aztecs were predicted to finish fourth. That team went 10-9-1, shared the Mountain West regular-season title at 8-2-0, and reached the championship match of the league tournament.
- Best in the (Mountain) West
- The Aztecs have won ten of the last 24 MW trophies (regular season and tournament), all of which have come under the direction of head coach Mike Friesen. In total, the 18th-year head coach has guided San Diego State to 11 conference titles.
- Top of the Mountain (West)
- San Diego State has earned 12 Mountain West titles since the conference's inception in 1999. SDSU was the regular season champions in 1999, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2019 and 2023. The program was the tournament champion in 2009, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2017. The Aztecs' lead all current teams in each category and have the most regular season titles while trailing only Brigham Young (7 tournament titles, 13 overall) in all-time titles.
