## SERIES NOTES

- San Diego State fell to 1-3 all-time against Washington State.
- The Aztecs are now 0-1 at WSU, 0-1 in neutral games and 1-1 at home.

## TEAM NOTES

- San Diego State wore all-white jersey and pants for the first time since Sept. 28, 2013 at New Mexico State. The Aztecs played 149 games in between wearing their all-white combo.
- SDSU played on exactly nine days rest for the first time since Sept. 7, 2002 at Colorado.
- This was the first 36-13 score in San Diego State's Division I history (since 1969).
- The Aztecs played in their third consecutive turnover-free game, extending their record for the longest streak in their DI history.

## TRENDS

- The Aztecs lost the coin toss for the second straight game.
- SDSU started with the ball for the 122nd time over 171 games.
- San Diego State did not score on its opening drive after doing so its previous two games (vs. Air Force in 2024 season finale and last week vs. Stony Brook).
- SDSU held its opponent scoreless on its opening drive. It's the second time this season in two games it has held its opponent scoreless on the first drive, ninth time in the last one-plus seasons (14 games), 25th time in 39 games since 2022, 37th time in 52 games since 2021 and 91st time since 2015 (128 games).
- San Diego State fell to 1-1 on the season and 4-3 under Sean Lewis when scoring first.
- The Aztecs allowed a first-quarter touchdown for just the 11th time in the last 23 games.
- SDSU has allowed seven or fewer points in 33 of the last 38 first quarters.

## PLAYER NOTES

**\*\* Jayden Denegal, Jr., QB (15-for-30, 133 yds., 1 TD, 0 INT | 8 att., -(28) yds., 1 TD)**

Fell to 1-1 as the team's starting quarterback ... Threw his second touchdown of the season and third of his career ... Ran for his first career touchdown.

**\* Jacob Bostick, Jr., WR (3 rec., 48 yds., 1 TD)**

Caught his second touchdown pass of the season and of his career ... Has a touchdown catch in both games this season.

**\* Jordan Napier, So., WR (7 rec., 69 yds.)**

Made seven catches after having just two in the opener ... The seven catches were the third most of his career.

## OTHER NOTES

- CB Bryce Phillips started for the 36th consecutive game, the longest streak on the team.
- Phillips' 36 career starts are also the most of any current Aztec.
- OL Christian Jones played in his 39th straight game, the longest streak on the team.
- S Deshawn McCuin and LB Mister Williams each played in their 46th career game, the most of any current SDSU player.
- Tonight's temperature was 80 degrees at kickoff.
- Tonight's attendance was 24,330.
- The four captains who went out for the coin toss tonight were: CB Chris Johnson, EDGE Trey White, LB Tano Letuli and OL Ross Ulugalu-Maseuli.
- The Aztec shield was carried by EDGE Trey White.
