Week 8 - Weekend Road Series vs. Nevada - Reno, Nev.

Aztecs Travel to Nevada This Weekend

The San Diego State softball team is back in action this weekend with a three-game series against the Nevada Wolf Pack in Reno, Nevada. The teams are scheduled to play at 3 p.m. on Thursday and Friday and 12 p.m. on Saturday. All three games will be broadcast on the Mountain West Network.

SDSU (21-10, 5-1) holds an 34-14 lead in the all-time series against Nevada (24-8, 2-1). San Diego State defeated the Wolf Pack in the MW Tournament in each of the last two seasons. The Aztecs have won seven of the ten total meetings between the teams since Stacey Nuveman Deniz took over ahead of the 2022 season.

Last week, the Aztecs played four times, all at SDSU Softball Stadium. SDSU dominated San Diego, scoring ten times in the first three innings and allowing just two infield singles in a 10-0 win in five innings on Wednesday night. SDSU kept up the nice play in a weekend sweep of New Mexico, allowing just three runs across three games. Jade Ignacio was the star of the week, hitting .750 with a 2.083 OPS, and finished the week with a cycle, tallying five singles, two doubles, a triple and her first career home run.

The Wolf Pack have some familiar faces to Aztec fans on their coaching staff. New Nevada Head Coach Victoria Hayward was an assistant on The Mesa in 2022 and 2023 while assistant coach Delanie Wisz was a volunteer assistant for SDSU in 2023 before a promotion to assistant coach last season. Another of Hayward's assistants, Jillian Celis, was a star infielder for SDSU from 2020-23 and a two-time All-Mountain West selection.

San Diego State has fared very well in Mountain West play during Stacey Nuveman Deniz's tenure as head coach. In 2022, the team went 20-4 during conference play to win the Mountain West title. The next year, SDSU finished with a 16-6 Mountain West record, finishing a half game shy of another championship, however the team went 3-0 in the conference tournament to win that title. A season ago, the Aztecs won both MW championships, going 15-7 during the regular season and 3-0 in the tournament. After two weeks this year, SDSU is tied for first with Fresno State.

Cece Cellura (3.06 ERA, 41 Ks, 5.86 K:BB, 1.24 WHIP, 66.1 IP) has pitched well this season as have Grace Uribe (3.56 ERA, 39 Ks, 57.0 IP) and freshman Ava Schaffel (0.91 ERA, 19 Ks, 30.2 IP), who began her career with 18.1 scoreless innings. Cali Decker (1.187 OPS, .496 OBP, .415 BA, 26 RBI, 16 R, 4 HR, 12 2B, 1 3B), Shannon Cunningham (.921 OPS, 4 HR, 23 RBI, 16 R, 9 2B), Uribe (.952 OPS, 3 HR, 16 RBI, 13 R, 5 2B), Bella Espinoza (.781 OPS, .412 OBP, 10 RBI, 25 R, 17 SB, 2 2B) and Yellen (.856 OPS, 3 HR, 17 RBI, 20 R, 2 2B, 1 3B) have all been regulars in the Aztec lineup and contributed significantly to the offense. Defensively, Quinn Waiki has been making flashy plays all season long.

Head Coach | 4th Season (17th overall) | UCLA, 2002

- Was named San Diego State's fifth head coach in program history on June 8, 2021, taking over for SDSU's all-time winningest head coach Kathy Van Wyk.
- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 14 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- In her first season as SDSU's head coach in 2022, San Diego State went 39-16 (.712) for the second-best winning percentage in school history, winning the Mountain West regular-season title for the first time since 2014.
- Was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in 2022 in her first season as head coach and again last year.
- Through 2024, is 109-53 (.673) as head coach at SDSU leading the Aztecs to a MW Tournament title each of the last two years as well as two of three regular season championships.
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Leading the AUSL Bandits in the league's inaugural season this summer
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs.

Cali Decker Earns Mountain West Player of the Week

For the second time this season, San Diego State softball has the Mountain West Player of the Week, the league announced Monday. Cali Decker earned the award this week for her performance in the Aztecs' conference-opening series win at Utah State.

