### Aztecs Set for Arizona State in LA Regional

The San Diego State softball team is headed back to the campus of No. 9/9 UCLA this week for the NCAA Los Angeles Regional at Easton Stadium. SDSU will open against Arizona State (35-19) at 7 p.m. PT on Friday in a game that will be broadcast on ESPN2.

SDSU (37-17) earned the second seed in the double elimination regional after earning a third-straight Mountain West Tournament title last weekend. In the other game, the host Bruins (49-10) will take on UC Santa Barbara (34-24) at 4:30 p.m. PT on Friday on ESPN+.

SDSU is playing in its 15th NCAA Tournament and fourth straight under fourth-year head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz. The Aztecs also made the tournament in 2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2022, 2023 and 2024 and have a 22-28 record. San Diego State has made seven Regional finals and a Super Regional, winning at least one game in 12 of its last 14 appearances.

The Aztecs are playing in Los Angeles for the seventh time and third straight season (also 2001, 2006, 2010, 2012 and 2015) and are 13-12 when playing at UCLA. However, two of those defeats came last season against Virginia Tech and Grand Canyon.

This is the tenth straight regional appearance that San Diego State is making in a regional hosted by either the Bruins or Sun Devils and now SDSU could potentially face both teams.

The winner of each regional will advance to Super Regional competition for a best-of-three series from May 22-25 at eight campus locations for a chance to travel to Oklahoma City for the Women's College World Series, held at Devon Park from May 29-June 5/6.

San Diego State relies heavily on pitching and defense and as a team, SDSU pitchers compiled a 1.20 ERA and .221 batting average against across 35 innings to win last week's Mountain West Tournament. The Aztec staff is led by Tournament MVP Cece Cellura, who tallied a 0.95 ERA across 22 innings to improve her season numbers to a 2.11 ERA, 18-7 record and three saves in 139.2 innings. The SDSU lineup is deep with Bella Espinoza, Julie Holcomb and Jazmin Williams setting the table for Cali Decker, Shannon Cunningham, Grace Uribe, Jade Ignacio and Angie Yellen. MW Defensive Player of the Year Quinn Waiki anchors the defense at shortstop.

## Stacey Nuveman Deniz

Head Coach | 4th Season (17th overall) | UCLA, 2002

- Was named San Diego State's fifth head coach in program history on June 8, 2021, taking over for SDSU's all-time winningest head coach Kathy Van Wyk.
- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 14 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- In her first season as SDSU's head coach in 2022, San Diego State went 39-16 (.712) for the second-best winning percentage in school history, winning the Mountain West regular-season title for the first time since 2014.
- Was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in 2022 in her first season as head coach and again last year.
- Through 2024, is 109-53 (.673) as head coach at SDSU leading the Aztecs to a MW Tournament title each of the last two years as well as two of three regular season championships.
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Leading the AUSL Bandits in the league's inaugural season this summer
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs.

### SDSU/NCAA Notes

\* The Aztecs are playing in its 15th NCAA tournament overall and fourth straight, but just the fourth since 2015.

\* SDSU is in its fourth NCAA tournament under fourth-year head coach Stacey Nuveman Deniz.

\* All 15 NCAA tournament appearances have come this century, including 2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2022, 2023, 2024 and now 2025.

\* San Diego State is 22-28 all-time at the NAAs, with five of the losses coming at the hands of UCLA (twice in 2001, and once in 2006, 2010 and 2015).

\* SDSU has advanced to seven NCAA regional finals (2001, 2006, 2011, 2012, 2015, 2022 and 2023) out of its 13 appearances, making it to one NCAA Super Regionals (2023 at Utah).

\* San Diego State has made the regional final in five of its seven trips to Easton Stadium (2001, 2006, 2012, 2015 and 2023), only not qualifying in 2010 and 2024.

\* The Aztecs have won at least one game in the double-elimination regional in 12 of its 14 appearances.

\* SDSU is 21-16 in the tournament when playing as a neutral team (1-12 as the road squad).

\* San Diego State is 13-12 all-time in Los Angeles in the NCAA tournament, going 3-2 in the eight-team field in 2001, and in the current four-team field 2-2 in 2006, 1-2 in 2010, 2-2 in 2012, 2-2 in 2015, 3-0 in 2023 and 0-2 in 2024.

\* The Aztecs have made the regional final in five of their seven appearances at UCLA.

\* SDSU is the No. 3 seed in the four-team regional for its ninth consecutive NCAA tournament appearance (also 2011-15, and 2022-24). San Diego State is 13-14 all-time as the No. 3 seed, advancing to five regional finals (2011 in Tempe, 2012 in Los Angeles, 2015 in Los Angeles, 2022 in Tempe and 2023 in Los Angeles).

\* The Aztecs have played in either the Tempe (Arizona State) or Los Angeles (UCLA) regional in 13 of their 15 appearances including their last 11 times (last regional at another site was 2008 in Fresno). This year, SDSU shares a regional with both schools. After Friday's game, San Diego State will have played both Arizona State and UCLA five times, which is the most of any school. The Aztecs currently have an 0-9 record against the Sun Devils and Bruins in the NCAA Tournament.

### Softball's Quinn Waiki Named MW Defensive Player of the Year

San Diego State softball's Quinn Waiki has been named the Mountain West Defensive Player of the Year, the league announced Tuesday. In addition to Waiki earning Defensive Player of the Year, Cece Cellura and Bella Espinoza were named to the all-conference first team while Julie Holcomb, Jade Ignacio and Grace Uribe landed on the All-Mountain West Second Team.

