RV/RV Aztecs Open 2025 Season This Weekend

The San Diego State softball team enters its fourth season under head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz this weekend with five games across three sites.

The Aztecs kick off the season at home on Thursday with a game against the CSUN Matadors at 1 p.m. PT. SDSU will have a couple hours to rest up following the contest before taking on No. 2/3 Oklahoma, winners of the last four Women's College World Series, at 6 p.m. at SDSU Softball Stadium. On Friday, San Diego State will travel to Fullerton, California, for an early afternoon doubleheader. The Aztecs will face Southern University for the first time ever at 1 p.m. before playing the host Cal State Fullerton Titans at 3:30. Following an off day on Saturday, SDSU will be back in action on Sunday, when it takes on the Black Knights of Army at 2:30 on the campus of California Baptist University.

A year ago, San Diego State brought home the Mountain West regular season title for the second time in three seasons under Coach Nuveman Deniz and finished 31-20 including a 15-7 record in conference play. Once again, the Aztecs swept through the conference tournament, winning all three games to earn their second MW Tournament title in the two years since the tournament was brought back following a 16-year hiatus. SDSU advanced to its third consecutive NCAA Regional but ultimately came up short against Virginia Tech and ran out of steam attempting a comeback against Grand Canyon in the Los Angeles Regional.

Last week, SDSU was picked to win the Mountain West with eight of the nine total first-place votes and 64 points overall in a preseason poll voted on by the league's nine coaches. Additionally, Cece Cellura (8-5, 2.78 ERA, 4 SV, .285 avg.) was chosen as the MW preseason pitcher of the year after allowing just eight walks in 108.1 innings last season. She was joined on the preseason all-MW team by fellow Aztecs Cali Decker (.304, 2 HR, 23 RBI, 13 R) and Dee Dee Hernandez (10-4, 2.65 ERA, 3 SV, .267 BAA).

Other returning starters for SDSU include Lala Macario (.313, 1 HR, 8 RBI, 40 R, 3 2B, 1 3B, 20 SB), Bella Espinoza (.241, 2 RBI, 19 R, 8 SB) and Angie Yellen (.260, 2 HR, 17 RBI, 18 R, 4 2B).

Despite falling 3-0 to No. 3/3 Stanford to open the 2024 campaign, the Aztecs have won 24 of 28 season openers since 1996, outscoring the opposition 6.0-2.1 in the wins. During that span, San Diego State is 6-0 when its opening game is not part of a larger tournament and the Aztecs haven't lost an opener since 2012 when facing an unranked opponent while going 7-2 in openers played on The Mesa.

Stacey Nuveman Deniz

Head Coach | 4th Season (17th overall) | UCLA, 2002

- Was named San Diego State's fifth head coach in program history on June 8, 2021, taking over for SDSU's all-time winningest head coach Kathy Van Wyk.
- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 14 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- In her first season as SDSU's head coach in 2022, San Diego State went 39-16 (.712) for the second-best winning percentage in school history, winning the Mountain West regular-season title for the first time since 2014.
- Was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in 2022 in her first season as head coach and again last year.
- Is 109-53 (.673) as head coach at SDSU leading the Aztecs to a MW Tournament title each of the last two years as well as two of three regular season championships.
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Leading the AUSL Bandits in the league's inaugural season this summer
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs.

MW Preseason Pitcher of the Year Cece Cellura Leads Aztecs to Top of Conference Preseason Poll

The Mountain West Conference announced its 2025 Softball Preseason Poll and Honors on Thursday morning. Three Aztecs were named to the Preseason Team highlighted by Pitcher of the Year Cece Cellura as the team earned the maximum of 64 points in the Preseason Poll to take the top spot in the projected order of finish. Cellura and Dee Dee Hernandez were two of the three pitchers named to the squad while catcher Cali Decker was one of 12 position players to make the team.

San Diego State's three players are tied for the most in the conference with Boise State, who is represented by infielder Sydney Groves and outfielders Mykenzie Hanna and Preseason Player of the Year Sophia Knight.

Last season was the first time the conference had a preseason team. San Diego State led the way in 2024 as well with four on the team: Decker, Bella Espinoza, Preseason Player of the Year Mac Barbara and Pitcher of the Year Allie Light.

In her freshman season last year, Cellura picked up Mountain West Pitcher of the Week once and was named the Mountain West Freshman of the Week twice. Cellura led the conference in walks allowed (8) and home runs allowed (3) while placing in the top six in saves (4, 3rd) and ERA (2.60, 6th). She set the program record for walks per seven innings record (min. 80 innings pitched) with a whopping 0.52. Her four saves were tied for the tenth most in a season and the second most in a conference season as well as by a freshman in SDSU history.

A fellow hurler, Hernandez paced the conference in runs allowed (31) and earned runs allowed (26) while placing second in ERA (2.53) on her way to an All-Mountain West First Team appearance. She was named the conference's Pitcher of the Week twice in 2024. Hernandez kept runners off the basepaths, finishing second in the Mountain West with 72 hits allowed. The team captain has excelled during her time as an Aztec. Her 12 career saves are tied with Alex Formby and Celena Velasquez for the most in team history. In the Aztecs career record book, the senior also enters the season in the top four in winning

percentage (min. 30 decisions, 3rd, .711), walks per seven innings (min. 200 innings pitched, 2nd, 1.02) and strikeout/walk ratio (min. 200 innings pitched, 4th, 4.83).