San Diego State (17-10, 2-1) played well against the Aggies. On Friday, SDSU picked up a 13-8 win in the opening game of the weekend. The Aztecs led 7-4 in the second game before it was suspended due to lack of light and resumed on Sunday morning as San Diego State held on for an 8-6 victory. In the series finale, SDSU rallied from down 4-1 in the seventh inning to tie the game, but the Aggies ended up winning on a walk-off home run in the bottom of the frame.

Decker started all three games at catcher for San Diego State. The senior came through in the series opener, going 2-for-4 with a go-ahead RBI double, a go-ahead three-run home run, an additional run scored and a walk while recording five putouts defensively. In the second game, she launched a go-ahead solo homer and walked twice, scoring once more. Decker closed out the weekend with two more doubles in the final game of the weekend. Her weekend numbers included a .455 batting average, a .571 on-base percentage, a 1.273 slugging percentage and a 1.844 OPS. This is Decker's first time winning a Mountain West weekly award and she is the fourth Aztec to do so this season, joining Lala Macario (Player), Cece Cellura (Pitcher) and Dee Dee Hernandez (Pitcher).

San Diego State hosts four games at SDSU Softball Stadium this week. On Wednesday night, the Aztecs will play crosstown opponent San Diego at 6 p.m. This weekend, SDSU will face the New Mexico Lobos in a three-game series. The games are scheduled to start at 6 p.m. on Friday, 4 p.m. on Saturday and 12 p.m. on Sunday. All four games will be broadcast on the Mountain West Network.

Dee Dee Hernandez Wins Mountain West Pitcher of the Week

For the second consecutive week, No. 25/23 San Diego State softball has the Mountain West Pitcher of the Week, the league announced Monday. Dee Dee Hernandez earned the award this week after helping the Aztecs to a 4-1 record in the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic.

San Diego State (12-3) had a good weekend. After falling 7-2 to No. 19/19 Oregon on Friday, the Aztecs bounced back and played well the rest of the weekend. SDSU defeated UC Santa Barbara 4-0 and UC Riverside 4-1 on Saturday before taking down Saint Mary's 6-5 and Hawai'i 8-0 in five innings on Sunday.

Hernandez pitched in three games, all wins for the Aztecs. Against UC Santa Barbara, she pitched a complete game shutout, the first complete game of her career, going seven innings and allowing just two singles and one walk and no runs while earning the win. Facing the Gaels on Sunday, Hernandez came in to pitch the seventh and worked around a single to earn the save. In the second game of the day against Hawai'i, she was two outs from a no hitter, pitching a five-inning complete game shutout in a run-rule victory. She allowed just a pair of singles while striking out three hitters.

San Diego State hosts California Baptist at 6 p.m. on Tuesday at SDSU Softball Stadium. Next weekend, the Aztecs return to Fullerton, California, where they went 1-1 on the opening weekend of the season. In this weekend's Judi Garman Classic, SDSU will play Weber State at noon and Notre Dame at 2:30 on Friday. The Aztecs will face the Utah Utes at 5 p.m. on Saturday and Arizona at 9:30 a.m. on Sunday morning before an 11:45 a.m. clash with host Cal State Fullerton that will be broadcast on ESPN+.

Lala Macario and Cece Cellura Bring Home Mountain West Weekly Awards

San Diego State softball brought home two of the three Mountain West weekly awards, the league announced on February 17. Lala Macario was named the Player of the Week and Cece Cellura garnered Pitcher of the Week for the Aztecs for their play during SDSU's 5-0 weekend in the Shriners Children's Clearwater Invitational Presented by EvoShield.

San Diego State (8-2) had a phenomenal weekend in the Sunshine State. The Aztecs knocked off No. 14/12 Alabama 4-1 and walked off on Wichita State 4-3 on Friday. On Saturday, SDSU took down No. 16/16 Missouri 5-2 and Virginia 6-2. San Diego State capped off the weekend with an 11-8 walk-off victory against Charlotte. The Aztecs were one of only two teams to play at least five games and go undefeated in the event, which featured many of the nation's best teams. SDSU made program history, beating multiple ranked teams in a weekend for the first time since 2008 and going 5-0 in a weekend tournament for the first time since 2016.

Macario started all five games at second base. She hit .500 (8-for-16) with hits in every game including a 2-for-3 game in the win against Alabama and a 3-for-4 day against Charlotte on Sunday. The Chula Vista, California, native crossed the plate four times including three against Charlotte and walked, drove in a run and stole a base over the weekend. Defensively, she tallied seven putouts and 11 assists. This is the senior's first time as Mountain West Player of the Week, but she was named the AAC Player of the Week on February 28, 2022, when she was playing at Central Florida.