The postseason awards are voted on by the league's nine head coaches and take into account Mountain West games only.

Waiki becomes just the second player in program history to bring home Mountain West Defensive Player of the Year honors, joining another shortstop, Shelby Thompson, who did so in 2018 and 2021. Waiki is also the first freshman in Mountain West history to garner Defensive Player of the Year, an award that was introduced for the 2014 season.

Starting all 22 conference games at shortstop for the Aztecs, Waiki finished with 61 assists and 38 putouts on 101 total chances for a .980 fielding percentage. She was a part of ten double plays of the league-leading 15 total turned by the Aztecs during Mountain West play. Waiki entered the final weekend of the conference season without an error. Among Mountain West fielders, the freshman paced the conference in assists, tied for second in fielding double plays and ranked ninth in total chances.

Cellura was stellar in the circle during conference play for San Diego State, going 9-1 with a 1.77 ERA, a 1.03 WHIP and a 3.80 K:BB ratio across 55.1 innings. Cellura struck out 38 hitters, throwing one complete game and picking up a save while being a part of all three of the Aztecs' combined shutouts. She appeared in 14 games, starting on six occasions and holding opposing hitters to a .228 batting average. Among conference pitchers, Cellura ranked first in ERA, second in wins, fifth in batting average against, seventh in strikeouts and eighth in innings pitched. She shut down the opposition, allowing the fewest runs and earned runs, second fewest home runs, fourth fewest walks and ninth fewest hits in the Mountain West.

## 15 NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCES

SDSU's leader in batting average during conference play, Espinoza started all 22 games in left field, hitting .387 with a .425 on-base percentage, 29 hits, 16 runs scored, six stolen bases, five RBIs and five walks. In the conference, she placed fourth in stolen bases, sixth in hits, 12th in batting average and runs scored and 20th in on-base percentage. Espinoza is making her third appearance on an All-Mountain West Team as she was on the First Team in 2022 and the Second Team in 2023.

The next best hitter by average on the Aztecs, Holcomb also started all 22 games, patrolling center field for San Diego State. She hit .382 with a .412 slugging percentage, 26 hits, 13 runs scored, 10 RBIs, four stolen bases and one triple. Holcomb finished seventh in stolen bases, 11th in hits and 13th in batting average in Mountain West play.

A regular at designated player for SDSU, Ignacio started in 19 of her 20 appearances. She hit .370 with a .404 on-base percentage and a .556 slugging percentage for a .960 OPS. The junior tallied 20 hits, nine RBIs, eight runs scored, five doubles, a triple, a home run and three walks. Her doubles were tied for the 11th most in the league.

A two-way player, Uribe shined in her first season with the Aztecs after transferring from Texas A&M. She started all 22 games, hitting .224 with a .381 on-base percentage and a .551 slugging percentage for a .932 OPS. The senior totaled 13 walks, 12 RBIs, 11 hits, seven runs scored, four home runs, four doubles and two stolen bases. In the circle, she posted a 4-1 record, 3.94 ERA and 1.46 K:BB ratio in 42.2 innings. She started in eight of her 13 pitching appearances, striking out 22 hitters, tossing three complete games including one complete game shutout, earned a save and appeared in a combined shutout. Among hitters, Uribe ranked sixth in walks and tenth in homers in the conference. She ranked highly in even more categories in the circle, finishing ninth in wins and batting average against, tenth in ERA and 11th in strikeouts while placing sixth in walks allowed, seventh in hits and runs allowed and tenth in earned runs allowed.

This week, San Diego State is hosting the Mountain West Tournament at SDSU Softball Stadium. The event runs from Wednesday-Saturday, and, after a bye, the second-seeded Aztecs will open against the winner of third-seeded Fresno State and sixth-seeded San Jose State at 6 p.m. PT on Thursday. The entire tournament will be broadcast on the Mountain West Network.

### Softball's Cali Decker Lands on NFCA All-West Region Team

San Diego State softball's Cali Decker garnered National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) All-West Region Third Team accolades, the NFCA announced Thursday.

NFCA member head coaches from each region voted on the teams.

Decker is making her second appearance on an NFCA All-West Region team after being selected to the Second Team in 2023. Her appearance as the lone Aztec on the list means that San Diego State does not have multiple players selected to an All-Region Team for the first time since Molly Sturdivant was SDSU's only representative in 2019. The senior was named to the Mountain West All-Tournament Team last Saturday after driving in all three of the Aztecs' runs in the Mountain West Championship Game.

San Diego State's catcher ranks second on the team in batting average (.362) while leading the way with a .564 slugging percentage, a .479 on-base percentage and a 1.043 OPS. Her 16 doubles this season rank 44th in the nation. Defensively, Decker has caught runners stealing 11 times, tied for the fifth most in a season in program history and has thrown out runners this season at a 57.9% rate, tied for the best in school history. At the dish, her on-base percentage is the tenth best in a season in SDSU history, and she places fourth in doubles, tenth in walks (29) and fifth in times hit by pitch (7).

This week, San Diego State will be at Easton Stadium on the campus of No. 9/9 UCLA for the NCAA Los Angeles Regional. The third-seeded Aztecs open play against second-seeded Arizona State at 7 p.m. on Friday on ESPN2. SDSU will continue action on Saturday against either the host Bruins or fourth-seeded UC Santa Barbara.