Decker is a two-time All-Mountain West Second Team selection. Among returning players from last year's roster, she paced the Aztecs in OPS last season (.810). After two seasons as an Aztec, Decker finds herself among the top ten hitters in program history in batting average (min. .250 at bats, 10th, .338) and on-base percentage (min. .250 at bats, 8th, .425). The catcher has found success behind the dish as well. She is ninth in school history in career fielding percentage (since 1981, min. 300 chances) with a .9887 rate and finished ninth in the Mountain West in 2024 with 195 putouts.

In the preseason poll, the Aztecs received the maximum of eight first place votes and 64 points for the second straight season. In the last 24 preseason polls, San Diego State has been projected to finish in the top three on 23 occasions and the Aztecs have been tabbed as a top two team, receiving at least one first place vote, 20 times including multiple first place votes 17 times. This season marks the 12th time in the last 24 seasons that San Diego State has been projected as conference champions and the third time in four seasons under Stacey Nuveman Deniz.

Behind the Aztecs' 64 points, Boise State and Fresno State tied for second with 50 votes while UNLV received the other first place vote and is projected for a fourth-place finish with 47 points.

Starting Off on the Right Foot

San Diego State has excelled in season-opening games since records were first kept in 1980.

Following a 3-0 defeat at the hands of No. 3/3 Stanford in the 2024 opener, the Aztecs fell to 33-12 (.733) in lid-lifters in recorded program history.

SDSU has won ten of its last 12 season openers, 21 of its last 24 and 24 of its last 28.

The Aztecs last loss to an unranked opponent in their season opener came in 2012 in a 5-4 loss to Texas Tech. The only other two losses in season openers going back to 1996 came in 2018 (No. 25/25 Georgia, 23-2) and 2000 (UIC, 5-3).

Over the last 28 openers, the Aztecs have outscored their opponent, 154-88, or 5.5-3.1 per game in lid-lifters. In the wins, SDSU outscored the opposition 145-52, or 6.0-2.1 per game.

In that same time span, San Diego State is 7-2 when opening at home, 6-0 on the road and 12-2 when playing at a neutral site.

The Aztecs hold a perfect 6-0 record since the start of the 1996 season when their first game of the campaign is not part of a tournament.

We Meet Again

Of the five teams the Aztecs will face on opening weekend, SDSU has played four of them previously.

SDSU has a 21-37-1 record against CSUN all-time but is 8-3 against the Matadors since the start of the 2011 season and has won the last two meetings and three of the last four. The teams last played in 2023. The Aztecs are just 1-12 against powerhouse Oklahoma but the Aztecs are 1-2 at home against the Sooners with the lone Aztec win coming by a 4-1 score on March 20, 2001.

The Aztecs have never faced Southern University before. SDSU is 28-53 against Cal State Fullerton but has won the last three meetings and six of the last eight since the start of the 2020 season.

SDSU has only faced Army twice, winning 8-0 and 7-3 in the 2022 SDSU Season Kickoff tournament.

Aztecs Hire Bryce Te Kolve as Assistant Coach

San Diego State head softball coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz has announced the hiring of Bryce Te Kolve as an assistant coach. Te Kolve heads to The Mesa after serving as an assistant coach at Texas Tech last season. He was a graduate assistant at Florida State for the two prior seasons.

"We are extremely excited for Bryce to join our staff and Aztec softball 'tribe'," says Coach Nuveman Deniz on the new hire. "Bryce comes from one of the best coaching trees in college softball and has learned from and trained with the best coaches in the game. He will be an outstanding addition to our program and we can't wait for him to get to San Diego and get started!"

The Red Raiders went 29-21 last season and beat Iowa State 10-9 (8 innings) to advance to the quarterfinals of the Big 12 Tournament. During the regular season, Texas Tech had a ranked win at No. 21-ranked Baylor on April 5. Te Kolve worked primarily with the pitching staff, which struck out 182 hitters during the season.

Te Kolve's two seasons in Tallahassee were spent under head coach Lonni Alameda. The Seminoles won the ACC Tournament and hosted regionals in both seasons, finishing as National Runners-Up in 2023. Florida State went 112-18 across those two years. Te Kolve worked with three-time All-American Kathryn Sandercock. In 2023, she finished 28-3 with 11 shutouts and a 1.12 ERA (seventh best in the country) and was named a second-team All-American, NFCA Southeast All-Region First Team, ACC Pitcher of the Year, ACC Tournament MVP and All-ACC First Team.

In addition to his coaching career, Te Kolve is a member of the 23U USA Men's National Softball Team.

A native of Luxemburg, Wisconsin, Te Kolve earned his bachelor's degree in business administration from St. Norbert College in 2021, playing a season of baseball for the Green Knights. Te Kolve graduated from Florida State with a master's degree in sports management in 2023.