Cellura appeared in all five games for the Aztecs, starting the opener against Alabama. In 14 1/3 innings across the weekend, the Preseason Mountain West Pitcher of the Year struck out ten hitters while walking none and allowing just five runs and 13 hits. She earned wins against Alabama, Wichita State, Virginia and Charlotte while picking up the save in her other appearance against Missouri. Against the Crimson Tide, the sophomore hurled five innings, allowing just one run and four hits while striking out three and keeping Alabama off the board after the first inning, allowing the Aztec bats a chance to heat up. In 2 1/3 innings across the next two wins, Cellura kept Wichita State and Missouri off the board, allowing just two hits with two strikeouts. Last season, she brought home her first Mountain West Pitcher of the Week award on April 15, also winning Freshman of the Week on that date.

MW Preseason Pitcher of the Year Cece Cellura Leads Aztecs to Top of Conference Preseason Poll

The Mountain West Conference announced its 2025 Softball Preseason Poll and Honors on Thursday morning. Three Aztecs were named to the Preseason Team highlighted by Pitcher of the Year Cece Cellura as the team earned the maximum of 64 points in the Preseason Poll to take the top spot in the projected order of finish. Cellura and Dee Dee Hernandez were two of the three pitchers named to the squad while catcher Cali Decker was one of 12 position players to make the team.

San Diego State's three players are tied for the most in the conference with Boise State, who is represented by infielder Sydney Groves and outfielders Mykenzie Hanna and Preseason Player of the Year Sophia Knight.

Last season was the first time the conference had a preseason team. San Diego State led the way in 2024 as well with four on the team: Decker, Bella Espinoza, Preseason Player of the Year Mac Barbara and Pitcher of the Year Allie Light.

In her freshman season last year, Cellura picked up Mountain West Pitcher of the Week once and was named the Mountain West Freshman of the Week twice. Cellura led the conference in walks allowed (8) and home runs allowed (3) while placing in the top six in saves (4, 3rd) and ERA (2.60, 6th). She set the program record for walks per seven innings record (min. 80 innings pitched) with a whopping 0.52. Her four saves were tied for the tenth most in a season and the second most in a conference season as well as by a freshman in SDSU history.

A fellow hurler, Hernandez paced the conference in runs allowed (31) and earned runs allowed (26) while placing second in ERA (2.53) on her way to an All-Mountain West First Team appearance. She was named the conference's Pitcher of the Week twice in 2024. Hernandez kept runners off the basepaths, finishing second in the Mountain West with 72 hits allowed. The team captain has excelled during her time as an Aztec. Her 12 career saves are tied with Alex Formby and Celena Velasquez for the most in team history. In the Aztecs career record book, the senior also enters the season in the top four in winning percentage (min. 30 decisions, 3rd, .711), walks per seven innings (min. 200 innings pitched, 2nd, 1.02) and strikeout/walk ratio (min. 200 innings pitched, 4th, 4.83).

Decker is a two-time All-Mountain West Second Team selection. Among returning players from last year's roster, she paced the Aztecs in OPS last season (.810). After two seasons as an Aztec, Decker finds herself among the top ten hitters in program history in batting average (min. 250 at bats, 10th, .338) and on-base percentage (min. 250 at bats, 8th, .425). The catcher has found success behind the dish as well. She is ninth in school history in career fielding percentage (since 1981, min. 300 chances) with a .9887 rate and finished ninth in the Mountain West in 2024 with 195 putouts.

In the preseason poll, the Aztecs received the maximum of eight first place votes and 64 points for the second straight season. In the last 24 preseason polls, San Diego State has been projected to finish in the top three on 23 occasions and the Aztecs have been tabbed as a top two team, receiving at least one first place vote, 20 times including multiple first place votes 17 times. This season marks the 12th time in the last 24 seasons that San Diego State has been projected as conference champions and the third time in four seasons under Stacey Nuvean Deniz.

Behind the Aztecs' 64 points, Boise State and Fresno State tied for second with 50 votes while UNLV received the other first place vote and is projected for a fourth-place finish with 47 points.
